DECORATED DEBUT SEASON - Redshirt freshman **Isabella Vega** concluded her first collegiate regular season on a high note, producing a dominant weekend in the circle to help lead the Knights to a weekend road sweep of the Kansas Jayhawks...she began the weekend with her first career no-hitter, allowing only two KU baserunners, and in game two, earned her second win of the weekend with a pair of scoreless innings in relief...for her efforts, Vega earned her second career Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Week honor, her second career D1 Softball National Freshman of the Week honor, and her first career Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week award...she became the second Knight this season to earn two Big 12 Pitcher of the Week awards (**Kaitlyn Felton**), and the first since **Sarah Willis** in 2023 and the fourth in program history to earn Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week honors.

ALL-CONFERENCE KNIGHTS - For the second time in as many seasons as members of the Big 12 Conference, the UCF softball team sees five members tabbed to the league's post-season All-Conference teams...redshirt freshman **Isabella Vega** landed on the All-Big 12 First Team and was a unanimous add to the All-Freshman Team, junior **Aubrey Evans** and sophomore **Sierra Humphreys** were added to the All-Big 12 Second Team, and freshmen **Izzy Mertes** and **Beth Damon** joined Vega on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team...the honor marks the second all-conference team recognition in Evans' career, who was an All-AAC Second Team selection in 2023, and Humphreys, who was a unanimous pick for the 2024 All-Big 12 Freshman Team.

POSTSEASON PLAY - With the UCF softball team's series sweep of the Kansas Jayhawks, as well as the Iowa State Cyclones' series win over the Baylor Bears, in the final weekend of the regular season, the Knights earned the No. 7 seed in the Phillips 66 Big 12 Softball Championship and will square off against the 10th-seeded Utah Utes in Wednesday's first round...UCF and Utah did not meet during the 2025 regular season, and have only played each other once before, a 4-3 Knights win in Orlando March 11, 2016...with a win over Utah, the Black and Gold would advance to a Thursday second-round matchup with the No. 10 Arizona Wildcats, a team from which UCF took two of three in Tucson March 7-9...Arizona, then ranked No. 4, represented the highest-ranked series win in UCF softball's program history...a win over Utah would also mark the first win in the Big 12 Softball tournament in program history, after the Knights fell to Baylor, 3-2, in the second round last season.

RESUME BUILDING - In topping the third-ranked Florida Gators Wednesday, March 26, the Knights earned their third win of the season over a top-four ranked opponent, joining the squad's series win on the road over the then-No. 4 Arizona Wildcats March 7-8...UCF also earned the fifth of its now six top-25 ranked wins this season overall, joining its efforts against then-No. 15 Missouri Feb. 11, then-No. 21 Oklahoma State April 18, and then-No. 22 Florida Atlantic Feb. 26, in addition to its series win over the Wildcats...according to the NCAA's latest RPI update Tuesday, the Knights also boast five RPI top 25 wins, against Florida (No. 2), Arizona (No. 11), Clemson (No. 13), and Oklahoma State (No. 20)...Eleven of UCF's 29 wins thus far are over RPI top 50 teams as well, with the Knights' wins over Florida Atlantic (No. 30), Missouri (No. 32), Arizona State (No. 34), North Florida (No. 45) and BYU (No. 46)...UCF enters the Big 12 tournament slotted at No. 29 in the latest RPI rankings.

HOMETOWN HERO - Freshman designated player **Kendall Yarnell** came through with one of the bigger hits of UCF's season thus far, as well as the biggest hit of her young career Sunday against Kansas...playing in her home state, she hit a pinch-hit, three-run, go-ahead home run, the first of her career, in the seventh inning of the teams' series finale to help lift the Black and Gold to an 8-6 win and its first Big 12 sweep of the season...the timely homer marked the latest of Yarnell's impressive run as a reliable option off the bench, as her nine total pinch hits this season lead the Big 12 Conference...Yarnell has now hit safely in three of her last four games, going 3-for-5 with one home run, six total bases, three RBI and one run scored in that span.

COMEBACK KIDS - On the strength of its most prolific offensive display of the season, the UCF softball team authored the largest comeback win in program history in its final 2025 midweek game at Stetson April 23, erasing an 11-0 first-inning deficit in an eventual 14-13 victory in DeLand...the effort bested the program's previous comeback record of seven runs against LIU Feb. 16, 2018...UCF's 14 runs scored and 17 hits marked season highs...the Knights would later earn two more come-from-behind wins in the final two games of their series sweep at Kansas, and enter the Big 12 tournament having recorded eight come-from-behind wins when trailing in the fifth inning or later, or trailing by three runs or more.

HOME RUN DERBY IN DELAND - In overcoming the 11-run deficit against the Hatters, the Knights set a handful of single-game program records, including the most home runs in a game (8), most home runs in an inning (5), and hitting back-to-back-to-back home runs in an inning for the first time...the Knights saw six different players leave the yard in the comeback win with **Aubrey Evans**, **Sierra Humphreys**, **Samantha Rey** and **Ashleigh Griffin** each hitting one home run, while **Izzy Mertes** and **Kiley Strott** both recorded their first career two-homer games...Strott paced the squad with 10 total bases on the evening, hitting her first two career home runs, her first career double, and driving in two runs while also scoring three times...Griffin completed the comeback with a go-ahead three-run homer with two outs in the top of the seventh inning...Griffin's long ball marked UCF's eighth hit of the game with two outs, representing a single-game season-high as the Knights hit for a combined .533 average (8-for-15) with two outs during the comeback effort.

TOPPED THE COWGIRLS - On the strength of a nine-run bottom of the first inning, UCF earned its sixth ranked win of the season against then-No. 21 Oklahoma State April 18, besting the Cowgirls 12-6...the win represented the first for UCF against Oklahoma State under head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone**, as well as the program's first win over the Cowgirls in Orlando...Junior shortstop **Aubrey Evans**' first career grand slam, as well as the first six of nine total walks helped push UCF out to its highest-scoring inning since the 2020 Knights plated nine runs against then-No. 12 Tennessee Feb. 21, en route to a 10-1 run-rule victory in five innings...the Black and Gold's nine total walks represented their most in a single game since the 2022 Knights walked 10 times against then-No. 12 Georgia Feb. 10 and Longwood Feb. 12.

FELTON CLIMBING THE RANKS - Senior right-hander **Kaitlyn Felton** clinched the Knights' recent series win over the BYU Cougars with her eighth complete game and 10th win of the season April 11, and in the process became the ninth pitcher in program history to eclipse 300 career innings pitched, joining **Alea White** (969.1), **Mackenzie Audas** (823), **Allison Kime** (798.1), **Shelby Turnier** (742.1), **Ashleigh Cole** (702.2), **Lindsay Enders** (484), **Dottie Cupp** (432.1), and **Gianna Mancha** (398)...she also recorded her second straight season with at least 10 winning decisions, after she notched 11 victories during her junior 2024 campaign...she enters the Big 12 tournament ranking among program career leaders in saves (7, T-4th), appearances (93, 6th), K/7 IP (4.99, 9th), innings pitched (321.0, 9th), and strikeouts (229, 10th), and program single-season career leaders in saves (4, T-2nd)...she also ranks among Big 12 leaders in saves (4, T-2nd), complete games (9, T-4th), saves (3, T-6th), ERA (2.10, 7th), wins (13, 7th), WHIP (1.20, 8th) and walks per seven innings (2.03, 8th).

PROTECT THE PLEX - Following UCF's series win over the Houston Cougars April 25-27, the Knights clinched their fourth consecutive season with at least 20 wins at the UCF Softball Complex, as well as their fifth such season in the first six (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season) during the Ball-Malone era overall (since and including 2019)...after posting a 20-12 record at home in 2025, UCF has produced an aggregate 143-55-1 (.721) record at home spanning Ball-Malone's first seven years.

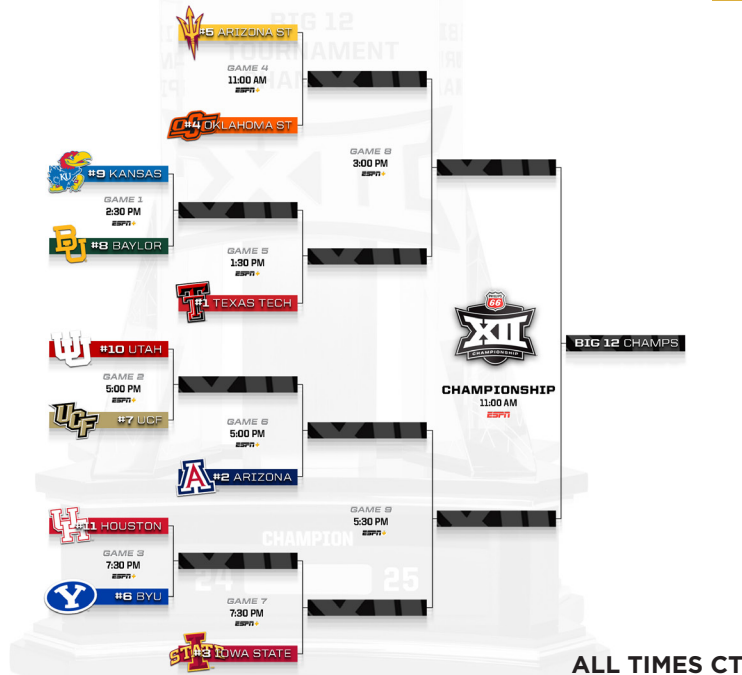
DAMON'S EARLY IMPACT - Freshman catcher **Beth Damon** has established herself as one of the Knights' key offensive contributors throughout her first collegiate campaign, recently hitting her eighth homer of the year in the Knights' 7-0 win at Kansas May 2...Damon has now hit the third-most home runs in a single season by a freshman in program history, trailing only **Jania Shinhoster** (12) and **Stephanie Best** (11) in 2002...she enters the Big 12 tournament trailing **Aubrey Evans**' team-leading nine by one.

GET ON BASE - Infielder **Sierra Humphreys** is enjoying a breakout sophomore campaign, hitting a team-best .371/.458/.530 (56-for-151) through the squad's 54 regular-season games...she recently produced a career-long 23-game on-base streak spanning Feb. 15-March 26, during which she hit .426/.500/.603 (29-for-68) dating back to UCF's 6-4, eight-inning win over Clemson in Clearwater Feb. 15, having hit safely in 19 of the 23 games during her streak...she also recorded 10 multi-hit games in that span, along with 18 runs scored, two doubles, two triples, two home runs, nine RBI, 10 walks and 41 total bases.

TOP-FOUR SERIES WIN - The UCF softball team made history in Tucson in its conference-opening series, taking two of its three games against the No. 4 Arizona Wildcats to earn the highest-ranked series win in program history...the Black and Gold notched their fourth ranked win of the season overall and second top-four win this spring, as well as the seventh all-time top four win in the program's history...UCF also owns four ranked wins in a single season for the first time since the 2022 Knights notched seven ranked victories en route to the first NCAA Super Regional berth in program history...the Knights boast multiple top-four victories in a single season for the first time since 2021 as well, when the team bested then-No. 2 Arizona 2-0 March 8 and then-No. 5 Florida 8-6 March 24, both in Orlando...UCF also earned a third top-four win that season against the then-No. 4 Gators in Gainesville, 7-0, April 14.

TWO-TIME BIG 12 PITCHER OF THE WEEK - Senior right-hander **Kaitlyn Felton** authored another chapter in her breakout final collegiate season against then-No. 4 Arizona March 7-9, earning her second Big 12 Pitcher of the Week award in the first five weeks this season...she became the first player this season to earn multiple conference weekly honors, and was also tabbed the No. 14 pitcher in the nation in D1Softball's March 12 pitcher power rankings...during the series at Arizona, Felton totaled five innings while allowing just one unearned run on three hits, limiting the Wildcats to a .150 batting-average against while also securing her third save and conference-leading ninth win of the campaign...Felton did it against an Arizona offense that entered the series leading the Big 12 in team batting average (.397), doubles (38), total hits (252), home runs (33), on-base percentage (.473), RBI (182), runs per game (8.87), slugging percentage (.638), total runs scored (204) and triples (8)...she also did not yield an earned run for a career-long 36 consecutive innings from UCF's 4-4 tie with Ohio State in Clearwater Feb. 16 through the fifth inning of the Knights' series-opener against Arizona State March 14.

HOW IT HAPPENED

2024 - 5 seed

UCF fell in its Big 12 Conference tournament opener to Baylor, 3-2, the first Big 12 Conference tournament game in program history. RHP Sarah Willis spun a six-inning complete game, yielding three runs on six hits with four strikeouts, and fifth-year DP Sona Halajian hit a sixth-inning two-run home run.

2023 - 2 seed

The Knights produced a 3-0 showing in the AAC Tournament in Tampa, including a come-from-behind 7-4 win over Memphis in the first round, a 2-0 victory over South Florida in the semifinals, and a 9-1 run-rule victory over Tulsa in the championship game. After trailing 4-1 through three innings against Memphis, UCF scored six unanswered runs, highlighted by a go-ahead two-run homer by Jasmine Williams and a two-run single by Aubrey Evans as part of a four-run sixth inning. Sarah Willis tossed a complete game shutout in the semis against South Florida, bolstered by a two-run home run by Chloe Evans in the bottom of the first inning. Kennedy Searcy, Aubrey Evans and Jasmine Williams all recorded two RBI in the championship game, including Williams' second two-run home run of the tournament.

2022 - 1 seed

UCF earned the top seed in the American Athletic Conference tournament for the third time in program history, and the first time since 2015 following the team's dominant 44-12 regular season. UCF drew a first-round matchup with the Houston Cougars, striking first courtesy of a Jada Cody RBI double in the third inning and a Cody RBI single in the fifth to take a 2-0 lead. Starter Gianna Mancha, who had spun five scoreless innings, was tagged for a 2-run homer in the top of the sixth inning that tied the game, but freshman pinch-hitter Savannah Adams came through in the bottom of the eighth with a walk-off two-run homer. UCF made quick work of its western rivals in the title game, scoring four runs in the first, three in the second and four more in the fourth to claim its 11-0 victory in five innings against the Bulls. Cody and Shannon Doherty both hit three-run homers, and the Knights also added runs on singles by Johnieisha Rowe, Ashleigh Griffin and Justine Molina, as well as a Bulls error. Kama Woodall threw a five-inning shutout with four strikeouts in the circle.

2021 - 3 seed

UCF used a three-run fourth inning to go up 4-2 on ECU in the quarterfinals. With the score 4-3 in the top of the seventh, the Pirates loaded the bases with one out. Gianna Mancha came out of the bullpen and got the next two batters to go down swinging, sending the Knights to face their War on I-4 rivals of South Florida. The Black and Gold plated two in the first inning before seeing the ballgame tied at the end of the third 2-2. Karissa Ornelas smashed a homer on a 2-0 pitch to put UCF up 3-2 in the fourth, which went on to prove as the game-winner. In the AAC championship game, UCF led 3-0 in the top of the third and was making a push for its first conference title since 2015. Wichita State put up two in the bottom of the third and five in the fifth, handing the Knights a 7-4 loss.

2020

No championship held due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

2019 - 5 seed

UCF and Wichita State were locked up at 1-1 until the bottom of the sixth, when a Neleigh Herring homer put the Shockers on top and sent them on to the next round with a 2-1 final score. It was the third straight season that UCF had been one-and-done in AAC Tournament play, but it was the first season under then-new head coach Cindy Ball-Malone.

2018 - 4 seed

The Knights were upset by Memphis in their first contest of the competition. Memphis went on to lose the following round by a single run to top-seeded South Florida.

2017 - 3 seed

UCF was a first-round exit against the host ECU Pirates, the six seed in the tournament. The Pirates utilized back-to-back homers in the sixth inning to win the game.

2016 - 2 seed

The Knights were able to slide past UConn by a one-run margin before falling to Tulsa. UCF beat Tulsa in the championship game in 2015 and saw the Golden Hurricane get revenge and go on to win one of their three American titles that year.

2015 - 1 seed

The top-seeded Knights earned a bye through the first round on their home field and matched up with South Florida in the semifinals. The Knights were the away team, but paid no mind, plating two runs in the top of the seventh to secure the victory. UCF legend Shelby Turnier held Tulsa to one hit in the championship game, but the offense couldn't back her up with any run support, bringing a 0-0 game into the seventh. Samantha McCloskey won UCF the title with one swing of the bat, walking it off on a solo shot. McCloskey went 3-for-3 that day, accounting for half of UCF's hits.

2014 - 1 seed

UCF was the inaugural regular-season champs of The American, finishing first in the first season of the American Athletic Conference's existence. The Knights posted a 15-3 record in conference and won the regular season by two games over South Florida. In the quarterfinals, the Black and Gold homered five times, setting a new school record, in a 6-0 rout of UConn. Rutgers struck first in the semifinal, scoring twice in the first inning. UCF answered with a five-run second inning.

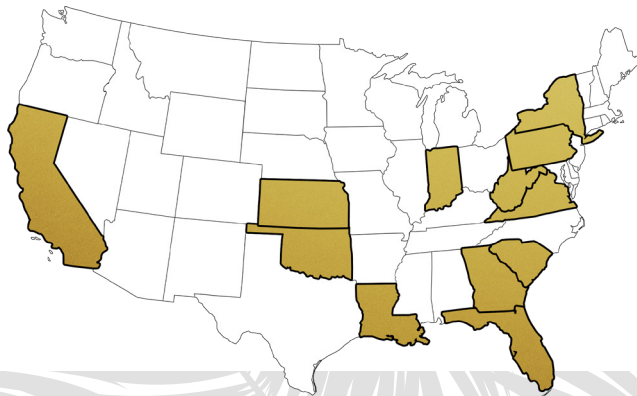

CINDY BALL-MALONE

Head Coach / Seventh Season

On the heels of a hall-of-fame collegiate playing career, UCF head softball coach Cindy Ball-Malone, also known by her nickname, “Bear,” has lifted the UCF softball program to new heights throughout her first six seasons at the helm since she was named the second head coach in program history June 27, 2018.

Ball-Malone’s resume showcases:

- ♦ Ten career seasons as an NCAA Division I head softball coach (the last six at UCF), including six postseason appearances, five NCAA Tournament berths, and one NCAA super regional appearance

♦ Extensive player development, highlighted by one All-America selection, one National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selection, two national Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week selections, one American Athletic Conference AAC Pitcher of the Year selection, one AAC Rookie of the Year selection, and three consecutive top 25 nationally-ranked recruiting classes (Extra Inning Softball, 2021-23)

♦ Four additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Washington and Cal State Northridge, including two NCAA super regional appearances with the Huskies

♦ A playing career at the University of the Pacific that landed Ball-Malone among the selections for the 13th West Coast Conference Hall of Honor Class in 2023

Under “Coach Bear,” the UCF softball team is in the midst of the most successful period in the program’s 23-year history. With the team’s 31-25 record in 2024, the Knights again made history, earning an NCAA Tournament berth in four consecutive seasons for the first time in program history.

The Knights’ current postseason run also encompasses three consecutive 40-plus-win seasons (2021-23), four NCAA Regional appearances, one of which was hosted by the Knights at the UCF Softball Complex (2022), and the first NCAA super regional appearance in program history.

Ball-Malone most recently led the Knights to their sixth consecutive non-COVID-19-shortened 30-plus-win season in 2024, also marking the team’s inaugural campaign in the Big 12 Conference.

The Knights saw five players earn selections to the Big 12’s post-season All-Conference teams, as well as a pair who saw their names added to the NFCA’s All-Region squads. Right-handed pitcher/outfielder Sarah Willis wrapped up her two-year Knights tenure as an All-Big 12 First Team honoree, as well as an NFCA All-Midwest Region Second Team selection.

First baseman Shannon Doherty and right fielder Chloe Evans earned All-Big 12 Second Team honors, while freshman infielder/outfielders Sierra Humphreys and Samantha Rey both garnered unanimous All-Big 12 Freshman Team appointments.

Fifth-year utility player Jada Cody concluded her storied career with the Black and Gold as an NFCA All-Midwest Region First Team selection as well, rounding out UCF’s post-season awards. Willis and redshirt-sophomore catcher/designated player Ashleigh Griffin became the first two Knights in program history to earn Big 12 Player of the Week honors as well.

UCF collected five series wins in its first season in its new conference, toppling the Kansas Jayhawks, Texas Tech Red Raiders, BYU Cougars, and Iowa State Cyclones while consistently playing close matchups against many of the top-ranked programs in the nation.

The Knights earned the first Big 12 Conference series win in program history against Kansas March 8-10, the first road Big 12 Conference series win at Texas Tech March 28-30, and the first Big 12 Conference series sweep against BYU April 4-6.

UCF’s series win at Texas Tech featured Coach Bear’s 200th UCF win (March 28, 8-5 victory) and the 300th win of her overall head coaching career (March 29, 12-9 victory) as well.

The Black and Gold concluded their 2024 campaign at the 2024 NCAA Tallahassee Regional, where they earned their highest-ranked win of the season by the NCAA’s RPI metric over the Auburn Tigers (No. 24). The victory marked the largest NCAA Tournament comeback win in program history, as the Knights rallied from a four-run deficit to claim an eventual 11-6 victory.

After leading the Knights to their first Super Regional appearance in program history in 2022, Coach Bear again made history with UCF softball in 2023, leading the team to its third consecutive 40-win season with its 40-21 finish, also marking the first time in program history that the Knights have won at least 40 games in three consecutive seasons. UCF opened the season ranked as high as 15th in the nation, and by season’s end had won its second consecutive American Athletic Conference Tournament Championship with a 3-0 showing against Memphis, South Florida and Tulsa.

The automatic NCAA tournament bid clinched by the Knights’ tournament title marked the 10th NCAA tournament appearance in program history and third straight dating back to 2021. UCF earned a spot in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional hosted by No. 3 Florida State, along with No. 20 South Carolina and Marist. The Knights opened NCAA Regional play with a 6-1 victory over the Gamecocks May 19, a victory that extended UCF’s season-long win streak to 14 consecutive games dating back to the Knights’ 13-1 win at Tulsa April 16. The Knights’ 2023 season came to an end with losses to the Seminoles and Gamecocks May 20.

During the 2023 season, Coach Bear oversaw the development of RHP/OF Sarah Willis, a junior transfer from the Washington Huskies, who became the second Knight in program history to win American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year. The Knights also saw three selections to the NFCA’s All-Region

First (Willis), Second (RHP Grace Jewell) and Third (INF/DP Aubrey Evans) Teams, as well as eight selections to The American's All-Conference First and Second Teams.

The Knights clinched the 800th win in program history during the 2023 season as well, a milestone that accompanied UCF's three-game sweep of the South Florida Bulls April 23. Coach Bear also recorded the 150th win of her UCF career with the Knights' 6-5 win over Mississippi State Feb. 19, and she notched the 250th win of her head coaching career four days later with UCF's 8-0 win over Gardner-Webb Feb. 23.

The UCF softball program took a massive leap in the 2022 season as the team posted an impressive 49-14 record. In what was the best season in program history, the year included the Black and Gold winning the conference's regular season and tournament titles as well as earning the right to host NCAA Regionals, being named the No. 16 national seed on Selection Sunday. Bear and her squad didn't stop there, as the Knights swept their way through the Orlando Regional, beating Villanova 6-0 on the strength of two Jada Cody home runs before topping No. 24 Michigan twice to advance to the program's first Super Regional.

The 2022 season began with a bang as UCF, which began the year receiving votes in the NFCA poll, earned a walk-off win over then-No. 12 Georgia on opening night with an eighth-inning solo shot from Shannon Doherty. Mid-February saw the Knights take part in the St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational, one of the top tournaments in the sport. UCF picked up a pair of wins against future Big 12 Conference foes, beating then-No. 11 Texas 15-10 and Texas Tech 7-3.

March saw UCF go 7-0 on its California swing, going unbeaten on a west coast trip for the first time in program history. The remainder of the regular season saw the Knights dominate American Athletic Conference play, eventually clinching the outright regular season championship on the final day of the season against Wichita State.

UCF earned a walk-off victory over Houston in the semifinals of The American Championship before run-ruling rival South Florida 11-0 to earn the conference tournament crown. It marked the first time since 2015 that the Knights had won both conference titles. The Black and Gold's magical season came to an end in Norman as UCF was swept in the Super Regional by the eventual national champion and top-seeded Oklahoma.

UCF finished in the top 16 in all four major polls at 2022's end. The Knights checked in at No. 14 in the final edition of the NFCA's rankings, their highest finish in the poll in program history. The Black and Gold finished in a tie for 15th in USA Softball's rankings while checking in at No. 13 in D1Softball's final poll and No. 14 in Softball America. The No. 14 finish in the NFCA poll was one spot shy of tying the program record, set back in week 15 of 2015. The same can be said about the Knights' USA Softball ranking, as UCF finished one spot behind its program-best ranking of No. 14 set in week 14 of 2015.

Bear helped guide more than one team to new heights in 2022, as she was named as an assistant coach for the USA National Team at the World Games and Canada Cup in the summer. The team won gold at the World Games.

Bear once again led the program to new heights in 2021, securing a career-best 41-19-1 record with the Knights and leading the Black and Gold into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2016. Bear led her Knights all the way to the AAC Championship game, and UCF's 41 wins represented its highest total since it had posted in a season since 2015.

The Black and Gold also recorded three wins over top five-ranked teams in the country, taking down then No. 5 Florida twice (March 24, 8-6 and April 14, 7-0) and No. 2 Arizona (March 8, 2-0). UCF played 14 games against a top-25 opponent in 2021, posting a 4-9-1 record in those games.

In year two in 2020, Ball-Malone brought the program to new heights. After leading UCF to a program-best 16-2 start in 2020, including an 11-game winning streak from 02/14-03/01, the Knights were tabbed as high as No. 22 in the ESPN/USA Softball and NFCA/USA Today Top 25 Polls. In the first release of the NCAA RPI, UCF checked in at No. 7 overall.

Coach Bear achieved her milestone 50th win at UCF on 03/01/20 in a 2-0 win over Longwood. In the 26 game, COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, UCF outscored opponents 156-64 and racked up a 9-4-1 record against Power6 teams and a 6-5-1 record against Top 25 teams or teams receiving votes.

She joined the Knights in 2019, going 34-21 (11-10), including picking up Power 6 wins over Ohio State, Pitt, Penn State and Boston College in her first season as head coach.

Ball-Malone joined the Knights following four successful seasons at Boise State University. In her last two campaigns, she compiled a 73-36 record and led the squad to the program's first postseason appearance at the 2017 National Invitational Softball Championship, followed by a 2018 NCAA Tournament berth.

In 2018, the Broncos set program records for most wins in a season (40), most conference wins in a season (18), and the first conference title in program history, defeating New Mexico in the Mountain West championship.

Ball-Malone brought a plethora of coaching experience into her first stop as a Division I head coach, highlighted by a two-year stint on staff with the Washington Huskies. In those two seasons, she served as recruiting coordinator and was responsible for the development of the Husky pitching staff. The Huskies went 76-35 during Ball-Malone's two seasons in Seattle and reached a pair of NCAA Super Regionals while developing Kaitlin Inglesby into a second team All-American.

Under Ball-Malone's leadership, Inglesby held the lowest ERA on the 2012 team for the second straight year (2.31), while also leading the Huskies pitching staff in starts (30), wins (19), saves (5), complete games (21), shut-outs (6), and strikeouts (169).

Ball-Malone has also spent time coaching at Cal State Northridge, Cosumnes River College, Modesto Junior College, and her alma mater, Pacific.

She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. Ball-Malone is considered the greatest two-way player in the history of Pacific Softball, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holding nine career pitching records for the Tigers.

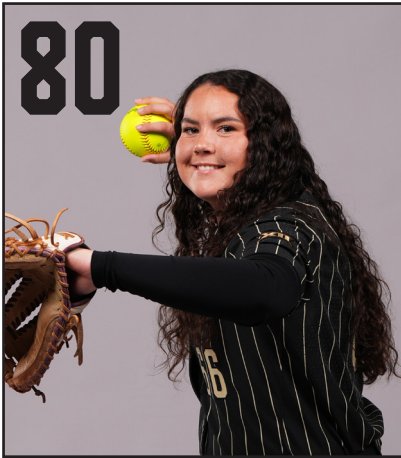
