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STORYLINES

SATURDAY'S MATCHUP: No. 13/15 UCLA vs. Cal State Fullerton (Dec. 10)

UCLA Women's Basketball (8-1) matches up against Cal State Fullerton on Saturday, Dec. 10, for the first meeting between the teams since Nov. 27, 2020 (W, 98-49). Tip off for the game is slated for 6 p.m., and the game will be broadcast on both Pac-12 Los Angeles and the Pac-12 Network.

LAST TIME OUT (W, 68-57 vs. UC Santa Barbara - Dec. 3)

The Bruins got off to their slowest start of the season, scoring just 4 points (2-for-16 FG) in the first quarter. UCLA got its offense going in the second quarter behind Charisma Osborne, Gabriela Jaquez and Kiki Rice, who combined for 21 points on 9-for-9 shooting. The Bruins carried the momentum through the break to outscore the Gauchos 43-24 in the second half, finishing the comeback for a 68-57 victory.

CHARISMA'S SENIOR CAMPAIGN

Charisma Osborne has continued to shine during her true senior season with the Bruins. Osborne has scored 20+ points in six of her nine starts this year (24 pts. at No. 1/1 South Carolina; 20 pts vs. Jackson State, Nov. 25; 23 pts vs. No. 11/12 Tennessee, Nov. 20; 28 pts vs. South Dakota State, Nov. 19; 29 pts. vs Troy, Nov. 13; 20 pts vs. Cal Poly, Nov. 7). The 5-foot-9 shooting guard had consecutive double-doubles (29 pts, 10 reb vs. Troy, Nov. 13; 12 pts, career-high 13 reb vs. UC Riverside, Nov. 10) and leads the team in points scored, rebounds, 3PM and FT made. Osborne also boasts second place on the team in FG% (min. 10 FGA) and steals. The Moreno Valley, Calif., native reached 1,300-career points in the first quarter against the Jackrabbits on Nov. 19 and 1,400 career points against UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 3 (1,411 total points). Osborne was named Pac-12 Player of the Week twice (Nov. 21 and Dec. 5) after helping lift the Bruins to victory in the first two rounds of the Battle 4 Atlantis and again after a 1-1 week against No. 1 South Carolina and UC Santa Barbara.

Coming off an All-Pac-12 season in 2021-22, Osborne opened this year on the following watch lists: Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard of the Year and the 2023 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Women's Watch List, Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 Watch List. She was also named to the preseason All-Pac-12 team for the 2022-23 season, her second-consecutive season with such honors. Osborne is currently ranked 5th in ESPN's 2023 WNBA mock draft.

KEY NOTES ON THE BRUINS

- UCLA has made 133 free throws through nine games (5th - Pac-12), shooting 75.1% on the year (3rd - Pac-12, 133-for-177 FT). The Bruins rank 15th in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (16.3 ORPG, 2nd - Pac-12).
- Charisma Osborne has scored 184 points (2nd - Pac-12, 19th in the NCAA) through ninth games, averaging 20.4 ppg (2nd - Pac-12, 17th - NCAA). She is tied for first in field goals made (64 FGM) and has the second-most field goal attempts (137 FGA) in the Pac-12. Osborne ranks 5th in minutes played (292 min.), T-4th in FTM (38) and 7th in FT% (84.4%). Osborne is tied for 6th in 3PM (18 3PM) and tied for fifth in defensive rebounds (49 DRPG) in the Conference. She also ranks 10th in total rebounds (61 REB) and 11th in rebounds per game (6.8 RPG) in the Pac-12.
- Kiki Rice has started all nine games of her first collegiate season, averaging 29.8 minutes per game, and she is immediately impacting the game. The freshman floor general leads the team in assists with 29 (T-11th in Pac-12), which is the second-most among freshmen in the Conference.
- Redshirt-sophomore Emily Bessoir continues to be a key contributor in the frontcourt for the Bruins as a versatile stretch big. The German forward ranks third on the team in points (8.6 ppg) and 3rd in rebounds (5.1 RPG) in 25.8 minutes per game. Bessoir has knocked down 13 three-pointers out of her 36 attempts (.361 3FG%).
- Graduate transfer Gina Conti suited up in the starting lineup for the first time in a Bruin uniform on Nov. 13 versus Troy and has seven-consecutive starts for UCLA. Her starting lineup appearance vs. No. 11/12 Tennessee marked Conti's 100th career start. Conti had a season-high 6 assists in UCLA's 72-60 win over Jackson State (Nov. 25) and has led the team in assists on three occasions through the first month of play. Conti averages a team-high 3.3 APG (16th - Pac-12).

FRESH FACES OF WESTWOOD

UCLA's top-ranked freshman class is seeing significant time on the floor early in the season, averaging 18.7 minutes of playing time per game between the five newcomers.

- Kiki Rice (12 pts/7a/2reb) acted as UCLA's primary ballhandler for a team-high 28.5 minutes in her college debut. Rice has led the team in assists in four of the nine UCLA games in 2022 (7 assists vs. Cal Poly, 5 assists vs. both UC Riverside and Troy, 6 assists vs. No. 11/12 Tennessee). The top-ranked class of 2022 point guard has scored 14+ points in four of her last five outings, shooting 26-for-55 (47.2%) from the field during that span.
- Freshman Gabriela Jaquez is averaging 6.9 points and 4.1 rebounds per game through her first nine contests and has become a key contributor with her energy off the bench in the 2022-23 season. Jaquez is shooting a team-best 42.9% from three-point land on the season (6-for-14 3FG). Jaquez scored 11 points in back-to-back games (Nov. 13 vs. Troy, Nov. 19 vs. South Dakota State) and grabbed a career-high 7 rebounds against the Jackrabbits in UCLA's first game of the Battle 4 Atlantis. Jaquez put up 12 points and grabbed 5 rebounds in the Dec. 3 win over UC Santa Barbara.
- Londynn Jones reached double-digit scoring for the first time in her career with an 11-point outing against Troy on Nov. 13. Jones shot 3-for-3 against the Lady Vols for 9 points on Nov. 20. The Riverside, Calif., native scored 16 points against Jackson State (Nov. 25) to help secure the win, hitting two three-pointers in the fourth to lift the Bruins over the Tigers.
- Lina Sontag had a big game off the bench against No. 11/12 Tennessee, scoring 12 points (5-for-12 FG, 2-for-4 3FG) and pulling down 7 rebounds before fouling out in 18.5 minutes of play. Sontag earned a starting spot against Jackson State on Nov. 25. The German had 9 points and a team-high 8 rebounds against the Tigers.
- Christeen Iwuala is averaging 3.7 ppg and 4.0 rpg in 15.1 mpg and was named the team's "Passion Player of the Game" for her hustle plays against South Dakota State (Nov. 19) and Jackson State (Nov. 25).

BRUINS AMONG THE RANKS

- After beginning the season unranked for the first time since the 2015-16 season, the Bruins found their way back into both the Associated Press (AP) Poll (No. 20, Week 3 - Nov. 21, 2022) and the USA Today Coaches Poll (No. 21, Week 3 - Nov. 22, 2022) to start the third week of the 2022-23 season.
- UCLA handled No. 11/12 Tennessee on Nov. 20 (W, 80-63) for its first ranked win since Feb. 19, 2021 when the Bruins took down then-No. 13 Oregon 83-56 inside Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom.
- The Bruins cracked the top 15 in Week 4 of the AP Poll, sitting at the No. 15 spot after taking down Marquette in the championship game of the Women's Battle 4 Atlantis Tournament (W - OT, 66-58) and Jackson State at home (W, 72-60).
- Despite a loss at No. 1 South Carolina, UCLA's performance against the reigning national champs helped boost the Bruins to the No. 13 spot in week five of the AP Poll.
- The Pac-12 boasts five programs in the top 25 in both the AP and USA Today Coaches polls (No. 2/2 Stanford, No. 12/12 Arizona, **No. 13/15 UCLA**, No. 15/14 Utah, No. 17/17 Oregon) for the second-consecutive week.

CORI CLOSE

The Michael Price Family UCLA
Women's Head Basketball Coach
12th Season

Cori Close was named The Michael Price Family UCLA Women's Head Basketball Coach on April 21, 2011, and is currently 233-123 (.654) overall. The 2022-23 campaign will mark Close's 12th season at the helm of the Bruins.

The 2021-22 season proved to be "one of the most challenging years of [Close's] career," as the Bruins battled injuries and faced postponements and a forfeiture due to COVID-19 protocols. UCLA finished 18-13 overall, but the team managed to catch fire late in the season. Close guided the Bruins to a postseason run in the WNIT, making a trip to the semifinals before falling to South Dakota State.

Charisma Osborne and Ilmar'i Thomas earned All-Pac-12 honors in the 2021-22 campaign, as Osborne ranked third in the conference in scoring (16.4 ppg). Thomas added 15.7 points on 54.4% shooting and 5.9 rebounds per game in 31 appearances for the Bruins. UCLA graduated seven members of the 2021-22 squad, including Thomas, Natalie Chou and Chantel Horvat, who all found themselves playing professionally overseas after earning their degrees from the No. 1 public institution in America.

Close led the Bruins through an unpredictable 2020-21 season, a campaign that required Close to navigate COVID-19 protocols and a limited roster. The Bruins posted a 17-6 overall record, picking up wins against five ranked opponents. The Bruins were ranked inside the top 11 of the AP Poll throughout the season and notched the No. 5 spot in November, the highest ranking for the program since 2017. Close guided the Bruins to the Pac-12 Tournament championship game and an eventual three-seed in the NCAA Tournament. It was the sixth NCAA Tournament appearance under Close's tenure.

Close earned her 200th-career win in the Bruins' victory at Arizona State on Dec. 6, 2020. She joined Billie Moore (296-181) and Kathy Olivier (232-208) as the only coaches in program history to eclipse the 200-win milestone. Close boasts the highest winning percentage (.662) of the three (Moore -- .621, Olivier -- .527).

Michaela Onyenwere earned AP Third-Team All-American honors for the second-straight year and was selected by the New York Liberty with the sixth pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft. Onyenwere became the sixth Bruin under Close's tenure to be drafted into the WNBA, and the fifth in the last four years. Onyenwere and Charisma Osborne each picked up All-Pac-12 accolades while Emily Bessoir was tabbed to the Pac-12 All-Freshman team. Natalie Chou earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition after averaging a career-high 9.9 points per game.

2019-20 was an historic year for Close and the Bruins. UCLA won its first 13 games of the campaign, setting a new program record for the most consecutive wins to start a season. The Bruins' win over then-No. 6 Stanford marked Close's 100th-career Pac-12 victory. A win over the Trojans in the Pac-12 Tournament quarterfinals won the Bruins the season series over their crosstown rival. UCLA would, ultimately, finish the year 26-5 and was set to host the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament. The national postseason schedule, however, was canceled due to COVID-19.

Close helped guide the Bruins to a myriad of individual honors during the 2019-20 season. Junior Michaela Onyenwere earned AP Third-Team All-America acclaim and also garnered All-Pac-12 recognition. Senior Japreece Dean also earned All-Pac-12 honors while Charisma Osborne picked up Pac-12 All-Freshman accolades. Dean was drafted with the 30th overall pick by the Chicago Sky in the 2020 WNBA Draft, becoming the fifth draft pick across Close's tenure at the helm.

The 2018-19 season saw UCLA win 13 of its last 17 games and finish fourth in a highly competitive Pac-12 Conference, and Close was ultimately named the Media Pac-12 Coach of the Year. The Bruins collected nine road wins, the most since 2012-13 when the team had 13. UCLA also had seven top-25 wins, including a pair of top-10 wins over then-ranked No. 2 Oregon and No. 9 Maryland. In UCLA's historic win over the Ducks on Feb. 22, the Bruins overcame a 22-point deficit and secured their biggest win since knocking off No. 2 Stanford in 2008. The loss for Oregon marked its only setback in Eugene that season.

UCLA, which ranked second in the NCAA in offensive rebounds per game (17.3) in 2018-19, ultimately finished 22-13 on the year, reaching the semifinals of the Pac-12 Tournament and collecting NCAA Tournament wins over Tennessee and Maryland, before falling to perennial power UCONN by a final score of 69-61. It was the fourth-straight Sweet 16 appearance for UCLA, making the Bruins one of just eight NCAA Division I programs to do so. In the final ESPN/USA Today rankings, UCLA rose 10 spots to No. 14, the highest leap by any program in the polls. Close produced her fourth WNBA draft pick as a head coach, as Kennedy Burke was picked in the second round by the Dallas Wings as the 22nd overall pick.

Close guided the Bruins to a 27-8 overall record in 2017-18, including a tie for third place in the Pac-12 with a 14-4 mark. She was named the 2018 United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I Region 5 Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. The Bruins reached the Sweet 16 for a record extending third consecutive year and ended the season with an Elite 8 appearance for the first time since 1999, falling to No. 1 Mississippi State on March 25, 2018.
