REDHAWK HEADLINES

- Seattle U opens their 2024 campaign with a trip to the Sunshine State to face South Florida and No. 19 Central Florida.
- The Redhawks open the new season at No. 23 in the first United Soccer Coaches Top 25 Poll. They were ranked 9th in the final poll of 2023, their highest ranking in program history.
- Seattle U was picked as the preseason favorites in the Western Athletic Conference. They received six of the ten first place votes in the coaches poll.
- R-junior Charlie Lanphier was named the WAC Preseason Goalkeeper of the Year. Lanphier won the inaugural award at the conclusion of last season after going 10-3-2 in net.
- Joining Lanphier on the preseason All-WAC Team are defender Jaden Manetta and midfielder Taketo Onodera. All three were named First Team All-WAC in 2023.
- 2024 marks year two of the Nate Daligcon era. He led the program to their sixth NCAA appearance in 2023 and was named the conference's Coach of the Year.
- The Redhawks have a heavy international influence in 2023, with 13 players being born outside of the United States.

After 10 seasons as an assistant coach on the Seattle U staff, Nate Daligcon was named the 10th head coach in program history prior to the 2023 season.

In his first season at the helm, he led the Redhawks to a 12-2-3 regular season that saw the team crowned the Western Athletic Conference Regular Season Champions. Seattle U went undefeated in conference play for the third time in program history and reached a national ranking of 9th, their highest in the Division I era. At the conclusion of the season Daligcon was named the conference's Coach of the Year.

Seattle U led the WAC in points, goals, assists, and goals against average in 2023. James Morris was named the Offensive Player of the Year and Charlie Lanphier was named the inaugural Goal-keeper of the Year. His coaching staff was named the top staff in the Division I Far West Region, as announced by the United Soccer Coaches.

In his time as an assistant coach with the program, coach Daligcon has helped guide the Redhawks to five WAC Tournament Championships and NCAA appearances. He has coached seven MLS Draft Picks, seven conference players of the year, four freshman of the year, and 59 all-conference selections.

Prior to joining the Redhawk coaching staff in 2013, Daligcon was a head coach for several local club teams, most recently serving as head coach of Seattle United B01 Copa and G95 Copa. He led Emerald City FC G93 A to the 2005 Washington State Cup championship, plus guided two other squads to the state cup finals. He has also served as an assistant men's soccer coach at Seattle Pacific since 2009.

Daligcon was a two-time All-American at Seattle Pacific, helping the Falcons win the 1993 Division II national championship and advance to three national semifinal games as a center midfielder. He played in the A-League from 1996 through 2002, winning four league titles (three with the Rochester Rhinos, one with the Seattle Sounders), as well as the 1999 U.S. Open Cup championship as a member of the Rochester Rhinos.

Daligcon received his Bachelor of Arts degree in business administration with a marketing concentration from Seattle Pacific University, plus he holds a USSF "A" coaching license.

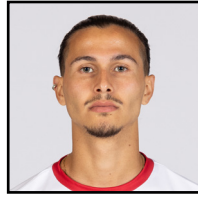

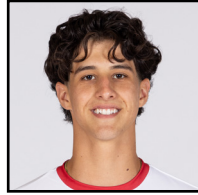

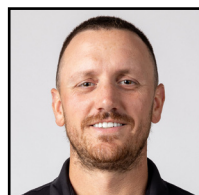
