<u>DOUBLE TROUBLE</u> - The UCF softball team has enjoyed strong early production of extra-base hits, as the squad's 21 doubles entering play Thursday lead the Big 12 Conference and rank tied for 11th in the nation, behind only Arkansas (27), New Mexico State (27), Stanford (26), Florida (25), South Carolina (25), UTEP (25), McNeese (22), Northern Kentucky (22), Seattle U (22) and UC Santa Barbara (22)...three Knights rank among the conference's individual doubles leaders as well, in freshman Izzy Mertes (6) and sophomores Sierra Humphreys (5) and Samantha Rey (4)...Mertes' six doubles rank second in the league and sixth nationally, Humphreys' five rank third in the Big 12 and 11th nationally, and Rey ranks tied for fourth in the league.

EXTRA, EXTRA - Over their weekend showing in the 2025 Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational, the Knights earned their second extra-inning win of the season, topping the Clemson Tigers, 6-4, in eight innings...the effort marked UCF's second win in as many chances beyond the regulation seven innings, joining the highest-ranked comeback win in program history against then-No. 15 Missouri Feb. 11, 6-5, also in eight frames...UCF is now 6-1 in its last seven extra-inning games dating back to the team's eight-inning 2-1 win over South Florida 4/21/2023, and 75-48-3 all-time in extra frames.

WIN, LOSE...OR TIE? - UCF played to a weather-abbreviated 4-4 tie with the Ohio State Buckeyes in its penultimate contest of the weekend in Clearwater...the tie, brought upon by an afternoon rain shower, marked the first for UCF since the Black and Gold played to a 0-0 stalemate with then-No. 20 Wichita State April 18, 2021, which was ruled complete after 11 scoreless innings due to the game reaching the drop-dead time for travel arrangements.

GROWING UP QUICK - The UCF softball team's offensive production has largely been spearheaded by its underclassmen through the team's first 13 games this spring...entering the weekend SpaceU Classic, the Knights as a team have recorded 82 hits, 24 extra-base hits, 110 total bases and 39 RBI, while the Black and Gold's rostered freshmen and sophomores have produced a combined 56 hits, 18 extra-base hits, 78 total bases and 29 RBI... through 13 games, UCF underclassmen are responsible for 68.2 percent of the team's total hits, 75 percent of the team's total extra-base hits, 70.9 percent of the team's total bases, and 74.4 percent of the team's total RBI.

- +Entering play Thursday, UCF **sophomores** have accounted for 28 hits (34.1 percent), 10 extra-base hits (41.7 percent), 39 total bases (35.5 percent), and 13 RBI (33.3 percent) of the team's total offensive production.
- + Entering play Thursday, Knights **freshmen** have accounted for 28 hits (34.1 percent), 8 extra-base hits (33.3 percent), 39 total bases (35.5 percent), and 16 RBI (55.2 percent) of the team's total offensive production.

TOPPED THE TIGERS - The UCF softball team earned one of the largest wins in the history of the program Tuesday, Feb. 11, erasing a 5-0 first-inning deficit en route to a 6-5, eight-inning comeback walk-off win over the No. 15 Missouri Tigers...the winning effort marked the team's first win over a ranked opponent since the program toppled then-No. 22 Wichita State, 3-1, in the team's final American Athletic Conference opener March 24, 2023, and its first top-15 win since the Knights bested then-No. 5 Virginia Tech in Orlando, 5-4, in 11 innings April 4, 2022...the victory also marked the largest comeback win over a ranked opponent in program history, and the Knights' second-largest comeback win overall...redshirt freshman right-handed pitcher Isabella Vega was the catalyst for the comeback, throwing seven scoreless innings in relief with just five hits allowed and nine strikeouts in just the third appearance of her collegiate career...fifth year transfer outfielder Madison Simon recorded her first collegiate walk-off hit to clinch the victory, a double in the bottom of the eighth inning that scored infielder Coco Jaimes. redshirt senior utility player Stormy Kotzelnick also enjoyed a standout evening at the plate, posting her first three-hit game of the season, second as a Knight and seventh of her career; Kotzelnick also tallied her first multi-double game of the season and fourth of her three-plus-year collegiate career.

PROTECT THE PLEX - The Knights have demonstrated a strong ability to defend their home field under head coach Cindy Ball-Malone, having authored three consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins at the UCF Softball Complex and four such seasons in the first five (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020) during the Ball-Malone era overall (since and including 2019)...entering play Thursday, UCF has produced a collective 129-45-1 (.740) record at home spanning Ball-Malone's first six-plus years.

AWARDS SEASON CAME EARLY – Senior right-handed pitcher Kaitlyn Felton was dominant through her three weekend appearances, and garnered the season's first Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Week award for her efforts...Felton made three appearances, including one start, and held her opposition scoreless through her 10.2 innings of work...her nine strikeouts co-led the team with freshman right-hander Yessenia Lopez, and she notched her first seven-inning complete game shutout and first save of the season...Felton yielded just four total hits between her three appearances, good for a team-low batting average-against of .108...she struck out one of three hitters she faced in her 0.2-inning outing against No. 12 Georgia Feb. 6, and in her next appearance clinched her fourth career save with three innings of one-hit ball against NC State Feb. 7...her third appearance saw her go the distance, shutting out Illinois on three hits while fanning six on 106 pitches...in addition to her first seven-inning shutout of the spring, Felton's start marked the second such outing of her career, joining her one-hit masterpiece against FAU April 17, 2024...she spun at least seven innings in an appearance for the sixth time in her three-plus-year UCF tenure as well.

STINGY STAFF – Felton's efforts factored into a dominant opening weekend by the UCF pitching staff as a whole, which through 40 innings of work posted a collective 1.23 ERA (7 ER) with 26 strikeouts, five extra-base hits allowed, and a .213 batting average-against (32-for-150)...UCF yielded more than two runs just once, in its 4-0 loss to No. 12 Georgia Feb. 6, and in its five weekend victories surrendered a total of four runs, including a pair of shutouts against CSU Bakersfield and Illinois...entering play Tuesday, the Black and Gold rank among Big 12 Conference leaders in ERA (1.23, 2nd, 18th NCAA) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.36, 4th), and join No. 8 Texas Tech and No. 11 Arizona as one of three Big 12 programs to record multiple shutouts through the first weekend of play...the Knights' 1.23 ERA through six games also represents *UCF's lowest team ERA through the first six games of a season in close to 10 years*; the 2016 Knights posted a 1.17 ERA through their first six games spanning 42 innings pitched, allowing seven earned runs and a batting average-against of .164 en route to a 4-2 start against Liberty, Rutgers, No. 5 Alabama, Fordham, No. 19 James Madison and No. 3 Auburn.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP - 2024 All-Big 12 Freshmen Sierra Humphreys and Samantha Rey paced the Knights' offense through the first weekend of play, with Rey recording a team-best .467 average (7-for-15) and Humphreys leading the way in slugging percentage (.647)...Humphreys' four doubles are good for a share of first in the Big 12 with Arizona's Kaiah Altmeyer and third in the nation overall, and she ranks tied for second in the league and 22nd in the NCAA in doubles per game (0.67), while Rey has registered three multi-hit games and has hit safely in four of her first six starts this season.

WELCOME TO ORLANDO, LENA – Junior transfer right-hander **Lena Elkins** produced a standout UCF debut in the circle against Illinois Feb. 8, throwing the Knights' first seven-inning complete game of the spring in the team's 2-1 victory...Elkins danced out of danger throughout the evening, stranding 10 runners on base while yielding just one run on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts on 119 pitches... the effort marked the third seven-inning complete game of her two-plus-year career, as well as her first against a power four foe after she also went seven innings in both of her previous two no-hitters against Canisius (Feb. 17, 2024) and St. John's (Feb. 17, 2023).

RANKED MATCHUPS - The Knights will square off against many of the nation's best teams throughout the 2025 spring season, as 11 on UCF's schedule were included among the preseason top 25 polls authored by NFCA/GoRout, ESPN/USA Softball, Softball America/On3, and D1Softball.com: No. 1 Florida, No. 2 Oklahoma, No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 8 Florida State, No. 12 Georgia (NFCA/GoRout), No. 12 Arizona (D1Softball.com), No. 15 Missouri, No. 16 Baylor, No. 20 Liberty, and No. 25 Clemson...against No. 15 Missouri Tuesday and No. 20 Liberty Wednesday, UCF will be in search of its first two ranked wins since March 24, 2023, when it topped then-No. 22 Wichita State 3-1 at home.

RANKED RECRUITS - Of the Knights' five-member 2024-25 freshman class, three were ranked within the top players in the nationwide class prior to joining UCF...right-handed pitcher Yessenia Lopez was tabbed the No. 35 overall player in the class by Extra Inning Softball, bringing extensive international experience to Orlando...she notably aided the Puerto Rico national team in its run to the silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile...infielder Izzy Mertes was ranked a four-star infielder by Softball America/On3, on the heels of helping the OC Batbusters (travel ball) to two Alliance National Championships in 2022 and 2023, as well as an Alliance Super Cup Championship in 2023... catcher/first baseman Beth Damon joins Mertes as the second four-star infielder on Softball America/On3's rankings, and was also the highest-ranked recruit in UCF's 2025 class by Extra Inning Softball (No. 24)...Damon in high school garnered two All-Conference Offensive Player of the Year selections, three All-District Player of the Year selections, one All-Region selection and one All-State Selection.

RISE FOR THE ROOKIES - As announced by D1Softball.com, right-handed pitcher Yessenia Lopez and infielder Coco Jaimes were tabbed to the publication's D100 Freshman Watch List ahead of the 2025 spring campaign...Jaimes, infielder Izzy Mertes and catcher/first baseman Beth Damon were included on Softball America's preseason Freshman Watch List as well...Lopez, fresh off helping lead the Puerto Rico national team to a silver medal at the 2023 Pan American Games, garnered the No. 35 overall ranking in the national 2024-25 freshman class according to Extra Inning Softball, and played nine years in travel and club softball with Florida Gold Lopez/Santana as well...Jaimes begins her collegiate tenure on the heels of four years spent as a varsity captain at Riverside Poly High School in Riverside, California, where she earned First Team All-League selections in three straight seasons from 2021-23, as well as two Golden Glove awards in 2021 and 2023...Damon represents the highest-ranked recruit in UCF's 2025 class at No. 24 in the nation according to Extra Inning Softball, and was tabbed a four-star catcher by Softball America/On3...Mertes joined Damon as the second four-star infielder according to Softball America/On3, and hit .566 during her junior year of high school accompanied by 30 career home runs.

Head Coach \int Seventh Season

On the heels of a hall-of-fame collegiate playing career, UCF head softball coach Cindy Ball-Malone, also known by her nickname, "Bear," has lifted the UCF softball program to new heights throughout her first six seasons at the helm since she was named the second head coach in program history June 27, 2018.

Ball-Malone's resume showcases:

- + Ten career seasons as an NCAA Division I head softball coach (the last six at UCF), including six postseason appearances, five NCAA Tournament berths, and one NCAA super regional appearance
- Extensive player development, highlighted by one All-America selection, one National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selection, two national Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week selections, one American Athletic Conference AAC Pitcher of the Year selection, one AAC Rookie of the Year selection, and three consecutive top 25 nationally-ranked recruiting classes (Extra Inning Softball, 2021-23)
- + Four additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Washington and Cal State Northridge, including two NCAA super regional appearances with the Huskies
- + A playing career at the University of the Pacific that landed Ball-Malone among the selections for the 13th West Coast Conference Hall of Honor Class in 2023

Under "Coach Bear," the UCF softball team is in the midst of the most successful period in the program's 23-year history. With the team's 31-25 record in 2024, the Knights again made history, earning an NCAA Tournament berth in four consecutive seasons for the first time in program history.

The Knights' current postseason run also encompasses three consecutive 40-plus-win seasons (2021-23), four NCAA Regional appearances, one of which was hosted by the Knights at the UCF Softball Complex (2022), and the first NCAA super regional appearance in program history.

Ball-Malone most recently led the Knights to their sixth consecutive non-COVID-19-shortened 30-plus-win season in 2024, also marking the team's inaugural campaign in the Big 12 Conference.

The Knights saw five players earn selections to the Big 12's post-season All-Conference teams, as well as a pair who saw their names added to the NFCA's All-Region squads. Right-handed pitcher/outfielder Sarah Willis wrapped up her two-year Knights tenure as an All-Big 12 First Team honoree, as well as an NFCA All-Midwest Region Second Team selection.

First baseman Shannon Doherty and right fielder Chloe Evans earned All-Big 12 Second Team honors, while freshman infielder/outfielders Sierra Humphreys and Samantha Rey both garnered unanimous All-Big 12 Freshman Team appointments.

Fifth-year utility player Jada Cody concluded her storied career with the Black and Gold as an NFCA All-Midwest Region First Team selection as well, rounding out UCF's post-season awards. Willis and redshirt-sophomore catcher/designated player Ashleigh Griffin became the first two Knights in program history to earn Big 12 Player of the Week honors as well.

UCF collected five series wins in its first season in its new conference, toppling the Kansas Jayhawks, Texas Tech Red Raiders, BYU Cougars, and Iowa State Cyclones while consistently playing close matchups against many of the top-ranked programs in the nation.

The Knights earned the first Big 12 Conference series win in program history against Kansas March 8-10, the first road Big 12 Conference series win at Texas Tech March 28-30, and the first Big 12 Conference series sweep against BYU April 4-6.

UCF's series win at Texas Tech featured Coach Bear's 200th UCF win (March 28, 8-5 victory) and the 300th win of her overall head coaching career (March 29, 12-9 victory) as well.

The Black and Gold concluded their 2024 campaign at the 2024 NCAA Tallahassee Regional, where they earned their highest-ranked win of the season by the NCAA's RPI metric over the Auburn Tigers (No. 24). The victory marked the largest NCAA Tournament comeback win in program history, as the Knights rallied from a four-run deficit to claim an eventual 11-6 victory.

After leading the Knights to their first Super Regional appearance in program history in 2022, Coach Bear again made history with UCF softball in 2023, leading the team to its third consecutive 40-win season with its 40-21 finish, also marking the first time in program history that the Knights have won at least 40 games in three consecutive seasons. UCF opened the season ranked as high as 15th in the nation, and by season's end had won its second consecutive American Athletic Conference Tournament Championship with a 3-0 showing against Memphis, South Florida and Tulsa.

The automatic NCAA tournament bid clinched by the Knights' tournament title marked the 10th NCAA tournament appearance in program history and third straight dating back to 2021. UCF earned a spot in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional hosted by No. 3 Florida State, along with No. 20 South Carolina and Marist. The Knights opened NCAA Regional play with a 6-1 victory over the Gamecocks May 19, a victory that extended UCF's season-long win streak to 14 consecutive games dating back to the Knights' 13-1 win at Tulsa April 16. The Knights' 2023 season came to an end with losses to the Seminoles and Gamecocks May 20.

During the 2023 season, Coach Bear oversaw the development of RHP/OF Sarah Willis, a junior transfer from the Washington Huskies, who became the second Knight in program history to win American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year. The Knights also saw three selections to the NFCA's All-Region

First (Willis), Second (RHP Grace Jewell) and Third (INF/DP Aubrey Evans) Teams, as well as eight selections to The American's All-Conference First and Second Teams.

The Knights clinched the 800th win in program history during the 2023 season as well, a milestone that accompanied UCF's three-game sweep of the South Florida Bulls April 23. Coach Bear also recorded the 150th win of her UCF career with the Knights' 6-5 win over Mississippi State Feb. 19, and she notched the 250th win of her head coaching career four days later with UCF's 8-0 win over Gardner-Webb Feb. 23.

The UCF softball program took a massive leap in the 2022 season as the team posted an impressive 49-14 record. In what was the best season in program history, the year included the Black and Gold winning the conference's regular season and tournament titles as well as earning the right to host NCAA Regionals, being named the No. 16 national seed on Selection Sunday. Bear and her squad didn't stop there, as the Knights swept their way through the Orlando Regional, beating Villanova 6-0 on the strength of two Jada Cody home runs before topping No. 24 Michigan twice to advance to the program's first Super Regional.

The 2022 season began with a bang as UCF, which began the year receiving votes in the NFCA poll, earned a walk-off win over then-No. 12 Georgia on opening night with an eighth-inning solo shot from Shannon Doherty. Mid-February saw the Knights take part in the St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational, one of the top tournaments in the sport. UCF picked up a pair of wins against future Big 12 Conference foes, beating then-No. 11 Texas 15-10 and Texas Tech 7-3.

March saw UCF go 7-0 on its California swing, going unbeaten on a west coast trip for the first time in program history. The remainder of the regular season saw the Knights dominate American Athletic Conference play, eventually clinching the outright regular season championship on the final day of the season against Wichita State.

UCF earned a walk-off victory over Houston in the semifinals of The American Championship before run-ruling rival South Florida 11-0 to earn the conference tournament crown. It marked the first time since 2015 that the Knights had won both conference titles. The Black and Gold's magical season came to an end in Norman as UCF was swept in the Super Regional by the eventual national champion and top-seeded Oklahoma.

UCF finished in the top 16 in all four major polls at 2022's end. The Knights checked in at No. 14 in the final edition of the NFCA's rankings, their highest finish in the poll in program history. The Black and Gold finished in a tie for 15th in USA Softball's rankings while checking in at No. 13 in D1Softball's final poll and No. 14 in Softball America. The No. 14 finish in the NFCA poll was one spot shy of tying the program record, set back in week 15 of 2015. The same can be said about the Knights' USA Softball ranking, as UCF finished one spot behind its program-best ranking of No. 14 set in week 14 of 2015.

Bear helped guide more than one team to new heights in 2022, as she was named as an assistant coach for the USA National Team at the World Games and Canada Cup in the summer. The team won gold at the World Games.

Bear once again led the program to new heights in 2021, securing a career-best 41-19-1 record with the Knights and leading the Black and Gold into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2016. Bear led her Knights all the way to the AAC Championship game, and UCF's 41 wins represented its highest total since it had posted in a season since 2015.

The Black and Gold also recorded three wins over top five-ranked teams in the country, taking down then No. 5 Florida twice (March 24, 8-6 and April 14, 7-0) and No. 2 Arizona (March 8, 2-0). UCF played 14 games against a top-25 opponent in 2021, posting a 4-9-1 record in those games.

In year two in 2020, Ball-Malone brought the program to new heights. After leading UCF to a program-best 16-2 start in 2020, including an 11-game winning streak from 02/14-03/01, the Knights were tabbed as high as No. 22 in the ESPN/USA Softball and NFCA/USA Today Top 25 Polls. In the first release of the NCAA RPI, UCF checked in at No. 7 overall.

Coach Bear achieved her milestone 50th win at UCF on 03/01/20 in a 2-0 win over Longwood. In the 26 game, COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, UCF outscored opponents 156-64 and racked up a 9-4-1 record against Power6 teams and a 6-5-1 record against Top 25 teams or teams receiving votes.

She joined the Knights in 2019, going 34-21 (11-10), including picking up Power 6 wins over Ohio State, Pitt, Penn State and Boston College in her first season as head coach.

Ball-Malone joined the Knights following four successful seasons at Boise State University. In her last two campaigns, she compiled a 73-36 record and led the squad to the program's first postseason appearance at the 2017 National Invitational Softball Championship, followed by a 2018 NCAA Tournament berth

In 2018, the Broncos set program records for most wins in a season (40), most conference wins in a season (18), and the first conference title in program history, defeating New Mexico in the Mountain West championship.

Ball-Malone brought a plethora of coaching experience into her first stop as a Division I head coach, highlighted by a two-year stint on staff with the Washington Huskies. In those two seasons, she served as recruiting coordinator and was responsible for the development of the Husky pitching staff. The Huskies went 76-35 during Ball-Malone's two seasons in Seattle and reached a pair of NCAA Super Regionals while developing Kaitlin Inglesby into a second team All-American.

Under Ball-Malone's leadership, Inglesby held the lowest ERA on the 2012 team for the second straight year (2.31), while also leading the Huskies pitching staff in starts (30), wins (19), saves (5), complete games (21), shutouts (6), and strikeouts (169).

Ball-Malone has also spent time coaching at Cal State Northridge, Cosumnes River College, Modesto Junior College, and her alma mater, Pacific.

She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. Ball-Malone is considered the greatest two-way player in the history of Pacific Softball, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holding nine career pitching records for the Tigers.






