>:415	ISU's Audi Crooks (player) and BYU's Sydney Benally (freshman) garnered Big I2 women's
	basketball awards for the fourth week of the 2025-26 season. Arizona's Daniah Trammell, UCF's
	Leah Harmon and KU's S'Mya Nichols joined the duo on the Big I2 Starting Five, which highlights
	strong performances from around the league. Crooks also earned national weekly honors from
	the LISBWA

2:41[Crooks posted lowa State single-game records for points (47) and field goals (19) against
	Indiana. The 47 points are the most nationally in a game this season and tied for the fourth
	most in Big I2 history for a single game, while her I9 made field goals also tie for fourth in league
	history (through Nov. 30).

- Entering the week, Arizona State is 8-0 this season after going I0-22 (.313) last season. The +.687 improvement in win percentage is the second largest of any DI team.
- Baylor's Kiersten Johnson has blocked at least five shots in three games this season, tied for the most in Division I through four weeks.
- TCU is holding opponents to 29.6% shooting this season, best in Division I going into the fifth week. This is the school's lowest mark within any eight-game span this century.
- lowa State's Audi Crooks is the only DI player since 2000-0I to average 25.0+ points on 70.0+ percent shooting through her first nine games of the season. Her 246 total points are the most by a Big I2 player through nine games since Baylor's Odyssey Sims in 2013-14 (265).
- The Conference ranks third nationally in winning percentage (104-27, .794) following the first four weeks of the season, including a 7-4 mark against the ACC.
- All-session and Weekend Pass tickets for the 2026 Phillips 66 Big I2 Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale. The premier postseason event returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the third consecutive season. The Tournament will begin Wednesday, March 4, with the championship game slated for Sunday, March 8, unless BYU advances to the final, in which case the game will be moved to Monday, March 9. Tickets are available on BigI2Sports.com.
- At Big I2 Basketball Media Days presented by New Era, the Conference announced a leaguewide women's basketball documentary. The series puts a never-before-seen spotlight on the Conference's coaches and players heading into the season. All three episodes are available now on the league's official YouTube channel.

- Iowa State's Audi Crooks has scored at least IO points in 76 straight games entering the week, the longest active streak in Division I. It is the longest run by a Big I2 player since Baylor's Brittney Griner had a II6-game stretch from March 2010 to March 2013.
- Crooks is one of two DI (men's or women's), NBA or WNBA players this century to have at least 25.0 points per game and a 75.0 field goal percentage through five games of a season. The other was Oklahoma's Blake Griffin (2008-09).
- Oklahoma State's 72 made 3-pointers are the most by a Division I team through its >:41 first five games since at least 1999-2000.
- West Virginia took a 57-49 win over then-No. I5 Duke with just five available WVU players in the second half. The 49 points mark the fewest points a team has given up against a top 25 team entering the fourth week of the year.
- The opening day of the season was the fifth time since 2000-01 that the Big I2 went a perfect 9-0 or better on a single day and it was the first one where each team allowed fewer than 65 points.
- 7:41 The Big I2 is the only conference to have multiple freshmen with 28+ point games during the first four weeks of the season (Lena Girardi, OSU vs. Langston - 29 points & Jaliya Davis, KU vs. Northwestern State - 28 points).
- The Big I2 announced a multi-year extension of its long-standing sponsorship with 2:11 Phillips 66, continuing the brand's role as the title partner of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments. The 2026 Phillips 66 Big I2 Women's Basketball Tournament returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center March 4-8/9.
- The Conference's preseason coaches' honors were headlined by lowa State's Audi Crooks (Player), TCU's Olivia Miles (Newcomer) and Cincinnati's Dee Alexander (Freshman).
- TCU was selected as the favorite in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time in program history. The Horned Frogs swept the regular season and postseason Big I2 titles during the 2024-25 campaign and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in school history.
- The Horned Frogs were also the top pick in the Big I2 media preseason poll, which was voted on by Big I2 and national media members. A full listing of preseason honors can be found on Page 2.
- The Big I2 Conference, in partnership with ESPN and FOX Sports, announced its women's basketball linear television schedule for the 2025-26 season, the most games picked up for national broadcast from the league's television package in seven years. A total of 20 league-controlled selections will be showcased by the Conference's broadcast partners throughout the season, plus other marquee matchups at neutral sites.
- Four league teams have new head coaches entering the 2025-26 season: Arizona -Becky Burke, Arizona State - Molly Miller, BYU - Lee Cummard, Houston - Matthew
- 2:41 Iowa State's Crooks and TCU's Miles helped Team USA capture the 2025 FIBA Americup title, as the Big I2 further solidified its reputation as a global leader in women's basketball. More than 20 student-athletes from the Big I2 competed in international events across the globe this summer.
- Crooks and Miles were also named to ESPN.com's Top 25 women's NCAA basketball players entering the season. The Big I2 was one of two leagues to have multiple teams with at least one player in the top IO. A full listing of preseason national honors can be found on Page 6.
- The Big I2 has had at least seven teams make the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons, while the league has had four straight seasons with at least six Conference teams making March Madness. Four of the last five NCAA tournaments have featured multiple Big I2 teams in the Sweet I6.
- In 2024-25, the Big I2 led the nation with a .743 home winning percentage (200-69) and was one of three conferences to have over I million in total attendance for the season. The Big I2 had five teams win at least 25 games last season, tied for the most among all DI conferences.
