**A DIFFERENT LEAGUE**

**XII** Four Big 12 teams are ranked in the AP Top 25 Women's College Basketball Poll. Iowa State is No. 11, TCU is No. 13, Baylor is No. 16 and Texas Tech is No. 17. West Virginia and Oklahoma State received votes. The Conference joins the Big Ten and SEC as the only three leagues to have at least four ranked teams.

**XII** The league has 12 teams inside the top 65 of the NET rankings released Jan. 5. TCU is No. 9, West Virginia is No. 17, Texas Tech is No. 20, Iowa State is No. 23, Baylor is No. 28, Oklahoma State is No. 32, Utah is No. 42, Arizona State is No. 44, BYU is No. 46, Kansas is No. 53, K-State is No. 61 and Colorado is No. 63.

**XII** The Big 12 joins the Big Ten and SEC as the three leagues nationally that have a non-conference winning percentage above .800 this season. No other league outside of those three has a non-conference winning percentage above .700 as of Dec. 29.

**XII** Texas Tech enters the week as one of four undefeated teams left in the country. The Big 12 joins the SEC as the only two leagues to have at least eight teams with 13 wins going into Week 10.

**XII** The Big 12 ranks second among Power Four leagues in total record against P4 opponents after nine weeks (19-14, .576). The Conference is 8-4 against the ACC and 6-4 versus the Big Ten.

**XII** Entering the week, the Conference has three of the four players nationally averaging at least 20.0 points per game this season, all doing so in less than 30 minutes per game (BU's Taliah Scott, ISU's Audi Crooks, KU's Jaliya Davis).

**XII** The Big 12 has had seven different teams defeat an AP Top 25 opponent this season, the second most among all DI conferences going into the 10th week of the year.

**XII** Baylor's Taliah Scott (player) and Kansas' Jaliya Davis (freshman) earned weekly Big 12 women's basketball recognition for the ninth week of the 2025-26 season. Iowa State's Audi Crooks, TCU's Olivia Miles and Utah's Lani White join the pair on the Big 12 Starting Five, which highlights strong performances from around the league. Scott also earned USBWA national honors for the week.

**XII** Scott hit the game-winning shot over then-No. 10 Iowa State to give Baylor its first top-10 road victory since Dec. 30, 2023. The guard from Orange Park, Florida scored all 21 of her points in the second half. Scott started the week putting up 24 points in her first full game back from injury, helping the Bears erase a 19-point third quarter deficit to defeat Oklahoma State 77-68.

**XII** Davis scored 20+ points in both of KU's games while averaging 23.5 points per game for the week. The freshman started with 21 points in her return from injury against West Virginia before adding 26 points in an 83-68 victory over UCF, where she shot 10-of-12 from the field.

**XII** Crooks averaged over 30 points per game for ISU while posting her 80th and 81st consecutive career games with double-figure scoring. Miles notched her Big 12 single-season record fourth triple-double to join Caitlin Clark (Iowa) and Sabrina Ionescu (Oregon) as the only players in women's college basketball history to have at least 10 career triple-doubles. White scored 25 points, including a game-tying three with 12 seconds left in the fourth quarter, as Utah claimed its 11th top-10 victory in program history with an 87-77 overtime victory over then-No. 8 TCU.

**XII** At Big 12 Basketball Media Days presented by New Era, the Conference announced a league-wide women's basketball documentary. The series puts a never-before-seen spotlight on the Conference's coaches and players heading into the season. All three episodes are available now on the [league's official YouTube channel](#).

- All-session and Weekend Pass tickets for the 2026 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale. The premier postseason event returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the third consecutive season. The Tournament will begin Wednesday, March 4, with the championship game slated for Sunday, March 8, unless BYU advances to the final, in which case the game will be moved to Monday, March 9. Tickets are available on [Big12Sports.com](https://Big12Sports.com).
- BYU is averaging 11.40 steals and 4.67 blocks per game through nine weeks. The last Big 12 team to finish a campaign with such marks was Baylor in 2002-03 (12.43, 5.83).
- Iowa State's Audi Crooks has scored at least 15 points and shot at least 55.0% from the field in 17 straight games dating back to last season. That is the longest streak by any DI (men's or women's), NBA or WNBA player this century.
- TCU's Olivia Miles is on pace to be the first DI player this century (men's or women's) to average at least 19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 7.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game in a single season.
- Texas Tech is the second Big 12 team all-time to start a season 16-0 while holding each opponent to under 70 points.
- West Virginia's Sydney Shaw and Kierra Wheeler are one of two DI duos this season to each have at least 200 points, 30 steals and 10 blocks. They are the only Big 12 duo this century to both reach those marks through 15 team games in a season.
- Iowa State's Audi Crooks has scored at least 10 points in 81 straight games entering the week, the longest active streak in Division I. It is the longest run by a Big 12 player since Baylor's Brittney Griner had a 116-game stretch from March 2010 to March 2013. She also leads the nation in points per game entering week 10 (29.1).
- TCU and Texas Tech rank in the top four nationally in both field goal percentage defense (TCU - No. 2, 30.8%, TTU - No. 4, 31.9%) and scoring defense (TCU - No. 2, 51.9%, TTU - No. 3, 52.1%) going into the 10th week of the year.
- Iowa State enters the week ranked first nationally in assist/turnover ratio (2.05).
- The Big 12 is the only league entering the week to have two players in the top four nationally for assists per game with ISU's Jada Williams (No. 3, 7.9) and TCU's Olivia Miles (No. 4, 7.7).
- Kansas' Elle Evans leads the country in 3-point percentage (52.1%) after nine weeks.
- KU's S'Mya Nichols (No. 1, 113) and BU's Taliah Scott (No. 2, 105) lead the nation in made free throws entering week 10.
- Entering week 10, the league has had 10 different teams score at least 100 points in a game this season. That is the most for the Big 12 in any campaign all-time.
- TCU's Olivia Miles and Marta Suarez became the second duo in NCAA history to post triple-doubles in the same game (first against an NCAA Division I Opponent). Miles became the first Big 12 player ever to have three straight triple-doubles and is the third player to do so all-time. The seven triple-doubles are the most in league history for a single season, while the four different players to have a triple-double so far this year are tied for the most in Conference history.
- Texas Tech's attendance of 15,098 against Jacksonville is the second most in league history. TTU joins UConn, Maryland and South Carolina as the only three schools so far this season to have over 15,000 in attendance at a single game. It was the first sellout since March 1, 2006, for Texas Tech.
- The Iowa State - Iowa matchup was the most-watched women's Jimmy V Classic Game ever with 1.0M viewers, was ESPN's 2nd most-watched Nov./Dec. game ever and was the most-watched NCAA women's basketball game across all networks so far this season.
- ISU's Jada Williams' 12 assists against No. 11 Iowa are tied for the most nationally in a victory over a top 25 team entering Week 10.
- West Virginia took a 57-49 win over then-No. 15 Duke with just five available WVU players in the second half. The 49 points mark the fewest points a team has given up against a top 25 team entering the seventh week of the year.
- The opening day of the season was the fifth time since 2000-01 that the Big 12 went a perfect 9-0 or better on a single day and it was the first one where each team allowed fewer than 65 points.
- The Big 12 announced a multi-year extension of its long-standing sponsorship with Phillips 66, continuing the brand's role as the title partner of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments. The 2026 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Tournament returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center March 4-9.
- The Conference's preseason coaches' honors were headlined by Iowa State's Audi Crooks (Player), TCU's Olivia Miles (Newcomer) and Cincinnati's Dee Alexander (Freshman).
- TCU was selected as the favorite in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time in program history. The Horned Frogs swept the regular season and postseason Big 12 titles during the 2024-25 campaign and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in school history.
- The Horned Frogs were also the top pick in the Big 12 media preseason poll, which was voted on by Big 12 and national media members. A full listing of preseason honors can be found on Page 2.
- The Big 12 Conference, in partnership with ESPN and FOX Sports, announced its women's basketball linear television schedule for the 2025-26 season, the most games picked up for national broadcast from the league's television package in seven years. A total of 20 league-controlled selections will be showcased by the Conference's broadcast partners throughout the season, plus other marquee matchups at neutral sites.
- Four league teams have new head coaches entering the 2025-26 season: Arizona - Becky Burke, Arizona State - Molly Miller, BYU - Lee Cummard, Houston - Matthew Mitchell.
- Iowa State's Crooks and TCU's Miles helped Team USA capture the 2025 FIBA Americup title, as the Big 12 further solidified its reputation as a global leader in women's basketball. More than 20 student-athletes from the Big 12 competed in international events across the globe this summer.
- Crooks and Miles were also named to ESPN.com's Top 25 women's NCAA basketball players entering the season. The Big 12 was one of two leagues to have multiple teams with at least one player in the top 10. A full listing of preseason national honors can be found on Page 6.
- The Big 12 has had at least seven teams make the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons, while the league has had four straight seasons with at least six Conference teams making March Madness. Four of the last five NCAA tournaments have featured multiple Big 12 teams in the Sweet 16.
- In 2024-25, the Big 12 led the nation with a .743 home winning percentage (200-69) and was one of three conferences to have over 1 million in total attendance for the season. The Big 12 had five teams win at least 25 games last season, tied for the most among all DI conferences.
