#### **Series Histories**

UCF: The former conference foes have met 28 times dating back to their first meeting in 2006 with a 15-13 margin for ECU, including the final two meetings both in 2023. The Pirates are 2-4 against the Knights in the Kim McNeill era. The final meeting in the series was on Feb. 18, 2023, a 63-57 decision in Greenville. Danae McNeal's 19 points led four ECU players into double figures scoring while Amiya Joyner had a double-double with 15 points and 12 boards.

Illinois State: The Pirates and Redbirds have met just once, way back on Jan. 14, 1977 in a neutral site game in Harrisburg, Va. Illinois State won the game 75-55. ECU was led in scoring by Gale Kerbaugh with 17 to go with seven rebounds. Cindy Ellis led Illinois State in the win with 16 points while Charlotte Lewis had a double-double on 15 points and 12 boards for the Redbirds.

Hofstra: The Pirates and Pride have met just once, back on Dec. 3, 2000 in Greenville as part of the Lady Pirate Classic. ECU won the game 71-50. Tamilla Murray led the team with 16 points in the game while Angela Sye hauled in 15 rebounds.

### HEAD Rim McDeill

#### Family. Academics. Basketball



Kim McNeill heads into her seventh season at the helm after agreeing to contract terms to become head women's basketball coach at East Carolina University on March 28, 2019. On April 28, 2023, McNeill agreed to a contract extension securing her position through the 2026-27 season. Through six seasons at ECU, McNeill has compiled a 87-92 record leading the Pirates.

Now the second-longest tenured coach in the American, McNeill led the Pirates to a third straight winning record in 2024-25, finishing 17-15 on the year with an 8-10 mark in American Conference Play. The team reached the conference tournament quarterfinal, winning a league tournament game for the third-straight season for the first time since 2010-13. In so doing, she guided Amiya Joyner to First Team All-Conference recognition. During the season, the Pirates once again broke the program single-game attendance record with 6,865 in attendance against Howard. It was the third time the program attendance record had been broken during McNeill's tenure.

2023-24 was a season of resilience for McNeill and her Pirates. Despite multiple season-ending injuries, the team still finished with a 19-14 record, including a 9-9 record in American Conference play. The team also made a phenomenal run to reach the American Tournament Final for the second year in a row. It

was the first time the Pirates had reached league finals in consecutive seasons since 1991 and 1992. In doing so, the Pirates won three games in three days, including a win over top-seeded Tulsa in the quarterfinal round. The Pirates posted some remarkable stats on the year, once again reaching the top 10 in program history in steals and turnovers forced as even shorthanded, McNeill's signature defense was a force to be reckoned with. The team also posted the second most blocks in ECU history and the second highest free-throw percentage in program history, a marked improvement under McNeill's leadership.

McNeill also once again guided individuals to tremendous success in her fifth year at the helm. Danae McNeal became the second Pirate in five years to win a second Defensive Player of the Year Award as well as being named unanimous First Team All-Conference. McNeal and Lashonda Monk, both under McNeill's tutelage are the only players in American Athletic Conference history to win the award twice. McNeal also posted a record-breaking season with the second-most points in a season in ECU history, the fifth-most steals and finished her career at ninth in career scoring, sixth in career steals and third in free throw percentage. Additionally receiving honors, transfer forward Tatyana Wyche was named to the American All-Newcomer squad after posting a career season with 6.8 points and 6.4 rebounds as well as 51 blocks, seventh in ECU history in a season.

McNeill's fourth season was a breakout for the Pirates which saw the head coach named American Conference Coach of the Year while leading the team to a 23-10 record and a third-place finish in the conference in the regular season. The team then made a run, winning three games in three days to claim the 2023 American Tournament Championship and the third NCAA Tournament bid in program history where the Pirates earned a 13-seed and traveled to Austin to play the No. 4-seed Texas Longhorns. In the American Championship Game, the Pirates trailed Houston by as many as 11 after scoring just two points in the first quarter before clawing back using their defense and timely transition offense to claim the 46-44 win.

Under McNeill's tutelage on the year, Danae McNeal was named American Conference Defensive Player of the Year and Most Improved Player and Amiya Joyner was named Freshman of the Year while torching the program record books. Synia Johnson was named American Tournament Most Outstanding Player and Amiya Joyner was named to the All-Tournament Team. McNeill's group also played their classic signature defense, breaking program records for single season steals (428), turnovers forced (790) and scoring defense (56.7). The Pirates also finished nationally ranked in several categories, finishing third in steals per game, fifth in turnover margin, third in turnovers forced per game and 24th in scoring defense.

In McNeill's third season, Taniyah Thompson was named the American Conference Most Improved Player in addition to earning conference First-Team honors.

McNeill's second season at the helm once again saw the Pirates near the top of the country in steals. East Carolina checked in at fifth in steals per game, grabbing 12.1 per game. The Pirates were also seventh in the NCAA in turnovers forced (22.05) and 13th in turnover margin (+6.23). The Pirates finished sixth in the American, their highest finish in the league since finishing in fifth in 2014-15.

McNeill once again saw Lashonda Monk earn American Conference Defensive Player of the Year honors under her tutelage. Monk became the first player in American Conference history to not only win consecutive Defensive Player of the Year awards, but the first to ever win it a second time. Monk finished the season leading the American and ranking 13th in the country in steals per game at 2.95 per game, earning American Second Team All-Conference honors as well. Dominique Claytor was also in the top-35 of the country in steals per game, ranking 33rd with 2.64.

In McNeill's first season in Greenville, the Pirates made history on the defensive end. ECU finished second in the country in steals (407), steals per game (13.6) and turnovers forced (24.10) as well as third in turnover margin (+8.13). The 407 steals by ECU were both a school record and both Lashonda Monk (third) and Dominique Claytor (14th) finished in the top-14 of the nation in steals.

Under McNeill's guidance, Monk put together one of the best individual seasons in ECU history. The junior guard finished the season with 125 steals, breaking both the ECU and the American Conference single-season record and finishing third in the NCAA. Monk became the first ECU player to win the American Conference Defensive Player of the Year award and was named Second Team All-Conference. Monk also made history by breaking the ECU career steals record as well as becoming the 23rd Pirate to reach the 1,000 career points plateau.

McNeill was a three-year letterwinner and co-captain at Richmond, where she received her bachelor's degree in sport science in 2000.

On the court, she was named to the Colonial Athletic Association All-Defensive Team as a senior. Prior to transferring to Richmond, she earned 1996 Big South Conference Rookie-of-the-Year honors at Radford.

McNeill is the proud mother of twins, Cayden and Gabrielle.

#### O Captain, My Captain

Seniors Jayla Hearp, Anzhané Hutton and Bobbi Smith have been named Team Captains for the 2025-26 season. The trio are the lone returners from last season and Hearp and Smith are the only remaining players from the Pirates' 2023 American Tournament Championship.

#### The Expectations Game

The Pirates were picked seventh in the American Athletic Conference Preseason Poll. No individuals earned preseason All-Conference nods.

#### **Returning Production**

The three returning players account for 1,749 minutes played last season. Just 27.01 percent of the team's total minutes played. The Pirates return just 29.18 percent of their scoring from a season ago (586/2008 points). The team returns 22.83 percent of rebounds (285/1248) and 24.66 percent of assists (109/442).

#### **Incoming Production**

The Pirates bring in a combined 2,228 points, 1,054 rebounds, 400 assists, 320 steals and 68 blocks across four incoming transfer players with collegiate playing experience.

» Taylor Barner, a four-star 92-rated recruit by ESPN out of high school, is the lone transfer who has not logged collegiate minutes, missing 2024-25 due to injury.

#### Historic Outing

Redshirt-freshman Taylor Barner scored 32 points on 13-22 from the field against Charleston Southern. It is the most points by a freshman since Ariyana Williams' 34 in 2017; the most field goals by a player in her first season of DI college basketball since Cherie Mills, a JUCO transfer, made 17 in 2005; and the most field goals ever by an ECU freshman since at least 1976-77 when game-by-game records became available.

#### **Old Dominion Game Notables**

- The game was played with 5.432 in attendance. It was the eighth largest home crowd in program history.
- ECU missed its final 12 shots of the second quarter.
- Anzhané Hutton led ECU in scoring and rebounding with 26 and 23. Hutton has led ECU in scoring in three games and in rebounding every game this season. All nine players who played scored.
- ECU has made multiple three pointers in 12 consecutive games dating back to Feb. 15, 2025 vs. Charlotte.
- ECU has made 34 three-point baskets in the first four games of the season, the most since 34 to start the 2016-17 season.
