KNIGHT NOTES

LEAGUE WIN NO. 1 - The UCF men's soccer team clinched its first Sun Belt Conference win of the season Sunday, Sept. 29, weathering a 72-minute mid-match lightning delay to earn a 2-1 victory over the Georgia State Panthers in Orlando...the match was originally scheduled for Sept. 27, but was postponed out of an abundance of caution for the effects of Hurricane Helene...the winning effort represented UCF's third of the season and first since the squad's 5-1 rout of the UC Irvine Anteaters Sept. 6, snapping a three-match winless drought while also bringing the Knights back to .500 in Sun Belt Conference play...the Black and Gold also pushed their all-time record against the Panthers to 9-3-0 in 12 meetings between the two teams, including an active four-match win streak dating back to 2004.

ALEX'S FIRST WITH THE KNIGHTS - Fifth year defender **Alex Smith** scored his first goal as a Knight in helping lead UCF to its one-goal win over the Panthers Sunday, scoring off of an **Anderson Rosa** corner kick with a header in the 18th minute...Smith represents the fifth Knight this season to score his first goal as a member of the Black and Gold, joining **Drew Hansen** (Aug. 25 vs. Seattle), **Sora Funakoshi** (Aug. 31 vs. Wake Forest), **Carlos Rojas** (Sept. 6 vs. UC Irvine) and **Jonas Fritschi** (Sept. 11 at FIU)...Rosa has also provided a key assist for three of the five in Hansen, Rojas and Smith.

ROSA'S THREE-POINT NIGHT – Fifth year defender Anderson Rosa enjoyed a strong night on the offensive end of the pitch in helping lead UCF to its 2-1 victory over the Georgia State Panthers Sept. 29, assisting Alex Smith's first Knights goal before he later scored his first goal of the season in the 84th minute...the contest represented Rosa's first three-point game of the season and second of his career, joining his three-point display in the Black and Gold's 3-2 victory at South Carolina Oct. 22, 2023...Rosa's 84th-minute goal also marked his second career game-winning score, the first of which also came in the match against the Gamecocks Oct. 22 last season (66th minute).

TOP 10 MOUNTAINEERS - The Knights will have another shot at toppling a ranked foe in their weekend road matchup against the No. 7 West Virginia Mountaineers Saturday...West Virginia represents the third ranked opponent UCF will have met this season, with the Knights owning an 0-1-1 record against then-No. 23 Seattle (1-1 draw Aug. 25) and then-No. 21 James Madison (2-0 loss Sept. 21) this season...since the Knights joined the Sun Belt Conference prior to the 2023 campaign, UCF has gone unbeaten in four of its six contests against ranked teams, highlighted by the program's 2-1 upset road victory over the then-No. 9 Clemson Tigers Aug. 24, 2023...with a win Saturday, UCF will have secured its first win over a team ranked seventh in the nation or higher since its 3-2 victory over then-No. 6 Tulsa Oct. 10, 2021...the Knights this weekend are looking to remain unbeaten by the Mountaineers in five all-time matchups between the two programs, as the Black and Gold lead the all-time series 2-0-2...when the two teams met in Orlando last season, the contest represented the first top five matchup in program history, with the Knights sharing the No. 5 spot in the nation with Louisville in the United Soccer Coaches' Sept. 12 poll, and West Virginia ranked No. 4.

DOURADO APPROACHING 40 – In kicking off the offensive efforts for the Knights in the team's season-opener Aug. 22, fifth year senior **Lucca Dourado** also netted the 38th goal of his career...he enters UCF's Saturday night tilt with No. 7 West Virginia two goals shy of becoming the fifth Knight to score at least 40 career goals all with the Knights...the club is currently occupied by **Heikki Ritvanen** (1996-99), **Randy DeShield** (1976-79), **Ari Nurmi** (1996-99) and **Cal Jennings** (2016-19)...Dourado's first goal of the season also pushed his career point total to 82, good for a share of sixth place on the UCF all-time career points list with **Matias Pyysalo** (2014-17)...with his fourth straight 20-plus point season in 2024, Dourado would become the sixth in program history to reach the 100-point plateau with the Knights, joining Ritvanen (188), DeShield (126), Nurmi (122), Jennings (107) and **Rony Francois** (101, 1980-83).

KNIGHT NOTES CONTINUED

LEAGUE READY ROSA – Following the conclusion of the 2023 fall season, Knights defender Anderson Rosa was selected by the Colorado Rapids with the 14th pick in the second round of the MLS Super-Draft 2024 on Dec. 19, 2023, but elected to return to UCF to complete his final collegiate season and his degree...with his selection, Rosa became the 13th Knight in program history to be selected in the MLS draft, as well as the fourth Knight to be chosen just the last three seasons, joining Gino Vivi (2023, LA Galaxy), Yanis Leerman (2022, Chicago Fire) and Nick Taylor (2022, Orlando City)...Rosa represents the second Knight to be selected by the Colorado Rapids in program history, joining Deshorn Brown in 2012, and he became the sixth to be picked under head coach Scott Calabrese, joining Vivi, Taylor, Leerman, Cal Jennings (2020, FC Dallas) and Jonathan Dean (2020, Orlando City)...Rosa also became the second Knight to be selected by a professional team based in Colorado during the 2023 calendar year, joining catcher and UCF baseball alum Ben McCabe, who was selected by the Colorado Rockies in the ninth round of the 2023 MLB Draft July 10...the defender enjoyed a career season en route to helping the UCF men's soccer team to the first No. 1 national ranking in a regular-season poll in UCF athletics history last fall, setting single-season career-bests in goals scored (3), points (7) and shot attempts (18), and he tied his season high with five shots on goal.

SHANE'S SETTLING IN – Redshirt freshman goalkeeper **Shane Wright** produced another strong showing in the Knights' most recent contest, a 2-1 victory over the visiting Georgia State Panthers in Orlando Sept. 29, yielding just one goal while making one save...the contest marked Wright's fifth out of his first six collegiate appearances with two or fewer goals allowed, lowering his goals-against average to 1.50...through six appearances, Wright has now totaled an even 20 saves to accompany his one clean sheet against South Florida Sept. 15...Wright enters Saturday's action at No. 7 West Virginia ranking fourth in the Sun Belt with 3.33 saves per game, and ninth in the league in both goals-against average (1.50) and save percentage (.690).

DOMINANT DEFENSE - In notching the team's first Sun Belt Conference win over Georgia State Sunday, UCF recorded its sixth match of its first eight this fall with one or fewer goals allowed...overall, the Knights this season had allowed eight or fewer goals in their first six matches for the third consecutive season as well...in its nine Sun Belt Conference matchups last season, UCF allowed just 10 goals, good for a 1.11 goals-against average that ranked tied for second-lowest in the league with Marshall (1.11)... Kentucky paced the Sun Belt with a GAA of 0.67 in 2023 Sun Belt play, yielding six goals in its nine contests

<u>DEFENDING THE KINGDOM</u> - Since head coach **Scott Calabrese** took the reins of the UCF men's soccer program at the beginning of the 2017 season, the Knights have produced a 41-15-11 record at home following the squad's 2-1 win over Georgia State Sept. 29...UCF has lost just 11 regular-season home matches during Calabrese's tenure...prior to the 2020-21 season, the Black and Gold had suffered only one regular-season home loss through the first three campaigns.

STANDOUT SUN BELT SCORERS - The Knights in 2023 Sun Belt Conference play were led offensively by then-senior forward **Lucca Dourado**, who tallied 14 of his 21 season points on the strength of six goals and two assists...the São Paulo, Brazil, native led nine different Knights goal-scorers in conference play who combined to score 19 total goals against Sun Belt opponents during the regular season...the Knights' 19 goals scored in conference play last season were tied with James Madison for third-most in the Sun Belt; Marshall paced the league with 21, followed by West Virginia with 20.

SHANE'S CLEAN SHEET - Redshirt freshman goalkeeper Shane Wright recorded the first shutout of his collegiate career in his fourth collegiate match in the Knights' Sept. 15 matchup against the South Florida Bulls, making two second-half saves in the teams' 0-0 draw...in shutting out the Bulls, Wright became the second UCF goalkeeper in the last three seasons to record a clean sheet within his first four collegiate games; teammate Juanvi Muñoz recorded his first shutout in his third career match, helping lead the Black and Gold to a 3-0 win over UC Riverside Sept. 5, 2022...Wright enters Saturday's action against the No. 7 West Virginia Mountaineers with a goals-against average of 1.50 through six contests, accompanied by a save percentage of .690 on the strength of 20 saves.

FIRST GAME, FIRST GOAL, FIRST BRACE - Freshman forward Carlos Rojas wasted no time making his presence felt in the Knights' four-goal win over the UC Irvine Anteaters Sept. 6, scoring his first two career goals in his first collegiate game...his first tally, in the 75th minute, was assisted by defender Anderson Rosa, scoring via a well-executed header shot off Rosa's free kick just outside the box...Rojas' second goal, just 78 seconds later, came from an assist by forward Clarence Awoudor following a mishandled save try by the UC Irvine goalkeeper...Rojas finished his evening with three total shot attempts as well, all on goal in the first match of his collegiate career...with his prolific debut, Rojas became the first Knight since Richard Amon (2016-19) to record a brace in his collegiate debut, when Amon did so with goals in the 20th and 20th a with goals in the 20th and 82nd minutes of the Knights' 4-2 loss at Grand Canyon Aug. 26, 2016.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFTOFF - The then-No. 10 UCF men's soccer team produced a dominant showing in its 5-1 win over UC Irvine Sept. 6, scoring five goals on the strength of 20 total shot attempts and 13 shots on goal in the squad's 5-1 victory in the program's first of two Space games this fall...the Knights' five goals, 20 shot attempts, 13 shots on goal and eight corner kicks all represented single-game season highs, and the 20 shot attempts also represented their highest single-game total since they threw 28 at the South Carolina Gamecocks during the 2023 Sun Belt Conference Tournament in Orlando Nov. 5...the Black and Gold's 13 shots on goal, meanwhile, marked their most since their 13 in the group's five-goal outburst against the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers Oct. 18 last season, appropriately, another Space game for the program...the prolific showing complemented the team's defensive efforts well, as the squad yielded just a single score for the fourth consecutive game to begin the new season, marking the first time since the 2013 campaign that has seen UCF allow one or fewer goals in each of its first four games of a season.

BAM'S QUICK STRIKE - Senior forward Emmanuel Bam scored the team's first goal of the match against UC Irvine in just the fifth minute, staking the Black and Gold out to an early 1-0 advantage. The goal marked Bam as the team's first multi-goal scorer of the 2024 fall season, and also represented the team's earliest goal of the season by gametime. The last time the Knights scored within the first five minutes was in their second-round NCAA Tournament tilt against Vermont Nov. 19, 2023. Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Saku Heiskanen scored the first goal of the game in the just 66 seconds into the score. into the contest

PLAYING THE NATION'S BEST - One fifth of the United Soccer Coaches preseason top 25 teams were included on UCF's fall schedule, with a sixth recieving votes...among the teams in the preseason poll the Knights are slated to square off against in 2024 are, with preseason rankings, No. 3 West Virginia, No. 8 Marshall, No. 15 Wake Forest, No. 18 James Madison and No. 23 Seattle...Kentucky was also included in the initial coaches poll, recieving seven votes...of the six programs included in the United Soccer Coaches initial poll, four are conference mates of UCF within the Sun Belt (West Virginia, Marshall, James Madison and Kentucky)...of the Knights' 15 scheduled opponents in 2024, nine programs were selected to compete in the 2023 NCAA Tournament, headlined by the now-fifth-ranked West Virginia Mountaineers' run to the 2023 College Cup Semifinals.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN - The Knights' 2024 roster features 27 players, including 19 returners from 2023 and eight newcomers...by position, the team rosters four goalkeepers, eight defenders, six midfielders, seven forwards, and two multi-position players...by class, UCF is led by its four fifth-year seniors, Lucca Dourado, Anderson Rosa, Jonas Fritschi and Alex Smith, followed by three seniors, five juniors, eight sophomores and seven freshmen...the 2024 squad also represents five different continents (North America, Africa, Asia, South America and Europe), as well as 12 different countries (United States of America, Costa Rica, Ghana, Senegal, Israel, Japan, Brazil, Colombia, France, Germany, Portugal and Spain)...UCF rosters five players from the state of Florida as well, as fifth year transfer defender Alex Smith (Jacksonville), sophomore transfer defender Gabi Velez (Weston), redshirt sophomore forward Joey Mueller (St. John's County), freshman forward Carlos Rojas (Orlando) and redshirt freshman goalkeeper Shane Wright (Orlando) all hail from the Sunshine State.

UCF DIVISION I CONFERENCE AFFILIATION HISTORY



Atlantic Sun Conference 1993-2004 (12 seasons)

After making the D-I jump in 1984, the Black and Gold didn't join their first Division I conference until 1993. Despite going 4-10-1 in their first year in a conference, the Knights made the A-Sun Semifinals in just their second year as part of the A-Sun. The Knights found success quickly and carried that momentum with them throughout their time in the A-Sun, tallying eight appearances in the conference tournament in 12 total seasons.

The Knights finished their time in the A-Sun on a high note, winning the tournament championship in three consecutive seasons from 2002-04. The championship runs led to UCF's first three NCAA Tournament appearances. The Black and Gold were turned away from their first NCAA Tournament victory in their first two tries by FIU, but were able to beat the Panthers in 2004 for the program's first tournament win.

Three Knights earned four major honors during the program's tenure in the A-Sun. Heikki Ritvanen scored 88 career goals from 1996-99, UCF's most in program history, and was honored as the A-Sun's Player of the Year in 1999. Alejandro Gessen was named Freshman of the Year while Ryan McIntosh was a two-time Defensive Player of the Year. In all, 54 nods were recieved to the A-Sun First, Second, Third and Freshmen Teams in UCF's 12 years in the league.



Conference USA 2005-2012 (8 seasons)

UCF had a new conference and a new head coach for the 2005 season. Brent Erwin and the Knights went 13-17-3 over their first two seasons as members of Conference USA. Fast forward to UCF's sixth season in the league, fourth year head coach Bryan Cunningham led UCF to its first NCAA Tournament apperance as members of C-USA, winning 12 matches with a 12-5-3 record. The team followed suit the next year, winning a dozen games again and making the NCAA Tournament second round for the second straight year.

The Knights won 32 matches in their final three seasons as part of C-USA, more than first five seasons in the league combined. The Black and Gold won no major honors as C-USA members, but saw nine nods to the All-Conference First Team and a total of 30 nods across the First, Second, Third and Freshman Teams.



American Athletic Conference 2013-2022 (10 seasons)

The Knights enjoyed massive success as part of The American, reaching the conference final in five of their final six seasons in the league. The Black and Gold earned three regular seasons titles and one tournamennt championship as members of The American. In total, UCF qualified for the conference's postseason tournament in nine straight seasons, only missing the 2022 postseason by two points.

Three of UCF's NCAA Tournament appearances came while in The American, qualifying in 2018, 2019 and 2020. The Knights punched their first ticket into the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 in 2019, and then did the same for the 2020 tournament, which was held in the spring of 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Plenty of Knights stood out in UCF's time in The American. A member of the Black and Gold was named Offesnive Player of the Year six times out of the team's 10 years in the league. Matias Pyysalo and Cal Jennings won the honor twice while Romario Williams and Hadji Barry were honored once each. UCF collected three Midfielder of the Year honors and three Goalkeeper of the Year awards; Oettl collected all three goalkeeping honors while Yoni Sorokin took two of the three midfielder awards along with Louis Perez who won the other. Gino Vivi was honored as UCF's lone Freshman of the Year award, earning the nod in 2019.

The Black and Gold had 11 First Team All-Conference honorees, including nine that were named on the top squad multiple times. In total, UCF earned 36 nods to the All-Conference First or Second Teams while 16 rookies graced the All-Freshman Team while in The American.



Sun Belt Conference 2023-present

UCF men's soccer's move to the Sun Belt Conference was made in tandem with the rest of UCF's sports moving to the Big 12 Conference in 2023-24, a league which does not sponsor men's soccer. The Sun Belt recently re-emerged as a conference, resuming play in 2022 after previously sponsoring men's soccer from 1976-1995 and 2014-20. The Knights will join Kentucky, South Carolina and West Virginia as men's soccer members only. Those four teams will join James Madison, Marshall, Old Dominion, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern and Georgia State.

"I'm very excited to be partnering with Commissioner Keith Gil and Deputy Commissioner Kathy Keene.
