SUNSHINE AND SOFTBALL

- The Dukes will start their season in Florida for the second straight season and the third time in four years.
- The opposition pool in the Black and Gold classic includes CSU Bakersfield, Georgia, Illinois, NC State and UCF, with JMU playing four of the teams in five games across three days.
- This will be James Madison's seventh trip to the City Beautiful in its history, last participating in the Knights Classic hosted by UCF amidst the 2022 season.

LET'S RECAP

- JMU softball finished the 2024 campaign with a 31-22 (12-12 Sun Belt) record and a quarterfinals exit from the Sun Belt Conference Tournament, being defeated by No. 1 Louisiana.
- The Dukes took home some SBC hardware with Payton List. Reed Butler and Bella Henzler being given All-SBC First Team honors. List was also tabbed as the 2024 Sun Belt Freshman of the year, following her first campaign in Harrisonburg.
- Senior Alissa Humphrey led the team in the circle, finishing the season with a 2.76 ERA and 11 wins in 13 starts and 35 appearances.
- Butler amassed a plethora of career-highs, including in hits (69), home runs (11) and runs scored (52). Her .415 batting average was the fourth-highest in single-season program history.
- As a team, the Dukes ranked first in the Sun Belt in slugging percentage (.523) and home runs per game (1.30), breaking the top-25 in both categories nationally.

MARQUEE MATCHUPS

- James Madison will face thirteen teams that appeared in NCAA Regional play last season, four of which won their respective regular-season conferences and three won conference tournaments. Including two in this tournament in Georgia and UCF.
- The Dukes will not play a single opponent they haven't faced before in either non-conference or SBC play.

NEW COACHES ON THE BLOCK

- This offseason, Coach LaPorte added two new faces to the staff in Maddie Penta and Emily Phillips.
- Coach Penta is fresh off of a four year career at Auburn under former JMU Head Coach Mickey Dean, where she etched her name into the program record book.
- The Chesapeake City, Md. native is a two-time All-American and the 2023 SEC Pitcher of the Year, amassing 76 wins in her career, which stands atop the list in Auburn history. She comes to Harrisonburg as the new pitching coach for the Dukes, following the departure of Libby Bowman after seven seasons.
- Coach Phillips is no stranger to JMU Softball, as she spent the first three seasons (2020-22) of her collegiate career as a Duke under Coach LaPorte. She earned 2021 CAA All-Rookie Team honors following JMU's 41-4 season, that included the historic run to the Women's College World Series.
- After earning NFCA Second Team All-Region in 2022, Phillips transferred to McNeese State for her final two years of eligibility. Her role on staff will be primarily with hitters, focusing on outfield development.

ROOKIES ON THE RISE

- The 2025 roster will feature seven freshmen from the 2023 signing class, the most since the 2022 season.
- Madalyn Johnson (P), Taylor Johnson (P), Emily LeGrand (UTL), Cali Legzdin (INF), Kira Ortega (C), Lili Smith (INF) and Raegan Wall (OF) look to contribute to the squad this spring.
- LeGrand, a Mount Juliet, Tenn. native, was named to D1 Softball's 2025 D100 Freshman Watch List.
- The Watch List is the first of its kind from the publication and is a true watch list, with athletes being displayed by school alphabetically.

- Coach LaPorte (228-96) needs 22 more wins to reach 250 as a head coach in her career at James Madison.
- She would be the second head coach to reach the 250 win mark, and needs 10 more wins to go ahead of Mickey Dean (237-56) to be the second-most winningest coach in program history.
- Overall as a head and assistant head coach at JMU, LaPorte owns a 444-131 record from 2014-pres.

OPENING WEEKEND ALL ON ESPN+

- Every game of the Black and Gold Classic hosted by UCF will be streamed on ESPN+
- James Madison opens the season against CSU Bakersfield at UCF on Feb. 7 at 9 a.m. Then will proceed to play two against NC State, Georgia and then wrapping its time in Orlando with UCF in a Sunday late-morning matchup.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- CSU Bakersfield finished the 2024 campaign last in the Big West with a 5-46 record
- Head coach Letty Olivarez will begin her second year at the helm for the Roadrunners. She was previously the assistant coach at San Jose State for three years. Olivarez arrived at CSU Bakersfield with one year of head coaching experience, as she was the co-interim head coach of the Arizona State Sun Devils in 2016.
- JMU and CSU Bakersfield have met once previously, when the Dukes won 6-2 in a neutral site game on Mar. 1, 2008 in San Diego, Calif.

NC STATE

- The ACC preseason poll has the Wolfpack ranked 13th out of 15 teams prior the 2025 season. NC State finished its season, 30-23, going 6-18 in ACC play, missing the conference tournament.
- Lindsay Leftwich will be entering her second year as head coach in Raleigh, as she was previous an assistant coach at LSU for 12 seasons.
- The last matchup between The Dukes and Wolfpack came on Feb. 26, 2023, when JMU pulled away with a 14-11 victory in eight innnings on the road, in the Wolfpack Classic.

GEORGIA

- The Bulldogs finished second in the SEC Preseason Poll, with six first place votes after a 43-19 record in 2024 and hosting the Athens NCAA Regional. Georgia's season ended with a loss to then No. 6 ranked UCLA at the Los Angeles Super Regional.
- Tony Baldwin enters his fourth season as the head coach for Georgia and has taken his team to an NCAA regional appearance in each of his first three years, including two super regionals.

UCF

- In the Big 12 Preseason Poll, the Knights have been picked to finish seventh, after 31-25 record with an NCAA Regional appearance in Tallahassee in their inaugural season in the Big 12.
- UCF is led by Coach Cindy Ball-Malone, who has been at the healm in Orlando since 2019 and has guided the Knights to four straight NCAA regional appearances. The Black and Gold also hosted its first regional in school history and advanced to its first Super Regional in 2022 under her direction.
- JMU has an all-time record of 4-2 against UCF, last being a UCF triumph, 11-0, in Orlando on Feb. 26, 2022.



She started all 53 games for the Dukes in center field. She enters 2025 as part of the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team in her final year of eligibility.



PAYTON LIST

Coming off her Sun Belt Freshman of the year campaign where she started 40 games including 15 in the circle, List secured herself as a top dual threat in the nation, being named No. 11 in D1 Softball's P/UTL rankings. At the plate she hit .333 with eight doubles and nine home runs in 111 at-bats. In the circle, she won 10 games in 32 appearances with 76 strikeouts. List ended the year with a First Team All-Sun Belt selection and will begin 2025 with a Preseason All-SBC Team nod.



JASMINE HALL

In 2024, Hall started all 53 games for the Dukes, split between third base and shortstop. She racked up her 100th career hit against Omaha on March 1 and is one of three on the team with 100+ career hits. She had a team-leading 24 walks, talling a .415 OBP. Hall also tallied career-highs in hits and run scored during the 2024 campaign.

- The Rocket City Softball Showcase which takes place from Feb. 19-23 in Huntsville, Ala. will be streamed on FloCollege.
- The inagural tournament will be hosted at two different sites and play host to 12 total teams.
- JMU will play five games against Miami (OH), Auburn, Jax State, ETSU and Ole Miss split between Toyota Field in Madison and Hexagon Field at UAH in Huntsville.

NOTES FROM THE 2025 SLATE

- JMU will play multiple teams ranked and receiving votes in the NFCA Preseason Poll. Those teams include No. 12 Georgia, No. 17 Virginia Tech, with Liberty, Virginia, Penn State, Cal and Louisiana receiving votes.
- 2025 Opening Weekend in Orlando will be the sixth time in program history that the Dukes begin the season in the Sunshine State and the second time at
 UCF. JMU started the 2016 season at the UCF Knights Invitational, going 4-1 during tournament play, which included then No. 5 ranked Alabama, Fordham,
 Rutgers and the then No. 17 ranked Knights.
- James Madison will host two round-robin style tournaments at Veterans Memorial Park this season. This will be the second straight year that the Dukes are
 hosting two home tournaments and second overall in their history. The Lakeside Book Company Invitational will be the home opener for JMU, taking place
 from Feb. 14-16 and the Lakeside Book Company Tournament will be held from March 7-9.
- Despite already matching up in previous seasons, the Dukes will face Southern Miss and South Alabama for the first time in a Sun Belt Conference series.
 JMU played both programs last year in neutral site tournments, losing to the Golden Eagles during opening weekend in Jacksonsville and besting the Jaguars, 4-2 at the Gamecock Invitational.

SBC IN NCAA REGIONALS

During 2024 NCAA Regional play, Louisiana, South Alabama and Texas State were the three programs representing the Sun Belt Conference.

Louisiana was the No. 13 seed nationally, hosting the Lafayette Regional that included Princeton, Ole Miss and Baylor. The 2024 Lafayette Regional was the 34th regional in Rajun' Cajun history, and the thirteenth hosted. After winning its first three games, Louisiana eventually fell to Baylor in Game 7, 4-3. The Bears advanced to the Gainesville Super Regional and fell to Florida in three games.

Texas State received an automatic bid to the regional following its 2024 Sun Belt Conference Tournament victory in San Marcos. The Bobcats were part of the Bryan-College Station Regional hosted by the No. 16 seed, Texas A&M. The pool of opposition for the regional included Texas A&M, Penn State and University at Albany. Texas State won its contest against Penn State to start the regional, lost to No. 16 Texas A&M in game three and won against Penn State in game five to reach the regional final. The Bobcats eventually lost to the Aggies again in the final, 8-0. Texas A&M advanced to the Austin Super Regional and fell to the Longhorns in three games.

South Alabama received an at-large bid and joined FGCU and Florida Atlantic at the Gainesville Regional hosted by the four-seeded Florida Gators. The Jaguars finished third in the conference and a 16-8 conferene record. South Alabama boasted two wins against Florida Gulf Coast in games two and five, but lost to the Gators in game three and eventually in the regional final game, 9-1. Florida ended up advancing to Game 12 of the Women's College World Series, falling to the eventual 2024 WCWS champion, Oklahoma Sooners.

James Madison has been to seven regionals, including three super regionals and the 2021 Women's College World Series run in its history.

Dukes Bow Out of Sun Belt Championship

SAN MARCOS, Texas – No. 1 seed Louisiana scored five runs in the first two innings and never looked back, downing No. 8 James Madison 8-0 in five innings in the Quarterfinals of the 2024 Sun Belt Softball Championship on Thursday afternoon.

JMU finishes its 2024 season with a 31-22 record, while first-seeded Louisiana moved to 41-16 and will play in the Semifinals tomorrow against the winner of No. 4 Coastal Carolina and No. 5 Troy. The Dukes finished with zero runs and three hits, while the Ragin' Cajuns tallied eight runs on seven hits.

Sam Landry got her 23rd win of the season in the circle, working 4.1 scoreless innings while only surrendering three hits and striking out four. Reed Butler picked up two of JMU's three hits on the day which included a double, while Jasmine Hall picked up the Dukes' other hit.

How It Happened

- Reed Butler hit a leadoff double in the top of the first, but Landry sat the Dukes down in order with a pair of strikeouts to keep JMU off the board.
- Louisiana manufactured a run in the bottom of the first after Maddie Hayden singled, stole second, moved to third on a groundout, and scored on a wild pitch to give the Cajuns a 1-0 lead after one inning.
- A two-out double from Jasmine Hall was stranded at second base for JMU in the top of the second, as Louisiana continued to lead 1-0 through an inning and a half.
- The Cajuns broke the game open in the bottom of the second, scoring four runs and opening a 5-0 lead.

Sam Roe launched a solo home run in the bottom of the third, extending Louisiana's lead to 6-0.

- · Kirsten Fleet worked a scoreless fourth inning which featured a strikeout to keep the Cajuns off the board.
- J. Hall and Madison Edwards walked in the top of the fifth, but a double play ended the inning and kept the UL lead at 6-0.
- Louisiana walked off the game in the bottom of the fifth on a pair of singles and walks, giving the Cajuns the 8-0 run-rule victory.

Game Notes

- Louisiana only left three runners on base, hitting 3-for-7 (.429) with runners in scoring position.
- Butler managed her 23rd multi-hit game of the season, finishing 2-for-2. Moreover, her final 2024 batting average of .415 is the fourth-highest in a single season in JMU history.
- Alissa Humphrey ends her JMU career with 504 strikeouts, the fifth-most in a JMU career. Her 10 saves tie her with Jenny Clohan for the program record, and her 110 appearances tied her with Heather Kiefer for the sixth-most in program history.

Humphrey. Alexander tabbed her third NFCA All-American honor and first CAA Pitcher of the Year award under the guidance of LaPorte. LaPorte and her staff earned NFCA Northeast Coaching Staff of the Year and become the first JMU staff to earn NFCA National Coaching Staff of the Year after finishing the season with the program's highest ranking in the national polls: fourth. LaPorte received recognition as the CAA Coach of the Year and VaSID Coach of the Year.

In her third season as head coach in 2020, LaPorte lead the Dukes to a record of 13-6 before the season ended short due to COVID-19. LaPorte started the season with two wins over Top-25 programs, including a shut-out win over Texas Tech. She guided Gordon to break the JMU career home run Record and receive the accolade of Louisville Slugger/NFCA Player of the Week along with Sara Jubas who was the first JMU softball student-athlete to be honored as a CoSIDA Academic All-American.

In her second season as head coach in 2019, LaPorte guided the Dukes to a historical season, finishing 51-10 and 20-1 in CAA games. The team advanced to the NCAA Super Regional for the second time in program history, and earned its seventh consecutive NCAA Regional appearance. LaPorte received recognition as the 2019 CAA Coach of the Year and 2019 Regional Coach of the Year. She coached three to All-American honors, nine All-CAA student-athletes and eight All-Region Honors student-athletes.

In her first season as head coach in 2018, LaPorte guided the Dukes to a 43-14 overall record, including 19-2 in CAA play. The 2018 CAA Coach of the Year, LaPorte helped JMU earn its seventh overall and sixth consecutive NCAA Regional appearance. Under her guidance, Odicci Alexander and Kate Gordon were named to the NFCA All-America Third Team. She also coached Alexander to earn 2018 CAA Player of the Year recognition and boasts five NFCA All-Region and four All-CAA student athletes.



CAREER RECORD Loren LaPorte, formerly Loren Messick, completed her 11th year with the softball team at James Madison University and seventh year as head coach in 2024. She served an assistant coach for five vears and was elevated to head coach in September of 2017.

> In her seven seasons as head coach, she has guided the program to its first-ever Top-25 ranking, earned eight straight NCAA Tournament appearances, three NCAA Super Regional appearances in 2016, 2019 and 2021 and a historic Women's College World Series appearance. Since LaPorte's head coaching debut, the Dukes have compiled a 228-96 (.704) record, including a 91-32 mark in conference play. Across her full 11 years at JMU, the Dukes have racked up a 444-131 mark, including an 169-36 record in conference play.

During the 2024 campaign, James Madison compiled a 31-22 record, going 12-12 in its second year of Sun Belt Conference play. The Dukes were the sixth seed in the SBC tournament and made it to the quarterfinal round. Reed Butler, Bella Henzler and Payton List earned All-Sun Belt First Team Honors, with List also being tabbed SBC Freshman of the Year.

In the 2023 season, JMU went 28-19 and 13-11 during its first year in the Sun Belt Conference. In LaPorte's first year in the Sun Belt, she led Hannah Shifflett and KK Mathis to First Team All-Conference honors. Under her direction, the Dukes clinched a six seed in the Sun Belt Championship and received a first round bye.

In the 2022 season, the Dukes went 21-21 and 10-5 in conference play. LaPorte led four Dukes to All-Colonial Athletic Association honors, including the 11th Duke to be named CAA Player of the Year: Hannah Shifflett. Six Dukes earned NFCA All-Region honors, with Lauren Bernett, Hannah Shifflett and Jasmine Hall being named to the first team.

In her fourth season as head coach, LaPorte lead the Dukes to a record of 41-4 and 17-1 in CAA games and the program's first-ever Women's College World Series appearance, making history as the first unseeded team to win its first two games at the WCWS. Under her guidance, the Dukes defeated four top-10 programs, including eventual national champion Oklahoma, along with two wins over No. 25 Liberty. Outfielder Kate Gordon set the CAA home run record and earned NFCA All-Region Honors alongside Madison Naujokas, Odicci Alexander, Logan Newton, Lynsey Meeks, Sara Jubas and Alissa
