#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

- **New Faces**: 11 newcomers highlight the 2025-26 Charlotte Women's Basketball roster along with the returns of Imani Smith, Caroline Thiel, and Daphane White.
- Series History: Charlotte is 3-2 all-time in the series history versus UCF, with the last matchup taking place in 2013-14, when Charlotte won 62-52 in Halton Arena. Charlotte is 2-1 on the road in Orlando.
- Quick Start: Charlotte used a strong first quarter performance, outscoring Campbell 15-4, to win their first game of the 2025-26 season.
- Career High: Princess Anderson scored a career high 26 points, including five three-pointers, to lead Charlotte to the win over Campbell.
- **Crash the Glass:** Charlotte grabbed 57 rebounds in the win over Campbell, including 32 offensive rebounds, the third most in a single game in program history.
- **She's Back!:** Daphane White returned to action after missing two years due to inuury. In just 10 minutes of action versus Auburn., White scored eight points while making four of her five shot
- **Coming Home:** Charlotte native Tanajah Hayes had 12 points and six assists in her 49ers debut, logging 30 minutes of action after missing most of last season due to injury.

## **GAME 3: AT UCF**

#### **SCOUTING UCF:**

The Knights took care of business in their 2025-26 season opener, dominating Bethune-Cookman 75-36. Four Knights scored in double figures, and 11 in the enitre game. UCF was led by Miami transfer Leah Harmon who notched a career high of 14 points. UCF improved to 4-0 in season openers under Head Coach Sytia Messer, having outscored opponents a combined 324-175 in a string of brilliant performances. Allowing just 36 points, it was the second-fewest allowed in a game under coach Messer, just shy of the mark of 32 given up to Winthrop in 2023.

#### **PRESEASON POLL:**

In the Big 12 preseason poll, UCF was tabbed to finish last at 16th. Last season, UCF finished with a record of 12-18 while going 4-14 in conference play. Coach Messer returns a pair of key frontcourt contributors in Khyala Ngodu and Mahogany Chandler-Roberts, along with versatile playmaker Summer Yancy. They all saw action in all but one game last season (29 of 30) with Ngodu scoring in double figures in four of the last six games of the season.

#### **CHARLOTTE VS. POWER FOUR:**

The 49ers last power four conference win came at Wake Forest during the 2023-24 campaign when Charlotte won 69-58 inside Lawrence-Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum. Charlotte also defeated Wake Forest and Boston College in the 2019-20 season. Wisconsin (Big 10) and Pittsburgh (ACC) were two key P4 wins for Charlotte during the 2016-17 season. In 2012-13, Charlotte picked up a win over TCU for a Big 12 victory, also defeating Texas A&M in 2002-03 while the Aggies were members of the Big 12.

#### **UPSET BID COMES UP SHORT:**

Charlotte pushed SEC foe Auburn to overtime in the season opener, a game that saw nine ties and six lead changes. Karen Nimo came off the bench and scored 13 points in the first half (17 for the game) in her first NCAA game after one season of JUCO and just one year of high school basketball, just beginning organized basketball her senior year. Daphane White returned to action after missing two years due to injury. In just 10 minutes of action in her debut, she scored eight points while making four of her five field goal attempts.

#### **CRASH THE GLASS**

Charlotte grabbed 32 offensive rebounds versus Campbell, which was good for third best in program history for a single game. Charlotte's 57 total rebounds were tied for the most in a game since the 2018-19 season. Nicholson led the way for Charlotte, coming up with seven offensive rebounds. All 11 players for Charlotte that saw action grabbed at least one rebound.

#### START STRONG, FINISH STRONG

Charlotte used a 15-4 first quarter advantage, and ending the game on an 11-0 scoring run after the game was tied 50-50. Tanajah Hayes' veteran leadership helped get Charlotte to the finish line in the fourth quarter, as her driving layup reclaim the lead 52-50. A possession later, two offensive rebounds from Imani Smith and Princess Anderson led to a three-pointer from Hayes. Leading 56-50, Zoe Best found an open Anderson to connect for her fifth made three-pointer of the evening, highlighting the 11-0 run Charlotte went on to close the game out by a score of 61-50.

#### **COACH'S CORNER**

"This is a game we had to win, and our team really wanted it," said Tomekia Reed. "I challenged them to get off to a strong start, and they did exactly that. Our defensive schemes worked down the stretch and challenged Campbell on the offensive end. Defensive intensity was a big part of the players we recruited for this team. We played with a high level of IQ and toughness. Our team showed a lot of heart and valued each possession. I am proud of the resilience to get this win. Today we wanted to use the bench more as we are preparing for a long run of away games. Those long trips can be taxing on the body, and it will take everyone as we progress into non conference play."

"We recruited Princess knowing she was a special player," said Reed. "It was obvious her performance against Auburn was bothering her. She was able to flip the script and move on from that. This morning at shootaround, she was operating on a clean slate and stayed ready for her moment."

#### **DOUBLE DOUBLE:**

Asianae Nicholson averaged a double double with 12.8 points per game and 12.0 rebounds per game for Bethune-Cookman last season. At the end of the season, she was named an HBCU All-American and to the All-SWAC Second Team. She ranked second in the entire NCAA for double doubles (22) and led the SWAC in rebounds with 367. Through two games with Charlotte, Nicholson has seven offensive rebounds in each contest (nine total in each game).

## **OTHER NEWCOMERS TO WATCH:**

Zoe Best impressed in 2024-25 with SEMO, winning the Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Year after averaging 14.1 points per game and 5.1 rebounds per game. Best scored double figures in 21 of her 28 games played including six 20+ point performances.

Ja'Navia Gage is transferring to Charlotte after a standout season at Gulf Coast State (JUCO) where she earned Honorable Mention All-American recognition. She averaged 12 points per game on an efficient 56% shooting from the floor. Gage's 12.9 rebounds per game ranked fifth in the nation.

# HEAD COACH Tomekia Reed

## 2nd Season • Alma Mater: Georgia Southwestern '03

Tomekia Reed enters her second year at the helm of Charlotte 49ers Women's Basketball. Reed was named the ninth head women's basketball coach in program history April 25th, 2024. Reed, a three-time HBCU National Coach of the Year, came to Charlotte following a highly successful sixyear stint as head coach of the Jackson State Tigers.

In year one with Charlotte, the 49ers went 11-21 while ending the season on a high-note by making a run to the American Conference Tournament Quarterfinals. Charlotte became the second 12th seed in American Conference history to reach the quarterfinals.

Reed took the program to new heights by winning five consecutive Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) regular season titles and three SWAC tournament titles, including back-to-back championships in 2021 and 2022.

In making the program's second straight appearance in the 2022 NCAA Tournament, and the first as a #14 seed, JSU led in the fourth quarter in nearly achieving a historic tournament win over #3 LSU. JSU made its return to the NCAA Tournament as a #14 seed again to face #3 UConn in 2024, where Reed won the respect of hall of fame coach Geno Auriemma.

Reed is a four-time SWAC Coach of The Year (2020, 2022, 2023, 2024). The 2020 championship was the first regular season crown for JSU since 2008, and the 2021 tournament championship earned the first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2008.
