KNIGHT NOTES

The Matchup

- UCF heads to West Virginia for its second matchup against the Mountaineers this season along with a home match against No. 8 Kansas.
- This will be the first time UCF plays at WVU Coliseum since the Knights have joined the Big 12 conference July 2023.
- Kansas leads the league with a .327 hitting percentage along with 123.74 assists per set.
- West Virginia has limited its opponents to just 13.39 digs per set this season which ranks it at No. 5 in the Big 12.
- The Knights average 13.38 kills per set and limits their opponent to just 10.42 assists per set to rank them No. 2 in the Big 12.

Scouting West Virginia

- The Mountaineers enter the matchup 6-11 on the season, and 0-6 in Big 12 play.
- Head coach Jen Greeny is in her first season with West Virginia as she spent the last 13 years at the helm for Washington State.
- Cassidy Tanton leads the Mountaineers in kills with 234 and is ranked 10th in the Big 12 with 3.39 kills per set.
- On the defensive side, Sydney Reed averages 3.59 digs per set which places her at No. 8 in the Big 12.

Scouting Kansas

- The Jayhawks enter the matchup 14-1 on the season, and are 5-0 in Big 12 play.
- Head coach Ray Bechard is in his 27th season with Kansas and boasts a 385-309 record with the Jayhawks.
- Toyosi Onabanjo leads the Jayhawks in hitting percentage with a .457 clip

 Camryn Turner runs the offense and leads the Big 12 with 11.52 assists per set.

Kuehl Killer

- Alexia Kuehl leads the Knights with .414 hitting percentage and is ranked No. 18 in the NCAA.
- The middle blocker has tallied 105 kills and 35 blocks this season.
- A transfer from Colorado, where she spent the last four seasons decided to move back to Florida for her last year.

Road Warriors

- The Knights started their season out with three weekends on the road.
- UCF traveled to Virginia and North Carolina, along with two weekends on the road in Florida.
- It marked the first time since the 2017 season that the Knights played their first three weekends away from The Venue.

Double-Trouble Trio

- Three Knights have recorded doubledoubles this season led by Avah Armour and Abby Schomers with three followed by Emily Wilson with two.
- Schomers and Armour each produced a double-double in the first match of the season against Virginia Tech.
- Schomers dished out 40 assists and 10 digs while Armour recorded 16 kills and 10 digs.
- Wilson earned her first double-double of the season in the first matchup against Nevada (9/19) tallying 21 kills and 10 digs.



Milestone Watch

- Chloe Scheer has recorded 1,373 digs in her career at UCF, which ranks her fifth in the individual career records for career digs.
- The Murrieta, California, native currently has 128 aces, where she sits at No. 9 on the individual career list.

100 Wins

- Head coach Jenny Maurer eclipsed her 100th career win as a head coach on August 31 against Virginia Tech.
- Maurer is in her second season as head coach at UCF and had previous stops at Lehigh (2007-2010) and Bradley (2011-2015).

Knight in Shining Armour

- Headlined by nine matches with double digits in kills along with a career-high 18 kills at Stetson (9/5).
- Armour recorded her first double-double this season in the season opener against Virginia Tech (8/31).
- The Colorado native's 18 kills at Stetson rank in the top five in the Big 12 for kills in a three-set match.

Knights In The Rankings

- Four players are currently ranked in the top 10 of the Big 12 rankings.
- Chloe Scheer is third in the conference, averaging 4.49 digs per set.
- Scheer is sixth with 238 total digs.
- Abby Schomers slides in at No. 8 with 9.75 assists per set.
- Avah Armour has tallied 9.77 attacks per set which ranks sixth in the Big 12.
- Alexia Kuehl ranks third in the Big 12, hitting a .414 clip.

Nonconference Recap

- The Knights wrapped up their nonconference schedule with a 7-2 record.
- UCF spent the first three weeks on the road with just one trip out of the state.
- Chloe Scheer was named to the All-Tournament team at Florida State, Stetson and our home tournament.
- Abby Schomers was tabbed to the Stetson All-Tournament team.
- Avah Armour received two All-Tournament team nominations (Florida State and Stetson).
- Emily Wilson was named to the UCF Invitational All-Tournament Team.

Familiar Face

- Head coach Jenny Maurer announced the addition of Cameron Stevens to the staff as an assistant coach.
- Stevens rejoins the Knights after spending the last two years as an assistant coach at High Point, where he helped lead the Panthers to consecutive Big South Tournament Championships.
- Before this time at High Point, Stevens was a part of three straight American Athletic Conference titles at UCF.
- Along with helping the Knights advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament twice during his first stint with the Black and Gold.

Preseason Olympic Trials

- During preseason, the Knights participated in their own form of Olympic trials with various events.
- The team was broken into five countries with three players in each group.
- The five countries consisted of Papua New Guinea,

Djibouti, Christmas Island, Oman and Zanzibar.

- With a total of five events, each country was scored on their performance.
- Event one consisted of each group receiving their country, making the country's flag on a t-shirt and national anthem, which was then judged on a scale of 1-5 from three guest judges.
- The team went bowling for event No. 2 as each country competed against each other and averaged the score.
- Events three and four included another panel of judges with interpretive dancing followed by presentations from each group which consisted of information regarding their specific country and why the judges would want to live there.
- The squad wrapped up their Olympic trials at Drive Shack as they tested their golf skills for the final edge in the leaderboard.
- Final Leaderboard: 1st place: Christmas Island (Chloe, Renee and Heidi) 2nd place: Djibouti (Katelyn, Megan and Britt), 3rd place: Zanzibar (Cam, Abby and Sasha), 4th place: Oman (Alexia, Sophia and Avah), 5th place: Papua New Guinea (Emily, Mya and Ashlynn - Student Manager)

Year Two in the Big 12

- The Knights ended their inaugural season in the Big 12 Conference with a 17-12 overall record and 8-10 in conference play.
- This season the Knights will open league play on ESPNU at Kansas on Sept. 25.
- With the addition of four new members into the Big 12, the Knights will host Colorado for the first time since 2003, Utah (1996) and travel to Arizona and Arizona State for the first time in program history.
- UCF officially joined the Big 12 Conference on July 1, 2023.
- The Knights enter the Power 5 as the youngest school, having been founded in 1963 to supply NASA with engineers.
- The Knights were ranked No. 11 in the Big 12 preseason poll.

SpaceU

- UCF volleyball has three uniforms and one of them is the Citronaut jersey which color is known as Canaveral Blue, these jersey's symbolize UCF's past.
- The game recognizes the University of Central Florida's roots, founded as Florida Technological University in 1963 with the mission of providing personnel to support the growing U.S. space program at the Kennedy Space Center and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station.
- As the academic scope expanded beyond its original focus on engineering and technology, the school was renamed the University of Central Florida in 1978.
- UCF is No. 1 nationally for placing graduates in aerospace industry jobs.
- In 1968, UCF established its motto: "Reach for the Stars" to represent the University's promising aerospace education in engineering, electronics and other technological professions.
- 29% of Kennedy Space Center employees are UCF Alumni.
- The 50-yard line of FBC Mortgage Stadium is on the exact latitude as Launch Complex 39A, NASA's most historic launch pad, 31 miles to the east.

Jenny Maurer

Head Coach - 2nd as HC / 8th Season with the Knights



Jenny Maurer, a key cog for the UCF volleyball program that has won the five American Athletic Conference titles (regular season or tournament or both) and competed in the NCAA Championship each of those years, was named the Knights' head coach on May 18, 2023.

Maurer was the UCF associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for seven years after joining the Knights' staff in January 2016—and her resume features nine years as an NCAA Division I head coach and 16 total years as a head coach. Her role at UCF has included overseeing recruiting efforts, serving as offensive coordinator and training the setters.

In seven seasons in Orlando, Maurer has helped the UCF attack maintain a season hitting percentage over. 250. The Knights posted five 20win seasons, including a trip to the 2017 National Invitational Volleyball Championship, and the 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 NCAA tournaments with two second round appearances. Maurer has mentored AVCA All-American McKenna Melville and AVCA All-Region selections Kia Bright, Jale Hervey, and Anne-Mare Watson during her time in Orlando. She also helped guide Amber Olson to UCF's first AAC Setter of the Year honor.

Maurer's commitment to academics is exhibited by the volleyball team's combined 3.64 grade-point average in the 2022 fall semester—best by any UCF team—followed by a 3.653 in the 2023 spring semester. Over the course of her seven seasons with the Knights, the volleyball program



has achieved a combined 3.621 GPA (paced by a 3.7 in 2021-22) and twice had the top team GPA.

Maurer joined the Knights after spending five seasons as the head volleyball coach at Bradley University, from 2011-2015. In her first three seasons at Bradley, she led the Braves to 34 wins, the program's most victories in a three-year stretch since the 2005 season. In 2012, Maurer led Bradley to the first 5-0 start in program history, and in 2013, the Braves advanced to the Missouri Valley Tournament for the first time since 2005.

Prior to her stint in Peoria, she served as the head coach at Lehigh University (Bethlehem, Pennsylvania). During her four years with the Mountain Hawks (2007-10), Maurer improved her squad's record each season and in 2009 coached Lehigh into the Patriot League Tournament for the first time since 2003. She improved her squad's RPI by 130 spots during her four-year tenure.

Originally from St. Louis, Missouri, Maurer (then Jenny Cafazza) was a four-year starter and two-time AVCA first-team All-America volleyball player (1997 and 1998) at Washington University in St. Louis. She was a three-time All-South and All-University Athletic Association first-team selection and the team leader in aces as a sophomore and digs as a junior and senior as a right-side hitter and setter. She helped the Bears to a combined 85-9 record during the 1995 and 1996 NCAA Division III title seasons. In 1997 Washington finished fourth nationally and in 1998 advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

She went on to earn a master's degree in education from Lindenwood University (St. Charles, Missouri) in 2003. Maurer spent seven years coaching volleyball at St. Joseph's Academy in St. Louis, three times taking the Angels to the championship game of the Missouri Class 3-4A state tournament and four times playing in the final four. She also played with USA Athletes International in Belgium and Holland in the summer of 1999. Maurer has two children: son Hud-

son and daughter Chaney.
