

## **FIRST AND 10**

## SENIOR SEND OFF

- ◆ The Knights will salute their senior class with a pregame ceremony vs. OSU → Three Knights have been with UCF since the beginning of their college campaign. OL Paul Rubelt has been with UCF since 2020, as has OL Pat
- Barnett. EDGE Malachi Lawrence has been with the Black and Gold for all four of his collegiate seasons, starting back in 2021.
- ◆ A handful of seniors who are in their first year with UCF have made a big impact, including Jaden Nixon, Cole Kozlowski, Phillip Dunnam and more.
- ◆ UCF will celebrate 25 seniors and fifth years in their final home game

## JADEN NIXON FACES SET TO FACE FORMER SQUAD

- ◆ RB Jaden Nixon is set to face the squad he started his college career with after spending his first three seasons with Oklahoma State.
- ◆ Nixon compiled 110 carries for 500 yards, averaging 4.5 yards per carry. In his one season with UCF, Nixon has already topped his rushing yards from those three seasons, chalking up 517 rushing yards on 61 carries for an impressive average of 8.5 yards per carry. He's tallied seven rushing touchdowns with UCF.

## LAWRENCE CLIMBING SACK LEADERBOARD

- ◆ UCF EDGE Malachi Lawrence has earned 20 career sacks, propelling himself into the top 10 of active leaders in the FBS and all-time at UCF
- ◆ Lawrence sits at No. 9 among active FBS players in career sacks and is second among active players in the Big 12 Conference behind only TTU's David Bailey
- ◆ Lawrence sits alone at No. 10 all-time in career sacks at UCF, passing Keenan Wimblev's 19 compiled from 1984-87 and is one sack away from jumping into sole possession of ninth (see record watch later in notes)
- ◆ Lawrence recorded back-to-back 2.0 sack games at Baylor and vs. Houston, putting him at 7.0 on the season which is 0.5 shy of tying his career best

## NO FLY ZONE

- ◆ The Knights have the second-best ranked passing defense in the Big 12 and 21st ranked in the nation, surrendering just 180.8 passing yards per game
- → UCF has a chance to finish the campaign with its lowest mark in passing yards per game in the program's FBS history (joined in 1996). This season's clip is the best since 2001. UCF surrendered just 178.0 passing yards per game in 2001 and 179.7 in 1998, currently the only two FBS marks ahead of this season's 180.8.
- → UCF is tied for the second-fewest passing plays allowed of 20+ yards in the Big 12, surrendering 22, one behind conference leader Utah. Additionally. UCF has allowed the third-fewest 20+ yard plays of any variety in the Big 12 with 31.
- ◆ UCF held West Virginia to just 79 passing yards, tied for the 17th fewest surrendered in UCF's FBS history. Earlier this year, UCF limited N.C. A&T to 40 passing yards, the fourth fewest allowed during UCF's FBS era.

## SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST

- The Knights have been sharp on defense in the fourth quarter, surrendering the seventh fewest points per game in the fourth this season with 39 total
- What's been more impressive is the amount of yards surrendered in the fourth quarter during Big 12 conference play:
  - Nov. 15 at #6 TTU 34 yards, 5 first downs, 13 plays, 0 points
  - Nov. 7 vs. HOU 96 yards, 8 first downs, 22 plays, 6 points Nov. 1 at BU - 64 yards, 4 first downs, 16 plays, 7 points

  - Ct. 18 vs. WVU 7 yards, 0 first downs, 14 plays, 6 points

    Oct. 11 at CIN 17 yards, 1 first down, 9 plays, 3 points

## FIRST QUARTER LOCKDOWN

- ◆ UCF has shutout its opponents in the first quarter in seven of 10 games this season, allowing 35 points.
- ◆ Prior to UCF surrendering 14 points at No. 6 Texas Tech in the first quarter, it had been remarkable at limiting opponents on the scoreboard in the opening frame. UCF was ranked 11th in the nation in fewest points allowed in the first

but now rank 37th. UCF entered November ranking third in the category after allowing seven points in the first quarter to Cincinnati on Oct. 11.

- ◆ UCF didn't allow a first-quarter score through the first five games of 2025 and didn't allow a touchdown in the first half of the first three games of the season
- UCF and Pitt were the only two FBS programs to hold its opponents scoreless in the first quarter through the first six weeks of 2025. Both teams saw that streak snapped in week seven, each giving up a TD in the first quarter.

## **REMARKABLE RUELAS - LOU GROZA SEMIFINALIST**

- ◆ Kicker Noe Ruelas was named one of 20 Lou Groza semifinalists on Nov. 18
- → The last Knight to be a Lou Groza semifinalist was Matthew Wright in 2018
- ◆ Ruelas tied his career long with a 54-yard made field goal against Houston on Nov. 7, making him the first player in UCF's FBS history to hit three field goals from 50 yards or longer in a single season (54 vs. Houston, 53 at Kansas State and 51 vs. West Virginia). The program record for 50+ yarders in a season is four, acheived by Scott Ryerson in 1981, UCF's final D-III season.
- Ruelas had a streak of 11 straight field goals made prior to just his second miss of the 2025 season at Baylor on Nov. 1. He joined a group of just five Knights to make 11 or more consecutive field goals in the program's history, tying the legendary Matt Prater for 11 straight made. The last UCF kicker to hit 11 or more consecutive field goals was Shawn Moffitt who nailed 12 in a row across the 2012 and 2013 seasons.
- Prior to hitting his third, Ruelas and Colton Boomer were the only two Knights in the program's FBS history to make a pair of 50+ yard field goals in a single season, Boomer doing so in 2023.

## **DUNNAM DAZZLES WITH THREE SPACE GAME INTS**

- + Senior DB Phillip Dunnam had a career night in UCF's space game, becoming the first player in program history to snag three interceptions in a single game. Two of the interceptions were in the first half, and one ended in a 43-yard pick-six to put UCF up 24-14 late in the second guarter.
- ◆ Dunnam was honored as the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week He became the third player this season to have three interceptions, but
- became the only one to return it for a touchdown. Additionally, he became one of 13 players to have a three pick game in the Big 12 since 1996
- Oddly enough, this isn't the first time defensive coordinator Alex Grinch has had one of his players on defense earn three picks in a game. The other was Wyoming's Shamiel Gary in his first collegiate game against Weber State. Grinch was the defensive backs coach in Wyoming from 2009-2011.

## LONG SCORING DRIVES

- ◆ UCF had two scoring drives of 90+ yards in the win over West Virginia,
- matching the two collected over the course of the season, now sitting at four ◆ Prior to the West Virginia win, the last time UCF had two or more 90+ vard touchdown drives in a single game was Oct. 19, 2019 against East Carolina
- Additionally, the Knights earned three scoring drives of 75+ yards against the Mountaineers, bringing the total to of 75+ scoring drives to 12 this season
- ◆ Now at 14 drives of 75+ yards, the 75+ yard drives make up 35% of all UCF's scoring drives this season with 40 total scoring drives

## **BIG GAIN RUNNING GAME**

- → J. Nixon has four runs of 50+ yards this season, all of thlem for touchdowns. Two of his long runs came in UCF's 68-7 victory over N.C. A&T, ripping off 87- and 66-yard touchdown runs. His third came at Kansas State, a 54-yard touchdown, making way for his 83-yard score against West Virginia.
- ◆ UCF is one of two Big 12 teams (Utah) to boast four different players with 100-yard rushing outings. Jaden Nixon, Myles Montgomery, Jacurri Brown and Cam Fancher have all earned 100+ rushing yards in a game this season.
- ◆ Additionally, Montgomery earned two long runs at Kansas State, scampering for 45 yards, his longest rush as a Knight, and later running for 44 yards for his highest career rushing total of 119 yards on 10 carries

## BY THE NUMBERS

The Knights have compiled 73 victories since the start of the 2017 season, the most of any program in the Big 12 Conference. The win total is tied for 16th most in the nation since that time. A full list is available in later in the notes.



The Knights welcome 63 new players to the roster this season, with the total roster size being 111. Of the 63 newcomers, 36 are transfers from DI schools while 18 are from high school. Just four players who started 6+ games last year return.



## Scott FROST

Head Coach / First Season, Third Season Overall at UCF

After an unforgettable two-year run that saw the UCF football program rise to national prominence, Scott Frost is coming back home.

Known for sparking the "Charge On" spirit and guiding UCF to its first perfect season, Frost was re-introduced as the program's next head coach by UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Terry Mohajir on Dec. 8, 2024.

Frost originally served as UCF's head coach from 2016 to 2017, culminating in a historic 13-0 season, an AAC championship and a national championship that captured the nation's attention. In his final game, Frost guided UCF to a victory over No. 7 Auburn in the 2018 Peach Bowl, securing the program's first undefeated season in school history.

Frost posted the greatest two-year turnaround in college football history at UCF, inheriting a 0-12 team in 2015 and taking the Knights to a perfect season in his second and final year, when he was named the national coach of the year.

"I'm deeply honored to return to UCF, a school that has always held a special place in my heart," Frost said. "The foundation we built here has only grown stronger, and I am thrilled to continue shaping this program's legacy. As we prepare for year three in the Big 12 Conference, I look forward to working alongside our dedicated student-athletes, talented staff, and passionate fans to reach new heights together."

Frost went a combined 19-7 in two seasons at UCF, helping turn an 0-12 team into a 13-0 squad in just two years. In Frost's first season, he took the Knights to a bowl game and finished with a 6-7 record. The turnaround was historic, as Frost became the only first-year coach in FBS history to make a bowl game with a team that was winless the previous season. UCF led the nation with a six-win improvement in 2016 and exceeded that mark in 2017 as the nation's only undefeated team. The Knights put together the first undefeated regular season in UCF and AAC history in 2017, posted the longest winning streak in school history at the time of his departure (13 games), achieved the highest in-season ranking in program history (10th), highest final ranking (6th) and set an AAC record with 16 all-conference selections.

UCF was led by its high-powered offense and improved defense under Frost. The Knights led the nation in scoring at 48.2 points per game and were the only FBS team to score at least 30 points in every game in 2017. Defensively, UCF improved its scoring defense by 65 spots in Frost's two seasons.

In addition to being the unanimous choice as the 2017 AAC Coach of the Year, Frost was honored as the national coach of the year by the Associated Press, American Football Coaches Association, the Touchdown Club of Columbus, the Lombardi Award and FCA in addition to winning the Home Depot, Paul "Bear" Bryant and Eddie Robinson coach-of-the-year awards.

Frost began his coaching career at Northern Iowa in 2007 as a linebackers coach and was promoted to co-defensive coordinator in 2008. That season, his defense excelled, tying for third in the FCS with 40 takeaways and ranking ninth in scoring defense, allowing just 17.7 points per game. The 12-3 Panthers also led the Missouri Valley Football Conference in both rushing defense (107.1 yards per game) and scoring defense.

In 2009, Frost joined the Oregon coaching staff as the wide receivers coach under head coach Chip Kelly and offensive coordinator Mark Helfrich. Frost helped Oregon post a 79-14 record in his seven seasons, during which time the Ducks won four conference titles and twice played for the national championship.

Oregon never ranked lower than eighth nationally in scoring offense during Frost's seven seasons on staff, and the Ducks led the nation in scoring in 2010. Frost was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2013, and Oregon ranked in the top five nationally in both scoring and total offense each of his three seasons calling plays. The Ducks scored 681 points in 2014, the second-highest total in NCAA history. Oregon made it to the College Football Playoff Championship Game that year, when Frost was one of five finalists for the Broyles Award, presented annually to the nation's top assistant. Frost's quarterback, Marcus Mariota, won the Heisman Trophy and was the No. 2 overall pick in the 2015 NFL Draft.

After Kelly left for the Philadelphia Eagles, Oregon promoted Mark Helfrich to head coach and named Frost offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach in 2013. In this role, Frost guided Marcus Mariota to a Heisman Trophy win and a berth in the national championship game. During Frost's tenure as offensive coordinator, Oregon recorded a 33–8 record and consistently ranked among the nation's top teams in scoring and total offense. His standout performance in 2014 earned him a finalist spot for the prestigious Broyles Award, recognizing the nation's top assistant coach.

Following his two years at UCF, Scott Frost served as the head football coach at the University of Nebraska for four-plus seasons from 2018 to 2022, coaching the first three games of the 2022 season. Frost posted a 16-31 record with the Cornhuskers. His tenure was defined by close losses, as 23 of his 31 losses were by single digits, including each of his final 13. Nebraska lost 22 one-score games during Frost's career, including 12 games by five or fewer points.

Last season, Frost had been serving as a coaching consultant for Sean McVay and the Los Angeles Rams.



Arizona State (25th) and Houston (23rd) made their CFP rankings debut this season, while Utah (12th), BYU (IIth) and Texas Tech (5th) all moved up one spot from last week.
- Entering Week 13, six teams are still eligible for a berth in the 2025 Edward Jones Big I2 Football Championship at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas. Those teams are Arizona State, BYU, Cincinnati, Houston, Texas Tech and Utah.
- BYU and Texas Tech are the only programs this week that can clinch a spot in the 2025 Edward Jones Big 12 Football Championship.
- Texas Tech clinches with a loss by Arizona State AND a BYU win over Cincinnati OR with losses by ASU, BYU and Utah.
- BYU clinches with a win over Cincinnati AND losses by Arizona State and Houston OR with a win over Cincinnati AND an Arizona State loss AND a Utah win.
- The Big I2 Conference will host FOX's Big Noon Kickoff pregame show for a fourth time this season for BYU's visit to Cincinnati on Saturday.
- 68.8% (II of I6) Big I2 programs have defeated an AP Top 25 team this season, which is the highest percentage of any FBS conference.
- Through Week I2 of the season, nine Big I2 programs are bowl eligible with three more that are one win away.

## **Doug Meacham**

Interim Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator 12th Year at OSU | 37th Year Overall Oklahoma State, 1988

- Former Cowboy student-athlete and coach Doug Meacham returned to the OSU football program as its offensive coordinator in December of 2024 and was named interim head coach September 23, 2025.
- Meacham, who was an Oklahoma State offensive lineman from 1983-87, previously served on Oklahoma State's coaching staff from 2005-12 and worked with tight ends and inside receivers. He also worked as an OSU graduate assistant from 1989-91.
- In seven seasons as an FBS offensive coordinator, Meacham's offenses have averaged more than 440 total yards, more than 270 passing yards and more than 32 points per game.
- Oklahoma State is one of eight schools where Meacham has been an offensive coordinator. He previously coordinated offenses at TCU (2014-16; 2021), Kansas (2017-18), Houston (2013), Samford (2002-04), Henderson State (1999-00), Jacksonville State (1997-99) and Georgia Military (1994-96). He also served in the role for the XFL's St. Louis BattleHawks.
- Meacham worked at TCU from 2020-24, serving various roles that included offensive coordinator and working with wide receivers and tight ends. The 2024 Horned Frogs finished the regular season ranked No. 7 in the FBS in passing offense (317.6 yards per game) and was among the top 30 in total offense, passing efficiency, scoring offense and red zone offense.
- He coached JP Richardson to All-Big 12 recognition in 2023 as TCU finished No. 7 in the FBS in passing offense and No. 11 in total offense.
- He coached TCU's Taye Barber and Derius Davis to All-Big 12 honors in 2022 as TCU reached the CFP National Championship. Davis was a fourth-round NFL Draft pick of the Chargers while Barber, a four-time All-Big 12 pick, signed a free-agent contract with Tampa Bay.
- Meacham was TCU's offensive coordinator in 2021, a role he previously held from 2014-16 when the Horned Frogs had record-setting offenses and ranked among the nation's leaders in several major statistical categories. His 2021 offense ranked 11th nationally in both passing efficiency and third down conversion percentage, and he was part of a 2020 TCU team that ranked No. 20 in the FBS in rushing offense.
- Prior to returning to TCU, Meacham was the offensive coordinator for the XFL's St. Louis BattleHawks, and before that he served as the offensive coordinator at Kansas for the 2017-18

- seasons. His 2018 unit turned the ball over just 11 times to rank as the fourth fewest in the nation and helped the Jayhawks rank second in the nation in turnover margin, while his first KU unit in 2017 produced three All-Big 12 honors and turned in the second-best single game receiving total in school history as Steven Sims Jr. recorded 233 yards against Kansas State.
- Before that he had his first coaching stint at TCU as an offensive coordinator from 2014-16.
   The 2016 unit ranked No. 29 in the FBS in both total offense and passing offense, despite having to replace a Heisman candidate quarterback in Trevone Boykin.
- In 2015, for the second straight year, TCU set numerous single-season school records. Additionally, the Horned Frogs ranked third nationally in total offense (562.8 yards per game) and seventh in scoring (42.1 points per game).
- Meacham's first season at TCU in 2014 saw it become the nation's most improved offense in total yards (+188.2 ypg) and scoring (+21.4 ppg). TCU's 21.4 points per game improvement broke the Big 12 record of 19.1 set by Oklahoma in 1999 (35.8; 16.7, 1998) and was the largest improvement by any team since Northwestern went up 24.0 points between 1999-00.
- The 2014 Horned Frogs ranked second in the nation in scoring (46.5 ppg) and tied for fifth in total offense (533.0 ypg). TCU set 26 school records for offense in winning its first Big 12 championship as well as the Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl with a 42-3 victory over Ole Miss.
- Meacham was a 2014 finalist for the Broyles Award for the nation's top assistant coach.
- Prior to TCU, he served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Houston for the 2013 season. He guided the Cougars to finish with the No. 29 passing offense in the nation at 280.5 yards per game while the offense also played a big role in helping UH lead the nation in turnover margin.
- Before UH, Meacham spent eight years (2005-12) as the tight ends/inside receivers coach at Oklahoma State. He was the Cowboys' passing game coordinator in the 2008 and 2009 campaigns. Meacham was part of two of the most successful eras in Oklahoma State football history, first as a student-athlete (1984-87) and then during his tenure as an assistant coach.
- The Cowboys ranked in the top 10 nationally in offense and averaged at least 40 points in five of Meacham's last six seasons in Stillwater. Oklahoma State was in the top five in the country in total offense in the 2010-12 campaigns, when it scored more than 50 points 15 times, broke the 60-point mark in seven contests, 70 points twice and the 80-point plateau once.
- Meacham coached 2012 first-team All-Big 12 receiver Josh Stewart into one of the best sophomore seasons in OSU history with 101 catches for 1,210 yards and seven touchdowns. Stewart's 101 receptions were the fourth-most in school history and his 1,210 receiving yards trailed only Justin Blackmon (Jacksonville Jaguars) and Dez Bryant (Dallas Cowboys) on the all-time OSU list for sophomore wideouts.
- Inside receiver Josh Cooper (Cleveland Browns) and tight end Brandon Pettigrew (De-

- troit Lions) were among other OSU standouts coached directly by Meacham.
- Meacham was instrumental in establishing a record-setting offense at Samford. He directed an attack in 2004 that set several school records, including passing yards (2,986), pass completions (256) and completion percentage (59.8).
- Prior to Samford, Meacham worked the same kind of magic at Henderson State, where he was offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. During the 2000 season, Meacham coached an offense that broke two Division II national passing and receiving records, four Gulf South Conference marks and nine school passing and receiving records.
- Meacham's history of record-breaking offenses, however, began before his stint at Henderson. Upon joining the staff at Jacksonville State in 1997, the Gamecocks went 7-4 and recorded the biggest turnaround in Division I-AA. During his tenure at Jacksonville State, Meacham's offensive unit broke 21 school passing and receiving records.
- Meacham also spent three years as the offensive coordinator at Georgia Military College. He first joined the GMC staff in 1991 and served as offensive line and tight ends coach. In 1994, he was promoted to offensive coordinator and helped guide the school to an impressive 35-8 record during his tenure.
- During his playing days at Oklahoma State, Meacham was on teams that participated in four bowl games (1983 Bluebonnet, 1984 Gator, 1985 Gator and 1987 Sun). He was a three-year starter on the offensive line for the Cowboys and had a string of 35 consecutive starts. The Cowboys were 34-9 during his time in Stillwater.
- Meacham earned All-Big Eight honors and was an Honorable-Mention All-American as a senior. He was a captain of the 1987 Sun Bowl team that defeated West Virginia. Meacham blocked for both 1988 Heisman Trophy winner Barry Sanders and two-time Big Eight Player of the Year Thurman Thomas.
- In high school, Meacham was a three-year starter and two-time all-district selection at Arlington's Sam Houston High School.
- Meacham graduated from Oklahoma State in 1988. He and his wife, Kendall, have three children: Peyton, Cole and Brooks.
