GENERAL NOTES

- The win gives UCF's its 200th victory as an FBS team. UCF became an FBS program in 1996.
- With the win, **Gus Malzahn** has now started 2-0 for the eighth time in his 13-year head coaching career.
- Malzahn has won the opening two contests in back-to-back seasons and extended his non-conference home winning streak to four consecutive games. Malzahn is currently 8-2 in regular-season non-conference bouts with the Knights.
- The win over Sam Houston was the first meeting between the two programs, and the 72nd different opponent Malzahn has coached against in his head coaching career
- The Knights move to 84-26 at FBC Mortgage Stadium, marking one of the best home winning percentages in college football (.764).
- Sam Houston marks the 73rd opponent that Malzahn has recorded a win against in his 13-year career and the eighth victory against a Texas opponent.

OFFENSE NOTES

- The Knights rushed for 384 vards 6 rushing touchdowns against the Bearkats. UCF has now rushed for 838 vards with 11 rushing TDs through the first two games of the season.
- The 384 yards also marked the first time UCF has rushed for at least 300 yards in consecutive games since the 2018 season.
- The Knights scored on six of their first seven possessions to start the game.=

DEFENSE NOTES

- With interceptions by **Sheldon Arnold** and **Mac McWilliams**, four different UCF defenders have recorded one INT through thr first two games.
- The two INTs mark the first time UCF has recorded two interceptions in back-to-back games since 2020 against Houston (10/31/20) and Temple (11/14/20).
- Outside of their second-quarter touchdown that went for 64 yards, the Knights did not allow the Bearkats to drive past midfield until late in the fourth quarter.
- The defense only allowed 67 rushing yards on the night.

PLAYER NOTES

- **RB RJ Harvey** rushed for 129 yards and a tied a school record with four rushing touchdowns. His 129 yards marked his 10th career 100-yard rushing performance.
- Harvey now has 2,483 rushing yards in his career as a Knight, the sixth most in school history.
- Harvey now has at least two rushing TDs in his last six regular season games dating to last season.
- Harvey also now has eight career games with multiple rushing TDs.
- Harvey's four scores give him 27 rushing TDs for his career, tying him for fifth on UCF's career list.
- **WR Kobe Hudson** finished with 104 yards receiving, the sixth 100-yard game of his career. He also extended his streak with at least one catch to 25 games.

FIENS

- **DB Sheldon Arnold** recorded his eighth career INT and his first as a Knight in the first quarter on Sam Houston's opening drive.
- **DE Nyjalik Kelly** recorded UCF's first sack of the season in the second quarter, forcing a fumble in the process. Kelly finished with 6.0 total tackles on the night, tying for the team lead with **LB Xe'ree Alexander**.

• **K Colton Boomer** connected on a 50-yard FG in the second quarter, the third of his career of at least 50 yards.
