GENERAL NOTES

- The Knights move to 3-4 on the season and 1-3 in conference play.
- Ranked ninth in the AP Poll. Iowa State marked the 10th game against a top 10 team for UCF.
- UCF moves to 4-5 on Fox Sports 1 and 3-3 in away games on the network.

OFFENSE NOTES

- **RJ Harvey** and **Jacurri Brown** became the first UCF tandem to rush for 100 or more yards in a game since the 2021 Gasparilla Bowl versus Florida (Isaiah Bowser and Ryan O'Keefe). They are the ninth pair to record this stat in program history.
- Brown and Harvey combined for the most rushing yards between a duo in program history (350 yards). Harvey finished the game with 196 rushing yards, and Brown contributed 154 rushing yards.
- On the first play of the game, **Kobe Hudson** recorded a reception for 12 yards. This marks his 30th consecutive game with a reception, tying for the seventh-longest streak in program history.
- In the second guarter, Harvey rushed for 80 yards to the end zone, the second-longest rush of his career and the longest by a running back in the Big 12 this season.
- The performance puts him at 3,105 career rushing yards, becoming the third Knight in program history to surpass 3,000. He ranks sixth among active FBS running backs.
- Harvey authored his 10th career performance with multiple rushing touchdowns.
- Brown took a 67-yard rushing touchdown to the house, marking his second of the game and fourth in his career. The touchdown is tied for the third-longest rushing touchdown by a guarterback in program history.

DEFENSE NOTES

- With under two minutes left remaining in the second quarter, **BJ Adams** intercepted a pass and brought it to the end zone for 63 yards for his first career pick-six, it was his second interception following his first last week against Cincinnati.
- Adams' pick-six becomes the second longest in the Big 12 this year and the first UCF interception for a touchdown since Richie Grant took one to the house against Marshall in the 2019 Gasparilla Bowl.
- Early in the fourth quarter, **Braeden Marshall** recorded an interception and ran it back for 70 yards. This interception is the second of his career, as well as the first of the season for him.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Mitch McCarthy notched a season high with his 56-yard first quarter punt, where he would later record a tackle in the play. McCarthy finished the contest with a career-high 407 punting yards.
- Freshman **Chasen Johnson** blocked a PAT, marking the inaugural of his career and the first Knight to record the feat since Demari Henderson at Kansas in 2023.
