THE BREAKDOWN

Mission Accomplished

In the program's fourth annual Space Game, the 'Nauts upset Colorado 74-68 in Orlando, proving everything is better in space. Summer Yancy set a career-high with 25 points, six field goals and a game-leading five three pointers. Mahogany Chandler-Roberts produced her fifth game with 10 more points this season and her fourth in the last six Big 12 contests. The win was also in large part due to a season-best 25 points in the second quarter, outscoring the Buffs 25-10 behind a 20-2 run over a seven minute stretch. - [See Page 6 For Space Game History](#)

Yancy Fancy's the Three

With the sophomore's previous career high of 14 left in the dust, Summer Yancy became just the sixth player in the Sytia Messer era (since 2022-23) to score 25 or more points. Yancy is now one of three players in the Big 12 to have 25 or more points, six or more rebounds, and four or more assists in a single game. The Kansas City native is now averaging 7.7 points per game in conference play.

It's Khy Time

Junior Khyala Ngodu led UCF to its first Big 12 win of the season at Arizona with a dominant 22-point, 13-rebound double-double in Tucson, also adding a team-leading five assists and four steals. The performance ranks among the best in the Big 12 this season, as Ngodu is one of four players in the Big 12 this season to secure a 20-point double-double in a conference game (Audi Crooks - Iowa State, Marta Suarez - TCU, Reese Ross - Utah). It joins a similar 21-point, 13-rebound performance against Wake Forest at the Discover Puerto Rico Shootout on Nov. 27. Ngodu is one of just 12 players in the NCAA this season to record 20+ points, 10+ rebounds, 4+ assists and 4+ steals in a single game (1 of 4 in Power 4). The junior followed it up with her second-consecutive double-double vs. Cincinnati and yet another at No. 14 Baylor (three in five games).

Harmon's Career Day

The best in a line of incredible performances to open her UCF account, Leah Harmon scored 38 points vs. Kansas on Jan. 4, a career high for the sophomore and the third most by a Knight in a single game since 1999. The total also marks the fifth most by a player in the Big 12 this season, the second most by a player in a Big 12 matchup, and is tied for the 18th most points by a player in the NCAA this season. The New Jersey native now ranks eighth in the Big 12 with 15.7 points per game.

NOTES

After stumbling during a five game losing streak, the Cyclones have bounced back in emphatic fashion, taking down Cincinnati and Arizona at home by a combined 50 points before going on the road and upsetting No. 21 Texas Tech 84-70. The hosts are led by the nation's leading scorer Audi Crooks, who averages 26.6 points per game, while also ranking third in the NCAA in field goal percentage (67.6). As a team, the Cyclones spread the ball across the court, ranking first in the Big 12 and fifth in the NCAA with 21 assists per game.

KNIGHT NOTES**Paint Production**

UCF has been dominant in the paint through the season, outscoring its opposition 674-588 (+74) below the basket. The Knights have tallied two 52-point outings and five 40-plus-point performances in the paint, winning the matchup 11 of 20 contests. UCF's post players are averaging nearly 30 points a game, with Khyala Ngodu leading the charge with 10.9 points per game.

Everybody Eats

Before the season, coach Messer talked about her excitement about the depth of the squad, with all 14 players having the ability to make an impact. Through 20 games, that sentiment rings true, as the Knights currently rank seventh in the Big 12 with 21.4 points per game off the bench. In non-conference action, the Black and Gold's bench outscored their opponents bench 379-273 (+106), reaching 20-plus in 10 contests and 30-plus in five games. Overall, UCF has outscored its opponents bench 427-325 (+102).

Harmon's Hot Start

Miami transfer and sophomore guard Leah Harmon has been dominant through her first 19 games, leading the Knights in scoring with 16.1 points per game, setting a career high with 38 points against Kansas on Jan. 3. Harmon's 306 points through her first 19 contests at UCF are the second most by a transfer this decade and the second most by any Knight in the first 19 games of a season since 2015. The sophomore has connected on five field goals in 14 of 19 games, including three 25-plus points outings, while shooting 38.0 from beyond the arch. Harmon currently ranks eighth in the Big 12 with 16.1 points per game. **Points average in a non-conference slate since 1999:**

KNIGHTS NOTES**Leah Named to Big 12 Starting Five**

Fresh off yet another career week, which saw Leah Harmon score 78 points across four games, the sophomore has been named to the Big 12 Starting Five as a top performer, becoming the third Knight to secure a weekly honor since joining the conference. Averaging 19.5 points as the Black and Gold went 3-1, including a 2-1 record at the Discover Puerto Rico Shootout in San Juan, Harmon has broken records throughout her opening eight games of the season. Across the four games, Harmon never scored below 17 points, matching that total in three contests before setting a career high with 27 points in a 57-56 win over Rice. The Miami transfer's 27 points were the sixth-most in a UCF neutral site game in program history, while her 10 free throws made her just the 16th Knight since 1999 to reach double digits. Harmon has tallied five or more field goals in her first eight games of the season, becoming the first player to do so to open their Black and Gold career. A true three-level scorer, Harmon connected on multiple three-pointers in each game, including three in her final two contests of the week.

Non-Conference Rundown

The Knights posted an 8-3 record in head coach Sytia Messer's fourth non-conference slate with the Knights. The win marked Messer's 100th career win across seven seasons and two schools, joining the century club in a dominating 78-56 triumph over Morgan State. Messer has tallied eight or more non-conference wins in each season at UCF. The Black and Gold outscored their opponents 799-625 (+174), winning four contests by 20+ points, while all three defeats came by a combined 10 points.

Tales from Puerto Rico

The Knights went 2-1 across three competitive games at the 2025 Discover Puerto Rico Classic, defeating East Carolina 75-61 to open action. UCF scored 52 points in the paint to fend off the Pirates, marking the first time the Knights have reached that total since Dec. 7, 2024 against Texas Southern. Against Wake Forest, the Knights ventured to their fourth overtime contest under coach Messer, eventually falling by five despite grabbing a season-high 20 offensive boards and 17 second chance points. In the finale against Rice, the Black and Gold held on for their 700th win in program history, with Harmon's 27 points leading them to their sixth victory of the season.

Buckets on Buckets

The Knights produced a historic shooting clip against Florida A&M in their convincing 76-59 triumph on Nov. 21, connecting on 55.1% of field goal attempts, a mark that ranks 11th in program history and the best percentage under head coach Sytia Messer. The performance was the best shooting performance since a March 2, 2020 contest with Wichita State (56.1). UCF's previous best under Messer came in a Dec. 19, 2023 triumph over Morgan State (54.8).

67... And Many More

In the program's annual kids day game, a strong second-half performance from the Knights propelled them past FIU, 79-61, the most points scored by UCF in the young season... The host's success was in large part due to their success from the free throw line, connecting on 18 of 20 attempts, breaking the program record for single-game free throw percentage with at least 20 attempts (90%)... Previous high came on Jan. 13, 2011 against UAB (0.899, 24-27).

On Island Time

The Knights competed in the 2025 Discover Puerto Rico Shootout, marking the third time in program history and the second in three seasons. UCF took care of business against East Carolina, before falling in a overtime heartbreaker to Wake Forest, eventually closing action with a gritty win over Rice. Two years ago in San Juan, the Black and Gold dominated the field, claiming all three contests and the crown by 33 combined points, defeating Jackson State (63-54), St. John's (61-48) and Sacred Heart (69-58). Under coach Messer, the Knights are 9-3 in mid-season tournaments/invitational, boasting a 4-0 record in 2022, joining a 3-0 clip in 2023, before dropping a pair of contests in Las Vegas a season ago. All-time, the Knights are 85-83 in mid-season invitationals and tournaments.

Head coach Sytia Messer improved to 4-0 in season openers with the Knights as her squad dominated Bethune-Cookman 75-36 in front of 6,000-plus at Addition Financial Arena... The 39-point win margin also stands as the second-largest victory under Messer, sitting just a point away from the 40-point win against Winthrop (72-32)... All-time the Knights are 26-23 in season openers and 35-14 in home openers... In the four contests, UCF has outscored its opponents 324-175 in season-opening contests

Sunshine State Dominance

The Knights have won seven of their last eight games against in-state opponents, boasting a 3-1 record to match their win total from 2024-25. Wins over Bethune-Cookman, FIU and Florida A&M continue the trend of success against in-state foes, as coach Messer boasts a 7-4 record against Florida opponents. Across their last seven contests with Florida opposition, the Knights have outscored them a combined 551-392 (+159), scoring 65-plus in each game.

KNIGHTS NOTES

Tamed the Wildcats

The Wildcats mustered just 36 points, the second-fewest points the Knights have allowed in the Messer era, and four off the 32 points Winthrop scored in Messer's first game in charge on November 7, 2022... Moreover, Bethune-Cookman's 14 first-half points were the fewest in any half allowed since the Knights held Campbell to 11 second-half points on Dec. 3, 2023... The Wildcats failed to score in double digits over the first two quarters, adding just 10 in the third and 12th in the fourth.

Home Court Advantage

Head coach Sytia Messer has found consistent success at Addition Financial Arena since her first season in 2022-23... The Knights have boasted a combined 35-24 record in home contests over the past four years... During her first slate with the Black and Gold, the Knights went 11-5 at home, before an 8-8 record in 2023-24 and a 9-7 record in 2024-25. UCF is 7-5 in 2025-26 with six wins through nine games this season.

Sweet November

Always striving to open the season on the front foot, coach Messer and the Knights have compiled a 22-4 record in the month of November, including a pair of undefeated marks throughout her first two seasons... A 6-2 record last year was highlighted by six straight to open the season, all at home, before falling in a pair of contests in Las Vegas, which stand as the lone defeats in November under Messer... This season, the Knights went 6-2 through eight games in the month.

Returning Knights

Coach Messer returns a pair of key frontcourt contributors in Khyala Ngodu and Mahogany Chandler-Roberts, along with versatile playmaker Summer Yancy... The formers saw minutes in all but one game last season (29 of 30), with Ngodu garnering starts down the stretch with four double-digit-point performances in her last six contests... Ngodu set career marks in points (6.9 p/g) and rebounds (5.9 p/g)... Chandler-Roberts and Yancy each contributed as freshmen under Messer, with the latter boasting an efficient .458 shooting percentage, while Chandler-Roberts was one of four to secure 100-plus rebounds.

Portal Additions

Eight transfers add a combined 17 seasons of collegiate experience to Orlando, as coach Messer added both physicality and Power Four experience to her roster. Savannah Scott (Auburn) boasted a standout freshman season two seasons ago, while Leah Harmon (Miami) and Kayanna Cox (SMU) each contributed to their respective teams as first years... Kristol Ayson (Tulsa) and Jacorriah Bracey (Southern Miss) each hold four years of experience themselves, while Jasmyne Gibson (North Florida) was named to the All-Atlantic Sun Freshman Team in 2024-25... Pensacola State transfer Audreonia Benson was named First-Team All-Panhandle and averaged 11.9 points per game in two seasons with the Pirates. Logan Reed (Texas A&M Corpus Christi) rounds out the exciting transfer class after redshirting her freshman season.


Freshmen Sensations







Sytia Messer (pronounced sit-TEE-uh) enters her fourth season as head coach of the UCF Knights. A 24-year coaching veteran, Messer was named the 13th head coach in UCF women's basketball history on April 3, 2022.

In her second season at UCF, Messer led the Knights to a record-breaking 8-0 start to the 2023-24 campaign. Her debut season featured a 6-0 start—the program's second-best since a 7-0 opening in 1984-85. Messer also helped guide the Knights through their inaugural season in the Big 12 Conference, producing an All-Big 12 Second Team selection in league-leading scorer Kaitlyn Peterson.

Messer came to UCF following a season as associate head coach at LSU (2021-22) under Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer and AP National Coach of the Year Kim Mulkey. Before that, she spent eight seasons as an assistant coach on Mulkey's staff at Baylor (2013-21), helping the Bears compile a remarkable 260-23 (.918) record, including eight Big 12 regular-season titles, six conference tournament championships, an NCAA title in 2019, and six Elite Eight appearances.

During her time at Baylor, Messer was instrumental in recruiting and scouting. She helped sign the nation's No. 1 recruiting classes in 2016 and 2018, and the No. 2 class in 2015. Her efforts brought in 15 top-50 players and 14 McDonald's All-Americans. Under her development, nine players were selected in the WNBA Draft, including Odyssey Sims (No. 2 overall in 2014), Alexis Jones (No. 12 in 2017), Kalani Brown (No. 7 in 2019), and Lauren Cox (No. 3 in 2020). Messer also played a key role in developing 2020 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Didi Richards and 2021 Wade Trophy winner and Big 12 Player of the Year Nalyssa Smith.

Baylor's success during Messer's tenure included six straight seasons of 32 or more wins, highlighted by a 37-1 record in 2018-19. Her coaching résumé at Baylor also featured 23 NCAA Tournament victories, 73 All-Big 12 selections, 20 All-America honorees, five Big 12 Players of the Year, 26 Academic All-Big 12 selections, and eight players on AP All-America teams, including first-teamers Sims (2014), Nina Davis (2014), Cox (2020), and Smith (2021, 2022).

Prior to her time at Baylor, Messer served as head coach at Tennessee Tech from 2009 to 2012. There, she led the Golden Eagles to a 54-41 record (.568), including a 23-8 mark in 2010-11, an Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) regular-season championship, and two postseason appearances (WNIT in 2011, WBI in 2012). She was named the 2011 OVC Coach of the Year.

Her earlier assistant coaching stops include Arkansas State (2000-02), where she began her coaching career, Memphis (2002-04), where she helped lead the Tigers to a 21-10 record and a WNIT appearance in 2003, and Georgia Tech (2004-09, 2012-13), where she played a key role on three straight NCAA Tournament teams from 2007 to 2009.

As a player, Messer starred at the University of Arkansas from 1995 to 1999, helping the Razorbacks reach the NCAA Final Four in 1998—the program's first ever. She was named Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA West Regional that year after scoring 24 points in a win over Kansas and leading Arkansas past Duke. That Razorback squad, seeded ninth, became the first unranked team in the modern era to reach the Final Four.

Messer finished her career ranked in the program's top 10 in points (1,379) and rebounds (603). She was a two-time team captain, a 1996 SEC All-Freshman honoree, and helped Arkansas win the 1999 WNIT title. She was inducted into the Razorbacks Hall of Honor in 2018 and named an SEC Legend in 2012.

She graduated from Arkansas in 2000 with a Bachelor of Science degree in kinesiology. Messer also played for Athletes in Action, both as a collegiate and post-graduate player, and completed the Center for Coaching Excellence program in 2012. She has served as an honorary chair for Habitat for Humanity and remains an influential voice in women's basketball.
