**2024 IN REVIEW** - The UCF softball team produced a 31-25 record in its inaugural season in the Big 12 Conference in 2024, earning a bid to the NCAA Tournament for a program-record fourth straight season...with the team's 31 wins, the Knights eclipsed the 30 win mark for the sixth straight year dating back to 2018 (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020 year)...UCF's 31-25 record included a 12-15 mark within Big 12 play and a 20-9 record at home...the Knights' 2024 season was highlighted by the largest NCAA Tournament comeback win in program history against the Auburn Tigers May 17, erasing a four-run deficit en route to an 11-6 win...the effort represented the Knights' highest-ranked win of the campaign by the NCAA's RPI metric (24).

MARQUEE MATCHUPS - The Knights' 2025 schedule features 54 total games against 14 different conferences, including 31 home games, 17 true road games and six neutral site contests...the Black and Gold will also host three weekend tournaments in the first four weeks of the season...of UCF's 33 opponents, four won their conference's tournament championship (Oklahoma, Florida, Liberty, FGCU) and two won their conference's regular-season championship (Liberty, FAU)...UCF will also match up against 14 programs that were selected for the 2024 NCAA Tournament, nine that advanced as far as NCAA Super Regional play, and three Women's College World Series participants (Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Florida)...the Black and Gold's 2025 opponents produced a standout .571 (1030-774-4) aggregate win percentage in the 2024 season as well, highlighted by eight teams that eclipsed 40 wins and two that reached at least 50 victories (Oklahoma and Florida).

RIVALRY RENEWED - UCF's opening night contest against the No. 12 Georgia Bulldogs represents the third time in the last four campaigns that has seen the two squads meet in Orlando on the season's first day...UCF earned a 7-6 eight-inning walk-off win over the then-No. 12 Bulldogs Feb. 10, 2022, thanks in part to former first baseman and current GA **Shannon Doherty**'s walk-off solo home run...Georgia prevailed in the teams' 2023 season-opener with a 4-2 win Feb. 9, a contest that saw former RHP and current GA **Sarah Willis** throw three innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts in her UCF debut...the Bulldogs bring a 3-1 all-time series lead into the Thursday matchup.

NEW-LOOK STAFF - Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone welcomes three new members to her coaching staff in 2025 in Noah Sanders, Stacie Pestrak and Shannon Saile, along with three new graduate assistants in UCF softball alums Shannon Doherty and Sarah Willis, and newcomer Christian Bernabe. ◆ Sanders joins the Knights following seven years with the Little Rock Trojans baseball team in Little Rock, Arkansas, first as an assistant coach from 2018-22 before he was promoted to the program's associate head coach in the summer of 2022...working primarily with the team's offense, Sanders helped lead his team to great success throughout his tenure in Little Rock; in posting the team's second 30-win campaign in as many seasons as a member of the Ohio Valley Conference in 2024, Little Rock finished the year with an aggregate .274/.355/.432 line, accompanied by 60 home runs and 116 doubles, a mark that ranked fifth-most in a single season in program history. ♦ A member of the Oklahoma State Cowgirls' 2024 ATEC/NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year, Pestrak joins the Knights after helping lead the Cowgirls throughout the last nine seasons as an assistant coach and director of operations...from 2015-24, Pestrak helped lead Oklahoma State

Tournament appearances and five consecutive Women's College World Series appearances in each of the last five non-COVID-19-shortened seasons. 
†Though in her first season as an assistant coach, Saile enters her third season on Ball-Malone's staff after serving as a graduate assistant from 2023-24...a former National Championship-winning right-handed pitcher with the Oklahoma Sooners (2021), Saile recorded a career 1.62 ERA with 854 strikeouts in 638.1 innings spanning her five-year collegiate career with FIU (2017-18) and Oklahoma (2019-21)...she finished her OU tenure ranking second in program history in K/7IP (9.75) and career saves (11), and sixth in BAA (.172).

FELTON'S FOURTH - Right-handed pitcher Kaitlyn Felton enters her final collegiate season as the lone senior on the Knights roster to have spent all four years with UCF...through her first three seasons. Felton has recorded a 3.72 ERA and a .279 BAA in 214.1 career innings, accompanied by 165 strikeouts, 10 complete games, four shutouts and three saves...Felton in 2024 set single-season career bests in innings pitched (87.0), starts (19) and complete games (4), and tied her previous career bests in shutouts (2)...entering the 2025 season, Felton ranks among all-time UCF program career leaders in saves (3, T-6th), strikeouts per seven innings pitched (min. 200 IP) (5.39, 9th), and appearances (65, T-9th).

HOMETOWN HERO - Junior infielder Aubrey Evans, a native of Apopka, Florida, enters her third season as a mainstay in the Knights starting lineup...on the heels of a 2023 debut campaign that garnered NFCA All-Region Third Team, AAC All-Conference Second Team and AAC All-Rookie Team recognition, Evans cemented herself as one of the top defenders in the Big 12...she finished within a tie for first in the league in fielding percentage (1.000) while recording the 10th-most assists (50) in Big 12 play...Evans in 2024 also recorded the first true walk-off hit of her career against BYU April 6, clinching the first Big 12 series sweep in program history, and produced a season-opening 11-game hit streak, the longest of her career, during which she hit .412 (14-for-34) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and 19 total bases.

PORTAL PICKUPS - Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone added three new Knights from the transfer portal

during the offseason: junior right-handed pitcher Lena Elkins (Charlotte), fifth year outfielder Madison Simon (Oregon State) and redshirt sophomore Destiny Washington (Marshall)...Elkins in two seasons with the 49ers compiled a 3.33 ERA and a .261 BAA in 103 IP (38 apps, 26 starts), accompanied by 73 strikeouts, three shutouts, six complete games and one save...she also owns two career no-hitters on the same day in two separate seasons, vs. Canisius (Feb. 17, 2024) and St. John's (NY) (Feb. 17, 2023)... Simon brings a wealth of outfield experience to UCF, having appeared in 160 career games (156 starts)... she was one of Oregon State's leaders in the team's 2022 NCAA Tournament run, hitting .267 (4-for-15) with 1 HR, 2 2B and 3 RBI in the NCAA Knoxville Regional before hitting a two-run homer in the first of Oregon State's two wins over then-No. 14 Stanford in the Super Regional round, helping lead the team to the Women's College World Series... Washington hit .336 with eight extra-base hits in her debut season with the Herd in 2024, including 10 multi-hit games...she also hit safely against a pair of ranked opponents, going a combined 3-for-6 against then-No. 23 Kentucky and then-No. 13 Virginia Tech.

RANKED RECRUITS - Of the Knights' five-member 2024-25 freshman class, three were ranked within the top players in the nationwide class prior to joining UCF...right-handed pitcher Yessenia Lopez was tabbed the No. 35 overall player in the class by Extra Inning Softball, bringing extensive international experience to Orlando...she notably aided the Puerto Rico national team in its run to the silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile...infielder Izzy Mertes was ranked a four-star infielder by Softball America/On3, on the heels of helping the OC Batbusters (travel ball) to two Alliance National Championships in 2022 and 2023, as well as an Alliance Super Cup Championship in 2023... catcher/first baseman Beth Damon joins Mertes as the second four-star infielder on Softball America/ On3's rankings, and was also the highest-ranked recruit in UCF's 2025 class by Extra Inning Softball (No. 24)...Damon in high school garnered two All-Conference Offensive Player of the Year selections, three All-District Player of the Year selections, one All-Region selection and one All-State Selection.

RISE FOR THE ROOKIES - As announced by D1Softball.com, right-handed pitcher Yessenia Lopez and infielder Coco Jaimes were tabbed to the publication's D100 Freshman Watch List ahead of the 2025 spring campaign...Jaimes, infielder Izzy Mertes and catcher/first baseman Beth Damon were included on Softball America's preseason Freshman Watch List as well...Lopez, fresh off helping lead the Puerto Rico national team to a silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games, garnered the No. 35 overall ranking in the national 2024-25 freshman class according to Extra Inning Softball, and played nine years in travel and club softball with Florida Gold Lopez/Santana as well...Jaimes begins her collegiate tenure on the heels of four years spent as a varsity captain at Riverside Poly High School in Riverside, California, where she earned First Team All-League selections in three straight seasons from 2021-23, as well as two Golden Glove awards in 2021 and 2023...Damon represents the highest-ranked recruit in UCF's 2025 class at No. 24 in the nation according to Extra Inning Softball, and was tabbed a four-star catcher by Softball America/On3...Mertes joined Damon as the second four-star infielder according to Softball America/On3, and hit .566 during her junior year of high school accompanied by 30 career home runs.

PROTECT THE PLEX - The Knights have demonstrated a strong ability to defend their home field under head coach Cindy Ball-Malone, having authored three consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins at the UCF Softball Complex and four such seasons in the first five (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season) during the Ball-Malone era overall (since and including 2019)...entering the 2025 season, UCF has produced an aggregate 123-43-1 (.740) record at home spanning Ball-Malone's first six years.

A STORM IN SPACE - Transfer INF/OF Stormy Kotzelnick excelled in UCF's six space games throughout the 2024 season, hitting a team-best .471/.526/.824 (8-for-17) with four runs scored, three doubles, one home run, six RBI and 14 total bases when the Knights donned their Canaveral blue and black uniforms.

AMONG THE BIG 12's BEST - Sophomores Samantha Rey and Sierra Humphreys lead the Black and Gold's returners in 2025, as both look to build upon strong debut seasons that landed the duo unanimous All-Big 12 Freshman Team selections in 2024...among Big 12 freshmen last season, Humphreys' .286 average in Big 12 play ranked 14th in the league, while Rey pulled in five spots behind at 19th (.250)...Humphreys also ranked among freshman leaders in Big 12 play in doubles (3, T-7th), RBI (11, 7th), total bases (20, 8th) and total hits (14, 8th)...Humphreys produced a .333/.376/.491 (36-for-108) line overall last season, accompanied by 10 XBH (6 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR), while Rey hit .321/.333/.375 (18-for-56).

RANKED MATCHUPS - The Knights will square off against many of the nation's best programs throughout the 2025 spring season, as 11 teams on UCF's schedule are included among the preseason top 25 polls authored by NFCA/GoRout, ESPN/USA Softball, Softball America/On3, and DISoftball.com: No. 1 Florida, No. 2 Oklahoma, No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 8 Florida State, No. 12 Georgia (NFCA/GoRout), No. 12 Arizona (D1Softball.com), No. 15 Missouri, No. 16 Baylor, No. 20 Liberty, and No. 25 Clemson...against the 12th-ranked Bulldogs on Opening Knight, UCF will be in search of its first ranked win since March 24, 2023, when it topped then-No. 22 Wichita State 3-1 in Orlando.

# CINDY BALL-MALONE

## Head Coach $\int$ Seventh Season

On the heels of a hall-of-fame collegiate playing career, UCF head softball coach Cindy Ball-Malone, also known by her nickname, "Bear," has lifted the UCF softball program to new heights throughout her first six seasons at the helm since she was named the second head coach in program history June 27, 2018.

Ball-Malone's resume showcases:

- + Ten career seasons as an NCAA Division I head softball coach (the last six at UCF), including six postseason appearances, five NCAA Tournament berths, and one NCAA super regional appearance
- Extensive player development, highlighted by one All-America selection, one National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selection, two national Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week selections, one American Athletic Conference AAC Pitcher of the Year selection, one AAC Rookie of the Year selection, and three consecutive top 25 nationally-ranked recruiting classes (Extra Inning Softball, 2021-23)
- + Four additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Washington and Cal State Northridge, including two NCAA super regional appearances with the Huskies
- A playing career at the University of the Pacific that landed Ball-Malone among the selections for the 13th West Coast Conference Hall of Honor Class in 2023

Under "Coach Bear," the UCF softball team is in the midst of the most successful period in the program's 23-year history. With the team's 31-25 record in 2024, the Knights again made history, earning an NCAA Tournament berth in four consecutive seasons for the first time in program history.

The Knights' current postseason run also encompasses three consecutive 40-plus-win seasons (2021-23), four NCAA Regional appearances, one of which was hosted by the Knights at the UCF Softball Complex (2022), and the first NCAA super regional appearance in program history.

Ball-Malone most recently led the Knights to their sixth consecutive non-COVID-19-shortened 30-plus-win season in 2024, also marking the team's inaugural campaign in the Big 12 Conference.

The Knights saw five players earn selections to the Big 12's post-season All-Conference teams, as well as a pair who saw their names added to the NFCA's All-Region squads. Right-handed pitcher/outfielder Sarah Willis wrapped up her two-year Knights tenure as an All-Big 12 First Team honoree, as well as an NFCA All-Midwest Region Second Team selection.

First baseman Shannon Doherty and right fielder Chloe Evans earned All-Big 12 Second Team honors, while freshman infielder/outfielders Sierra Humphreys and Samantha Rey both garnered unanimous All-Big 12 Freshman Team appointments.

Fifth-year utility player Jada Cody concluded her storied career with the Black and Gold as an NFCA All-Midwest Region First Team selection as well, rounding out UCF's post-season awards. Willis and redshirt-sophomore catcher/designated player Ashleigh Griffin became the first two Knights in program history to earn Big 12 Player of the Week honors as well.

UCF collected five series wins in its first season in its new conference, toppling the Kansas Jayhawks, Texas Tech Red Raiders, BYU Cougars, and Iowa State Cyclones while consistently playing close matchups against many of the top-ranked programs in the nation.

The Knights earned the first Big 12 Conference series win in program history against Kansas March 8-10, the first road Big 12 Conference series win at Texas Tech March 28-30, and the first Big 12 Conference series sweep against BYU April 4-6.

UCF's series win at Texas Tech featured Coach Bear's 200th UCF win (March 28, 8-5 victory) and the 300th win of her overall head coaching career (March 29, 12-9 victory) as well.

The Black and Gold concluded their 2024 campaign at the 2024 NCAA Tallahassee Regional, where they earned their highest-ranked win of the season by the NCAA's RPI metric over the Auburn Tigers (No. 24). The victory marked the largest NCAA Tournament comeback win in program history, as the Knights rallied from a four-run deficit to claim an eventual 11-6 victory.

After leading the Knights to their first Super Regional appearance in program history in 2022, Coach Bear again made history with UCF softball in 2023, leading the team to its third consecutive 40-win season with its 40-21 finish, also marking the first time in program history that the Knights have won at least 40 games in three consecutive seasons. UCF opened the season ranked as high as 15th in the nation, and by season's end had won its second consecutive American Athletic Conference Tournament Championship with a 3-0 showing against Memphis, South Florida and Tulsa.

The automatic NCAA tournament bid clinched by the Knights' tournament title marked the 10th NCAA tournament appearance in program history and third straight dating back to 2021. UCF earned a spot in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional hosted by No. 3 Florida State, along with No. 20 South Carolina and Marist. The Knights opened NCAA Regional play with a 6-1 victory over the Gamecocks May 19, a victory that extended UCF's season-long win streak to 14 consecutive games dating back to the Knights' 13-1 win at Tulsa April 16. The Knights' 2023 season came to an end with losses to the Seminoles and Gamecocks May 20.

During the 2023 season, Coach Bear oversaw the development of RHP/OF Sarah Willis, a junior transfer from the Washington Huskies, who became the second Knight in program history to win American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year. The Knights also saw three selections to the NFCA's All-Region

First (Willis), Second (RHP Grace Jewell) and Third (INF/DP Aubrey Evans) Teams, as well as eight selections to The American's All-Conference First and Second Teams.

The Knights clinched the 800th win in program history during the 2023 season as well, a milestone that accompanied UCF's three-game sweep of the South Florida Bulls April 23. Coach Bear also recorded the 150th win of her UCF career with the Knights' 6-5 win over Mississippi State Feb. 19, and she notched the 250th win of her head coaching career four days later with UCF's 8-0 win over Gardner-Webb Feb. 23.

The UCF softball program took a massive leap in the 2022 season as the team posted an impressive 49-14 record. In what was the best season in program history, the year included the Black and Gold winning the conference's regular season and tournament titles as well as earning the right to host NCAA Regionals, being named the No. 16 national seed on Selection Sunday. Bear and her squad didn't stop there, as the Knights swept their way through the Orlando Regional, beating Villanova 6-0 on the strength of two Jada Cody home runs before topping No. 24 Michigan twice to advance to the program's first Super Regional.

The 2022 season began with a bang as UCF, which began the year receiving votes in the NFCA poll, earned a walk-off win over then-No. 12 Georgia on opening night with an eighth-inning solo shot from Shannon Doherty. Mid-February saw the Knights take part in the St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational, one of the top tournaments in the sport. UCF picked up a pair of wins against future Big 12 Conference foes, beating then-No. 11 Texas 15-10 and Texas Tech 7-3.

March saw UCF go 7-0 on its California swing, going unbeaten on a west coast trip for the first time in program history. The remainder of the regular season saw the Knights dominate American Athletic Conference play, eventually clinching the outright regular season championship on the final day of the season against Wichita State.

UCF earned a walk-off victory over Houston in the semifinals of The American Championship before run-ruling rival South Florida 11-0 to earn the conference tournament crown. It marked the first time since 2015 that the Knights had won both conference titles. The Black and Gold's magical season came to an end in Norman as UCF was swept in the Super Regional by the eventual national champion and top-seeded Oklahoma.

UCF finished in the top 16 in all four major polls at 2022's end. The Knights checked in at No. 14 in the final edition of the NFCA's rankings, their highest finish in the poll in program history. The Black and Gold finished in a tie for 15th in USA Softball's rankings while checking in at No. 13 in D1Softball's final poll and No. 14 in Softball America. The No. 14 finish in the NFCA poll was one spot shy of tying the program record, set back in week 15 of 2015. The same can be said about the Knights' USA Softball ranking, as UCF finished one spot behind its program-best ranking of No. 14 set in week 14 of 2015.

Bear helped guide more than one team to new heights in 2022, as she was named as an assistant coach for the USA National Team at the World Games and Canada Cup in the summer. The team won gold at the World Games.

Bear once again led the program to new heights in 2021, securing a career-best 41-19-1 record with the Knights and leading the Black and Gold into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2016. Bear led her Knights all the way to the AAC Championship game, and UCF's 41 wins represented its highest total since it had posted in a season since 2015.

The Black and Gold also recorded three wins over top five-ranked teams in the country, taking down then No. 5 Florida twice (March 24, 8-6 and April 14, 7-0) and No. 2 Arizona (March 8, 2-0). UCF played 14 games against a top-25 opponent in 2021, posting a 4-9-1 record in those games.

In year two in 2020, Ball-Malone brought the program to new heights. After leading UCF to a program-best 16-2 start in 2020, including an 11-game winning streak from 02/14-03/01, the Knights were tabbed as high as No. 22 in the ESPN/USA Softball and NFCA/USA Today Top 25 Polls. In the first release of the NCAA RPI, UCF checked in at No. 7 overall.

Coach Bear achieved her milestone 50th win at UCF on 03/01/20 in a 2-0 win over Longwood. In the 26 game, COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, UCF outscored opponents 156-64 and racked up a 9-4-1 record against Power6 teams and a 6-5-1 record against Top 25 teams or teams receiving votes.

She joined the Knights in 2019, going 34-21 (11-10), including picking up Power 6 wins over Ohio State, Pitt, Penn State and Boston College in her first season as head coach.

Ball-Malone joined the Knights following four successful seasons at Boise State University. In her last two campaigns, she compiled a 73-36 record and led the squad to the program's first postseason appearance at the 2017 National Invitational Softball Championship, followed by a 2018 NCAA Tournament berth.

In 2018, the Broncos set program records for most wins in a season (40), most conference wins in a season (18), and the first conference title in program history, defeating New Mexico in the Mountain West championship.

Ball-Malone brought a plethora of coaching experience into her first stop as a Division I head coach, highlighted by a two-year stint on staff with the Washington Huskies. In those two seasons, she served as recruiting coordinator and was responsible for the development of the Husky pitching staff. The Huskies went 76-35 during Ball-Malone's two seasons in Seattle and reached a pair of NCAA Super Regionals while developing Kaitlin Inglesby into a second team All-American.

Under Ball-Malone's leadership, Inglesby held the lowest ERA on the 2012 team for the second straight year (2.31), while also leading the Huskies pitching staff in starts (30), wins (19), saves (5), complete games (21), shutouts (6), and strikeouts (169).

Ball-Malone has also spent time coaching at Cal State Northridge, Cosumnes River College, Modesto Junior College, and her alma mater, Pacific.

She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. Ball-Malone is considered the greatest two-way player in the history of Pacific Softball, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holding nine career pitching records for the Tigers.






