## CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES



Houston is in the Men's Final Four for the second time in five years. Four different Big 12 programs have reached the Final Four in the past six tournaments.



For the eighth time in nine NCAA Tournaments, the Big 12 had at least one team in a Regional Final and had multiple teams in the Elite 8 for the second time in three years.



Four teams in the Sweet 16 tied a Big 12 record, last accomplished in 2002. The Conference has sent multiple teams to the Sweet 16 for the fourth consecutive year and at least three teams to the second weekend for the first time since 2022.



All four Big 12 teams that reached the Sweet 16 finished with a top-four seed in the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship and advanced to the semifinals of the event. It marks the first time all four semifinalists would go on to reach the Sweet 16.



Six Conference teams advanced to the Round of 32 for the third time in five years and fourth time overall (2009, 2021, 2022, 2025), matching the Big 12 record. During that timespan, the Big 12 is a combined 28-7 in the First Round.



Seven Big 12 teams were selected to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. It marks the 11th consecutive tournament that the Big 12 has sent at least six to the Big Dance.



Houston holds streaks of 17 consecutive wins and six consecutive trips to the Sweet 16, both of which rank as the nation's longest active streak.



Six more teams were selected to the College Basketball Crown or the NIT, giving the Big 12 a total of 13 postseason teams.



During non-conference play, the Big 12 posted a 59-18 (.766) record against teams who made the field of 68.



Houston won the Big 12's automatic bid by virtue of their first Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship title, and representing the program's first postseason conference championship since 2022. Emanuel Sharp of Houston was the Most Outstanding Player.



Houston won the Big 12 regular season title outright. The Cougars are the first team in a century to join an existing major conference and win a regular season men's basketball title in its first two years in the league.



Houston was the first major conference team in history to win 22 games in the conference regular season and conference championship combined. Duke matched the number a few hours after Houston in the ACC title game.



Five Big 12 teams were ranked in the final regular season AP Top 25 Poll. No. 2 Houston, No. 9 Texas Tech, No. 15 Iowa State, No. 17 BYU and No. 21 Arizona comprise the Conference's ranked teams.

- Texas Tech's JT Toppin was named Big 12 Player and Newcomer of the Year to highlight the 2024-25 Phillips 66 All-Big 12 men's basketball awards, voted on by the league's head coaches.
- UH's Joseph Tugler (defensive player), LJ Cryer (Scholar-Athlete) and Kelvin Sampson (coach) earned league superlatives. BU's VJ Edgcombe (freshman), BYU's Richie Saunders (most improved) and ISU's Curtis Jones (sixth man) completed the Conference's superlatives.
