Joining UCF and Florida llahassee will be the Auburn Tigers, who earned an at-large bid on the strength of a 27-19-1 overall 2024 record, and the Chattanooga

rge bid for UCF represents its fourth trip to the tournament in the last four seasons, marking the first time in program history the we earned four straight tournament bids. UCF makes its 11th appearance in the dance overall since its debut in the tournament in 2005.

F makes its appearance in the 2024 NCAA Tournament, the squad will match up with a pair of familiar postseason foes. The Knights' rip will mark their second trip to the Tallahassee Regional in as many seasons after UCF was sent to Tallahassee in the opening round of ment last year as well, and the Black and Gold will also be making their fourth all-time Tallahassee Regional appearance. hts hung with the Seminoles throughout the teams' 2023 Regional matchup May 20 but were unable to find the key hit they needed in

o then-No. 3 Florida State, despite outhitting the Seminoles 9-4 in the contest overall. UCF this weekend will be in search of its first win prida State since April 6, 2011, a 2-1 victory in Orlando.

t weekend matchup against the Auburn Tigers also represents the second time the two programs have met in postseason play. The id Tigers previously squared off during the 2021 NCAA Tallahassee Regional, when UCF snagged a 5-4 victory. The Knights bounced back m a 1-0 first-inning deficit, producing a five-run second inning highlighted by a two-run double from Shannon Doherty and an RBI rtesy of **Jada Cody**.

hts' 2021 regional victory over Auburn also marked the first win over the Tigers in program history in the teams' third all-time meeting.

transfer Sona Halajian continued her torrid offensive pace over her last month of play with a 2-for-3 showing in UCF's Phillips 66 Big 12 ship quarterfinal matchup against the Baylor Bears, an effort that featured a game-tying two-run homer in the top of the sixth inning. s long ball represented her fifth of the season, as well as her 21st and 22nd RBI of the spring, and clinched the San Anselmo, California, ird consecutive multi-hit game, marking the first time in her four-year career Halajian has notched three straight multi-hit games. enters the 2024 NCAA Tournament having hit safely in 11 of her last 17 games dating back to UCF's nightcap against North Florida April n which she has recorded a team-best. 457 average (16-for-35) with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 17 RBI, 31 total bases, a .472 ercentage and an .886 slugging percentage.

game long ball also represented her 10th and 11th RBI of her 22 this season that have come in key moments in the fifth inning or later this spring. Halajian this season has also hit a sixth-inning three-run homer at Oklahoma State March 17, a fifth-inning game-ending n against UNF April 2, a game-tying RBI single in the bottom of the seventh inning against BYU April 6, and an RBI double in the bottom inning against then-No. 2 Oklahoma April 27 before her clutch sixth-inning two-run shot against Baylor May 17.

Freshman infielder/outfielders Samantha Rey and Sierra is also made memorable impacts in their first collegiate seasons, with both earning Big 12 All-Freshman Team honors as well rns earns the honors for the second time in as many seasons with UCF after garnering AAC All-Conference First Team recognition in earns post-season conference honors for the third time in her career overall, after she was tabbed to the Pac-12's All-Freshman Team her freshman year at Washington

earns a selection to post-season All-Conference honors for the second straight year and third time in her career overall, after she was the AAC's All-Conference First Team in 2023 and The American's All-Rookie Team in 2021.

SARAH'S STRONG FINISH

Knights

• For the second time in her final three appearances of the regular season, senior right-hander Sarah Willis authored a masterpiece. Just two starts after holding the then-No. 2 Oklahoma Sooners to two hits in seven innings, Willis put a bow on her regular season efforts with a seveninning, two-hit shutout against Iowa State in the teams' series finale May 5, and followed with a solid six-inning, three-run effort against Baylor in the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship quarterfinal. She enters NCAA Tournament play ranking among the conference leaders in complete games starts (21, T-3rd), (10, T-4th), fewest hits allowed per 7 IP (5.47, 5th), innings pitched (120.1, 6th), saves (2, T-8th) and ERA (2.44, 9th). Willis also made history in her final home appearance against No. 2 Oklahoma, limiting the Sooners to just 2 runs on 2 hits in 7 IP with 5

strikeouts. The two hits allowed by Willis represented a season-low for the Sooners, who hadn't been held to two or fewer hits since four LSU Tiger pitchers combined to hold Oklahoma to two hits in a 3-0 Sooners win in Baton Rouge April 11, 2023.

• Willis also became the first pitcher to throw a seven-inning complete game with two or fewer hits allowed to Oklahoma since Texas' Hailey Dolcini handed the Sooners their first loss of the season, and snapped a then-40-game Oklahoma win streak, in Austin April 16, 2022, a game the then-No. 18 Longhorns took by a 4-2 final score.

UCF this season embarks on its inaugural season as a member of the Big 12 Conference after accepting an invitation to join the conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10.2022.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II. the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC. Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement.  First baseman Shannon Doherty is gaining offensive momentum at the right time in leading the offensive charge for UCF, highlighted by her 5-for-10 showing in the Knights' series at Iowa State. The veteran infielder hit her fifth home run of the season, and 34th of her career, in the series finale to claim sole possession of third place on the UCF all-time career home runs list, one day after she hit a pair of doubles in the Black and Gold's 12-3 rout of the Cyclones in game two. • In earning an All-Big 12 Second Team selection, Doherty has enjoyed a strong final month of the regular season to finish as her team's leading hitter in Big 12 Conference play (.344, 22-for-64). In 24 games since UCF's series-opener at Texas Tech 3/28. Doherty's .397 average leads the squad among players with at least 50 at-bats, producing a .397/.521/.586 line (23-for-58) accompanied by 2 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 34 TB, 13 BB and 2 SB.

SONA'S SUCCESS AGAINST THE SOONERS

• Graduate transfer DP Sona Halajian provided key offensive production throughout the Knights' weekend series against the No. 2 Oklahoma Sooners April 26-28, hitting an RBI double in the bottom of the seventh inning Saturday afternoon before slugging the second of UCF's three Sunday homers in the second inning, marking the squad's two-run shot of the game

• Dating back to last season's 2023 NCAA Norman Regional, when Halajian faced the Sooners as a member of the California Golden Bears, the San Anselmo, California, native has hit .429 (3-for-7) with one home run, one double, one run scored and five RBI in her last four games against Oklahoma.

CHLOE LEADS THE CHARGE

• Senior right fielder Chloe Evans enjoyed a prolific final week at home against the No. 2 Oklahoma Sooners and Bethune-Cookman Wildcats, producing an aggregate .385/.385/.923 (5-for-13) line with one double, two home runs, five RBI and 12 total bases in the Knights' four games. Against the Sooners, Evans hit .364 (4-for-11) with one double, two homers, four RBI and 11 total bases.

 She kicked off her strong series against the Sooners with a 2-for-4 showing in the opener, driving in both UCF runs Friday night by way of a line drive double down the right field line and a solo home run in the bottom of the seventh inning. In Sunday's finale, she provided an early offensive jolt with the first of UCF's three home runs, a two-run blast inside the right field foul pole that gave the Knights a 2-0 first-inning lead.

JUSTMAN JOINS AN EXCLUSIVE CLUB

• UCF junior southpaw Ava Justman turned in a dominant start in her 17/8 most recent outing against the Bethune-Cookman Wildcats, recording 12/7 her first collegiate complete-game shutout, first career solo no-hitter, 5/1 and her first win with the Black and Gold in UCF's six-inning, 8-0 run-10 rule victory Wednesday, April 24. 5th (48 pts.)

 Justman yielded just one baserunner in authoring the 24th no-hitter in UCF's program history, coming on a one-out error in the top of the first inning, and proceeded to retire the next 16 consecutive hitters she faced, totaling 15 of her 18 outs on via the ground ball and not allowing a single ball to leave the infield.

• With her Wednesday effort, Justman joined Gianna Mancha (2022), Shelby Turnier (2015) Mackenzie Audas (2015) and Allison Kime (2006) as the fifth pitcher in program history to contribute to multiple no-hitters in the same season, after she combined to no-hit the Jacksonville Dolphins with graduate transfer Sona Halajian in her previous appearance April 10.

 Justman became the first pitcher in program history to earn her first winning decision as a Knight in a no-hitter, as well as becoming the first in program history to contribute to no-hitters in back-to-back appearances within the same season, as her start against Bethune-Cookman represented her first appearance since she tossed her scoreless fifth inning against Jacksonville April 10.

STRONG RUN FOR THE STAFF

• Ava Justman's exploits against Bethune-Cookman represented the latest strong appearance in the circle for the UCF pitching staff, which posted a team 0.93 ERA (7 ER) in 54.0 innings pitched between the squad's nine games since its 9-1 win over Jacksonville April 10 and Justman's no-hitter against Bethune-Cookman. Justman in that span was joined by the remaining six arms which have seen action this season: Katelyn Cochran, Grace Jewell, Angelina DeVoe, Kaitlyn Felton Sarah Willis and Sona Halaiian.

• Willis had shouldered a team-leading 23.0 innings pitched in that span, posting a 1.52 ERA (5 ER) with 18 strikeouts and a batting average against of just .165. Felton also spun double-digit innings in that span, recording a 0.53 ERA (1 ER) in 13.1 innings of work with 12 strikeouts and a batting average-against of just .178.

 Justman, in her last two appearances, has tossed seven hitless frames also surrendering no walks, with a trio of strikeouts.

 Felton was joined by Willis. Cochran and DeVoe in shutting down the Baylor Bears in Waco April 19-21, as the Knights guartet surrendered just four runs in 18 innings pitched, good for a 1.56 ERA, while allowing a .203 batting average-against during the three-game series.



 The pitching staff's showing in Waco represented among the best produced in a three-game Big 12 Conference series for UCF, behind its strong outings against Kansas March 8-10 and at Houston April 12-14. During the Knights' three games against Kansas, DeVoe, Willis, Felton. Halajian and Jewell combined to post a 1.27 ERA (4 ER) in 22 innings pitched, accompanied by a .208 batting average-against. In Houston, the tandem of Felton, Jewell and Willis posted a sterling 0.78 ERA (2 ER) in 18 innings pitched, while yielding a batting average-against of just .200 in the three-game sweep.

JADA EARNS THE DOUBLES CROWN

• Fifth-year senior utility player Jada Cody continued her climb up the ranks within UCF softball lore, hitting the 51st double of her career in the first inning against the FAU Owls April 17 and breaking **Jania** Shinhoster's (2002-05) all-time career doubles record. Cody's newest record represents the second she has claimed in the last three seasons, as the utility player also claimed the Knights' all-time single-season RBI record, with 75, in leading UCF to its first Super Regional appearance in program history in 2022. Cody's 75 RBI in 2022 represented the second-most in the American Athletic Conference, and the fourth-most in the nation, behind Oklahoma's **Tiare Jennings** (87) and Jocelyn Alo (85), and Wichita State's Addison Barnard (84).

JADA JOINS THE ORDER

• In seeing its players receive the most prestigious honor that can be bestowed upon a student at UCF, the UCF softball team has now gone back-to-back. As announced by the university April 2, fifth-year utility player Jada Cody has become the third player in program history, and the second in as many years, to be honored with the Order of Pegasus award, as well as the lone student-athlete to be selected in 2024. The Order of Pegasus award is given annually to those who display incredible academic achievement, university involvement, leadership and community service, and Cody joins Shannon Doherty (2023) and Shelly Frick (2010) as the third Knights softball player to receive the honor.

DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-CENTURY MARK

• The Knights' series finale in Houston April 14 saw a pair of Knights reach significant career milestones and continue climbing the program's all-time record lists. First baseman Shannon Doherty recorded the 200th hit of her Knights career with her first-inning single, becoming the 12th player in program history to eclipse the 200-hit milestone. Doherty enters UCF's Wednesday midweek contest against FAU tied with Amber Lamb (2004-07) for 11th on the program's all-time hits list (200). Right-handed pitcher Sarah Willis reached her own milestone in the bottom of the first inning, notching the 200th strikeout of her Knights career. With the punchout, the senior became the ninth pitcher in program history to reach 200 strikeouts at UCF.

SWEEPING SERIES AND BIG 12 CONFERENCE WEEKLY HONORS

 The efforts of catcher Ashleigh Griffin and senior right-handed pitcher Sarah Willis paced the team on both sides of the ball throughout the squad's perfect 4-0 showing April 8-14, with the duo becoming the first two Knights in program history to earn the Big 12 Conference's weekly Player and Pitcher of the Week awards. UCF also joined Oklahoma and Texas as the third school to earn both the Big 12's weekly Player and Pitcher of the Week awards in the same week this season. Willis' Big 12 Pitcher of the Week award represented the third weekly honor of her collegiate career, after she was twice named American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week last season. Her most recent recognition also represented the second time in as many series that Willis has been honored with a conference pitcher of the week award after facing the Houston Cougars.

 Griffin earned the first conference Player of the Week award of her career, after being named to The American Athletic Conference's weekly Honor Roll twice during her freshman 2022 season.

 Griffin paced UCF's offense throughout her team's four games, hitting .600/.714/1.500 (6-for-10) with 3 HR. 7 RBI and 15 TB. leading the team in each category while also scoring 6 runs and drawing 4 BB against just 1 SO in 4 starts. Her 15 TB and 1.500 SLG led all Big 12 players during the week. She also homered in each of UCF's 3 games in Houston, and with her third long ball matched her single-season career high of four she set during her freshman 2022 campaign. The series also marked the first time the redshirt-sophomore had homered in consecutive games in her young career, and she also notched her second 3-hit game of the season and the third of her career in game two against Houston April 13. • Willis threw a team-leading 11 innings over the course of the Knights' four games, highlighted by her six-inning, one-hit complete game shutout in the Knights' series-opener at Houston April 12. She posted a 1.27 ERA (2 ER) with 10 strikeouts and limited her opposition to a .171 batting average-against (6-for-35) in her two appearances, and her two wins during the week tied for the most of any league pitcher. Willis' 1.27 ERA represented the lowest of any Big 12 pitcher to throw six or more innings in Week 10 as well.





HOW IT HAPPENED

2023 - 2 seed The Knights produced a 3-0 showing in the AAC Tournament in Tampa, including a come-from-behind 7-4 win over Memphis in the first round, a 2-0 victory over South Florida in the semifinals, and a 9-1 run-rule victory over Tulsa in the championship game. After trailing 4-1 through three innings against Memphis, UCF scored six unanswered runs, highlighted by a go-ahead two-run homer by Jasmine Williams and a two-run single by Aubrey Evans as part of a four-run sixth inning. Sarah Willis tossed a complete game shutout in the semis against South Florida, bolstered by a two-run home run by Chloe Evans in the bottom of the first inning. Kennedy Searcy, Aubrey Evans and Jasmine Williams all recorded two RBI in the championship game, including Williams' second two-run home run of the tournament.

2022 - 1 seed

UCF earned the top seed in the American Athletic Conference tournament for the third time in program history, and the first time since 2015 following the team's dominant 44-12 regular season. UCF drew a first-round matchup with the Houston Cougars, striking first courtesy of a Jada Cody RBI double in the third inning and a Cody RBI single in the fifth to take a 2-0 lead. Starter Gianna Mancha, who had spun five scoreless innings, was tagged for a 2-run homer in the top of the sixth inning that tied the game, but freshman pinch-hitter Savannah Adams came through in the bottom of the eighth with a walk-off two-run homer. UCF made quick work of its western rivals in the title game, scoring four runs in the first, three in the second and four more in the fourth to claim its 11-0 victory in five innings against the Bulls. Cody and Shannon Doherty both hit three-run homers, and the Knights also added runs on singles by Johneisha Rowe, Ashleigh Griffin and Justine Molina, as well as a Bulls error. Kama Woodall threw a five-inning shutout with four strikeouts in the circle.

2021 - 3 seed

UCF used a three-run fourth inning to go up 4-2 on ECU in the quarterfinals. With the score 4-3 in the top of the seventh, the Pirates loaded the bases with one out. Gianna Mancha came out of the bullpen and got the next two batters to go down swinging, sending the Knights to face their War on I-4 rivals of South Florida. The Black and Gold plated two in the first inning before seeing the ballgame tied at the end of the third 2-2. Karissa Ornelas smashed a homer on a 2-0 pitch to put UCF up 3-2 in the fourth, which went on to prove as the game-winner. In the AAC championship game, UCF led 3-0 in the top of the third and was making a push for its first conference title since 2015. Wichita State put up two in the bottom of the third and five in the fifth, handing the Knights a 7-4 loss.

2020

No championship held due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

2019 - 5 seed

UCF and Wichita State were locked up at 1-1 until the bottom of the sixth, when a Neleigh Herring homer put the Shockers on top and sent them on to the next round with a 2-1 final score. It was the third straight season that UCF had been one-anddone in AAC Tournament play, but it was the first season under then-new head coach Cindy Ball-Malone.

2018 - 4 seed

The Knights were upset by Memphis in their first contest of the competition. Memphis went on to lose the following round by a single run to top-seeded South Florida.

<u> 2017 - 3 seed</u>

UCF was a first-round exit against the host ECU Pirates, the six seed in the tournament. The Pirates utilized back-to-back homers in the sixth inning to win the game.

2016 - 2 seed

The Knights were able to slide past UConn by a one-run margin before falling to Tulsa. UCF beat Tulsa in the championship game in 2015 and saw the Golden Hurricane get revenge and go on to win one of their three American titles that year.

2015 - 1 seed

The top-seeded Knights earned a bye through the first round on their home field and matched up with South Florida in the semifinals. The Knights were the away team, but paid no mind, plating two runs in the top of the seventh to secure the victory. UCF legend Shelby Turnier held Tulsa to one hit in the championship game, but the offense couldn't back her up with any run support, bringing a 0-0 game into the seventh. Samantha McCloskey won UCF the title with one swing of the bat, walking it off on a solo shot. McCloskey went 3-for-3 that day, accounting for half of UCF's hits.

2014 - 1 seed

UCF was the inaugural regular-season champs of The American, finishing firts in the first season of the American Athletic Conference's existence. The Knights posted a 15-3 record in conference and won the regular season by two games over South Florida. In the quarterfinals, the Black and Gold homered five times, setting a new school record, in a 6-0 rout of UConn. Rutgers struck first in the semifinal, scoring twice in the first inning. UCF answered with a five-run second inning.
