LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

A SUPER REMATCH

- The UCF softball team plays host for the three-time defending national champion and second-ranked Oklahoma Sooners for a three-game Big 12 Conference series April 26-28, representing the final three regular-season home games of the 2024 season for UCF, as well as Senior Weekend, which will see the Knights honor their 11 seniors in a postgame ceremony Sunday, April 28: **Shannon Doherty, Jada Cody, Chloe Evans, Jasmine Williams, Grace Jewell, Angelina DeVoe, Johnneisha Rowe, Kennedy Searcy, Katie Burge, Sona Halajian and Sarah Willis.**
- The second-ranked Sooners represent the second top two nationally-ranked opponent the Knights host this season, after then-No. 2 Texas made the trip to Orlando March 22-24. The two series at the UCF Softball Complex makes the 2024 season the first in program history that has seen UCF host two different top two nationally-ranked foes.
- The Knights will meet Oklahoma for just the second time in program history, and the first time since UCF made its first Super Regional appearance in program history May 27-28, 2022. The Black and Gold, after sweeping their way through the 2022 NCAA Orlando Regional with a trio of wins over Villanova and then-No. 20 Michigan, earned a trip to Norman, Oklahoma for a date with the Sooners in the 2022 NCAA Super Regionals. Oklahoma ended the Knights' historic run with a pair of wins by 8-0 and 7-1 final scores, and would go on to win the sixth of its now-seven national championships.
- Cody etched her name into UCF's record books in spite of the Knights' two losses in the 2022 NCAA Norman Super Regional, becoming the first Knight to hit a home run and score in the Super Regionals in UCF's program history. The then-junior punctuated her prolific 75-RBI campaign with her 15th long ball of the season, a one-out sixth-inning solo shot off **Nicole May** in the Knights' 7-1 defeat.

JUSTMAN JOINS AN EXCLUSIVE CLUB

- UCF junior southpaw **Ava Justman** turned in a dominant start in her most recent outing against the Bethune-Cookman Wildcats, recording her first collegiate complete-game shutout, first career solo no-hitter, and her first win with the Black and Gold in UCF's six-inning, 8-0 run-rule victory Wednesday, April 24.
- Justman yielded just one baserunner in authoring the 24th no-hitter in UCF's program history, coming on a one-out error in the top of the first inning, and proceeded to retire the next 16 consecutive hitters she faced, totaling 15 of her 18 outs on via the ground ball and not allowing a single ball to leave the infield.
- With her Wednesday effort, Justman joined **Gianna Mancha** (2022), **Shelby Turnier** (2015) **Mackenzie Audas** (2015) and **Allison Kime** (2006) as the fifth pitcher in program history to contribute to multiple no-hitters in the same season, after she combined to no-hit the Jacksonville Dolphins with graduate transfer **Sona Halajian** in her previous appearance April 10.
- Justman became the first pitcher in program history to earn her first winning decision as a Knight in a no-hitter, as well as becoming the first in program history to contribute to no-hitters in back-to-back appearances within the same season, as her start against Bethune-Cookman represented her first appearance since she tossed her scoreless fifth inning against Jacksonville April 10.

STRONG RUN FOR THE STAFF

- Ava Justman's** Wednesday exploits in the circle represented the latest strong appearance in the circle for the UCF pitching staff, which has posted a team 0.93 ERA (7 ER) in its last 54.0 innings pitched spanning the squad's last nine games since its 9-1 win over Jacksonville April 10. Justman in that span is joined by the remaining six arms which have seen action this season: **Katelyn Cochran, Grace Jewell, Angelina DeVoe, Kaitlyn Felton, Sarah Willis and Sona Halajian.**
- Willis has shouldered a team-leading 23.0 innings pitched in that span, posting a 1.52 ERA (5 ER) with 18 strikeouts and a batting average-against of just .165. Felton has also spun double-digit innings in that span, recording a 0.53 ERA (1 ER) in 13.1 innings of work with 12 strikeouts and a batting average-against of just .178.
- Justman, in her last two appearances, has tossed seven hitless frames, also surrendering no walks, with a trio of strikeouts.
- Felton was joined by Willis, Cochran and DeVoe in shutting down the Baylor Bears in Waco April 19-21, as the Knights quartet surrendered just four runs in 18 innings pitched, good for a 1.56 ERA, while allowing a .203 batting average-against during the three-game series.
- The pitching staff's showing in Waco represented among the best produced in a three-game Big 12 Conference series thus far for UCF, behind their strong outings against Kansas March 8-10 and at Houston April 12-14.
- During the Knights' three games against Kansas, DeVoe, Willis, Felton, Halajian and Jewell combined to post a 1.27 ERA (4 ER) in 22 innings pitched, accompanied by a .208 batting average-against. In Houston, the tandem of Felton, Jewell and Willis posted a sterling 0.78 ERA (2 ER) in 18 innings pitched, while yielding a batting average-against of just .200 in the three-game sweep.

JADA EARNS THE DOUBLES CROWN

- Fifth-year senior utility player **Jada Cody** continued her climb up the ranks within UCF softball lore over the last week as well, hitting the 51st double of her career in the first inning against the FAU Owls April 17 and breaking **Jania Shinhoster's** (2002-05) all-time career doubles record.
- Cody's newest record represents the second she has claimed in the last three seasons, as the utility player also claimed the Knights' all-time single-season RBI record, with 75, in leading UCF to its first Super Regional appearance in program history in 2022. Cody's 75 RBIs in 2022 represented the second-most in the American Athletic Conference, and the fourth-most in the nation, behind Oklahoma's **Tiare Jennings** (87) and Jocelyn Alo (85), and Wichita State's **Addison Barnard** (84).

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10, 2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

SWEEPING SERIES AND BIG 12 CONFERENCE WEEKLY HONORS

The efforts of catcher **Ashleigh Griffin** and senior right-handed pitcher **Sarah Willis** paced the team on both sides of the ball throughout the squad's perfect 4-0 showing April 8-14, with the duo becoming the first two Knights in program history to earn the Big 12 Conference's weekly Player and Pitcher of the Week awards. UCF also joined Oklahoma and Texas as the third school to earn both the Big 12's weekly Player and Pitcher of the Week awards in the same week this season.

• Willis' Big 12 Pitcher of the Week award represented the third weekly honor of her collegiate career, after she was twice named American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week last season. Her most recent recognition also represented the second time in as many series that Willis has been honored with a conference pitcher of the week award after facing the Houston Cougars.

• Griffin earned the first conference Player of the Week award of her career, after being named to The American Athletic Conference's weekly Honor Roll twice during her freshman 2022 season.

• Griffin paced UCF's offense throughout her team's four games, hitting .600/.714/1.500 (6-for-10) with 3 HR, 7 RBI and 15 TB, leading the team in each category while also scoring 6 runs and drawing 4 BB against just 1 SO in 4 starts. Her 15 TB and 1.500 SLG led all Big 12 players during the week. She also homered in each of UCF's 3 games in Houston, and with her third long ball matched her single-season career high of four she set during her freshman 2022 campaign. The series also marked the first time the redshirt-sophomore had homered in consecutive games in her young career, and she also notched her second 3-hit game of the season and the third of her career in game two against Houston April 13.

• Willis threw a team-leading 11 innings over the course of the Knights' four games, highlighted by her six-inning, one-hit complete game shutout in the Knights' series-opener at Houston April 12. She posted a 1.27 ERA (2 ER) with 10 strikeouts and limited her opposition to a .171 batting average-against (6-for-35) in her two appearances, and her two wins during the week tied for the most of any league pitcher. Willis' 1.27 ERA represented the lowest of any Big 12 pitcher to throw six or more innings in Week 10 as well.

STACKING WINS

The UCF softball team wrapped up its hottest stretch of the 2024 spring campaign with its Wednesday, April 17 contest against the Florida Atlantic Owls, following its three-game road series sweep of the Houston Cougars April 12-14 and a perfect 4-0 week when including the team's midweek tilt against the visiting Jacksonville Dolphins April 10.

• The team's 10-game win streak in that span, including a six-game Big 12 Conference win streak, represented the Knights' longest such streaks of the season, and both also marked the longest such streaks among all Big 12 Conference programs. UCF's 10-game win streak represented the team's longest overall win streak since the squad won 14 straight games from April 16-May 19, 2023, punctuated by the Knights' 6-1 win over South Carolina in the 2023 NCAA Tallahassee Regional.

• UCF also clinched its second straight Big 12 series sweep in Houston April 12-14, outscoring the Cougars by an aggregate 27-2 runs in the three games while the Knights staff posted a 0.78 ERA (18 IP, 2 ER) with 19 strikeouts, 2 complete games and a .200 batting average-against. • The Knights' hot stretch vaulted the team back over .500 in Big 12 Conference play (10-8) at the time and into fifth place in the Big 12 standings behind only Oklahoma, Texas, Oklahoma State and Kansas. Now 26-18 overall and 10-11 in the Big 12, the Knights enter Wednesday's midweek action still just one game behind Kansas (11-10) in Big 12 play, with the benefit of a series victory in the teams' regular-season meeting in the first weekend of conference play March 8-10.

KAITLYN'S CAREER SEASON

UCF junior right-hander **Kaitlyn Felton** etched another chapter in her dominant third season donning the Black and Gold over the last week, spinning a seven-inning complete game shutout in the Knights' 1-0 win over the Florida Atlantic Owls Wednesday, April 17.

• In clinching her team's fifth shutout win of the season, Felton brought a no-hitter into the sixth inning and recorded her third effort of the season with at least seven innings pitched, as well as the fifth such start of her two-plus year career.

• Her Wednesday outing also marked the second start of her career with one or fewer hits allowed in at least seven innings of work, joining her dominant 13-strikeout performance against the UMass Minutewomen Feb. 10, 2023, that also saw her go the distance with just one hit allowed.

• Her Wednesday complete game, which also marked the 10th of her collegiate career overall, factored into an overall week that saw the right-hander post a 0.84 ERA (1 ER) in 8.1 innings between her two starts against FAU and at Baylor, yielding 4 hits and a batting average-against of just .143 while recording five strikeouts.

• Entering play Friday, April 26, Felton is just six innings shy of matching her previous season high of 77.1 she set during the spring 2023 campaign, while her 2.55 ERA and 10 wins both represent career-bests. The junior is also just 22 strikeouts away from matching her previous season high of 73, also set during the 2023 season.

DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-CENTURY MARK

The Knights' series finale in Houston April 14 saw a pair of Knights reach significant career milestones and continue climbing the program's all-time record lists. First baseman **Shannon Doherty** recorded the 200th hit of her Knights career with her first-inning single, becoming the 12th player in program history to eclipse the 200-hit milestone.

Doherty enters UCF's Wednesday midweek contest against FAU tied with **Amber Lamb** (2004-07) for 11th on the program's all-time hits list (200). • Right-handed pitcher **Sarah Willis** reached her own milestone in the bottom of the first inning, notching the 200th strikeout of her Knights career. With the punchout, the senior became the ninth pitcher in program history to reach 200 strikeouts at UCF.

SONA SLAM

• **Sona Halajian's** grand slam, which ended game two of the Knights' twin-bill against North Florida April 2 in the bottom of the fifth inning with a 9-0 final score, represented UCF's first grand slam since **Kennedy Searcy's** go-ahead slam in the top of the eighth inning on the road against the Houston Cougars April 22, 2022, which lifted the Black and Gold to their 4-1 victory.

• Her home run marked the Knights' first run-rule-ending grand slam since former UCF catcher and current assistant coach **Cassady Brewer's** grand slam in the bottom of the sixth inning against the UConn Huskies April 30, 2017, also concluding the game with a 9-0 final score.

• Halajian's slam also marked the first run-rule-clinching long ball for the Knights since **Jada Cody's** three-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning of UCF's 11-2 win over FGCU March 5, 2022, and it represented the first grand slam to prove the decider in a run-rule contest since UCF right-hander **Grace Jewell's** pinch-hit grand slam in the top of the fifth inning at FIU Feb. 23, 2022, which at the time gave the Knights an 8-0 advantage in the team's eventual 11-0 victory in five innings.

JADA JOINS THE ORDER

In seeing its players receive the most prestigious honor that can be bestowed upon a student at UCF, the UCF softball team has now gone back-to-back. As announced by the university April 2, fifth-year utility player **Jada Cody** has become the third player in program history, and the second in as many years, to be honored with the Order of Pegasus award, as well as the lone student-athlete to be selected in 2024.

• The Order of Pegasus award is given annually to those who display incredible academic achievement, university involvement, leadership and community service, and Cody joins **Shannon Doherty** (2023) and **Shelly Frick** (2010) as the third Knights softball player to receive the honor.

COACH BEAR CLINCHES 200, THEN 300

Head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone** reached a pair of significant career milestones in the Knights' series win over the Texas Tech Red Raiders March 28-30, notching the 200th win of her UCF head coaching career in the Black and Gold's series-opening 8-5 win Thursday night, before earning her overall 300th head coaching victory with the Knights' 12-9 win in game two Friday evening. Entering UCF's Wednesday contest against FAU, Coach Bear owns a career 210-95-2 (.687) record in five-plus seasons with UCF, and a career 309-211-2 (.594) head coaching record in nine-plus seasons.

• Ball-Malone beat her predecessor, **Renee Gillispie**, to the 200 UCF wins mark, needing just 296 games to reach the milestone against the 344 Gillispie needed to reach 200 wins in her sixth season at the helm of the Knights in 2007.

NENE'S SPARK IN THE LEADOFF SPOT

Center fielder **Johneisha Rowe** is enjoying a career season throughout her first 46 games this spring, as she brings a .382 average (42-for-110) into Friday's series-opener against No. 2 Oklahoma, good for the highest mark on the team (min. 100 AB). Her .382 mark would represent her highest season batting average since the .481 average she posted in 27 games during her freshman debut season at FGCU in 2020, and she has excelled in her most recent role as the Knights' leadoff hitter.

• In 10 games since she was appointed UCF's regular at the lineup in UCF's nightcap against North Florida April 2 to the Knights' series-opener at Baylor April 19, Rowe hit .429/.484/.429 (12-for-28) with 10 runs scored, 3 walks and 7 stolen bases in 7 tries. Her .429 average in that span led the squad among players who started all 10 games.

HOME RUN HISTORY

First baseman **Shannon Doherty** and utility player **Jada Cody** both hit historic home runs in the Knights' 21-9 rout of Wisconsin Feb. 16, with the former becoming the fourth Knight in program history to hit 30 home runs donning the Black and Gold. Cody's solo shot to lead off the game in the top of the first inning marked the 34th of her career, giving the Murrieta, California, native sole possession of second place on the UCF all-time career home run list, trailing only UCF Hall-of-Famer **Stephanie Best's** career total of 71 from 2002-05. Cody enters the Knights' Wednesday tilt against FAU the owner of 37 home runs in her four-plus-year career.
