### **LAST TIME OUT**

JACKSONVILLE DOLPHINS

Jacksonville concluded its 2023-24 season with an exciting run through the ASUN Tournament. As the No. 10 seed, the Dolphins knocked off No.1 EKU in dramatic fashion with a 67-65 victory after defeating #9 Kennesaw State in the opener 92-86. The Dolphins next drew #2 Stetson, falling 88-87.

7 PM JU looks to build off the momentum generated from last year's end to conference play in the 2024-25 season by making it to the championship game and earning an auto-bid to the NCAA Tournament.

1:30 PM The team looks to do so behind a roster laden with transfer talent and incoming freshmen, coupled with marquee 11 AM returners from the previous season. Led by Robert McCray and Stephon Payne, head coach Jordan Mincy is set to 7:00 PM get Jacksonville into the NCAA field for the first time since 1986. Before then, they will have to win the conference for <sup>7 PM</sup> the first time since joining the ASUN.

### **JORDAN MINCY NAMED 2022 JOE B. HALL AWARD WINNER**



Jacksonville University men's basketball coach Jordan Mincy was announced as the winner of the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award on April 1, 2022.

He was selected out of 15 finalists, including Hubert Davis at North Carolina, Tommy Lloyd at Arizona and Mike Woodson at Indiana for the award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball.

"I cannot thank the committee enough for honoring me with this year's Joe B. Hall Award," Mincy said. "I am extremely blessed and humbled to be selected out of such a great field for such a prestigious award.

"The support I received from our administration and the hard-work from our players and staff

are what makes moments like this possible for our program."

Mincy joins the pantheon of former winners, including Brad Underwood (2014, Stephen F. Austin), Steve Prohm (2012, Murray State) and Ryan Odom (2017, UMBC).

"What an honor it is for Coach Mincy to receive the Joe B. Hall Award as the top first year head coach in Division I. Jordan is so deserving of this recognition," Athletic Director Alex Ricker-Gilbert said. "From the time he stepped foot on campus almost exactly one year ago, he has made an impact on our community, program, and student-athletes. He has created an atmosphere of family and that is being felt by our young men.

"This is the first of many 'Coach of the Year' honors that Jordan Mincy will receive as head men's basketball coach at Jacksonville University."

In his first year on-campus, Mincy led the Dolphins to its most wins since the 1985-86 season, going undefeated at a routinely raucous Swisher Gymnasium and advancing in the ASUN Men's Basketball Championship final while connecting with community and reviving the aura around JU basketball in the city.

The Dolphins won 21 games, secured the first undefeated home season since 1972-73 and advanced to the doorstep of the NCAA Tournament. After being picked in the preseason to finish 10th out of 12 teams in the league, JU finished ASUN play with 11 wins, its most wins since the 2010-11 campaign, and finished as the two-seed in the South Division, including a sweep of North Florida in the River City Rumble.

JU earned its first postseason victory since 2018, beating Central Arkansas in the ASUN Quarterfinal round and advanced to its first conference tournament championship game since 2009 after defeating Jacksonville State on the road in the semifinal round.

Mincy compiled the second-most wins for a first-year head coach in program history and was one of only five mid-major coaches in the country to reach the 20-win mark in his first season.

He coached the team to a conference-best scoring defense, field goal percentage defense, three-point percentage defense and rebounding margin. The scoring defense was fifth in the nation among Division I teams and the rebounding margin was good for 12th in the country.

Kevion Nolan earned First Team All-ASUN honors, the first Dolphin to make the All-Conference First Team since Kori Babineaux in 2016.

The committee that selects the winner is a 15-member panel, consisting of five current Division I head coaches, five retired head coaches and five collegeinsider.com staff members.

Joe B. Hall passed away on Jan. 15, 2022, at the age of 93.

### THE MATCHUP

Jacksonville is coming off of an exciting home win over ETSU, extending JU's home winning streak to four games this season. However, the Dolphins must leave the friendly walls of Swisher Gym to head down to Orlando to face a red-hot UCF team.

JU has struggled in true road games, only picking up one win thus far- Virginia Tech. UCF on the other hand is undefeated at home and its two losses have come by just a combined 23 points. The Knights already have a top-15 ranked win over Texas A&M and are riding a fourgame winning streak into Saturday's matchup. The last time these two teams faced off, UCF took home a 42-point victory.

### **ROBERT MCCRAY - BACK FOR MORE**

Jacksonville's own Robert McCray is no longer just an ASUN secret. His talent has taken many on the national stage by storm.

This offseason, McCray was named as the 2024-25 ASUN Preseason Player of the Year as well as being named to the All-Preseason Team. McCray finished his first season at JU on the league's postseason Third-Team, but clearly opposing programs think they have undervalued the top-flight guard.

In recent weeks, McCray was also listed as a potential NBA Draft pick, as Bleacher Report slotted McCray to go No. 44 to the Golden State Warriors. McCray was also named as a Preseason All-American by The Bracketeer.

With his recent accolades, McCray became the first Dolphin since 2010 to be named a league's Preseason Player of the Year. If he ends up being drafted, McCray would become the first Dolphin since 1992 to hear his named called by the NBA Commissioner.

McCray was also named to the Fort Myers All-Tournament team after posting 70 minutes played and 41 points across two games.

### SIZE ON THE INSIDE

Jacksonville men's basketball already has solid size with the return of Jacksonville-native Stephon Payne, but the JU coaching staff really added to the arsenal this offseason.

Payne (6'9") will be flanked by the likes of returners Tito Deng (6'11", tallest on the team) and returner Donovan Rivers (6'9"). The staff also added senior transfer Kendall Munson (6'9") and freshman Enrico Borio (6'8") to the fold. After four years at Dayton, Zimi Nwokeji (6'7") looks to add size down low. Freshman guard Chris Arias (6'6") stands as the tallest non-big on the team.

### MINCY FACING FORMER SCHOOL, MENTOR

Head Coach Jordan Mincy is one of the hottest young coaches in all of Division 1. His storied playing career in the MAC has translated well to the coaching circuit and this season he will face off against a coach and school he knows well.

First, Mincy will take his squad to the Univeristy of Florida where he was an assistant under former head coach Mike White for six seasons. Mincy followed White from Louisianna Tech and will now coach against the school that helped him land the JU head coaching job.

Later in the year, Mincy will take his team up to Athens, Georgia to face off against the University of Georgia. The Bulldogs are led by none other than White himself, who took over the black and red in 2022.

Both contests will be firsts for Mincy, as he has yet to face off against his former school or White since taking over in Jacksonville.

### **COMMITTED LONG TERM**

After the strong debut season of the Jordan Mincy era, Jacksonville University Athletics signed him to a new long-term contract on that would keep him at JU for a decade. His new contract runs through the 2030-31 season.

### **COACHING STAFF UPGRADED**

The Jacksonville University men's basketball team welcomed two new coaches for the 2024-25 season: Mychal Covington, fresh off an NCAA March Madness run with Oakland University,

and Joshua Washington, who will lead strength and sports performance after his tenures at the University of Texas San Antonio and Auburn.

Returning coaches Stuckey Mosley and Christian Terrell received title upgrades, and Desmond Kennedy joined as a Graduate Assistant as well as Lavender Briggs. Shakarri Mack will oversee media and creative services with a team of interns, while Alennix Merejo and Taylor Miller were promoted to Assistant Director of Sports Medicine and Director of Basketball Academics, respectively.

This energized staff brings a wealth of experience to elevate the program this season.

### **LOCAL FLAIR**

Jacksonville basketball has a proud history of local players going on to do big things. Four of the six current retired jerseys in the program were Floridians, and three, Roger Strickland, Otis Smith and Dee Brown, all are Jacksonville-natives. Mincy has made it a priority to attack local recruiting, and four members of this year's team have local ties. Returner Stephon Payne prepped at Jackson, while Kent Jackson played at Episcopal and Chris Arias competed for Providence. Anakin Brown, son of Dee, played his high school ball at Beachside.

### INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

The year's team features two players with international backgrounds for the second consecutive season.

Tito Deng, a native of South Sudan, returns to the squad after playing in 13 games in 2023-24. Deng competed in NBA Academy Africa in 2021 and the NBA Academy Games in 2023. Deng will be joined by Brazilian national Enrico Borio. Borio suited up for Basketball Without Borders representing Brazil during the 2024 NBA All-Star Weekend. He also compted for the Brazilian National Team and played for the Brazilian team Clube Curitibano.

### **ROSTER MAKEUP**

The Dolphins' roster features three returning starters, two more letterwinners and 11 total returners. This year's newcomers are five Division I transfers and six freshmen.

### <sup>8</sup> Home Sweet Swisher

The Dolphins have a long tradition of success at home. Last season, JU finished 11-3 inside Swisher Gym almost eclipsing the perfect 15-0 record the team had while at home during the 2021-2022 season. The Dolphins have finished with a winning record at home every season since 2019-2021.

16 The Dolphins play 13 home games this season and aare 2-0 ahead of facing Florida Tech.


### **SEASON AT A GLANCE**
