FIRST SERVE (TL;DR)

- USC is led by fifth-year head coach **Brad Keller** who has the unique experience of having coached both men's and women's programs at both USC and UCLA. Overall, Keller is **77-59 (.592)** as the Trojans' head coach.
- USC assoc. head coach **Spencer McLachlin** was an assistant for the UCLA men (2018-21). Trojan asst. coach **Megan Moenaa** was a setter for the Bruins (2011-14) and won the 2011 NCAA championship. USC tech coordinator **Virginia Pham** is a 2015 UCLA grad and served as a student assistant for the Bruins' men's, women's, and beach volleyball programs from 2012-15. UCLA asst. coach **Stevi Robinson-Trail** was an All-American for USC beach.
- Sr. S **Mia Tuaniga** has started as the Trojans' setter for each of the last three seasons and has 4,081 career assists to rank fourth in school history.
- Gr. OH **Ally Batenhorst** ranks ninth in the Big Ten for kills (3.77 kps) and is seventh in the league for points (4.51 pps).
- Sr. MB **Tyrar Ariail** is fifth in the Big Ten in blocks (1.28 bps). USC ranks second in the conference (5th in the NCAA) for blocks at 2.97 bps.

LOS ANGELES – The No. 21-ranked USC women's volleyball team (14-6, 6-4 Big Ten) heads down the 10 Freeway to take on crosstown rival UCLA (10-9, 4-6) on Halloween Night, Thursday (Oct. 31) for a 6:30 p.m. meeting that will be shown live on Big Ten Network. The Women of Troy have won six of their last eight against the Bruins including a five-set victory at Galen Center two weeks ago (Oct. 13). Sunday, USC welcomes Washington (16-4, 6-4) to Galen Center for a 1 p.m. PT matchup that will be streamed live on Big Ten Plus.

USC HEAD COACH BRAD KELLER



Brad Keller is in his fifth season as USC's head coach. He was hired as the seventh coach in program history on February 20, 2020, and holds a **77-53 (.592) career record** at Troy.

Keller coached the Trojans to their 39th NCAA tournament appearance in 2023, the program's second consecutive appearance in the national tourney under his direction. He was previously the associate women's head coach at UCLA in 2019. Before that, he served six years (2013-18) as an assistant coach for the UCLA men's volleyball program. While on staff, Keller coached 10 All-Americans and helped the Bruins reach the NCAA national semifinals in 2016 and a national runner-up finish in 2018. According to *Volleyball Magazine* rankings, Keller helped recruit four top-ranked classes at UCLA: 2013, '14, '17, and '18.

On the national level, Keller has served as a coach for the U.S. Youth National Team programs. He was the head coach of the A1 U.S. Boys' Youth Team that won silver at the 2018 NORCECA U19 Continental Championship. Keller was also the U.S. Youth National Team's associate head coach in 2016 and 2017; and served as an assistant coach in 2014 and 2015.

Keller's collegiate coaching career began at USC where he served as an assistant coach for the Trojans for four seasons (2007-10). In 2009, USC won the MPSF Tournament and finished as the NCAA runner-up. Among the outstanding Trojan men that he coached were Murphy Troy, Tony Ciarelli, Tri Bourne, and brothers Riley and Maddison McKibbin.

Keller joined the UC Irvine men's program for the 2011 season as an assistant coach where he helped the Anteaters to a No. 3 national ranking and a semifinal appearance in the MPSF tournament. In the fall of 2011, Keller moved to the women's side of the sport and spent that season as an assistant coach at UConn. In the spring of 2012, Keller was named an assistant coach for the Santa Clara women's volleyball program. He helped the Broncos through the spring season before he was hired by the UCLA men's program that summer.

Prior to joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Keller was the owner, director, and a coach of Bay to Bay, a boys' volleyball club in Northern California, from 2000-06. His club won a pair of silver medals at the Junior Olympics and produced numerous NCAA Division I student-athletes. In the summer of 2006, he served as an assistant coach with the U.S. Men's Junior National Team.

Keller's other coaching experience includes two seasons (1995-96) as an assistant with the girls' team at Del Mar High School in San Jose, Calif.; and as head coach in 1999 of the girls' junior high team at Harvard-Westlake High School in North Hollywood, Calif.

As a student-athlete, Keller played outside hitter and defensive specialist at Loyola Marymount for two seasons (1999-2000) before the school stopped sponsoring the sport. He received his bachelor's degree in graphic design with a minor in marketing from LMU in 2002.

Keller attended Bellarmine Prep in San Jose, Calif., where he was the CIF Central Coast Section MVP in 1998. His younger brother Jarod played libero for the Stanford men's volleyball program. Keller was born Dec. 30, 1979.

LAST TIME OUT: USC had a nine-match home win streak snapped in a stunning five-set loss to Michigan State and then went toe-to-toe with third-ranked Penn State before the Lions pulled out a 3-1 win. The Trojans fell to 9-3 at home and suffered back-to-back losses for the first time this season. **Mia Tuaniga** put up 43 assists and had 11 digs against Penn State for her sixth double-double of the season. **Jadyn Livings** had 14 kills and 11 digs in the match with the Spartans for her third double-double. **Ally Batenhorst** scored a career-high 26.0 points and had a career-best 23 kills against Michigan State.

AGREE TO DISAGREE: The Women of Troy lead the all-time series with rival UCLA by a **65-58** margin. Ask someone in blue and gold and they'll tell you otherwise. The Bruins claim to lead the series, **69-65**, but how? UCLA's program, which started in 1972, is several years older than the one at USC, which began in 1976. The Bruins earned a handful of victories over the Trojans before the Women of Troy officially started a varsity program. In those four seasons, the Bruins racked up 11 wins against USC's club team, which are included in UCLA's all-time record.

CROSSTOWN CONNECTIONS: USC head coach **Brad Keller** has the unique distinction of having coached both the men's and women's volleyball programs at both USC and UCLA. Prior to his arrival at USC, he served one season (2019) as UCLA's associate head coach. The Trojans' associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** also has UCLA ties having served as an assistant coach for the Bruin men (alongside Keller in his first season) for three years (2018-21). Assistant coach **Megan Moenoa** was a standout setter for the Bruin women and helped UCLA capture the 2011 NCAA championship. She graduated from UCLA in 2015. USC technical coordinator **Virginia Pham** also graduated from UCLA in 2015—with a bachelor's degree in computer science—and served three seasons as a student assistant for several of the Bruins' volleyball programs. First-year UCLA assistant coach **Stevi Robinson-Trail** was a 2013 AVCA All-American with the USC beach volleyball program. She won the AVCA's individual national championship with partner **Kirby Burnham** in her only season at Troy.

DAWG WALKERS: USC leads Washington **45-33** all-time but has had little luck when it has played the Huskies in Seattle. The Trojans are **18-20** as the road team and are just **4-15** since 2005 when the Huskies won the NCAA championship. After winning eight straight road matches over UW between 1996-2004, USC has won just four times (2011, '18, '19, '23) in **19 matches** at Hec Ed. At home, the Trojans are a far more palatable **25-12** against Washington.

BIG AWARDS: Sr. **Mia Tuaniga** was chosen as the Big Ten Setter of the Week and OH **Jadyn Livings** was awarded Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors on Sept. 23. The two honors were the first ever earned by Trojan players as members of the Big Ten Conference. For Livings, it was her first weekly award of any kind. Tuaniga took home her first weekly award since she was tabbed for Pac-12 Freshman of the Week honors in 2021.

ONCE AROUND THE BLOCK: The Trojans' **2.97 blocks per set** ranks second in the Big Ten and rank **fifth** nationally. In **20** matches, USC has reached double-digit blocks **13** times including season-highs of 19.5 blocks twice; vs. Kansas State (Sept. 6), vs. Loyola Marymount (Sept. 19).

AVCA POLL POSITION: The Trojans opened the 2024 season ranked No. 21 in the AVCA coaches' poll. Overall, USC has appeared in the coaches' poll **536 times**, which ranks **sixth** all-time. The Women of Troy have held a spot among the poll's top 10 teams **317 times**, which ranks **eighth** all-time, and the Trojans have held the No. 1 ranking **47 times** for **seventh** all-time. Since 1982—the year of the poll's inception—USC has appeared in the final poll 34 of 41 times with 18 finishes in the top 10; 12 in the top five, and twice as the No. 1-ranked team (2002, '03).

HOME, SWEET HOME: USC is **213-59 (.783)** all-time at Galen Center. The Trojans were 11-2 at home a year ago. USC went 12-1 in home matches in 2011 and completed the 2012 home schedule with a 17-1 mark. In 2007, USC was 19-0 at home on the way to an appearance in the NCAA national semifinal match. The Trojans are **20-4** all-time at Galen Center in NCAA tournament matches. The four losses were to Hawai'i (2008 and 2009) and San Diego (2018) each time in the second round; and to Washington in the 2013 NCAA Regional Final.

LONG DISTANCE: USC is **156-109** all-time in five-set matches: **66-41** at home; **66-54** on the road; **24-14** in neutral matches. The Trojans were **6-5** in 11 five-set matches in 2023, which tied a school record previously set in 2019. Against Big Ten opponents, USC is **46-40** all-time in five-set contests.

RANK AND FILE: Of the Trojans' **six** losses this season, **five** have come against ranked opponents. Those include No. 1 Pittsburgh at home (Sept. 11), No. 2 Nebraska on the road (Sept. 29), No. 3 Penn State at home (Oct. 26), No. 11 Creighton in Omaha, Neb. (Sept. 5), and No. 11 Oregon on the road (Oct. 9). The Bluejays later moved up as high as No. 6 in the weekly rankings. USC is otherwise **13-1** against unranked opponents this season and picked up its first victory over a ranked opponent in a four-set win against No. 12 Minnesota (Oct. 5).

THE ONE AND ONLY: USC's meeting with No. 1-ranked Pittsburgh on Sept. 11 was the 32nd time the Trojans faced the nation's top-ranked team. USC faced its first No. 1-ranked team on Dec. 19, 1982, in that fall's NCAA championship match; a five-set loss to Hawaii'i. Overall, USC is **8-24** in those **32** matches with a **4-9** mark when it hosts No. 1 at home. When No. 1 teams visit Galen Center, USC is **3-3** with wins over California (2011), UCLA (2012), and Stanford (2012). The three losses were to Stanford in 2010 and 2014, and to Pitt in 2024.

DOUBLE DOWN: Six Trojans have recorded career double-doubles. Setter **Mia Tuaniga** owns **34** double-doubles in her career (one triple-double on Sept. 30, 2022, against Colorado). OPP **Adonia Faumuina** logged a double-double in her first-collegiate match as she led the Women of Troy to a win over crosstown rival UCLA. OH **London Wijay** had back-to-back double-doubles in road matches at Purdue and UCLA for her first two of her career and now has **nine**-career double-doubles. LIB **Gala Trubint** had a 20-dig, 10-assist double-double against Arizona State in 2022 for the first of her career. OH **Ally Batenhorst** owns **seven**-career double-doubles, twice as a Husker in 2022. OH **Jadyn Livings** recorded her first-career double-double on Sept. 21 with 13 kills and 11 digs in a win over UC San Diego and now has **three** this season.

A DOS MANOS: Senior **Mia Tuaniga** has held the starting setter position for the Trojans for more than three years. She is a two-time Pac-12 All-Conference Team member and ranks **fourth** in USC's career record books with **4,081** assists. Tuaniga is **429** assists from matching the program record held by All-American **Kendall Bateman** (4,510 assists; 2008-11) and just **21** assists moving into third place in school history (**Taylor Carico**, 4,101 assists; 2006-08). Tuangia is also tied for **fourth** all-time in USC history for service aces with **140**.

DIGGIN' DEEP: LIB **Gala Trubint** produced back-to-back 416-dig seasons in 2022 and 2023. She ranked ninth in the Pac-12 last season with 3.33 digs per set and was sixth with her 416 total digs. Trubint has reached double-digit digs in **61-career** matches and has reached the 20-dig mark **15** times.

SELF-DEFENSE: LIB **Gala Trubint** has collected **1,055** career digs and became the 20th Trojan to collect 1,000-plus digs on Oct. 9 when she posted 15 against Oregon. She now ranks 16th all-time among Women of Troy. Prior to Trubint, the last Trojan to cross the 1,000-dig mark was All-American OH **Khalia Lanier** in 2019. Lanier finished her career with 1,039 digs, which ranks 19th in program history.

FAVOR FAVE: MB **Favor Anyanwu** started in each of her first two collegiate matches and logged hitting percentages of .636 (7-0-11) and .526 (11-1-19) in road wins over Pepperdine. In her first week of action, she finished hitting .567 to lead the Big Ten and rank third in the NCAA.

ARIAIL ACT: MB **Tyrah Ariail** leads the Trojans in blocks (**1.28 bps**) and ranks **fifth** in the Big Ten. She had five in USC's season opener and has matched her season high of eight blocks in four matches. Ariail is now up to **242** career blocks.

ALL IN ON ALLY: OH **Ally Batenhorst** leads USC and ranks **seventh** in the Big Ten in points (**4.51 pps**). She set new career marks for kills (23), attacks (62), service aces (3) and points (26.0) this season. Her **3.77 kills per set** ranks **ninth** in the Big Ten.

GIRL TRIPPIN': On Sept. 30, 2022, **Mia Tuaniga** put up 37 assists, had 10 digs, and served a USC-record 10 aces in a four-set win over Colorado. It was the first triple-double of her career and only the second produced by a Trojan in the rally-scoring era. Previously, **Raquel Lázaro** did it on Sept. 7, 2019, against Northern Iowa with 36 assists, 16 digs, and 11 blocks.

ACE CASE: Setter **Mia Tuaniga** set a USC record with **10 service aces** against Colorado on Sept. 30, 2022. The previous record was eight achieved seven times by six different players. Tuaniga has had five or more aces **four** times and has registered three or more service aces in **18** matches. She ranks tied for **fourth** on USC's career top 10 with **140-career aces** (**Alex Jupiter**, 2008-11).

TEXAS TWO-STEP: Five Trojans hail from the Lone Star State. Since All-American MB **Lauren Williams** (Houston) arrived in 2008, at least one USC player has come from Texas in every season but one (2016). This year, MB **Tyrah Ariail** and MB **Leah Ford** return to carry the Lone Star banner. Ariail is from Frisco and played at Lebanon Trail HS and Ford is from Keller, near Dallas. The two USC veterans are joined by graduate transfer OH **Ally Batenhorst** (Houston), freshman MB **Favor Anyanwu** (Rowlett), and freshman OH **Jadyn Livings** (Dallas). When USC visits Texas, it is **32-8** all-time, and **12-3** in postseason matches.

LONDON BRIDGE: OH **London Wijay** earned Pac-12 All-Freshman Team laurels in 2023—the 36th Trojan to be chosen to the all-freshman squad—and was an honorable mention for the All-Pac-12 Team. She collected 191 kills in her first-year campaign to rank third on the team. Wijay reclassified into the class of '23 so that she could join the Women of Troy one year ahead of schedule and made an immediate impact. Her 2.14 digs per set also ranked third on the team.

TRANSFER CREDITS: USC welcomed two new faces via the NCAA transfer portal in 2024; both from the Big Ten. OH **Ally Batenhorst** was a two-time NCAA runner-up at Nebraska and played her freshman season under first-year USC associate head coach **Tyler Hildebrand** as a Husker. OH **Grae Gosnell** is the second player from Indiana to join the Trojans in as many years. Last year, setter **Emily Fitzner** also transferred to play at USC following a four-year career as a Hoosier. Both Fitzner and Gosnell played under second-year USC associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** while in Bloomington.

ROUND TRIP: USC head coach **Brad Keller** is the only coach to have served as a coach for both the USC and UCLA men's and women's volleyball programs. He began his career at Troy as a men's assistant coach in 2007 and held several other posts before his arrival at UCLA where he was an assistant coach for the Bruin men from 2013-18. In 2019, Keller assumed the title of associate head coach for the UCLA women's program before he was tabbed for his first head coaching position in 2020 as the seventh head coach of the Women of Troy.

'OHANA MEANS FAMILY: USC associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** grew up in Hawai'i where he attended the Punahou School. His father **Chris McLachlin** is a longtime color analyst for UH volleyball broadcasts and was a volleyball and basketball coach at Punahou where he coached President Barack Obama. Spencer's mother **Beth (Hollinger) McLachlin** was an All-American volleyball player at Hawai'i and was a co-captain of the U.S. Olympic team. She served 23 years as the director of athletics at La Pietra Hawai'i School for Girls. The Trojans made a trip to the islands for the third straight year for a two-match series with the Rainbow Wahine. McLachlin is married to former USC pin-hitter **Diane Copenhagen** (2004-07) and the two have two daughters and a son.

SIDELINE SHUFFLE: The Trojans added a second associate head coach to the bench this fall. Former Long Beach State All-American setter and women's head coach of the 49ers **Tyler Hildebrand** was hired by USC in February and joined a pair of second-year coaches on the bench: associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** and assistant coach **Megan Moenoa**. McLachlin was a national champion student-athlete at Stanford and previously coached at Indiana, UCLA, and California. As a junior outside hitter, he won the 2010 NCAA title with

the Cardinal. Moenoa was a standout setter at UCLA and was a freshman setter with the Bruins when they won the 2011 NCAA championship—and is quite familiar with the USC-UCLA rivalry on the women's side.

PAC IT UP: The Women of Troy played their final season in the Pac-12 Conference in 2023. On June 30, 2022, USC and UCLA both announced that the schools' athletic programs would join the Big Ten Conference in 2024. Oregon and Washington later made similar announcements, and all four teams will compete in the Big Ten for most sports. The Pac-12 in its final alignment existed for 13 years and was the Pac-10 for the 25 previous years.

#1 SIT-SET-GO: OH **Adonia Faumuina** sat out most of her freshman season in 2022 because of an injury but was pressed into action when starting setter **Mia Tuaniga** suffered an ankle injury in the second-to-last regular-season match. Faumuina stepped in to play setter and racked up a double-double to help lead the Trojans to a win over crosstown rival UCLA in her first-ever collegiate contest. She then sat out and received a redshirt in 2023 with another injury but is full-go in 2024 for her redshirt sophomore year.

#2 HIGH CLASS: OH **London Wijay** was scheduled to be a senior in high school last fall, but completed her required course studies early and reclassified in order to join the Trojans' 2023 freshman class. Her older brother **Indiana Wijay** is also a sophomore in college and plays quarterback at Houston.

#4 TROJAN BLOODLINES: LIB **Megan Verbiest** is a fourth-generation Trojan. Great grandfather Kenneth Grossman helped originate the Trojan Huddle with longtime USC football coach **John McKay**. Her grandmother, aunt and uncle, and mother Stacy Brannen Verbiest were all Trojans as well. Megan is now at school with her twin brother Trevor working towards degrees with the class of 2026.

#7 BUILT FORD TOUGH: MB **Leah Ford**'s father Kirk Sr. was an All-Southwestern Conference basketball forward and team captain at the University of Houston (1994-96). He later played professional basketball in Brazil and Europe.

#9 MOTHER FIGURE: Setter **Allie Hazelwood**'s mother **Jenny Hazelwood** is the head coach at Southern Mississippi. Thought having her mom move away during her junior year in high school was one of life's toughest obstacles, Allie credits the change as something that helped her grow in independence. In the Trojans' match with the Golden Eagles on Aug. 27, 2023, Allie took the court in the third set and recorded two assists to help USC close out a 3-0 sweep. Allie lists playing volleyball professionally and coaching as her career aspirations, much like those of her mother.

#10 MILLER TIME: MB **Lindsey Miller** is the only known women's volleyball player to have played for both USC and Notre Dame, two fierce inter-sectional rivals in football. Miller was an AVCA All-East Region Team selection and the region's Freshman of the Year in 2020. She also earned All-ACC second-team recognition before she chose to transfer and join the Women of Troy.

#12 GOLDEN GIRL: MB **Favor Anyanwu** helped the U.S. Girls U19 National Team win gold at the 2023 FIVB Girls World Championship in Croatia. A year later, she joined the U.S. U21 squad to win gold at the NORCECA Women's U21 Continental Championship in Toronto. The second gold was won with USC Technical Coordinator **Virginia Pham** on the bench as a USAV Performance Analyst.

#13 BIG AIR: MB **Tyrar Ariail** sat out the entire 2021 non-conference schedule but saw her first collegiate action in the Trojans' league-opener at UCLA. She later suffered an injury that would sideline her for the remainder of the season and all of 2022. Since returning to action, she picked up right where she left off and hit .778 in the Trojans' win over No. 17 Purdue (Sept. 15, 2023) to tie the second-highest single-match mark in program history.

#14 GATORADE GAL: OH **Ally Batenhorst** was chosen as the 2020-21 Gatorade Texas and National Volleyball Player of the Year as a senior at Seven Lakes High School in Houston, Texas. She is the third GPOY national award winner to play for the Women of Troy. Previously, **Khalia Lanier** (2015-16) and **April Ross** (1999-2000) also won the award and went on to play collegiately at USC.

She also looks up to former Trojan defender **Victoria Garrick** as one of her all-time favorite Women of Troy. Trubint's father Bela Trubint, a coach at Coast Volleyball Club was a member of the Serbian National Team in 1991.

#18 COLORFUL GRAE: OH **Grae Gosnell** is no one-trick pony. She was a South Carolina All-State singer and swimmer in high school and once sang the national anthem to open a women's basketball game at Indiana. She is also well versed in the martial art of Shaolin kempo karate—something she learned for self-defense, appropriate for an outstanding volleyball floor defender.

#22 GRIDIRON GIRL: MB **Rylie McGinest** is the daughter of USC All-American linebacker **Willie McGinest**. Rylie grew up around sports and lists her father as her biggest sports hero. The elder McGinest was a three-time Super Champion with the New England Patriots and a two-time Pro Bowl selection. He was the fourth overall pick in the 1994 NFL draft and helped solidify the lore of USC's No. 55 jersey on the football field worn by top linebackers.

#23 PEACHY KEEN: OPP **Madison Pietsch** almost quit volleyball at the age of 12 but gave it one more season and the rest is truly history. After a redshirt season in 2022, Pietsch saw her first action at Hawai'i in the Trojans' 2023 trip to the islands and racked up eight and 10 kills on back-to-back nights.

#42 DALLAS STAR: OH **Jadyn Livings** is the daughter of Nate Livings, a standout offensive guard in the NFL. He played collegiately for LSU and helped the Tigers win the 2003 BCS championship. As an undrafted free agent, he signed with the Cincinnati Bengals and played six seasons for the Bengals (2006-11) before heading to Dallas where he played the 2012 season. Jdayn's aunt **Isabelle Harrison** was a first-round pick by the Phoenix Mercury in the 2015 WNBA Draft and played for several WNBA teams and is now a member of the Chicago Sky.

#91 FULL FAMILY SET: Setter **Mia Tuaniga** is the younger sister of Long Beach State All-American, two-time NCAA champion and 2018 AVCA National Player of the Year **Josh Tuaniga**. Though Josh is a well-known name among volleyball fans, Mia credits a lot of her volleyball skills and success to her eldest brother Gustiano. Gus played outside hitter at Hawai'i (2009-10) and now helps serve as one of the directors of the Apex1 Volleyball Club in Seal Beach. Mia lists Gus as her biggest sports hero.
