THE BREAKDOWN

Hoops is Back

UCF women's basketball will open its fourth season under head coach Sytia Messer and its third as a member of the Big 12 Conference on Monday, November 3, against Bethune-Cookman... Under Messer, the Knights are 3-0 in season openers, having outscored opponents 249-139... UCF and Bethune-Cookman last met in the program's 2023 season-opening contest, with the Knights scoring 63 second-half points en route to a commanding 101-63 triumph... The 20th all-time meeting between the two teams and 12th in Orlando, where the Black and Gold maintain and 10-1 advantage, will open up an 11-game non-conference slate for UCF... The campaign is highlighted by eight games at home, marking the second-consecutive season with that total and the fourth season with at least seven... Under Messer, the Knights are 20-3 in non-conference games at Addition Financial Arena.

Returning Knights

Coach Messer returns a pair of key frontcourt contributors in Khyala Ngodu and Mahogany Chandler-Roberts, along with versatile playmaker Summer Yancy... The formers saw minutes in all but one game last season (29 of 30), with Ngodu garnering starts down the stretch with four double-digit-point performances in her last six contests... Ngodu set career marks in points (6.9 p/g) and rebounds (5.9 p/g)... Chandler-Roberts and Yancy each contributed as freshmen under Messer, with the latter boasting an efficient .458 shooting percentage, while Chandler-Roberts was one of four to secure 100-plus rebounds.

Portal Additions

Eight transfers add a combined 17 seasons of collegiate experience to Orlando, as coach Messer added both physicality and Power Four experience to her roster. Savannah Scott (Auburn) boasted a standout freshman season two seasons ago, while Leah Harmon (Miami) and Kayanna Cox (SMU) each contributed to their respective teams as first years... Kristol Ayson (Tulsa) and Jacorriah Bracey (Southern Miss) each hold four years of experience themselves, while Jasmynne Gibson (North Florida) was named to the All-Atlantic Sun Freshman Team in 2024-25... Pensacola State transfer Audreonia Benson was named First-Team All-Panhandle and averaged 11.9 points per game in two seasons with the Pirates. Logan Reed (Texas A&M Corpus Christi) rounds out the exciting transfer class after redshirting her freshman season.



KNIGHTS NOTES

Freshmen Sensations

The Knights welcome in three promising freshmen to campus ahead of the 2025-26 campaign, each making long journeys from their hometowns to suit up in Black and Gold... Samari Bankhead was a standout guard at Windward High School in Los Angeles, California, receiving an opportunity to be coached by basketball legend Kobe Bryant during her youth career... Swedish natives Felicia Scholander and Meja Hansel, who both competed on the national team alongside one another, each bring something exciting to the team... Scholander shot 33 percent from beyond the arc in Sweden's Basketettan League, while Hansel's height and physicality saw the freshman average 6.3 rebounds per game with RIG Lulea in the Basketettan League.

Home Court Advantage

Head coach Sytia Messer has found consistent success at Addition Financial Arena since her first season in 2022-23... The Knights have boasted a combined 28-20 record in home contests over the past three years, with 20 of the victories coming in Orlando... During her first slate with the Black and Gold, the Knights went 11-5 at home, before an 8-8 record in 2023-24 and a 9-7 record in 2024-25.

Sweet November

Always striving to open the season on the front foot, coach Messer and the Knights have compiled a 17-2 record in the month of November, including a pair of undefeated marks throughout her first two seasons... A 6-2 record last year was highlighted by six straight to open the season, all at home, before falling in a pair of contests in Las Vegas, which stand as the lone defeats in November under Messer... This season, the Knights will play eight games in the month, including five consecutive to open the season before venturing to Puerto Rico for the San Juan Shootout from Nov. 26-28.

Sunshine State Dominance

The Knights have won four straight games against in-state opponents, going a perfect 3-0 a season ago after splitting a pair of contests in 2023-24. This season, the Knights will play four Sunshine State foes, the most in a campaign under Messer and the most overall since the 2015-16 season when UCF played six.

University of Arkansas, 2000 Bachelors in Science, Kinesiology

Sytia Messer (pronounced sit-TEE-uh) enters her fourth season as head coach of the UCF Knights. A 24-year coaching veteran. Messer was named the 13th head coach in UCF women's basketball history on April 3, 2022.

In her second season at UCF, Messer led the Knights to a record-breaking 8–0 start to the 2023–24 campaign. Her debut season featured a 6–0 start—the program's second-best since a 7–0 opening in 1984–85. Messer also helped guide the Knights through their inaugural season in the Big 12 Conference. producing an All-Big 12 Second Team selection in league-leading scorer Kaitlyn Peterson.

Messer came to UCF following a season as associate head coach at LSU (2021–22) under Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer and AP National Coach of the Year Kim Mulkey. Before that, she spent eight seasons as an assistant coach on Mulkey's staff at Baylor (2013–21), helping the Bears compile a remarkable 260–23 (.918) record, including eight Big 12 regular-season titles, six conference tournament championships, an NCAA title in 2019, and six Elite Eight appearances.

During her time at Baylor, Messer was instrumental in recruiting and scouting. She helped sign the nation's No. 1 recruiting classes in 2016 and 2018, and the No. 2 class in 2015. Her efforts brought in 15 top-50 players and 14 McDonald's All-Americans. Under her development, nine players were selected in the WNBA Draft, including Odyssey Sims (No. 2 overall in 2014), Alexis Jones (No. 12 in 2017), Kalani Brown (No. 7 in 2019), and Lauren Cox (No. 3 in 2020). Messer also played a key role in developing 2020 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Didi Richards and 2021 Wade Trophy winner and Big 12 Player of the Year NaLyssa Smith.

Baylor's success during Messer's tenure included six straight seasons of 32 or more wins, highlighted by a 37–1 record in 2018–19. Her coaching résumé at Baylor also featured 23 NCAA Tournament victories. 73 All-Big 12 selections, 20 All-America honorees, five Big 12 Players of the Year, 26 Academic All-Big 12 selections, and eight players on AP All-America teams, including first-teamers Sims (2014), Nina Davis (2014), Cox (2020), and Smith (2021, 2022).

Prior to her time at Baylor, Messer served as head coach at Tennessee Tech from 2009 to 2012. There, she led the Golden Eagles to a 54–41 record (.568), including a 23–8 mark in 2010–11, an Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) regular-season championship, and two postseason appearances (WNIT in 2011, WBI in 2012). She was named the 2011 OVC Coach of the Year.

Her earlier assistant coaching stops include Arkansas State (2000–02), where she began her coaching career, Memphis (2002–04), where she helped lead the Tigers to a 21–10 record and a WNIT appearance in 2003, and Georgia Tech (2004–09, 2012–13), where she played a key role on three straight NCAA Tournament teams from 2007 to 2009.

As a player, Messer starred at the University of Arkansas from 1995 to 1999, helping the Razorbacks reach the NCAA Final Four in 1998—the program's first ever. She was named Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA West Regional that year after scoring 24 points in a win over Kansas and leading Arkansas past Duke. That Razorback squad, seeded ninth, became the first unranked team in the modern era to reach the Final Four.

Messer finished her career ranked in the program's top 10 in points (1,379) and rebounds (603). She was a two-time team captain, a 1996 SEC All-Freshman honoree, and helped Arkansas win the 1999 WNIT title. She was inducted into the Razorbacks Hall of Honor in 2018 and named an SEC Legend in 2012.

She graduated from Arkansas in 2000 with a Bachelor of Science degree in kinesiology. Messer also played for Athletes in Action, both as a collegiate and post-graduate player, and completed the Center for Coaching Excellence program in 2012. She has served as an honorary chair for Habitat for Humanity and remains an influential voice in women's basketball.
