THE OPENING TIP

The Golden Grizzlies Men's Basketball is back on the road into Big 12 Conference territory again for a meeting with the University of Central Florida Knights inside Addition Financial Arena in Orlando, Fla. Legendary player/coach Johnny Dawkins and Oakland head coach Greg Kampe's squads will meet for the first time in program history. The "Voice of the Golden Grizzlies" Neal Ruhl will be on the radio call on The Ticket 971 HD-3 FM and The Bet 1270AM (WXYT-AM) as well as the Audacy App.

LAST TIMEOUT

Fifth-year senior Brett White II led Oakland with 18 points coming off the bench, converting four 3-pointers and recording three steals. Fifth-year senior Tuburu Naivalurua posted a perfect shooting performance, scoring 17 points on 8-for-8 from the field and adding three steals, as senior Brody Robinson contributed 17 points while successfully converting seven of 10 free throws for a career-high and dished out five assists. Senior Ziare Wells scored 13 points and collected seven rebounds, along with four assists and two steals, along as senior Nate Deer picked up his first NCAA career double-double, shooting 11 points and picking up 10 boards.

PRESEASON TROPHY CASE

Naivalurua was named the Horizon League's Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason All-League First Team after a strong junior campaign. Naivalurua returns as the Horizon League's leading scorer at 13.9 points per game. Known for his work on the other side of the ball, the Australia native averaged 7.1 boards per game, totaling 234 rebounds through all 33 games he started. He shot .555 from the field, including 83 made free-throws.

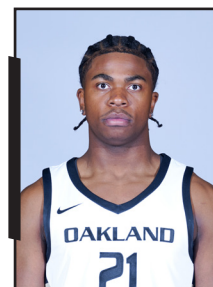

3-POINTER STREAK

The last time Oakland did not convert a shot from behind the arc was on Jan. 30, 1988 vs. Wayne State University.

UNLV and Princeton are the only two schools to make a 3-pointer in every game since the inclusion of a 3-point line in 1986-87.

BACK-TO-BACK

The Golden Grizzlies made history with Houston's jump to No. 1 in the AP Poll, Oakland is the first program to face back-to-back No. 1 teams since Oklahoma faced consecutive No. 1 teams in 1990, as the Sooners saw No. 1 Missouri and No. 1 Kansas back-to-back.

SEEING THE SAME

Oakland is just one of two schools (Florida Gulf Coast) in Division I that have two sets of brothers on the roster this season. The Yeagers are one of six sets of twins playing on the same team in Division I, as well.

HARDEST OPENING SLATE IN THE COUNTRY

Oakland opened the 2025-26 slate on the road against three AP Top-10 teams for the first time in program history. The Golden Grizzlies started in-state against No. 7 Michigan before heading to West Lafayette to face Matt Painter and the No. 1 Purdue Boilermakers. Going into week two, Oakland traveled to the new No. 1 in Houston on Nov. 12. In the KenPom.com rankings, Oakland is listed as the hardest schedule in the country, with a +32.13 net rating in strength of schedule

EIGHT FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

WEAR THE COLORS

Oakland is 0-2 when wearing black and 0-1 when in gold. They have yet to wear white, playing on the road for three games now. The Golden Grizzlies debuted a new uniform with black and gold checkers down the sides and a look at the new logo of the grizzly bear making a jump shot.

SAME TIME, SAME PLACE

Oakland continues their partnership with Audacy that made 97.1 The Ticket HD3 and The Bet 1270AM (WXYT-AM) the official radio providers for the department. With this new partnership, 97.1 The Ticket HD3 and The Bet 1270AM (WXTY-AM) will provide coverage for all Oakland men's basketball games as well as the Greg Kampe Radio Show at Patti Finnegan's at the OU Golf Course.

BACK FOR ANOTHER RUN

Kampe enters his 42nd season at the helm of the Oakland men's basketball program. He is the longest tenured active coach in Division I, ahead of Tom Izzo (Michigan State, 31 seasons) and Mark Few (Gonzaga, 27 seasons). Kampe's 715 career wins rank ninth among active Division I coaches.

KEEPING THE 20TH CENTURY RELEVANT

Through brief research with Division I men's basketball media contacts across the country, fifth-year guard Brett White II is the second oldest player in the country at 27 years old (born Feb. 17, 1998) after Green Bay's own Ramel Bethea (born July 27, 1996). White II started his collegiate eligibility in 2021, roughly four years post-high school, at Kellogg Community College before transferring to Rochester Christian for two years.

PUTTING OAKLAND ON THE MAP

Kampe joined Oakland in 1984 after six seasons as an assistant coach at Toledo (1978-1984). Formerly known as the Pioneers, OU had only six winning seasons in 16 years of competition before his arrival.

PRESEASON POLL

Oakland was projected to finish second with seven first-place votes in the 2025-26 Horizon League Preseason Poll, which was voted by the league's 11 head coaches, media members, and men's basketball media contacts throughout the conference.

KEY RETURNEES

The Golden Grizzlies return 25.3% of their scoring from a year ago, including one starter in Tuburu Naivalurua. OU also brings back sophomore Nassim Mashhour who saw time off the bench in 2024-25 and redshirt-freshman Warren Marshall IV.

I'M COMING HOME

Fifth-year forward Michael Houge transferred to Oakland after stints at Mars Hills, Walters State CC, St. Peter's, and Jax State. The Detroit native returns home after playing in 104 career games and averaging 8.5 ppg and 268 total rebounds during his senior season in Jacksonville.

EARLY TESTS

Oakland's non-conference schedule features five NCAA Tournament teams from a year ago and a multi-team exempt event in Montana.

HORIZON SLATE

Each Horizon League team will play a 20-game double round-robin schedule. Oakland's conference schedule gets underway Wednesday, December 3 at home against Purdue Fort Wayne. The Golden Grizzlies conclude their conference slate with a Metro Series battle against Detroit Mercy on the Blacktop.

OVERTIME MADNESS

The Golden Grizzlies conclude their conference slate with a Metro Series battle against Detroit Mercy on the Blacktop. Last year, the Golden Grizzlies tied their record of reaching six overtime games in a single season. OU recorded a 3-3 record in overtime, including extra time in back-to-back games in Hawaii in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Oakland garnered their first overtime victory of the season with a Metro Series battle against Detroit Mercy before the conclusion of the 2024-25 season at the HL Tournament, succumbing to one-seed Robert Morris in OT.

"To be able to come home, play everybody a lot of minutes, get up and down and press. I was very pleased with the game. I was pleased with the intensity we played with throughout."

Fifth-year senior Brett White II led Oakland with 18 points, converting four 3-pointers and recording three steals. Fifth-year senior Tuburu Naivalurua posted a perfect shooting performance, scoring 17 points on 8-for-8 from the field and adding three steals, as senior Brody Robinson contributed 17 points while successfully converting seven of 10 free throws and dishing out five assists. Senior Ziare Wells scored 13 points and collected seven rebounds, along with four assists and two steals, along as senior Nate Deer picked up his first NCAA career double-double, shooting 11 points and picking up 10 boards.

Oakland opened the game with a dominant performance, capitalizing on turnovers and fast-break opportunities to take an early lead. Wells initiated a scoring surge with a layup following a steal at 18:33, contributing to a quick 7-2 advantage. The home team continued to extend their lead, fueled by efficient shooting and solid defense, as they amassed 12 steals and forced 15 turnovers by the Yellowjackets. By the end of the first half, Oakland had established a commanding position, leading 68-21.

The Golden Grizzlies surged ahead in the second half with a strong defensive display, forcing multiple turnovers that led to back-to-back fastbreak points. A notable sequence saw sophomore Nassim Mashhour steal the ball twice, resulting in quick points from Robinson and Wells, solidifying their lead. White contributed significantly, hitting two 3-pointers, and a dunk, extending Oakland's advantage. Oakland maintained control throughout the half, ending with a 45-26 scoring advantage in the frame as the game concluded in the Black and Gold's favor.

Oakland will travel to face the Big 12's UCF on Monday, Nov. 17, at 7 p.m. The game, streamed on ESPN+ will be inside Addition Financial Arena in Orlando, Fla, as the Voice of the Golden Grizzlies, Neal Ruhl, will be on the call on 97.1HD-3/1270am or the Audacy App online.
