# **GENERAL NOTES**

- For the fourth consecutive year, UCF opened its season on a Thursday night at home.
- Thursday night was the first meeting between the programs.
- Head coach Gus Malzahn is now 4-0 in season-openers at UCF and 12-1 overall in 13 seasons as a head coach.
- UCF now owns an all-time record of 35-10 in season openers.

## **OFFENSE NOTES**

- The Knights recorded 639 yards of total offense, including 454 on the ground, the most in the Gus Malzahn era and the second most in program history (461 in 1992).
- The UCF offense recorded 12 plays of at least 15 yards.
- The Knights averaged 8.4 yards per rush, which marks the second-consecutive year UCF has averaged more than 8.0 yards per rush in its season opener.

## **DEFENSE NOTES**

- The Knights held UNH to just four first downs through the first three quarters of play.
- UCF held the Wildcats to just 67 net rushing yards and 95 passing yards for only 162 total net yards.
- The Knights totaled 7.0 TFL for minus-26 yards.
- The Knights held the Wildcats to just 2 of 15 on third-down conversions.

## **PLAYER NOTES**

- **RB RJ Harvey** rushed for 142 yards and two touchdowns for 12.9 yards per carry. It marked the ninth 100-yard rushing game of his career and his eighth multiple-touchdown game of his career. His 12.9 rushing yards per attempt rank second in program history.
- **QB KJ Jefferson** scored on a 3-yard touchdown rush run early in the second quarter, the 21st rushing touchdown of his career. He also passed for two touchdowns. He now is responsible for 88 career touchdowns: 67 through the air and 21 on the ground.
- Playing in his first game as a Knight, **RB Myles Montgomery** recorded a 49-yard touchdown reception early in the third quarter, the first receiving touchdown of his career. He also rushed for 77 yards and a score.
- **RB Peny Boone**, also playing in his first game in the Black and Gold, ripped off a 59-yard touchdown in the third quarter, the 21st of his career.
- **RB Johnny Richardson** recorded his third career receiving touchdown, and his first since the 2022 season, with a 22-yard catch-and-run from Jefferson in the third quarter.
- **LB Deshawn Pace** recorded his first interception as a Knight and the seventh of his career on the first play of the second quarter. He returned it 37 yards to the UNH 3-yard line, setting up a 3-yard touchdown run by KJ Jefferson. Pace also led the Knights with 5 tackles.
- DB Braeden Marshall recorded a career-high 2.0 TFL for minus-11 yards.
- **DB Antoine Jackson** recorded his second career INT in the third quarter.

EFENSE

• **DB Ladarius Tennison** blocked a UNH punt with 13:12 left in the second quarter, resulting in a safety for the Knights. The last blocked punt by the Knights came against Georgia Tech in 2022 (Jarvis Ware), and the last safety also came that season against Cincinnati.
