♥ First pitch on Friday is scheduled for 6 p.m. ET (5 p.m. CT) followed by a 2 p.m. ET (1 p.m. CT) start Saturday and an 11 a.m. ET (10 a.m. CT) Sunday finale. The first two games of the series will be available on ESPN+ with Sunday's finale broadcast nationally on ESPNU.

Q Radio coverage of all three games can be found on 1560 AM The Franchise 2. Saturday's game will also air on 103.3 FM and 107.7 FM The Franchise while Sunday's finale can be heard on 103.3 FM.

Q Oklahoma is 2-0 against UCF in the all-time series, sweeping the Knights at the 2022 NCAA Super Regional in Norman. The Sooners outscored UCF 15-1 across the two games, earning an 8-0 runrule win in the opener then taking the clincher 7-1 behind a gem from Nicole May.

Q OU enters the weekend in first place with a onegame lead over Texas in the Big 12 standings and a two-game advantage over third-place Oklahoma State.

SCOUTING THE KNIGHTS

UCF enters the series with a 28-18 record on the season and is fifth in the Big 12 standings at 10-11, eight games behind OU. The Knights were swept by Baylor last weekend, snapping a 10-game UCF winning streak, and scored just one run across the three-game series in Waco. They responded with a double-header sweep of Bethune-Cookman on Wednesday and enter the series 2-3 over their last five games.

Q Johneisha Rowe leads UCF with 19 steals and a .377 average, setting the table with her speed and on-base skills. Jada Cody and Chloe Evans share the home run lead at five each while the latter paces the club with 31 RBIs. UCF has stolen 68 bags on 77 tries for a 88.3% success rate. As a team. UCF bats .309 and reaches base at a .371 clip.

Right-handers Sarah Willis (8-7, 2.47 ERA) and Kaitlyn Felton (10-4, 2.55 ERA) anchor the circle for the Knights, combining to cover 170.1 of the team's 284.0 innings this season. Willis has fanned 87 over 99.0 frames with a .223 batting average against while Felton has 51 strikeouts and just 29 walks across 71.1 innings of work.

LAST TIME OUT

Q Sophomore left-hander Kierston Deal matched her career-high of 10 strikeouts as Oklahoma earned a series sweep with a 5-0 blanking of Houston on Sunday afternoon at Love's Field.

Q The Sooners recorded their 21st shutout of the season with Sunday's win over Houston and registered their sixth series sweep at Love's Field. With the win and a Texas victory in Lawrence, OU will enter the second-to-last week of conference play a full game ahead of the Longhorns in the Big 12 standings.

Deal starred in the circle, fanning 10 while firing her fourth complete-game shutout of the season. The southpaw scattered two hits and a walk over her 7.0 innings of work, carried a no-hitter into the fifth and did not allow a runner to reach second base. She improves to 10-1 on the season and has now won 10 of her last 11 starts.

GASSO NEARS ANOTHER MILESTONE

Q Oklahoma head coach Patty Gasso is two wins away from recording the 1,500th of her career at OU, currently holding a 1,498-349-2 (.810) record with the program. Gasso would become just the third coach in NCAA Softball history to reach 1,500 victories. Carol Hutchins (Michigan) is the all-time leader in career wins with 1.708 while Mike Candrea (Arizona) is second with 1,674. OU's head coach leads all active NCAA coaches in career wins.

TIA TIME

Senior shortstop Tiare Jennings is within striking distance of two significant career milestones, entering the weekend two RBIs away from her 300th run batted in and six hits away from also reaching her 300th.

With one RBI, Jennings would tie Stacey Nuveman for sixth on the NCAA all-time list. A second RBI would make Jennings just the fifth player in NCAA history to record 300 in her career. Jenny Dalton is the NCAA's all-time leader in RBIs with 328, putting Jennings 30 RBIs away from tying the national career record.

Q Jennings is one home run away from hitting her 90th, which would also tie Nuveman for sixth on the national all-time list.

The senior has reached safely in each of her last 25 games played, batting .403 with 10 home runs and a .516 on-base percentage during that span.

BIG 12 STANDINGS

Q Oklahoma enters the eighth week of conference play holding a 1.0-game lead over Texas and is 2.0 games ahead of third-place Oklahoma State.

• The Sooners' magic number to clinch the outright title is six entering the weekend, meaning OU needs a combined six Oklahoma wins and Texas losses to secure a 12th consecutive Big 12 Championship.

COLE WORLD

Q Jayda Coleman carries a 32-game on-base streak into the weekend and has slashed .473/.631/.946 for a 1.577 OPS across the stretch. Over her last 32 contests she has scored 40 runs and driven in 27 while producing 35 hits, 10 home runs and five doubles. Her plate discipline has been nothing short of incredible during her 32-game stretch, striking out just once in 113 plate appearances (0.9%) and walking 34 times (30.1%).

SHE'S DEALING

Q Sophomore left-hander Kierston Deal has enjoyed a phenomenal stretch over her last 11 starts, continuing her rise as one of the Big 12's top young talents in the circle. Deal has won 10 of her last 11 starts, going 10-0 with a miniscule 0.42 ERA across 50.0 innings in that span. She has struck out 53 while walking just 10, holding opponents to a .113 average and a meager three extra-base hits.

Q Deal was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday following a terrific week in the circle. She opened the week by firing her first collegiate no-hitter on April 16 against Tulsa, allowing just two baserunners on a hit batsman and a catcher's interference while striking out four across 6.0 innings of work. The southpaw followed by spinning a complete-game shutout on April 21, securing a sweep of Houston with 7.0 scoreless frames of two-hit, one-walk softball. She matched her career best of 10 strikeouts, earning her second win of the week.

Q OU's talented sophomore threw a combined 13.0 scoreless innings while going 2-0 on the week and striking out 14. Opponents went just 2-for-41 off Deal for a minuscule .049 batting average and managed a meager .142 OPS. Deal worked at a 32.6% strikeout rate and walked just 2.3% of batters faced on the week.

LEADERBOARDS

Q The Sooners enter the week ranked highly across the national leaderboards in multiple statistical categories. OU leads the nation in batting average (.379), fielding percentage (.985) and on-base percentage (.485), is top-three in slugging percentage (2nd, .681), shutouts (21), OPS (2nd, 1.166), runs per game (2nd, 8.39), home runs (3rd, 87) and ERA (1.56). Senior outfielder Jayda Coleman is fourth in the NCAA in on-base percentage (.556) and sophomore left-handed pitcher Kierston Deal is fourth nationally in ERA (1.01).

• The Sooners held at No. 2 in both the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and the ESPN.com/ USA Softball poll this week, earning four first-place votes in the coaches top-25.

RUNS, RUNS AND MORE RUNS

• The Oklahoma lineup continues to roll in 2024, leading the nation in batting average and on-base percentage while ranking second in runs per game and third in home runs entering the midweek.

Q OU plates 8.39 runs a game and slashes .379/.485/.681 for a 1.16 OPS, blasting 87 home runs. The Sooners' incredible plate discipline sees them strike out in just 7.5% of their trips while walking at a 16.8% clip. As a club, OU owns a .501 weighted on-base average (wOBA).

Q Five everyday players are batting .400 or better while every position player with at least 15 starts is batting .296 or better. A whopping nine Sooners with at least 115 plate appearances boast an OPS mark above 1.000, 10 have driven in 20 or more runs and seven have left the yard at least seven times.

CHAMPS IN THE CLUTCH

Oklahoma's lineup has produced the secondmost runs per game across the NCAA at 8.39 this season. A key factor in the order's success has been the club's penchant for hitting with runners in scoring position. OU slashes .368/.465/.686 for a 1.152 OPS with RISP, producing a .485 wOBA in those situations.

Q Alyssa Brito is 20-for-41 (.488) with RISP this spring, producing a 1.604 OPS. Tiare Jennings has blasted seven home runs and six doubles while registering a 1.502 OPS with runners in scoring position. Fellow senior Jayda Coleman adds a 1.420 OPS with RISP, Rylie Boone bats .415 and Ella Parker produces a 1.197 OPS on a .400/.508/.689 slash line.

FRESHMEN PHENOMS

Q Not to be lost in the success of the Oklahoma upperclassmen this season, freshmen Ella Parker, Kasidi Pickering and Maya Bland have provided immediate impact to the program as key players in their debut season.

Q Parker is sixth among her teammates in hitting at .394, reaching base at a .511 clip and slugging .670 for a 1.181 OPS. She adds nine doubles, seven home runs and 39 RBIs and has walked in 18.0% of her trips to the plate.

• Pickering slashes .378/.504/.633 for a 1.137 OPS entering the weekend. She has collected eight doubles and five homers to go with 31 RBIs while logging strong defense in both outfield corners.

Bland has been the Sooners' top option as a runner off the bench, stealing eight bags on 10 tries (80.0%) with 20 runs scored.

REPRESENTING THE USA

Four current and one former Oklahoma Softball players have been named to USA Softball Women's National Team rosters ahead of the 2024 World Baseball Softball Confederation (WBSC) Women's World Cup and Japan All-Star Series, announced by the organization Friday.

Q Jocelyn Alo, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen and Kelly Maxwell will represent the United States at the Japan All-Star Series on July 4-8 while Tiare Jennings will appear in the WBSC Women's World Cup in Castions de Strada, Italy, July 15-21.

Oklahoma State

Oklahoma leads all NCAA programs with four representatives on the Japan All-Star Series roster while Jennings is one of just two active studentathletes on the WBSC World Cup roster. Athletes were chosen by the Women's National Team Selection Committee (WNTSC) based on previous and ongoing evaluations at the collegiate levels as well as USA Softball National Team events, trials and camps.

Jennings is set to make her World Cup debut this summer, last appearing with USA Softball at the 2022 Japan All-Star Series. A three-time NFCA First Team All-American and two-time unanimous selection, Jennings is OU's career leader in doubles (60) while ranking second in RBIs (294) and extra-base hits (149) and third in hits (288), batting average (.425) and home runs (88).

Alo batted .417 at the 2023 World Cup Stage Event with USA Softball and enjoyed a dominant four-homer, 11-RBI effort while hitting .591 at the 2022 Canada Cup. The 2022 Honda Sport Award Winner for Softball and two-time USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year closed her legendary career at Oklahoma in 2022 as the NCAA all-time leader in home runs (122), slugging percentage (.987) and total bases (761). She holds OU's career records for batting average (.445), on-base percentage (.557), slugging, hits (343), runs (281), home runs, RBIs (323), total bases and extra-base hits (126).

Ocleman will make her first USA Softball appearance with the Women's Elite Team at the Japan All-Star Series this summer. She batted .522 with six RBIs at the 2019 WBSC U-19 Women's World Cup, leading the U.S. to Gold. The three-time NFCA First Team All-American has started all 224 games since joining Oklahoma in 2021, batting .430 with 260 runs scored, 44 home runs, 175 RBIs and 53 stolen bases. Coleman ranks second in OU program history with a .430 batting average and a .557 on-base percentage while landing third in runs scored (260).

Hansen earned Gold at the 2022 World Games and is slated for her third-straight appearance at the Japan All-Star Series. A two-time NFCA All-American, the backstop earned the 2023 Johnny Bench Award for the nation's top catcher. She has appeared in 217 games across five seasons at OU, batting .389 with 56 home runs and 198 RBIs.

Axwell logged 7.0 innings of one-run ball with 14 strikeouts at the 2023 World Cup Stage Event and returns to the Japan All-Star Series for the second time in her career. The two-time NFCA All-American was named Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2022 and joined OU this season as a graduate transfer. She has won 70 games at the collegiate level, logging a 1.59 ERA across 573.0 innings with 836 strikeouts, 25 shutouts and 13 saves.

COACH GASSO REACHES 400

Patty Gasso became the first Big 12 head coach, in any sport, to earn her 400th conference win with the Sooners' 11-1 win over Texas Tech on March 17.

Q The conference's all-time league wins leader is 412-90 (.821) in Big 12 games over her illustrious career, earning 15 regular season championships and eight postseason titles.

ONE LAST RIDE IN THE BIG 12

Q The Sooners are in their final season of Big 12 competition with a 412-90 (.821) league record since the conference began in 1996 and have won 11 consecutive conference championships.

Q OU won both the regular season and conference tournament championships last season while going 18-0 in Big 12 play. The program has won 23 Big 12 titles (15 regular season and eight Big 12 tournament championships), all under head coach Patty Gasso.

Oklahoma will join the SEC on July 1, 2024.

REFLECTING ON OPENING WEEKEND

Q Oklahoma opened Love's Field with wins over Miami (OH) and Liberty on Friday, March 1, earning its first two victories at the program's new stadium in front of a program-record home crowd of 4,450. Kinzie Hansen walked off Miami with a two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh in the stadium opener, earning OU a 9-7 slugfest win.

A RECORD-BREAKING RUN

Q OU's NCAA-record winning streak was snapped at 71 games on March 3 vs. Louisiana, ending a truly historic run. The Sooners outscored opponents 578-72 for a plus-506 run differential over the 71-game stretch, earning wins over 42 different programs. The streak included 46 wins over Power Five opponents, 40 shutouts, 33 run-rule wins and 28 ranked wins.

Entering her 30th season at the University of Oklahoma in 2024, NFCA Hall of Fame head coach Patty Gasso has molded the OU softball program into a national power and permanently placed herself among the elite college softball coaches in the country.

Oklahoma has won seven national championships (2000, 2013, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022 and 2023) and is one of just three programs in NCAA history to win more than two national titles. Gasso has reached the Women's College World Series 16 times during her tenure, and has advanced to the postseason in each one of her 29 seasons (no tournament in 2020).

With 33 seasons as a head coach to her name, Gasso has a career collegiate coaching record of 1,617-404-3 (.799) and holds a record of 1,456-345-2 (.808) at OU.

She has won more Big 12 games (394-87; .819) than any coach in the league's history and has more than twice as many overall wins as any other coach in OU annals. The Sooners have claimed 15 Big 12 regular season titles, including an unprecedented 11 straight since the 2012 season, and eight conference tournament titles under her direction. Gasso's teams have finished second or higher 23 times in the 27 years since the inception of the Big 12 in 1996.

Numerous Sooner players have prospered under Gasso's tutelage and garnered national, regional and conference recognition. Most recently, Jocelyn Alo helped lead the Sooners to back-to-back titles en route to winning consecutive USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year awards in 2021 and 2022. Keilani Ricketts was also a two-time USA Softball Player of the Year in 2012 and 2013. Gasso has recruited and coached 79 All-Americans, 145 All-Region honors and 192 all-conference selections at OU.

In the Big 12 era, Sooners have been named Big 12 Player of the Year a total of 16 times and Big 12 Pitcher of the Year nine times, while nine have been selected as Big 12 Freshman of the Year and one as Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. In 2010, Amber Flores became the first player in league history to earn player-of-the-year honors twice, Shelby Pendley joined her in 2015 before Alo claimed the honor in consecutive seasons in 2021 and 2022.

The OU softball success under Gasso has also spilled over into the classroom where the Sooners have been honored with 170 academic all-conference honors. Twenty of those have gone on to become Academic All-Americans, including Lana Moran, the 2000 Academic All-American of the Year.

Gasso and her staff have consistently been recognized for their efforts on and off the field. The staff was awarded three consecutive Speedline/NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year awards from 1999-2001 and received the national honor in 2000, 2013, 2016, 2017 and 2023. Gasso and staff have claimed the regional honor in 15 of their 29 seasons, with the most recent award coming in 2023. In addition, Gasso has been named the Big 12 Coach of the Year 15 times: 1996, 1999, 2000, 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2023.


