KNIGHT NOTES

STILLWATER SERIES W - The UCF softball team enters week two of Big 12 Conference play riding the high of its series win over the then-No. 12 Oklahoma State Cowgirls March 6-8, having taken the first and third games of the weekend set in Stillwater, Oklahoma...the Knights over the weekend made history on more than one occasion, first earning the program's first road win over Oklahoma State before clinching the first overall series win over the Cowgirls in program history...the effort also represented UCF's second road ranked Big 12 series win to kick off conference play in as many seasons, after the Knights also took two of three from then-No. 4 Arizona in Tucson March 7-9, 2025...with their two wins over the 12th-ranked Cowgirls, the Knights now own three ranked wins this spring, all over top 12 teams, joining the Black and Gold's 5-1 victory over then-No. 10 LSU during the 2026 Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational Feb. 14...UCF outscored the Cowgirls by an aggregate 11-7 throughout the weekend, and also claimed advantages in total hits (32-12), doubles (7-3), home runs (3-1), and total bases (50-18)...five Knights pitchers combined to hold the Cowgirls to a .162 batting average-against, allowing just the seven runs, only one of which were earned, in 20.2 innings...UCF's latest exploits also marked the program's ninth overall conference series victory since joining the Big 12 prior to the 2024 campaign, as the Knights have claimed at least one series against each of Kansas, Texas Tech, BYU, Houston, Iowa State, Arizona and Oklahoma State...Baylor joins Utah and Arizona State as one of the remaining three current Big 12 programs that UCF has yet to win a series against in the last two-plus years.

CLIMBING THE RANKS - For their efforts in Stillwater over the weekend, the Knights have been rewarded in the latest national top 25 polls, rising to as high as No. 15 in the nation (Softball America) and seeing their name represented in all four major polls for the first time this season...ranked No. 15 by Softball America, UCF also landed at No. 17 in DI Softball.com's week five rankings, and jumped to No. 22 in both the NFCA/GoRout coaches and ESPN/USA Softball polls...UCF's No. 15 national ranking is just two spots shy of the all-time high water mark for the program, behind the 2015 and 2022 Knights who climbed as high as No. 13 in the nation...after receiving votes in each of ESPN/USA Softball's first five rankings (including the preseason top 25), the Black and Gold appear within the poll's top 25 programs for the first time since week one of the 2023 campaign...six other Big 12 programs outside of UCF saw representation in the week five national rankings, in Arizona (No. 12, ESPN/USA Softball), Arizona State (No. 25, NFCA/GoRout), Baylor (receiving votes, ESPN/USA Softball), Oklahoma State (No. 15, ESPN/USA Softball, DI Softball.com), Texas Tech (No. 2, NFCA/GoRout, ESPN/USA Softball), and Utah (No. 25, Softball America).

DO YOUR THING, 21 - UCF redshirt sophomore right-hander **Isabella Vega** was integral in leading her squad to its series win over the No. 12 Cowgirls last weekend, totaling 11.2 innings of work without surrendering an earned run in three total appearances...for her efforts, she was named Sports Illustrated's National Softball Pitcher of the Week, representing the first in program history to receive the honor...the recognition also marks the fourth national weekly honor she's received since the start of last spring, as well as her second weekly honor this season, joining her appointment as the Big 12 Conference's week two Pitcher of the Week...in throwing a seven-inning complete game in the Knights' game one 4-1 victory, Vega became the first pitcher since **Jordy Frahm** (formerly Bahl) Feb. 28, 2025 to throw a seven-inning complete game with two or fewer hits allowed against Oklahoma State...the effort also marked Vega's third career appearance with at least seven innings pitched and one or fewer runs allowed against a ranked opponent, joining her dominant relief effort in the Knights' 6-5 comeback win over then-No. 15 Missouri Feb. 11, 2025, and her seven-inning shutout against then-No. 3 Florida in Orlando March 26, 2025...following the conclusion of UCF's first weekend of conference action, Vega has tossed a team-high 17.1 innings in five appearances against ranked opponents this season, recording a 1.62 ERA with 13 strikeouts and a .200 batting average-against.

MARY HAD A BIG OL' BAT - Sophomore catcher **Beth Damon** has represented one of UCF's hottest offensive performers of late, entering play this weekend against Baylor having hit safely in each of her last seven games and in 15 of her last 16 contests overall dating back to UCF's 6-2 win over NC State Feb. 15, as well as in 22 of her first 26 games overall this season...with solo homers in games two and three in Stillwater last

weekend, Damon recorded her third instance this season with home runs in back-to-back games, and set a new single season career high with her ninth of the spring on Sunday..both of her home runs during the series came against Oklahoma State ace **Ruby Meylan**, and her nine homers thus far fanned tied for fourth most in the Big 12 Conference, behind only Houston's **Maddie Hartley** (11) and Texas Tech's **Lagi Quiroga** and **Mia Williams** (10)...Damon also ranks among Big 12 leaders in hit-by-pitch (6, T-2nd), slugging percentage (.912, 5th), total bases (62, 6th), RBI (30, 6th), and doubles (7, T-10th).

STACKING RBI - Sophomore utility **Izzy Mertes** has represented among the Knights' most prolific run-producers as of late, having authored UCF's second eight-game RBI streak of the season with three more in the Knights' 4-1 win over then-No. 12 Oklahoma State Friday..with her first-inning three-run homer, Mertes notched her third consecutive 3-RBI game and had driven in 16 runs in an eight-game span from Feb. 22 vs. Charleston Southern through Friday's series-opener in Stillwater...she joined teammate **Sierra Humphreys** as the second Knight this season to drive in at least one run in eight consecutive games, and has seized the team lead in RBI entering the weekend series against Baylor with 32 through her first 27 games...just two ahead of teammate **Beth Damon**'s 30 and three ahead of Humphreys' 29, Mertes' 32 RBI rank tied for third most in the Big 12 Conference entering play this weekend, behind only Arizona's **Sydney Stewart** (43) and Texas Tech's **Mia Williams** (39)...UCF's offensive improvement from the 2025 season shows in the team's RBI total to this point as well, as the Black and Gold's 174 RBI through 27 games almost double the 2025 Knights' RBI total of 97 through their first 27 games.

PROTECT THE PLEX - The Knights have done well in defending their home field under head coach **Cindy Ball-Malone**, having authored four straight years with at least 20 wins at the UCF Softball Complex and five such years in the first six (not including the COVID-19-shortened 2020) during the Ball-Malone era (since and including 2019)...entering play vs. Baylor, UCF owns a 17-2 mark through its first 19 home games, and has produced a 160-57-1 (.736) record at home spanning Ball-Malone's first seven years.

AYY, WE'RE WALKIN' HERE! - After drawing 31 walks throughout their fourth week of action, just over five per game, the UCF softball team drew seven more free passes throughout its weekend series against then-No. 12 Oklahoma State to push its season total to 117 through 27 games, or just under five per game...the Black and Gold drew a single-game season high 11 walks in their 9-1 run-rule win over Wagner Feb. 27, joining 50 other instances of 11-walk games produced by teams this season, and representing their highest single-game walk total since the 2020 Knights drew 13 walks in a 6-2 win over St. John's (NY) Feb. 9...the Knights' 117 walks rank second most in the Big 12 Conference entering the weekend's action and rank 11th most in the nation...UCF has more than doubled its walk total through 27 games from the 2025 season (56), and its 117 walks through 27 games this spring represents its highest 27-game walk total since the 2022 Knights drew 121 free passes through their first 27 games.

POWER SURGE - With three more home runs during the weekend series in Stillwater, the UCF softball team has totaled 29 long balls through its first 27 games of the season, and 85 total extra-base hits (49 doubles, seven triples, 29 home runs)...the Knights' 29 home runs represent the program's most through the first 27 games of a season since the 2021 Knights slugged 31 through their first 27 contests, and UCF's 85 extra-base hits so far represent the most any Knights team has totaled through the first 27 games of a season in program history...sophomores **Kendall Yarnell** (6 2B, 3 3B, 6 HR), **Izzy Mertes** (10 2B, 7 HR) and **Beth Damon** (7 2B, 9 HR) lead the team in extra-base hits, and 13 players have notched at least one extra-base hit through 27 games...joining Yarnell, Damon and Mertes with at least two extra-base hits entering play this weekend are junior second baseman **Sierra Humphreys** (9 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR), senior shortstop **Aubrey Evans** (6 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR), sophomore third baseman **Coco Jaimes** (3 2B), junior infielder/outfielder **Samantha Rey** (1 2B, 1 3B), and freshman infielder **Kendall Trimm** (3 2B).

YARNELL'S BREAKOUT YEAR - After representing one of the top pinch-hitters in the nation throughout her freshman 2025 season, sophomore utility **Kendall Yarnell** has risen to stake her claim as one of the Big 12's top hitters through UCF's first 27 games this season...she enters play against Baylor leading her team in average (.443), on-base percentage (.541), slugging percentage (.934), and triples (3), and has hit safely in 17 of her 27 games this season accompanied by seven multi-hit games...entering play against Baylor this weekend, Yarnell leads the Big 12 Conference in triples (3, T-1st), slugging percentage (.934, 4th), on-base percentage (.541, 6th), batting average (.443, 7th), and total bases (57, 10th).

DOWN GEAUX THE TIGERS - UCF's stay during the 2026 Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational was highlighted by the program's 5-1 victory over the then-No. 10 LSU Tigers Feb. 14, representing the team's first win over a ranked opponent this season and its second victory over an SEC program...the effort marked UCF's eighth ranked win since the beginning of the 2025 season, a year during which the team tied a single-season program record with seven ranked wins (also 2022), as well as the program's 16th win over a top 10 opponent in program history...the Knights also earned their first win over LSU in program history, evening the all-time series at one win apiece...UCF did it on the strength of a strong day in the circle by freshman southpaw **Hildie Dempsey** (3.2 IP, 1 R) and redshirt sophomore right-hander **Isabella Vega** (3.1 IP, 0 R, 3 K), as well as multi-hit games by **Beth Damon** (1 HR) and **Coco Jaimes**...Damon's fourth-inning solo shot represented her third homer of the season, her second homer against an SEC team this spring, and the third homer of her career against a ranked opponent.

GRAND SLAM x3 - Among the offensive fireworks that highlighted the Knights' opening weekend, UCF saw two different players hit three grand slams...sophomore utility player **Kendall Yarnell** hit UCF's first home run of the season, a first-inning grand slam that helped lead her team to its 13-0 run-rule victory over Boston U Feb. 5, marking the second home run of her career, both of the pinch-hit variety...Yarnell then hit her second grand slam of the weekend in the bottom of the fourth inning of UCF's come-from-behind 15-7 win over Maryland Feb. 7...UCF's third grand slam of the weekend came off the bat of sophomore infielder/outfielder **Izzy Mertes**, part of her second career multi-homer game in the bottom of the second inning against Maryland Feb. 8...opening weekend marked the first time in program history that the Knights hit three grand slams in the span of one weekend...Yarnell became the second player in program history (**Stephanie Best**, 2003) to hit multiple grand slams in the span of one weekend, and she also became the second player in program history to hit a grand slam on opening day (**Ashley Van Ryn**, Feb. 10, 2006)...Yarnell also joins **Hillary Barrow**, **Farah Sullivan**, **Jessica Ujvari** and **Cassady Brewer** with two career grand slams, all tied for the second most career grand slams in program history behind Best (3).

CINDY BALL-MALONE

Head Coach / Eighth Season

On the heels of a hall-of-fame collegiate playing career, UCF head softball coach Cindy Ball-Malone, also known by her nickname, “Bear,” has lifted the UCF softball program to new heights throughout her first seven seasons at the helm since she was named the second head coach in program history June 27, 2018.

Ball-Malone’s resume showcases:

- ◆ Eleven career seasons as an NCAA Division I head softball coach (the last seven at UCF), including seven postseason appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, and one NCAA super regional appearance

- ◆ Extensive player development, highlighted by three All-America selections, one National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selection, three national Wilson/NFCA Pitcher of the Week selections, one American Athletic Conference AAC Pitcher of the Year selection, one AAC Rookie of the Year selection, and three consecutive top 25 nationally-ranked recruiting classes (Extra Inning Softball, 2021-23)

- ◆ Four additional previous seasons of experience as an assistant coach at Washington and Cal State Northridge, including two NCAA super regional appearances with the Huskies

- ◆ A playing career at the University of the Pacific that landed Ball-Malone among the selections for the 13th West Coast Conference Hall of Honor Class in 2023

Under “Coach Bear,” the UCF softball team is in the midst of the most successful period in the program’s 24-year history. With the team’s 35-24-1 record in 2025, the Knights re-wrote their record books on numerous occasions en route to UCF softball’s fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament berth and the 12th in program history.

In earning two wins during the 2025 NCAA Austin Regional, Ball-Malone also eclipsed the 250th win of her UCF tenure, as well as the 350th win of her head coaching career, and concluded the 2025 campaign boasting a 350-245-3 (.588) career record as a head coach, and a 251-129-3 (.659) mark through her seven years at UCF.

The Black and Gold’s current postseason run encompasses three consecutive 40-plus-win seasons (2021-23), five NCAA Regional appearances, one of which was hosted by the Knights at the UCF Softball Complex (2022), and the first NCAA regional championship and super regional appearance in program history (2022).

UCF’s 35-win season in 2025 marked a season high as a member of the Big 12 Conference, besting the program’s 31-win 2024 slate, and with seven top 25 ranked wins the group matched the 2022 Knights for the most ranked wins in a season in program history.

Under Ball-Malone’s leadership, the Black and Gold also recorded three wins over top four-ranked teams at the time of the contest, taking two of three from then-No. 4 Arizona March 7-9 to earn the highest-ranked series win in program history before the squad earned a 4-0 shutout victory over then-No. 3 Florida at home March 26.

The Knights did it behind two freshman All-America picks, three NFCA All-Region selections and five All-Big 12 Conference selections.

Redshirt freshman right-handed pitcher Isabella Vega led the way as a D1Softball Freshman First Team All-American, Softball America Freshman Second Team All-American, top 10 finalist for the NFCA’s National Freshman of the Year, NFCA All-Gulf Region First Team selection, All-Big 12 Conference First Team selection, All-Big 12 Conference Freshman Team selection, one-time Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week, two-time D1Softball National Freshman of the Week, and two-time Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Week.

Freshman catcher Beth Damon represented UCF’s second All-American in 2025, tabbed to D1Softball’s freshman second

team, and joined Vega and Izzy Mertes on the All-Big 12 Freshman Team. Junior shortstop Aubrey Evans and Sierra Humphreys were also added to the All-Big 12 Second Team, and Mertes and Evans were honored with NFCA All-Gulf Region Second and Third Team honors, respectively.

UCF's most recent campaign under Ball-Malone brought the Knights' win total to 66 through just two years as members of the Big 12 Conference, highlighted by two NCAA Tournament berths, one NCAA Regional Final appearance, 10 All-Big 12 Conference selections, five NFCA All-Region selections, five Big 12 Pitcher of the Week honors, one Big 12 Player of the Week honor and one Wilson/NFCA National Pitcher of the Week selection.

Through the final half of the Knights' tenure as members of the American Athletic Conference from 2019-23, Ball-Malone established her team as one of the league's elite programs. UCF won at least 34 games in every season, outside of the COVID-19-shortened 2020 slate that saw the Knights off to a 21-5-1 start prior to the season's cancellation, including three 40-plus-win seasons.

The Black and Gold in that span also earned NCAA Tournament berths in the program's final three seasons in The American from 2021-23, as well as one AAC regular-season title and two AAC tournament championships.

UCF's penultimate season in the AAC in 2022 represented among the best in program history, when Ball-Malone led her squad to a 49-14 overall record that featured the team's first time hosting the NCAA Regional round, its first NCAA Regional championship, and its first NCAA Super Regional berth.

Ball-Malone helped guide more than one team to new heights in 2022 as well, as she was named as an assistant coach for the USA National Team at the World Games and Canada Cup in the summer. The team won the gold medal at the World Games.

She joined the Knights following four seasons at Boise State University. In her last two campaigns, she compiled a 73-36 record and led the squad to the program's first postseason appearance at the 2017 National Invitational Softball Championship, followed by a 2018 NCAA Tournament berth.

In 2018, the Broncos set program records for most wins in a season (40), most conference wins in a season (18), and the first conference title in program history, defeating New Mexico in the Mountain West championship.

Ball-Malone brought a plethora of coaching experience into her first stop as a Division I head coach, highlighted by a two-year stint on staff with the Washington Huskies. In those two seasons, she served as recruiting coordinator and was responsible for the development of the Husky pitching staff. The Huskies went 76-35 during Ball-Malone's two seasons in Seattle and reached a pair of NCAA Super Regionals while developing Kaitlin Inglesby into a second team All-American.

Ball-Malone has also spent time coaching at Cal State Northridge, Cosumnes River College, Modesto Junior College, and her alma mater, Pacific

She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. Ball-Malone is considered the greatest two-way player in the history of Pacific Softball, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holding nine career pitching records for the Tigers.

Ball-Malone currently lives in Oviedo, Fla. with her husband, Robert Malone III. Together, they have four children, three boys named Four, Ryder and Cayson, and a girl named Sawyer.
