BYU's Ailana Agbayani's 57 runs scored are the most in the league through I2 weeks while her 67 hits are tied for first.

Sarah Willis turned in her eighth complete game of the season and the 18th of her career in a seven-inning outing against OU. She became the first pitcher since 2022 to throw a seven-inning complete game with two or fewer hits allowed against Oklahoma.
Gigi Solis spun UH's third one-hitter of the season to earn the freshman's first collegiate win while also striking out two.

Carli Spelhaug is the sixth player in lowa State's history to reach 200 career hits, joining teammate Milaysia Ochoa as members of the exclusive club.


Kansas' Lyric Moore has thrown out II runners stealing on the year, which ranks first in the Big 12 entering the week.


Oklahoma's Patty Gasso became the third NCAA coach to reach I,500 career wins.
Oklahoma State set a home regular season attendance record, with 22,070 fans packing into Cowgirl Stadium this season.
Reese Atwood's 70 RBIs entering the week are the most in a single season in Texas' program history.


The four hits by Arriana Villa in Texas Tech's series clincher over Houston is the third time a Red Raider has had four hits in a game this season.
Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big I2 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.

Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), Iowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.
Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list.


The Conference ranked second with eight players represented on Softball America's Preseason AllAmericans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.

This year marks the debut of BYU, UCF and Houston in Big 12 softball. Teams will play each league opponent in a three-game series for a total of 27 Conference games for each school.
