KNIGHT NOTES

The Matchup

• The Knights will kickoff their season in Blacksburg, Virginia against Virginia Tech on Aug. 31.

• Followed by a trip to North Carolina for a matchup against Charlotte on Sept. 1.

• The last matchup between the Knights and Hokies was in 1993 when UCF came away with a 3-0 win.

• The Black and Gold last played Charlotte in 1993 and earned a 3-1 win.

Scouting Virginia Tech

• The Hokies finished the 2023 season with a 13-16 record.

• Head coach Marci Byers enters her 19th year overall and fifth season with Virginia Tech.

• The squad is comprised of 10 returners, eight freshman and one transfer.

Scouting Charlotte

• The 49ers ended last season with an 11-20 record.

• Head coach Karen Weatherington is in her 10th season with Charlotte and is the program's longest-tenured coach.

• Lauren Kretschmer, the team's leader in kills, blocks and aces will return for her fifth season at Charlotte.

• Kretschmer ended last season with a total of 265 kills and averaged 2.25 kills per set.

Road Warriors

• The Knights start their season out with three weekends on the road.

• UCF travels to Virginia, North Carolina along with two weekends on the road in Florida.

• This will be the first time since the 2017 season that the Knights play their first three weekends away from The Venue.

Double-Trouble Trio

• Three Knights recorded double-doubles last season led by Emily Wilson with eight followed by Abby Schomers with six and Avah Armour with two.

• Wilson and Armour each produced a double-double in the first match of the season against Navy.

• As a setter, Schomers dished out 46 assists and 11 digs to mark her first double-double of her career against Mississippi State.

Ace it up

• The Knights finished out the 2023 season ranked 16 in the NCAA and No. 1 in the Big 12 for aces per set averaging 1.91.

• Emily Wilson ranked among the top 30 for aces per set at No. 28 with .46.

• Last season, the Black and Gold tallied 199 aces to rank them at No. 45 in the NCAA.

Knight in Shining Armour

• Headlined by 11 matches with double digits in kills along with a career-high of 17 kills against Cincinnati (9/21) in her rookie season at UCF.

• Armour has recorded two double-doubles this season one in the first non-conference matchup (Navy 8/25) along with another one in the first Big 12 match (Cincinnati 9/21).

Ace and Double-Double Queen

• Emily Wilson ranked No. 1 in service aces per set (0.46) and second in total service aces (63) in the Big 12 standings last season.

• In last season's matchup against Oklahoma, Wilson recorded a career-high six service aces in the 3-1 win.

• Wilson led the team with nine double-doubles last season and has recorded 19 matches with double digits in kills.

Calling All Newbies

- The Knights added a total of four newcomers to the roster during the offseason.
- Two of those are freshmen and the other two are transfers.
- The freshmen include Cam Shelton and Mya Ball.
- The transfer duo includes Alexia Kuehl (Colorado) and Sophia Kotsovolos (Gardener-Webb).

Bringing 'Em Back

- The Knights return 10 from the previous season.
- Key returners for UCF include Abby Schomers, Avah Armour, Chloe Scheer, Emily Wilson, Katelyn Grimes, Heidi Bonde and Britt Carlson who all saw playing time last year.

Familiar Face

- Head coach Jenny Maurer announced the addition of Cameron Stevens to the staff as an assistant coach.
- Stevens rejoins the Knights after spending the last two years as an assistant coach at High Point, where he helped lead the Panthers to consecutive Big South Tournament Championships.
- Before this time at High Point, Stevens was a part of three straight American Athletic Conference titles at UCF.
- Along with helping the Knights advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament twice during his first stint with the Black and Gold.

Preseason Olympic Trials

- During preseason, the Knights participated in their own form of Olympic trials with various events.
- The team was broken into five countries with three players in each group.
- The five countries consisted of Papua New Guinea, Djibouti, Christmas Island, Oman and Zanzibar.
- With a total of five events, each country was scored on their performance.
- Event one consisted of each group receiving their country, making the country's flag on a t-shirt and national anthem, which was then judged on a scale of 1-5 from three guest judges.
- The team went bowling for event No. 2 as each country competed against each other and averaged the score.
- Events three and four included another panel of judges with interpretive dancing followed by presentations from each group which consisted of information regarding their specific country and why the judges would want to live there.
- The squad wrapped up their Olympic trials at Drive Shack as they tested their golf skills for the final edge in the leaderboard.
- Final Leaderboard: 1st place: Christmas Island (Chloe, Renee and Heidi) 2nd place: Djibouti (Katelyn, Megan and Britt), 3rd place: Zanzibar (Cam, Abby and Sasha), 4th place: Oman (Alexia, Sophia and Avah), 5th place: Papua New Guinea (Emily, Mya and Ashlynn - Student Manager)

Year Two in the Big 12

- The Knights ended their inaugural season in the Big 12 Conference with a 17-12 overall record and 8-10 in conference play.
- This season the Knights will open league play on ESPNU at Kansas on Sept. 25.
- With the addition of four new members into the Big 12, the Knights will host Colorado for the first time since 2003, Utah (1996) and travel to Arizona and Arizona State for the first time in program history.
- UCF officially joined the Big 12 Conference on July 1, 2023.
- The Knights enter the Power 5 as the youngest school, having been founded in 1963 to supply NASA with engineers.
- The Knights were ranked No. 11 in the Big 12 preseason poll.
- In the AVCA poll, there are eight Big 12 schools that are ranked or receiving votes.

SpaceU

- UCF volleyball has three uniforms and one of them is the Citronaut jersey which color is known as Canaveral Blue, these jersey's symbolize UCF's past.
- The game recognizes the University of Central Florida's roots, founded as Florida Technological University in 1963 with the mission of providing personnel to support the growing U.S. space program at the Kennedy Space Center and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station.
- As the academic scope expanded beyond its original focus on engineering and technology, the school was renamed the University of Central Florida in 1978.
- UCF is No. 1 nationally for placing graduates in aerospace industry jobs.
- In 1968, UCF established its motto: "Reach for the Stars" to represent the University's promising aerospace education in engineering, electronics and other technological professions.
- 29% of Kennedy Space Center employees are UCF Alumni.
- The 50-yard line of FBC Mortgage Stadium is on the exact latitude as Launch Complex 39A, NASA's most historic launch pad, 31 miles to the east.

Jenny Maurer

Head Coach - 2nd as HC / 7th Season with the Knights



Jenny Maurer, a key cog for the UCF volleyball program that has won the five American Athletic Conference titles (regular season or tournament or both) and competed in the NCAA Championship each of those years, was named the Knights' head coach on May 18, 2023.

Maurer was the UCF associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for seven years after joining the Knights' staff in January 2016—and her resume features nine years as an NCAA Division I head coach and 16 total years as a head coach. Her role at UCF has included overseeing recruiting efforts, serving as offensive coordinator and training the setters.

In seven seasons in Orlando, Maurer has helped the UCF attack maintain a season hitting percentage over .250. The Knights posted five 20-win seasons, including a trip to the 2017 National Invitational Volleyball Championship, and the 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 NCAA tournaments with two second round appearances. Maurer has mentored AVCA All-American McKenna Melville and AVCA All-Region selections Kia Bright, Jale Hervey, and Anne-Mare Watson during her time in Orlando. She also helped guide Amber Olson to UCF's first AAC Setter of the Year honor.

Maurer's commitment to academics is exhibited by the volleyball team's combined 3.64 grade-point average in the 2022 fall semester—best by any UCF team—followed

by a 3.653 in the 2023 spring semester. Over the course of her seven seasons with the Knights, the volleyball program has achieved a combined 3.621 GPA (paced by a 3.7 in 2021-22) and twice had the top team GPA.

Maurer joined the Knights after spending five seasons as the head volleyball coach at Bradley University, from 2011-2015. In her first three seasons at Bradley, she led the Braves to 34 wins, the program's most victories in a three-year stretch since the 2005 season. In 2012, Maurer led Bradley to the first 5-0 start in program history, and in 2013, the Braves advanced to the Missouri Valley Tournament for the first time since 2005.

Prior to her stint in Peoria, she served as the head coach at Lehigh University (Bethlehem, Pennsylvania). During her four years with the Mountain Hawks (2007-10), Maurer improved her squad's record each season and in 2009 coached Lehigh into the Patriot League Tournament for the first time since 2003. She improved her squad's RPI by 130 spots during her four-year tenure.

Originally from St. Louis, Missouri, Maurer (then Jenny Cafazza) was a four-year starter and two-time AVCA first-team All-America volleyball player (1997 and 1998) at Washington University in St. Louis. She was a three-time All-South and All-University Athletic Association first-team selection and the team leader in aces as a sophomore and digs as a junior and senior as a right-side hitter and setter. She helped the Bears to a

combined 85-9 record during the 1995 and 1996 NCAA Division III title seasons. In 1997 Washington finished fourth nationally and in 1998 advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

She went on to earn a master's degree in education from Lindenwood University (St. Charles, Missouri) in 2003. Maurer spent seven years coaching volleyball at St. Joseph's Academy in St. Louis, three times taking the Angels to the championship game of the Missouri Class 3-4A state tournament and four times playing in the final four. She also played with USA Athletes International in Belgium and Holland in the summer of 1999.

Maurer has two children: son Hudson and daughter Chaney.

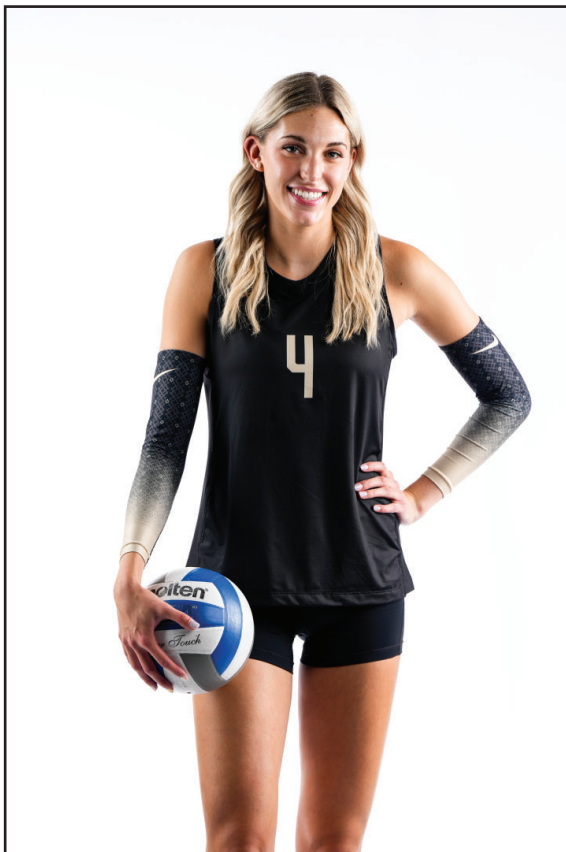

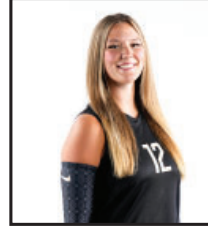
