## KNIGHT NOTES

- ◆ The Knights will enter Sunday's home match against LSU off to a 3-0-0 start to the 2025 campaign. The 3-0 record marks the Black and Gold's best start since 2003.
- → UCF opened the season with a 2-1 victory on the road at UAB last Thursday and followed it up with back-to-back late-night home victories over in-state foes Florida Atlantic (3-1) and South Florida (4-1).
- ◆ UCF has outscored the opposition 9-3 on the young season and senior forwards Liz Worden and Rajanah Reed are tied for the team lead in goals with two apiece. With two assists on Thursday against USF, Worden now fronts the team in assists with three. She also it tops on the squad in points (7), shots (12) and shots on goal (9).
- ♦ With a win on Sunday against LSU, the Black and Gold would be off to 4-0-0 start to a season for the first time since 2002.

#### O CAPTAIN, OUR CAPTAIN

- ◆ Redshirt junior midfielder Maria Tregansin has been named UCF's team captain for the 2025 campaign.
- + Tregansin is in her fifth year with the program and had a solid season a year ago in which she played in 13 matches and started four of them.
- ◆ She notched a career-high three assists in 2024 with two coming against Arizona and one against Cincinnati.
- ◆ Maria was named to the 2024 Fall Academic All-Big 12 Team and is a true team leader for the Knights both on the field as well as behind the scenes.

#### **12 NEWCOMERS**

- ◆ UCF welcomes in a total of 12 newcomers to the 2025 roster.
- ◆ Of the 12 newcomers, eight are transfers and four are freshmen.
- ◆ Of the transfers, five are seniors in Hannah Boughton (M, Baylor), Haylee Merserau (D, Pitt), Payton Patrick (F, Charlotte), Rajanah Reed (F, Washington State) and Liz Worden (F, Long Beach State); one is a junior in Brianne MacDonald (GK, Dalhousie Univ.); one is a sophomore in Ainsley Moy (M, TCU); and one is a redshirt freshman in Camryn Szotak (D, South Carolina).
- → The freshmen include Kalena Bellini (F/D, Lehi, Utah), Tyra Eriksen (F/D, Umea, Sweden), Natalie Leon (D, San Clemente, Calif.), and Sophia May (M, Chula Vista, Calif.).

#### RETURNING CORE

- → The Knights welcome back six returning starters from the 2024 squad and a total of 13 returning letterwinners. Of the starting group, redshirt sophomore keeper Genesis Perez Watson is back along with defenders Kayla Chatman-Haggerty (5th Yr.), Guta Franke (So.), and Jada Silvest (So.), midfielder Honoka Hamano (Jr.), and forward Edidiong Etim (So.).
- ◆ Fellow other returning letterwinners include keeper Sami Lipcon (So.), defenders Audrey Buck (RJr.), Jessica McCullen (Jr.) and Brooke Mulroney (RJr.), midfielders Katsi Bengoa (So.), Ella Holloran (So.) and Maria Tregansin (RJr.)

#### **NEW FRONT LINE**

- ◆ With first team all-conference and second team all-region 2024 performer Chloe Netzel having graduated, UCF will look to find a new core of goal scorers
- ◆ Behind's Netzel's 11 goals from a season ago (nearly 50% of the team's goals), UCF returns forward Edidiong Etim and midfielder Honoka Hamano, who each scored a pair of goals for the Black and Gold a season ago. Ella Holloran (forward), Brooke Mulroney (defender), Jessica McCullen (defender) and Guta Franke (defender) also all return after netting a goal apiece in 2024.
- ◆ Of the newcomers this year, big things are expected from senior forwards Rajanah Reed (Washington State), Liz Worden (Long Beach State) and Payton Patrick (Charlotte), as well as senior midfielder Hannah Boughton (Baylor) and sophomore midfielder Ainsley Moy (TCU). Of the new group, three of the five have previously played in the Big 12, as Worden previously played at Texas. and Boughton Baylor and Moy TCU. Big things are also expected from redshirt freshman midfielder Gabi Berchon and freshman forward/defender Kalena Bellini.

#### THE ROBERTS SAHAYDAK ERA

- ◆ The Knights have experienced tremendous success under Roberts Sahaydak, as the program has made the NCAA Tournament five times during her tenure here in Orlando as well as won four conference championships.
- ◆ Under Roberts Sahaydak's leadership, UCF has made the NCAA Tournament in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2017, and 2022.
- → The Knights also won conference titles in 2013, 2014, 2017, and 2022. Roberts Sahaydak has recorded a winning season in 10 of her 12 years here in Orlando and will enter the season with a 121-61-32 record at UCF as well as a 174-111-51 career record over 18 years.

#### YEAR THREE IN THE BIG 12

- → The University of Central Florida officially joined the Big 12 Conference on July 1, 2023, and will enter its third season of competition in the league in 2025-26.
- ◆ UCF entered the Power 4 as the youngest school, having been founded in 1963 to supply NASA with engineers.
- ◆ The Knights, who finished sixth in its first season of Big 12 competition in 2023 with a 5-4-1 clip and 13th in 2024 with a 1-5-4 record, are 36-23-9 against current Big 12 teams all-time.

#### TO BE THE BEST. YOU'VE GOT TO PLAY THE BEST

- ◆ Head coach Tiffany Roberts Sahaydak has stressed the importance of playing
- a tough schedule and the Knights 2025 slate is no different.

  UCF will face a pair of SEC foes in non-conference play in LSU and Florida, and a total of six teams that made the NCAA Tournament a season ago in LSU, FIU, West Virginia, Oklahoma State, BYU and Texas Tech.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

◆ Sunday's match against LSU will mark the fifth all-time contest between the two. In four previous meetings, UCF holds a 1-1-2 record. The Black and Gold's victory in the series came on Oct. 15, 2017 when the No. 8 Knights defeated the Tigers 4-0 in Baton Rouge. LSU returned the favor with a 2-0 win in the lone meeting in Orlando (Aug. 29, 2021).

#### **KNIGHT KICKS**

#### ABOUT UCF

- The Black and Gold will enter Sunday's contest with an unblemished 3-0-0 record on the season. The 3-0 start matches UCF's best start since 2003. After opening the year with a 2-1 road victory at UAB last Thursday, the Knights followed things up with back-to-back home victories over in-state foes Florida Atlantic (3-1) and South Florida (4-1).
- In Thursday's most recent outing against the Bulls, four different Knights found the back of the net en route to leading UCF to the victory.
- Following a two-hour and 28-minute lightning delay, the Black and Gold opened the scoring in the 23rd minute when Tyra Eriksen raced a ball down the left side and crossed a pass to Ella Holloran in the box for the goal to make it 1-0.
- With USF having tied the match in the 45th minute, the Knights immediately answered, as Liz Worden passed a through ball ahead to Edidiong Etim and Etim drilled one home from the top of the box with seven seconds remaining in the half to give the Black and Gold a 2-1 advantage.
- Ainsley Moy helped UCF extend its lead to 3-1 in the 48th minute when Kalena Bellini found Worden on a throw-in and Worden one-timed a pass to Moy and the sophomore transfer rocketed a shot into the back of the net. The Knights then capped the scoring in the 72nd minute, as Rajanah Reed found the back of the net after following her own rebounded shot.
- As a team, UCF outshot USF 12 to eight on the evening as well as six to five with shots on frame. Holloran, Moy and Reed led the way with two shots apiece, while Worden recorded a pair of assists to match a career high.
- Genesis Perez Watson recorded a season-high four saves on her way to moving to 3-0-0 in goal on the year.
- Senior forwards Worden and Reed are tied atop the team in goals scored with two goals apiece. After recording a pair of assists on Thursday, Worden also fronts the team in assists with three. She is also tops on the team in points (7), shots (11) and shots on goal (9). Sophomore keeper Perez Watson leads in saves with seven and holds a 3-0-0 record in goal.

#### **ABOUT LSU**

- The Tigers will come to Orlando on the heels of a 6-1 victory at FGCU in Fort Meyers on Thursday night. LSU holds a 2-1-0 record on the young season with wins over Florida Gulf Coast and South Alabama, as well as 1-0 setback at No. 10 Wake Forest last Sunday. The Tigers posted a 9-9-3 record a season ago and an 11th-place finish in the SEC with a 3-5-2 conference mark en route to qualifying for their fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament. LSU was picked to finish 11th in the SEC this season.
- LSU had seven players named to the 2025 SEC Preseason Watchlist in Sydney Cheesman, Jazmin Ferguson, Makenna Dominguez, Ava Galligan, Ida Hermannsdottir, Gabbi Ceballos and Amy Smith. Galligan, who was tabbed to the 2023 All-SEC Second Team, leads the way this season with a trio of goals and six points. Jazmin Feguson fronts the squad in assists with two, while Sophine Kevokian leads in goal with six saves.
- The Tigers are coached by Sian Hudson. Hudson is in her sixth season in Baton Rouge and holds a 48-38-18 record at LSU.

#### BACK-TO-BACK MATCHES AGAINST SEC FOES

- After opening the season with a trio of matches against American Conference opponents in which the Knights went a perfect 3-0 with wins over UAB (2-1), Florida Atlantic (3-1) and South Florida (4-1), UCF will now start a stretch in which it will play back-to-back matches against SEC foes.
- The Knights will first welcome LSU to the UCF Soccer Complex on Sunday, before heading to Gainesville to face the Florida Gators at Dizney Stadium for the second consecutive year. UCF and Florida played to a 2-2 draw a season ago in Gainesville behind a brace from former Knight Chloe Netzel.
- All-time, UCF has previously faced LSU and Florida a combined 30 times.

#### **BIG 12 CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLI**

- The Knights have been picked to finish 12th out of 16 teams in the Big 12 Conference's annual preseason poll that was annouced prior to the season.
- UCF went 3-6-6 overall and tied for 13th a season ago with a 1-5-4 league clip. The Black and Gold were picked to finished ahead of Cincinnati (13th), Iowa State (14th), Houston (15th) and Kansas State (16th).
- The defending Big 12 champion TCU Horned Frogs were picked to win the conference this year, while Texas Tech was picked second, BYU third, West Virginia fourth, Kansas fifth, Colorado sixth, Oklahoma State seventh, Arizona eighth, Utah ninth, Baylor 10th and Arizona State 11th.

#### FORMER KNIGHTS LINDER & ADAMEK TAKE PART AT 2025 UEFA WOMEN'S EUROS

- A pair of former UCF Knights took part at the 2025 UEFA Women's European Championship in Sarai Linder and Kayla Adamek. Linder, who helped Germany win bronze at the 2024 Paris Olympics, competed for her home nation of Germany, while Adamek took part for Poland. The 2025 Women's Euros were held in Switzerland.
- The two met up in the first round of the tournament and Linder and Germany went on to take the contest by a score of 2-0. Linder helped her German squad make a deep run at the event, as they advanced to the semifinal round before having their run come to a close with a hard fought 1-0 setback to Spain.

#### GUTA FRANKE & GENESIS PEREZ WATSON COMPETED AT FIFA U20 WOMEN'S WORLD CUP

- UCF had a pair of players represent their home nations at the 2024 FIFA U20 Women's World Cup that ran Aug. 31-Sept. 22 in Colombia.
- Now sophomore defender Guta Franke played for her home country of Brazil, while now redshirt sophomore goalkeeper Genesis Perez Watson participated for Costa Rica.
- Franke started all five games for Brazil and helped her home nation go 4-1 and advance to the quarterfinal round, while Perez Watson started all three matches in goal and was a captain for Costa Rica.

## Head Coach - 13th Season

An Olympic gold medalist, World Cup champion and two-time NCAA champion, Tiffany Roberts Sahaydak was named head women's soccer coach at UCF in May 2013.

A four-time American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, Roberts Sahaydak has wasted on time in putting her stamp on UCF's successful program. Under her guidance, the Knights have earned five NCAA Tournament bids and four American Athletic Conference championships while boasting 18 Conference Player of the Year awards and 67 all-league and tournament selections.

An integral member of the 1999 United States World Cup winning squad, Roberts Sahaydak returned to the fold as an assistant coach under Vlatko Andonovski in 2022. At the 2023 FIFA World Cup in Australia and New Zealand, Roberts Sahaydak became the first champion as a player to transition into a coaching role with the team, propelling the USWNT to knockout round qualification for the ninth consecutive edition.

Ushering in a new era in the Big 12, the Knights' inaugural campaign as a member of one of the nation's premier conferences was historic, resulting in a trip to the Big 12 Championships semifinals. Under the guidance of Roberts Sahaydak, UCF secured a 10-7-1 (5-4-1 Big 12) record and the second-most wins of any conference newcomer. In Austin, Texas, the Knights defeated the 2022 conference runner-ups, TCU, 3-2 to garner UCF Athletics its first postseason win in the Big 12. In the program's inaugural conference home match at the UCF soccer Complex, the Knights defeated reigning champions, West Virginia, 4-2. Following the squad's sixth-place finish in conference play, Dayana Martin earned second-team honors on the Big 12 All-Conference team, while Jessica McCullen secured a spot on the all-freshman team. Martin would also be named to the United Soccer Coaches All-Midwest Region Third Team following yet another dominating 13-point season leading the Knights attack. For the second consecutive season, Roberts Sahaydak and her staff produced an NWSL draft pick as Talia Garbarra was selected by the Orlando Pride with the 14th pick in the fourth round.

In their final season in the AAC, the Knights boasted a 9-2-7 (7-0-1 AAC) record, going undefeated in conference play and picking up nine clean sheets along the way to becoming AAC Regular Season Champions. With the first victory of the season, Roberts Sahaydak earned her 100th win at UCF as a head coach. The Black and Gold collected a bid to the NCAA Tournament and advanced past NC State in the first round to face eventual national champion UCLA, where they fell in penalty kicks. Kristen Scott picked up Offensive Player of the Year honors, while Caroline DeLisle earned her second-straight Goalkeeper of the Year award. DeLisle and Scott were joined by Dayana Martin and Darya Rajaee on the All-Conference First Team, with Georgia Eaton-Collins being named to the All-Conference Scoond Team and Mia Asenjo earning unanimous selection to the All-Rookie Team. Scott would later be drafted by the Orlando Pride with the 41st overall pick in the 2023 NWSL draft.

In 2021, Roberts Sahaydak coached the Knights to an 8-7-1 (3-4-1 American Athletic Conference) and entered the American Athletic Conference Championship tournament as a six seed. With the Knights sixth victory of the season, Roberts Sahaydak earned her 150th career win as a collegiate head coach. Under Roberts Sahaydak, Caroline DeLisle and Darya Rajaee earned their first selections to the All-Conference First Team. In total, four Knights earned conference awards with Caroline DeLisle also earning Goalkeeper of the Year and Darya Rajaee also earning Midfielder of the Year while Ariel Young earned All-Rookie Team honors and Kristen Scott earned All-Conference First Team.

In an unconventional 2020-21 campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Roberts Sahaydak led the Black & Gold to picking up five all-league selections as the Knights finished the spring season with a 2-4-1 mark. Four Knights picked up honors, with Sarai Linder representing the Knights on the First Team All-Conference and All-Rookie Teams, Ellie Moreno and Madsion Murnin were named to the Second Team All-Conference, and Katie Bradley joined Linder on the All-Rookie Team.

In 2019, Roberts Sahaydak led the Knights to a 11-4-4 (5-2-2 American Athletic Conference) and earned a No. 3 seed to the American Championship. The Knights posted a six-game unbeaten streak and climed to as high No. 21 in the United Soccer Coaches Polls. Under Roberts Sahaydak, Konya Plummer was named First Team All-Region by the United Soccer Coaches Association, as well as the AAC Defensive Player of the Year. In total, six student-athletes were recognized by the Conference coaches with Plummer also earning First Team All-Conference, while Senior Zandy Soree and sophomore Kristen Scott earned Second Team All-Conference honors. Caroline DeLisle, Ally Gudorf, and Ellie Moreno picked up All-Rookie accolades.

The Knights finished the 2018 campaign at 10-7-1 (6-3 American Athletic Conference) and entered the American Athletic Conference Championship tournament as a the third seed. Under Roberts Sahaydak, three Knights earned All-Southeast Region honors - Stefanie Sanders earned second team all-region, while Vera Varis and Carrie Lawrence collected third team all-region recognition. Vera Veris was named Goalkeeper of the Year and named to First Team All-Conference. Stefanie Sanders joined Veris with First Team All-Conference accolades and Kristen Scott was named to the All-Rookje team. All-Rookie team.

In 2017, Roberts Sahaydak coached the Knights to a 13-2-3 record, the most wins since the 2014 campaign. UCF climbed as climbed as high as No. 6 and finished the regular season ranked eighth. The Knights posted a 16-match unbeaten streak, the longest since the 2013 campaign, captured the American Athletic Conference regular season championship and made their 21st NCAA Tournament appearance.

Under Roberts Sahaydak's tutelage, five members of the team received All-Southeast Region recognition and goalkeeper Vera Varis was named to the United Soccer Coaches Association All-American Third Team. In addi-

tion, five of her starters were recognized as American AAC Players of the Year, including Morgan Ferrara (Offensive), Kathellen Sousa (Co-Defensive), Vera Varis (Goalkeeper), Kayla Adamek (Midfielder), and Dina Orschmann (Rookie). A total of seven Knights were placed on the All-American Athletic Conference Teams, and three were recognized on the all-tournament team.

In 2016, four student-athletes were named to the All-American Athletic Conference Teams. Saga Fredriksson was named to the All-Northeast Region Team and recognized as the American Athletic Conference Co-Defensive Player of the Year. Off the field, the Knights earned recognition for their academic success as they received the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Team Academic Award.

Roberts Sahaydak tackled the 2015 season with team that featured more newcomers (14) than returners (12) and lost three key members due to injury for the year before the season-opening weekend was in the books. Eight of their starters, including their American Athletic Conference Offensive Player, Defensive Player and Goalkeeper of the Year, had moved on from the year before. But the Knights earned a berth to their ninth-stright NCAA Tournament (20th overall) and nabbed a hosting gig for the first round for the fifth straight season. In addition, Carol Rodrigues was named the American's Co-Offensive Player of the Year.

In 2014, she guided the Knights to their second NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in four years and the American regular season title. Under her direction, three Knights were recognized as conference Players of the Year: Tatiana Coleman (Co-Offensive); Carleigh Wiliams (Defensive); and Connie Organ (Goalkeeper). UCF posted its first undefeated home slate (11-0) since 1999, matched the school record for wins in a season (18) and was nationally ranked through much of the year.

In her first season (2013), she led UCF to a school-record unbeaten streak (18 matches), an NSCAA national standing through much of the year and the program's first undefeated conference season since 1999. In addition, UCF made history, as the first program to win an American Athletic Conference Championship. Roberts Sahaydak came to Orlando after serving six seasons at VCU alongside her co-head coach, husband and current UCF associate head coach Tim Sahaydak.

Roberts Sahaydak spent a decade with the U.S. National Team from 1994-2004, earning 110 caps (with 60 starts). Her career was highlighted by three women's World Cups - among them, the unforgettable 1999 championship - and a gold medal with the 1996 Olympic team.

After retiring from the USWNT, she has served as an ambassador for U.S. Soccer with the U.S. Department of State Sports Envoy Program since 2007, promoting the power and benefit of sport internationally. With the program, she has visited Indonesia, Uganda, the Philippines, Thailand, Namibia, Brazil and France. In 2014, she was appointed to President Barack Obama's Presidential Delegation to the Federative Republic of Brazil at the opening of the FIFA World Cup in Brazil.

She is a native of San Ramon, Calif., and was selected as the 1994 California High School Player of the Year. She was a three-time Parade High School All-American, a three-time NSCAA All-American and was the two-time National Girl's High School Player of the Year. She debuted for the Stars and Stripes in 1994 when she was only 16 as one of the youngest players ever to suit up for the National Team. She played in her first FIFA Women's World Cup a month after her 18th birthday and won Olympic gold before she was out of her teens (USSoccer.com).

As a collegian, Roberts Sahaydak was a standout midfielder for North Carolina (1995-98) as a three-time All-ACC First Team selection. She led the Tar Heels to two NCAA titles (1996, 1997) during her tenure, was voted the 1998 ACC Tournament MVP and finished third in voting for collegiate soccer's highest honor, the Hermann Trophy. She still ranks among the top five for career starts in UNC's record book.

She was a two-time captain for the Carolina Courage in the first fully professional U.S. women's league (Women's United Soccer Association). She helped the Courage win the 2002 title after finishing last in the team's inaugural campaign one year prior.

Roberts Sahaydak took over VCU's program in 2007 and led the Rams to three conference championship game appearances. She was voted as the 2011 Colonial Athletic Association Co-Head Coach of the Year, along with her husband Tim. The duo mentored two CAA Defenders of the Year, one CAA Rookie of the Year and 20 all-conference players, including six first-team honorees. The Sahaydaks reside in Orlando with their two daughters, Layla and Evie
