Team Notes

- ♦ UCF falls to 0-3 all-time against Kansas State and 0-2 in conference matchups with the Wildcats, having also fallen to them in the program's first Big 12 game back in 2023 at Bill Snyder Family Stadium.
- ♦ Head coach Scott Frost's historic 16-game winning streak with UCF came to end Saturday afternoon, losing a contest in Black and Gold for the first time since a Dec. 17, 2016, Cure Bowl defeat to Arkansas State. 3,206 days separate the two losses.

Offensive Notes

- ♦ Jacurri Brown connected with DJ Black on an 82-yard touchdown to secure the Knights' first points of the game, new career-longs for each player with the pass and reception, and the eighth-longest reception in program history
- ♦ Myles Montgomery recorded his longest rush of his UCF career at 45 yards during the Knights' first drive of the second half
- ♦ Jaden Nixon completed his third run of 40+ yards this season on his third quarter touchdown. All three occasions have been touchdowns.
- ♦ Today's matchup marked the first 100+ yard rushing game for Montgomery as a Knight

Defensive Notes

- ♦ Demari Henderson secured his fourth-career interception after picking off a Kansas State trick play on the opening drive. It marks his fourth-career interception and first since the Gasparilla Bowl against Georgia Tech on Dec. 22, 2023.
- ♦ Henderson's first-quarter interceptions marked the first by a Knight on an opening drive since Deshawn Pace picked off Shedeur Sanders on the third play of the game of UCF vs. Colorado Sept. 28, 2024.
- ♦ UCF's defense has held opponents to a minimal 210 yards across four first quarters this season without allowing a point.

Special Teams Notes

- ♦ Noe Ruelas' 53-yard field goal, just a yard short of his career-long of 54 his freshman year. The field goal marks the longest for UCF since Colton Boomer's 55-yarder on Sept. 9, 2023. Ruelas' ties for the third longest in program history.
