The Big 12 holds three of the top four spots for the third consecutive week in the USA Today/NFCA Divi sion I Top 25 Coaches Poll with Texas at No. I, Oklahoma State moving up to No. 3 and Oklahoma at No. 4. Baylor received votes.

5 In the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, Texas is No. I, Oklahoma State is No. 2 and Oklahoma is No. 4. Baylor received votes.
5 For the third week in a row, the Conference is the only league to have multiple teams in the top four of either poll.
5415 In the RPI rankings released May 7, the Big 12 ranks second in RPI and is one of three leagues that has all of its teams ranked inside the top 90 . Texas is No. I, Oklahoma is No. 2, Oklahoma State is No. 8, Baylor is No. 18, UCF is No. 38, Texas Tech is No. 39, Kansas is No. 46, BYU is No. 5I, lowa State is No. 86, Houston is No. 89.
The Conference has the second-highest non-conference winning percentage (.778) of any league entering Championship Week.
24 Texas' Reese Atwood (Player) and Oklahoma State's Lexi Kilfoyl (Pitcher) procured Big 12 softball awards for the final week of the regular season. Atwood led the Longhorns to their first regular season Conference title since 2010 while Kilfoyl helped the Cowgirls take a series over Oklahoma in Norman for the first time since 1993. Both student-athletes also earned national honors as Atwood was named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA Player of the Week while Kilfoyl was selected as the Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week. This is the fourth time this season Big 12 players have swept the awards and the second time that Atwood and Kilfoyl have won in the same week.
5415 Atwood led the Big 12 in batting average (.700), hits (7), home runs (4), RBIs (13), total bases (19) and slugging percentage (1.900) during the week. The sophomore set a career high with a 9-RBI game in a 23-O UT victory over Texas Tech. She became the single-season home run leader (21) in Longhorn history while also climbing to sixth on the Big 12 's single-season RBI list (83). This is Atwood's third honor this season and her first since Feb. 27.

Kilfoyl did not give up an earned run in seven innings of relief work against Oklahoma and picked up two wins in the process. The senior from Land O' Lakes, Florida held the team ranked second nationally in slugging percentage to just one extra-base hit and four hits total to earn her third award of the year and fifth of her career.
Texas clinched the 2024 Big 12 softball regular season title after sweeping Texas Tech on the road in Lubbock. It is the first Big 12 regular season championship since 2010 for the Longhorns, their fifth overall and the first under head coach Mike White.
The league has announced the 2024 All-Big I2 Softball award winners. Texas collected three individual honors while Oklahoma State's Lexi Kilfoyl was revealed as the Unanimous Big I2 Pitcher of the Year and Oklahoma's Kinzie Hansen was named Defensive Player of the Year. The honorees were selected by a vote of the league's head coaches. Texas sophomore Reese Atwood became the first Longhorn to be voted Big 12 Player of the Year since Taylor Thom in 2014. Teagan Kavan is the Longhorns' first Freshman of the Year since Tiarra Davis in 2014 while Mike White was named Big 12 Coach of the Year for the first time in his career.

Texas is the top seed after winning its first regular season title since 2010 and finishing with a 23-4 record in Conference action. UT will look to take the postseason Championship for the first time since 2005.
Oklahoma earned the second seed and is looking for the program's sixth title in the last seven completed Championships and the Sooners' ninth overall crown.
Oklahoma State is the No. 3 seed, its seventh consecutive season finishing in the top third of the league. The Cowgirls are looking for their second postseason title in the last three years.

OSU will match up with No. 6 seed BYU on Thursday, May 9 at II a.m. CT. The Cougars are making their Championship debut. BYU secured a 30-win season this year for the 23rd time in the 24-year history of the program, excluding the COVIDcanceled 2020 season.
Baylor finished fourth in the standings and will take on first-year member UCF who collected the fifth seed. The Bears swept the three-game regular season series over the Knights. BU and UCF will play Thursday at 7:30 p.m. CT.
Kansas is the No. 7 seed and will face No. 10 seed Houston in the Championship's first game on Wednesday, May 8 at 5 p.m. CT. KU last won the league's postseason title in 2006 while UH is making its first appearance in the Championship. The winner will face second-seeded Oklahoma.

The second matchup on Wednesday will see eighth-seeded Texas Tech face off against ninth-seeded lowa State at 7:30 p.m. CT with a matchup against top-seeded Texas awaiting the victor.


The first eight games of the Championship can be seen on Big I2 Now on ESPN+ while Saturday's Championship final will air on ESPN2 at 6:30 p.m. CT.

All-session and single-session tickets are now on sale and can be purchased here. Gates will open one hour before the first pitch of each day.
Parking for spectators will be available at OGE Field at Devon Park for \$20/day. Re-entry will not be allowed. Upon exiting the complex, vehicles returning to the ballpark must pay to gain entry. The parking lot will open four hours prior to the first pitch each day.


Oklahoma, the three-time defending national champion, was voted a unanimous favorite in the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Poll. League coaches voted in the poll and were not allowed to select their own team. The full poll can be found on Page 3.
OU led all teams with seven selections to the 2024 Big 12 Softball Preseason Team (Rylie Boone, Alyssa Brito, Jayda Coleman, Kinzie Hansen, Tiare Jennings, Kelly Maxwell and Nicole May). Texas followed with five players on the team (Citlaly Gutierrez, Ashton Maloney, Viviana Martinez, Mac Morgan and Mia Scott).
Baylor (Shaylon Govan), BYU (Huntyr Ava), UCF (Sarah Willis), Houston (Turiya Coleman), lowa State (Milaysia Ochoa), Oklahoma State (Lexi Kilfoyl) and Texas Tech (Kailey Wyckoff) each had one player selected.

Eleven league players were listed on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 watch list. represented on Softball America's Preseason All Americans list. Oklahoma led all teams nationally with six selections.
