KNIGHT NOTES

TOPPED THE TIGERS - The UCF softball team concluded its season-opening seven-game homestand with a late-inning come-from-behind 5-1 victory over the Missouri Tigers Wednesday evening, pushing its record to 6-1 entering play in the 2026 Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational...the effort lifted the Knights back to even at 3-3 in six all-time meetings with Missouri, and UCF has now bested the Tigers in both of the teams' last two matchups dating back to the Knights' dramatic 6-5, eight-inning win in Orlando Feb. 11, 2025, a contest that saw UCF erase a 5-0 first-inning deficit to clinch the largest comeback win over a ranked opponent in program history...the Black and Gold also now boast a 6-1 start to a season for the second straight year.

RETURNING TO CLEARWATER - The UCF softball team makes its return to the Clearwater Invitational this weekend, partaking in the event for the fifth consecutive season...the Knights last season in Clearwater earned a 6-4, eight-inning win over the eventual ACC Tournament champion Clemson Tigers, and also previously earned notable victories over Texas Tech (7-3, 2022), then-No. 9 Texas (15-10, 2022), then-No. 25 Michigan (8-2, 2023), Mississippi State (6-5, 2023), and Wisconsin (21-9, 2024) in the tournament...UCF's showing in Clearwater last year was highlighted by then-freshman right-hander **Yessenia Lopez's** six-inning, nine-strikeout performance against Auburn, then-freshman utility **Izzy Mertes'** first career home run and then-freshman catcher **Beth Damon's** three-hit, three-RBI game against Clemson, and then-sophomore infielder **Sierra Humphreys'** three-RBI showing against Ohio State.

POWER SURGE - With two more home runs in their win over Missouri Wednesday night, the UCF softball team has totaled 11 long balls through their first seven games of the season, and 26 total extra-base hits (13 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs)...the Knights' 11 home runs represent the program's most through the first seven games of a season since the 2023 Knights slugged 12 through their first seven contests, and UCF's 26 extra-base hits so far represent the most any Knights team has totaled through the first seven games of a season in program history...junior second baseman **Sierra Humphreys** leads the team with seven extra-base hits (3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR), and nine players have notched at least one extra-base hit through seven games...joining Humphreys with at least two extra-base hits entering play in Clearwater are senior shortstop **Aubrey Evans** (2 2B, 1 HR), sophomore catcher **Beth Damon** (2 2B, 2 HR), and sophomore utility players **Izzy Mertes** (1 2B, 3 HR) and **Kendall Yarnell** (1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR).

YOUTH MOVEMENT - Of the Knights' first 39.0 innings pitched through seven games, the team's freshmen have been responsible for 28.2...freshman left-hander **Hildie Dempsey** represents UCF's innings leader through seven games, having totaled 12.0 and appeared in five of her team's seven games thus far...she most recently spun a personal season high 3.2 in the team's 5-1 win over Missouri Wednesday evening, allowing just two hits and one walk with one strikeout in relief...through her first five relief appearances, Dempsey has inherited eight baserunners, allowing just one to score, and owns a 1.75 ERA with two winning decisions and a .175 batting average-against...reigning Big 12 Freshman of the Week **Ava Stuewe** has been responsible for 6.2 innings thus far, throwing a scoreless sixth inning against Missouri Wednesday and leading the Knights to their first win of the season with four spotless frames against Boston U Feb. 5...freshman left-hander **Reagan Yokoun** has totaled 5.1 frames, striking out two in a scoreless first inning against Missouri Wednesday after spinning three scoreless frames with five strikeouts against Maryland Feb. 8...freshman right-hander **Tori Payne** has made two appearances so far, totaling 4.2 innings with just two runs allowed; she enjoyed a strong collegiate debut against CSU Bakersfield, throwing three scoreless innings with only a walk allowed.

A RECORD START - The Knights' 66 runs scored entering play Thursday represent the second most in program history through a season's first six games, second only to the 2021 team's 68, and mark the third-most runs scored by any team in the nation, behind only UCLA and Florida (68)...the Knights' +50 run differential entering play Thursday also represents the second-best through seven games in program history, behind only the 2021 squad (+55)...UCF's 13-0 win over Boston U marked the team's most prolific season-opener since 2021, when the program also topped FGCU by a 13-0 final score, and gave UCF its third straight sea-

son-opener with at least 10 runs scored after the squad bested Howard, 10-2, Feb. 8, 2024, and CSU Bakersfield, 10-0, Feb. 6, 2025...the Black and Gold's 23 combined runs between Thursday's two contests marked the most scored by the program in a single day since the 2012 Knights scored 27 runs between two games of a twin bill at UTEP April 6...UCF earned back-to-back shutout wins to start a season for the first time since the 2021 Knights kicked off their season with consecutive shutouts against FGCU, 13-0 and 8-0...the Knights' first five wins all came via a five-inning run rule, marking the first time in program history the Black & Gold had run-ruled their opposition in each of their first five wins of a season.

OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT - The UCF softball team earned wins in five of its first six games during the program's season-opening Black & Gold Classic, besting Boston U (13-0), CSU Bakersfield (10-0), Maryland twice (15-7, 9-1), and Buffalo (12-2)...the team earned its third straight 5-1 start, already having clinched a win over a 2025 conference champion (Boston U, Patriot League)...the Knights outscored their opposition 61-15 throughout their 5-1 start, hitting three grand slams, nine homers overall, and earning two shutout wins.

GRAND SLAM x3 - Among the offensive fireworks that highlighted the Knights' opening weekend, UCF saw two different players hit three grand slams...sophomore utility player **Kendall Yarnell** hit UCF's first home run of the season, a first-inning grand slam that helped lead her team to its 13-0 run-rule victory over Boston U Feb. 5, marking the second home run of her career, both of the pinch-hit variety...Yarnell then hit her second grand slam of the weekend in the bottom of the fourth inning of UCF's come-from-behind 15-7 win over Maryland Feb. 7...UCF's third grand slam of the weekend came off the bat of sophomore infielder/outfielder **Izzy Mertes**, part of her second career multi-homer game in the bottom of the second inning against Maryland Feb. 8...opening weekend marked the first time in program history that the Knights hit three grand slams in the span of one weekend...Yarnell became the second player in program history (**Stephanie Best**, 2003) to hit multiple grand slams in the span of one weekend, and she also became the second player in program history to hit a grand slam on opening day (**Ashley Van Ryn**, Feb. 10, 2006)...Yarnell also joins **Hillary Barrow**, **Farrah Sullivan**, **Jessica Ujvari** and **Cassady Brewer** with two career grand slams, all tied for the second most career grand slams in program history behind Best (3).

JUST GETTING STARTED - Freshman right-handed pitcher **Ava Stuewe** was named Big 12 Conference co-Freshman of the Week, along with Oklahoma State's **Jayelle Austin**, for her efforts throughout the first weekend of play...Stuewe, the first winner of the Big 12's newest weekly honor this spring, made three appearances, including two starts, throughout UCF's season-opening Black & Gold Classic, posting a spotless 0.00 ERA in 5.2 innings with six strikeouts...she was instrumental in leading her squad to its first win of the season, tossing four scoreless innings against Boston U Feb. 5, issuing just one hit while striking out four...she later saw action in both of the Knights' contests against Maryland, concluding her weekend on a high note with a scoreless fifth inning and two more punchouts in UCF's 9-1 win over the Terrapins Feb. 8.

MAGIC 8 BALL - Junior second baseman **Sierra Humphreys** has represented the Knights' offensive leader through the first seven games, slashing .556/.636/1.333 (10-for-18) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, four walks, 10 RBI and three stolen bases in three tries...she hit safely in each of the Knights' first seven games, driving in at least one run in each, and notched an extra-base hit in six of UCF's seven contests, including in each of the team's first four games...she enters play in Clearwater ranking among Big 12 Conference leaders in home runs (3, T-1st), stolen bases (3, T-1st), slugging percentage (1.333, 2nd), total bases (24, 2nd), total hits (10, T-2nd), doubles (3, T-3rd), RBI (10, T-3rd), runs scored (10, T-3rd), on-base percentage (.636, 5th), and average (.556, 6th)...following a strong first two years in Orlando, Humphreys entered the new season ranking among all-time UCF career leaders in batting average (min. 250 AB) (.346, 2nd), on-base percentage (.416, 4th), and slugging percentage (.500, 6th).

SPACE GAME MAGIC - As the Knights donned their Canaveral blue SpaceU uniforms for the first time in 2026 against the Maryland Terrapins Feb. 7, the team made a bit of history in its come-from-behind 15-7 run rule win...the contest marked the first time in program history UCF overcame a four-run deficit in a run rule victory, and also featured the highest-scoring inning (9 runs, fourth inning) since the Knights last season opened their April 18 game against then-No. 21 Oklahoma State with a nine-run first inning.

PROTECT THE PLEX - The Knights have demonstrated a strong ability to defend their home field under head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone**, having authored four consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins at the UCF Softball Complex and five such seasons in the first six (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season) during the Ball-Malone era overall (since and including 2019)...following its 5-1 win over Missouri Wednesday, UCF has produced an aggregate 149-56-1 (.726) record at home spanning Ball-Malone's first seven years.

RETURNING OFFENSE - The Knights return a significant percentage of their offensive exploits from the 2025 season, as 10 returning offensive players to this year's squad were responsible for 354 total hits (79.9%), 210 total runs scored (79.5%), 58 total doubles (75.3%), 40 home runs (87%), 193 RBI (80.4%) and 546 total bases (81%) in 2025...UCF also brings back four offensive All-Big 12 Conference selections and two offensive NFCA All-Region picks from the 2025 campaign...the Knights' returning offensive leaders by statistical category in 2025 include **Sierra Humphreys** (AVG - .355, OBP - .440, runs - 43, hits - 61), **Aubrey Evans** (SLG - .576, TB - 99, HR - 10), **Izzy Mertes** (2B - 16, BB - 30), and **Beth Damon** (RBI - 37).

EYE ON THE ROOKIES - A strong contingent of the Black and Gold's 2026 freshman class have been recognized on national preseason watch lists between D1Softball.com and Softball America...infielder **Kendall Trimm** and right-handed pitcher **Ava Stuewe** were both tabbed to D1Softball's D100 Freshman Watch List, while Trimm, Stuewe, outfielder **Ayala Durant**, left-handed pitcher/outfielder **Hildie Dempsey**, left-handed pitcher **Reagan Vokoun**, and right-handed pitcher **Tori Payne** were all included on Softball America's preseason freshman watch list...Trimm and Dempsey headline UCF's freshman class as members who garnered national rankings on Signing Day, as Trimm was tabbed the No. 57 player overall in the 2026 recruiting class by Softball America/On3, and No. 22 nationally on her club team by Extra Inning Softball in 2022...Dempsey, meanwhile, was slotted No. 33 overall in the 2026 signing class by PrepSoftball.com.

CINDY BALL-MALONE

Head Coach / Eighth Season

On the heels of a hall-of-fame collegiate playing career, UCF head softball coach Cindy Ball-Malone, also known by her nickname, “Bear,” has lifted the UCF softball program to new heights throughout her first seven seasons at the helm since she was named the second head coach in program history June 27, 2018.

Ball-Malone’s resume showcases:

- ◆ Eleven career seasons as an NCAA Division I head softball coach (the last seven at UCF), including seven postseason appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, and one NCAA super regional appearance

- ◆ Extensive player development, highlighted by three All-America selections, one National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selection, three national Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week selections, one American Athletic Conference AAC Pitcher of the Year selection, one AAC Rookie of the Year selection, and three consecutive top 25 nationally-ranked recruiting classes (Extra Inning Softball, 2021-23)

- ◆ Four additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Washington and Cal State Northridge, including two NCAA super regional appearances with the Huskies

- ◆ A playing career at the University of the Pacific that landed Ball-Malone among the selections for the 13th West Coast Conference Hall of Honor Class in 2023

Under “Coach Bear,” the UCF softball team is in the midst of the most successful period in the program’s 24-year history. With the team’s 35-24-1 record in 2025, the Knights re-wrote their record books on numerous occasions en route to UCF softball’s fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament berth and the 12th in program history.

In earning two wins during the 2025 NCAA Austin Regional, Ball-Malone also eclipsed the 250th win of her UCF tenure, as well as the 350th win of her head coaching career, and concluded the 2025 campaign boasting a 350-245-3 (.588) career record as a head coach, and a 251-129-3 (.659) mark through her seven years at UCF.

The Black and Gold’s current postseason run encompasses three consecutive 40-plus-win seasons (2021-23), five NCAA Regional appearances, one of which was hosted by the Knights at the UCF Softball Complex (2022), and the first NCAA regional championship and super regional appearance in program history (2022).

UCF’s 35-win season in 2025 marked a season high as a member of the Big 12 Conference, besting the program’s 31-win 2024 slate, and with seven top 25 ranked wins the group matched the 2022 Knights for the most ranked wins in a season in program history.

Under Ball-Malone’s leadership, the Black and Gold also recorded three wins over top four-ranked teams at the time of the contest, taking two of three from then-No. 4 Arizona March 7-9 to earn the highest-ranked series win in program history before the squad earned a 4-0 shutout victory over then-No. 3 Florida at home March 26.

The Knights did it behind two freshman All-America picks, three NFCA All-Region selections and five All-Big 12 Conference selections.

Redshirt freshman right-handed pitcher Isabella Vega led the way as a D1Softball Freshman First Team All-American, Softball America Freshman Second Team All-American, top 10 finalist for the NFCA’s National Freshman of the Year, NFCA All-Gulf Region First Team selection, All-Big 12 Conference First Team selection, All-Big 12 Conference Freshman Team selection, one-time Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week, two-time D1Softball National Freshman of the Week, and two-time Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Week.

Freshman catcher Beth Damon represented UCF’s second All-American in 2025, tabbed to D1Softball’s freshman second

team, and joined Vega and Izzy Mertes on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team. Junior shortstop Aubrey Evans and Sierra Humphreys were also added to the All-Big 12 Second Team, and Mertes and Evans were honored with NFCA All-Gulf Region Second and Third Team honors, respectively.

UCF's most recent campaign under Ball-Malone brought the Knights' win total to 66 through just two years as members of the Big 12 Conference, highlighted by two NCAA Tournament berths, one NCAA Regional Final appearance, 10 All-Big 12 Conference selections, five NFCA All-Region selections, five Big 12 Pitcher of the Week honors, one Big 12 Player of the Week honor and one Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week selection.

Through the final half of the Knights' tenure as members of the American Athletic Conference from 2019-23, Ball-Malone established her team as one of the league's elite programs. UCF won at least 34 games in every season, outside of the COVID-19-shortened 2020 slate that saw the Knights off to a 21-5-1 start prior to the season's cancellation, including three 40-plus-win seasons.

The Black and Gold in that span also earned NCAA Tournament berths in the program's final three seasons in The American from 2021-23, as well as one AAC regular-season title and two AAC tournament championships.

UCF's penultimate season in the AAC in 2022 represented among the best in program history, when Ball-Malone led her squad to a 49-14 overall record that featured the team's first time hosting the NCAA Regional round, its first NCAA Regional championship, and its first NCAA Super Regional berth.

Ball-Malone helped guide more than one team to new heights in 2022 as well, as she was named as an assistant coach for the USA National Team at the World Games and Canada Cup in the summer. The team won the gold medal at the World Games.

She joined the Knights following four seasons at Boise State University. In her last two campaigns, she compiled a 73-36 record and led the squad to the program's first postseason appearance at the 2017 National Invitational Softball Championship, followed by a 2018 NCAA Tournament berth.

In 2018, the Broncos set program records for most wins in a season (40), most conference wins in a season (18), and the first conference title in program history, defeating New Mexico in the Mountain West championship.

Ball-Malone brought a plethora of coaching experience into her first stop as a Division I head coach, highlighted by a two-year stint on staff with the Washington Huskies. In those two seasons, she served as recruiting coordinator and was responsible for the development of the Husky pitching staff. The Huskies went 76-35 during Ball-Malone's two seasons in Seattle and reached a pair of NCAA Super Regionals while developing Kaitlin Inglesby into a second team All-American.

Ball-Malone has also spent time coaching at Cal State Northridge, Cosumnes River College, Modesto Junior College, and her alma mater, Pacific

She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. Ball-Malone is considered the greatest two-way player in the history of Pacific Softball, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holding nine career pitching records for the Tigers.

Ball-Malone currently lives in Oviedo, Fla. with her husband, Robert Malone III. Together, they have four children, three boys named Four, Ryder and Cayson, and a girl named Sawyer.
