FIRST SERVE (TL;DR)

- USC is led by sixth-year head coach **Brad Keller** who has the unique experience of having coached both men's and women's programs at both USC and UCLA. Overall, Keller is **95-61 (.609)** as the Trojans' head coach.
- The Trojans' assoc. head coach **Spencer McLachlin** was an assistant for the UCLA men (2018-21) and assoc. head coach **Megan Moenaa** was a setter for the Bruins (2011-14) and won the 2011 NCAA championship. UCLA assistant coach **Stevi Robinson-Trail** was an All-American for USC beach.
- The Trojans are ranked **No. 22** in the AVCA Coaches Poll.
- USC is 7-2 at home. The Women of Troy are **223-62 (.782)** all-time at Galen Center since the arena opened in 2006.
- The Trojans have reached double-digit blocks in eight matches and rank second in the Big Ten in blocks per set (2.84 bps), 14th nationally.
- Redshirt So. MB **Leah Ford** leads USC (5th in the Big Ten) in blocks (1.30 bps).
- Fr. OPP **Abigail Mullen** is the Trojans' leading scorer at 4.06 points per set and ranks 13th in the Big Ten. She leads the conference with 0.55 aces per set.

LOS ANGELES – No. 22-ranked USC (10-4, 1-3 Big Ten) takes on a pair of familiar foes this week when Oregon (11-3, 2-2) visits Galen Center for a Thursday-night bout (Oct. 9) before the Women of Troy head across town to take on rival UCLA (8-6, 2-2) for a Saturday matinee meeting (Oct. 11). The Trojans dropped both home matches last weekend to Indiana and Purdue and look to pick up a pair of much-needed league victories this time around. Both matches are national television broadcasts with Thursday night on FS1 and Saturday on NBC.

USC HEAD COACH BRAD KELLER



Brad Keller is in his sixth season as USC's head coach. He was hired as the seventh coach in program history on February 20, 2020, and holds an **95-61 (.609) career record** at Troy.

Keller coached the Trojans to their 40th NCAA tournament appearance in 2024, the program's third consecutive appearance in the national tourney under his direction. He was previously the associate women's head coach at UCLA in 2019. Before that, he served six years (2013-18) as an assistant coach for the UCLA men's volleyball program. While on staff, Keller coached 10 All-Americans and helped the Bruins reach the NCAA national semifinals in 2016 and a national runner-up finish in 2018. According to *Volleyball Magazine* rankings, Keller helped recruit four top-ranked classes at UCLA: 2013, '14, '17, and '18.

On the national level, Keller has served as a coach for the U.S. Youth National Team programs. He was the head coach of the A1 U.S. Boys' Youth Team that won silver at the 2018 NORCECA U19 Continental Championship. Keller was also the U.S. Youth National Team's associate head coach in 2016 and 2017; and served as an assistant coach in 2014 and 2015.

Keller's collegiate coaching career began at USC where he served as an assistant coach for the Trojans for four seasons (2007-10). In 2009, USC won the MPSF Tournament and finished as the NCAA runner-up. Among the outstanding Trojan men that he coached were Murphy Troy, Tony Ciarelli, Tri Bourne, and brothers Riley and Maddison McKibbin.

Keller joined the UC Irvine men's program for the 2011 season as an assistant coach where he helped the Anteaters to a No. 3 national ranking and a semifinal appearance in the MPSF tournament. In the fall of 2011, Keller moved to the women's side of the sport and spent that season as an assistant coach at UConn. In the spring of 2012, Keller was named an assistant coach for the Santa Clara women's volleyball program. He helped the Broncos through the spring season before he was hired by the UCLA men's program that summer.

Prior to joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Keller was the owner, director, and a coach of Bay to Bay, a boys' volleyball club in Northern California, from 2000-06. His club won a pair of silver medals at the Junior Olympics and produced numerous NCAA Division I student-athletes. In the summer of 2006, he served as an assistant coach with the U.S. Men's Junior National Team.

Keller's other coaching experience includes two seasons (1995-96) as an assistant with the girls' team at Del Mar High School in San Jose, Calif.; and as head coach in 1999 of the girls' junior high team at Harvard-Westlake High School in North Hollywood, Calif.

As a student-athlete, Keller played outside hitter and defensive specialist at Loyola Marymount for two seasons (1999-2000) before the school stopped sponsoring the sport. He received his bachelor's degree in graphic design with a minor in marketing from LMU in 2002.

Keller attended Bellarmine Prep in San Jose, Calif., where he was the CIF Central Coast Section MVP in 1998. His younger brother Jarod played libero for the Stanford men's volleyball program. Keller was born Dec. 30, 1979.

LAST TIME OUT: USC hosted a surging Indiana squad and 13th-ranked Purdue for its first Big Ten home matches at Galen Center and fell to the Hoosiers in four sets and to the Boilermakers in three. It was the first time the Trojans have taken back-to-back losses this fall and has USC on a six-set losing streak entering this week. The Women of Troy claimed a 25-15 win over Indiana to open the weekend but the Hoosiers outblocked the Trojans, 12-0 to 9-5, and held USC to .192 hitting in the win. USC's middles both hit .500 and went off against the Hoosiers as **Mia Tyrdy** racked up a career-high 17 kills and **Leah Ford** scored 10 kills. It was the first Indiana win in four matches between the teams. **Abigail Mullen** topped all Trojans with 10 kills against Purdue, but the Boilers hit .287 and put up 11 blocks in the sweep. It was Purdue's second straight 3-0 win over USC after having lost the previous six meetings with the Women of Troy.

AVCA POLL POSITION: The Trojans open the 2025 season ranked No. 21 in the AVCA coaches' poll—the same position it held to open the 2024 season. Overall, USC has appeared in the coaches' poll **549 times**, which ranks **sixth** all-time. The Women of Troy have held a spot among the poll's top 10 teams **317 times**, which ranks **eighth** all-time, and the Trojans have held the No. 1 ranking **47 times** for **seventh** all-time. Since 1982—the year of the poll's inception—USC has appeared in the final poll 35 of 42 times with 18 finishes in the top 10; 12 in the top five, and twice as the No. 1-ranked team (2002, '03).

CENTURY CITY: Sixth-year head coach **Brad Keller** is **95-61** and needs **five** wins to reach 100 in his career. Only three other coaches have ever collected 100 or more wins in USC history: **Mick Haley** (435), **Chuck Erbe** (310), and **Lisa Love** (205). At **95 wins**, Keller is already the fourth-winningest coach in program history.

PLUCKY DUCKS: Since 2019, USC and Oregon have played five-set matches **seven** times, and but one have gone the Ducks' way; four times at Galen Center and twice in Eugene. Prior to the recent plethora of marathon matches with Oregon, USC owned a dominant 55-13 all-time record in the head-to-head history. The Trojans are now **57-21** against the Ducks (**7-6** in five-setters) including a **28-9** mark in Eugene. From Oct. 26, 1990, to Oct. 12, 2007, the Women of Troy **won 34** consecutive matches over the Ducks.

AGREE TO DISAGREE: The Women of Troy lead the all-time series with rival UCLA by a **66-58** margin. Ask someone in blue and gold and they'll tell you otherwise. The Bruins claim to lead the series, **69-66**, but how? UCLA's program, which started in 1972, is several years older than the one at USC, which began in 1976. The Bruins earned a handful of victories over the Trojans before the Women of Troy officially started a varsity program. In those four seasons, the Bruins racked up 11 wins against USC's club team, which are included in UCLA's all-time record.

CROSTOWN CONNECTIONS: USC head coach **Brad Keller** has the unique distinction of having coached both the men's and women's volleyball programs at both USC and UCLA. Prior to his arrival at USC, he served one season (2019) as UCLA's associate head coach. The Trojans' associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** also has UCLA ties having served as an assistant coach for the Bruin men (alongside Keller in his first season) for three years (2018-21). Assistant coach **Megan Moenaa** was a standout setter for the Bruin women and helped UCLA capture the 2011 NCAA championship. She graduated from UCLA in 2015. First-year UCLA assistant coach **Stevi Robinson-Trail** was a 2013 AVCA All-American with the USC beach volleyball program. She won the AVCA's individual national championship with partner **Kirby Burnham** in her only season at Troy.

BIG POW: Redshirt So. MB **Leah Ford** was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 1—the first weekly award of her career—after she produced career highs of 11 kills and 10 blocks for her first double-double. In the process, she racked up a career-best 18.5 points as the first player to reach 10 blocks since Aug. 31, 2023, when **Lindsey Miller** had 11 against Hawai'i on the islands. **Reese Messer** was chosen as the Big Ten Freshman of the Week (Sept. 22) for her first-career weekly award. Trojans have earned Big Ten weekly awards **six** times. In 2024—USC's first year in the conference—**Mia Tuaniga** earned Setter of the Week laurels twice while **Ally Batenhorst** was named the Player of the Week once and **Jadyn Livings** was chosen for the Freshman of the Week award once.

ONCE AROUND THE BLOCK: USC's **2.84 blocks per set** ranks **second** in the Big Ten and is **14th** nationally. USC posted 16.0 blocks in a win over Loyola Marymount (Aug. 31) and has reached double-digit blocks **eight** times. In 2024, USC reached double-digit blocks 20 times in 32 matches including season highs of 19.5 blocks twice: vs. Kansas State (Sept. 6) and vs. Loyola Marymount (Sept. 19).

BIG AND SMALL: Only three Big Ten teams hold winning records against the Trojans. Wisconsin has the best win percentage of the three with a **6-3** mark against USC. Illinois is **4-3** and Penn State is **4-2** against the Women of Troy.

LONG DISTANCE: USC is **159-111** all-time in five-set matches: **69-41** at home; **66-56** on the road; **24-14** in neutral matches. The Trojans were **6-5** in 11 five-set matches in 2023, which tied a school record previously set in 2019. Against Big Ten opponents, USC is **47-42** all-time in five-set contests.

THE ONE AND ONLY: USC has faced the nation's No. 1-ranked team 32 times. The Trojans played their first No. 1-ranked team on Dec. 19, 1982, in that fall's NCAA championship match; a five-set loss to Hawai'i. Overall, USC is **8-24** in those **32** contests with a **4-9** mark when it hosts No. 1 at home. When No. 1 teams visit Galen Center, USC is **3-3** with wins over California (2011), UCLA (2012), and Stanford (2012). The three losses were to Stanford in 2010 and 2014, and to Pittsburgh in 2024.

DOUBLE DOWN: Six Trojans own career double-doubles. Three were achieved in the first week of the season. OPP **Abigail Mullen (4)**, MB **Leah Ford**, and S **Reese Messer (6)** each produced the first of their careers to help the Trojans go 2-0 to open the 2025 season. Entering the fall, OH **Adonia Faumuina** had logged a double-double in her first-collegiate match as she led the Women of Troy to a win over crosstown rival UCLA. OH **London Wijay** had back-to-back double-doubles in road matches at Purdue and UCLA for her first two of her career and now has **12-career** double-doubles. LIB **Gala Trubint** has had **two-career** double-doubles with digs and 10 assists each time.

HOME, SWEET HOME: USC is **223-62 (.782)** all-time at Galen Center. The Trojans went 12-4 at home in 2024. In 2011, USC was 12-1 in home matches and completed 2012 with a 17-1 mark. In 2007, USC was 19-0 at home on the way to an appearance in the NCAA national semifinal match. The Trojans are **20-4** all-time at Galen Center in NCAA tournament matches. The four losses were to Hawai'i (2008 and 2009) and San Diego (2018) each time in the second round; and to Washington in the 2013 NCAA Regional Final.

TEXAS LONE STAR: For the first time in many seasons, only one Trojan hails from the state of Texas. Since All-American MB **Lauren Williams** (Houston) arrived in 2008, at least one USC player has come from Texas in every season but one (2016). This year, MB **Leah Ford** returns to carry the Lone Star banner. She is from Keller, near Dallas. When USC visits Texas, it is **33-9** all-time, and **13-4** in postseason matches.

A TALE OF TWO CITIES: Pin-hitters **London Wijay** and **Brooklyn Tealer** are carrying the left-side load for the Women of Troy. Wijay—a redshirt sophomore—is second on the team with **2.96** kills per set while Tealer—a redshirt freshman—ranks fourth among Trojans with **1.88** kills per set.

FRESH SET: Setters **Reese Messer** and **Allie Hazelwood** have some big shoes to fill following the departure of All-American setter **Mia Tuaniga**. Tuaniga held the starting setter position for the Trojans for more than three years and played in 121 matches to become the program's all-time leader with **4,529** career assists. Tuaniga surpassed a program record previously held by All-American **Kendall Bateman** (4,510 assists; 2008-11) that stood for more than 12 years.

DIGGIN' DEEP: LIB **Gala Trubint** produced back-to-back 416-dig seasons in 2022 and 2023 and had 377 in 2024. Trubint has reached double-digit digs in **73-career** matches and has reached the 20-dig mark **16** times. With **1,308** career digs, Trubint ranks **11th** in program history. She is only the 20th Trojan ever to reach the 1,000-dig plateau.

LONDON BRIDGE: OH **London Wijay** is back after having her 2024 season cut short due to injury. She earned Pac-12 All-Freshman Team laurels in 2023—the 36th Trojan at the time to be chosen to the all-freshman squad—and was an honorable mention for the All-Pac-12 Team. She collected 191 kills in her first-year campaign to rank third on the team. Wijay reclassified into the class of '23 so that she could join the Women of Troy one year ahead of schedule and made an immediate impact.

ROUND TRIP: USC head coach **Brad Keller** is the only coach to have served as a coach for both the USC and UCLA men's and women's volleyball programs. He began his career at Troy as a men's assistant coach in 2007 and held several other posts before his arrival at UCLA where he was an assistant coach for the Bruin men from 2013-18. In 2019, Keller assumed the title of associate head coach for the UCLA women's program before he was tabbed for his first head coaching position in 2020 as the seventh head coach of the Women of Troy.

'OHANA MEANS FAMILY: USC associate head coach **Spencer McLachlin** grew up in Hawai'i where he attended the Punahou School. His father **Chris McLachlin** is a longtime color analyst for UH volleyball broadcasts and was a volleyball and basketball coach at Punahou where he coached President Barack Obama. Spencer's mother **Beth (Hollinger) McLachlin** was an All-American volleyball player at Hawai'i and was a co-captain of the U.S. Olympic team. She served 23 years as the director of athletics at La Pietra Hawai'i School for Girls. The Trojans made a trip to the islands for the third straight year for a two-match series with the Rainbow Wahine. McLachlin is married to former USC pin-hitter **Diane Copenhagen** (2004-07) and the two have two daughters and a son.

COACHING CLASS: The Trojans' pair of third-year associate head coaches **Spencer McLachlin** and assistant coach **Megan Moenaa** were each college standouts in the sport. McLachlin was a national champion student-athlete at Stanford and previously coached at Indiana, UCLA, and California. As a junior outside hitter, he won the 2010 NCAA title with the Cardinal. Moenaa was a standout setter at UCLA and was a freshman setter with the Bruins when they won the 2011 NCAA championship.

ABERCROMBIE AND CHAMP: Trojan All-American OPP **Brittany Abercrombie** (2014-17) was crowned the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Volleyball champion after she earned 4,521 leaderboard points. She was the first non-outside hitter to win the league title after she stood atop the leaderboard on 11 of 15 match days, including the final 10 days in a row. She set a record with 2,020 win points and led in both stat points (2,001) and MVP points (500). Abercrombie led her teams to a 10-2 record, with a perfect 3-0 mark twice, and collected match MVP honors in 11-of-15 contests. The following spring, she helped the Orlando Valkyries win the 2025 PVF Championship.

LEVELED UP: Last year, OH **Ally Batenhorst** and S **Mia Tuaniga** were each chosen in the second-annual Pro Volleyball Federation collegiate draft. Batenhorst was taken with the seventh pick of the second round (15th overall) by the Omaha Supernovas. Tuaniga was selected by the Atlanta Vibe with the third pick of the fourth round (27th overall). Before that, OPP **Kalyah Williams** was taken the fifth pick of the fifth round (33rd overall) by the Orlando Valkyries, a franchise coached by former USC associate head coach **Amy Pauly**. That Valkyries team also featured USC All-American OPP and AU Pro Champion **Brittany Abercrombie** and former libero **Shannon Scully**, who helped the team capture the 2025 championship.

PAC IT UP: The Women of Troy played their final season in the Pac-12 Conference in 2023. On June 30, 2022, USC and UCLA both announced that the schools' athletic programs would join the Big Ten Conference in 2024. Oregon and Washington later made similar announcements. The Pac-12 in its final alignment existed for 13 years and was the Pac-10 for the 25 previous years.

#1 SIT-SET-GO: OH **Adonia Faumuina** sat out most of her freshman season in 2022 because of an injury but was pressed into action when then-starting setter **Mia Tuaniga** suffered an ankle injury in the second-to-last regular-season match. Faumuina stepped in to play setter and racked up a double-double to help lead the Trojans to a win over crosstown rival UCLA in her first-ever collegiate contest. She then sat out and received a redshirt in 2023 with another injury but returned to play a full sophomore season in 2024.

#2 HIGH CLASS: OH **London Wijay** completed her required course studies early and reclassified to join the Trojans' 2023 fall freshman class. Her older brother **Indiana Wijay** is a junior in college and plays quarterback at Houston.

#3 REESE'S PIECES: S **Reese Messer** is the first USC women's volleyball player to hail from the Sunflower State. A native of Olathe, Kansas, Messer surprisingly is not a fan of BBQ but loves seafood and sushi. The highly touted setter was the 2024 Kansas Gatorade Player of the Year who also starred in basketball and in track and field at Saint James Academy. She won state track championships in the 4x100 and 4x400 as a prep and helped her team place third in the basketball state championship.

#4 TROJAN BLOODLINES: LIB **Megan Verbiest** is a fourth-generation Trojan. Great grandfather Kenneth Grossman helped originate the Trojan Huddle with longtime USC football coach **John McKay**. Her grandmother, aunt and uncle, and mother Stacy Brannen Verbiest were all Trojans as well. Megan is now at school with her twin brother Trevor working towards degrees with the class of 2026.

#5 SHOWSTOPPER: OPP **Abigail Mullen** is the first USC women's volleyball player to come from the Show-Me State. The Kansas City native and sought-after pin-hitter comes from a line of athletes in her family. Her mother Jill played volleyball (right side) and her father Scott played football (quarterback); both for Iowa. Her sister **Ashley Mullen** played setter at UCLA for two years (2023-24) and is a sophomore at NC State on the volleyball team.

#6 ON DECK: LIB **Taylor Deckert** is the daughter of USC instructor and lecturer of Physical Education & Mind Body Health **Julie Sprague Deckert**. Mom played volleyball at Chico State and had a 10-year pro-beach career in AVP and USAV events. Sprague was coached in beach volleyball by USC's national championship winning coach **Anna Collier** and was the first volunteer assistant coach of the Trojans' beach volleyball program in 2012.

#7 BUILT FORD TOUGH: MB **Leah Ford**'s father Kirk Sr. was an All-Southwestern Conference basketball forward and team captain at the University of Houston (1994-96). He later played professional basketball in Brazil and Europe.

#8 SOUTHERN MIGRATION: MB **Mia Tvrdy** played 14 matches as a freshman at Oregon and saw action in 26 sets. She was a 2023 High School All-American but is no stranger to Southern California. The Nebraska native was born in Orange, Calif., in 2006.

#9 MOTHER FIGURE: Setter **Allie Hazelwood**'s mother **Jenny Hazelwood** is the head coach at Southern Mississippi. Thought having her mom move away during her junior year in high school was one of life's toughest obstacles, Allie credits the change as something that helped her grow in independence. In the Trojans' match with the Golden Eagles on Aug. 27, 2023, Allie took the court in the third set and recorded two assists to help USC close out a 3-0 sweep. Allie lists playing volleyball professionally and coaching as her career aspirations, much like those of her mother.

#10 HOME ON THE RANGE: OH **Quinn Loper** is the daughter of a pair of Buffaloes. Her mother **Alison Koepke** was a middle blocker at Colorado (1994-97) and her father **Ian Loper** played football at CU (1996-2000). Brother **Jack Loper** is a member of the Stanford men's volleyball team.

#11 READY TO IMPRES: OH **Presley Kiffin** may be the daughter of **Layla Kiffin** and former USC football head coach **Lane Kiffin** but the high-flying outside chose the Trojans so she could blaze her own trail. The Mater Dei graduate helped the Monarchs win CIF championships in 2023 and 2025.

#15 TOP CHEF: OH **Dani Thomas-Nathan** often gets the nod from her teammates as the best chef on the team. She enjoys baking and cooking but her favorite food to eat is sushi. She chose USC because of the highly regarded Viterbi School of Engineering and hopes to pursue a career as a Disney Imagineer.

#16 TRUE TROJAN: LIB **Gala Trubint** lists three-time USC All-American and three-time Olympic medalist **April Ross** as her biggest sports hero. She also looks up to former Trojan defender **Victoria Garrick** as one of her all-time favorite Women of Troy. Trubint's father Bela Trubint, a coach at Coast Volleyball Club was a member of the Serbian National Team in 1991.

#17 PEAS IN A POD: LIB **Paisley Douglas** is one of three siblings with P names. She has younger sisters named Presley and Parkley. Presley is a freshman soccer player at Omaha. To top it off, Paisley was born in Phoenix.

#18 DIAMOND SONG: LIB **Addison Townsend** is the daughter of a pair of Trojans. Late father **Joshua Townsend**—whom she lists as her biggest sports hero—was a member of the 1998 NCAA champion USC baseball team and her mother Lauren was a member of the famed USC Song Leaders. The two met on campus during their time as Trojan undergrads (1995-98).

#21 SUNSHINE ARRIVAL: OH **Brooklyn Tealer** sat out the 2024 season but returned from injury ready for her redshirt freshman season in 2025. She is only the third USC player to hail from the state of Florida. She is the daughter of Cedric and **Lynda Tealer**. Her mother—formerly Lynda Jones—starred as a forward/center for the women's basketball team at San Diego. She later served 20 years as the Deputy Athletic Director at Florida before being appointed as the NCAA's senior vice president of championships in 2024.

#22 GRIDIRON GIRL: MB **Rylie McGinest** is the daughter of USC All-American linebacker **Willie McGinest**. Rylie grew up around sports and lists her father as her biggest sports hero. The elder McGinest was a three-time Super Champion with the New England Patriots and a two-time Pro Bowl selection. He was the fourth overall pick in the 1994 NFL draft and helped solidify the lore of USC's No. 55 jersey on the football field worn by top linebackers.

#23 PEACHY KEEN: OPP **Madison Pietsch** almost quit volleyball at the age of 12 but gave it one more season and the rest is truly history. After a redshirt season in 2022, Pietsch saw her first action at Hawai'i in the Trojans' 2023 trip to the islands and racked up eight and 10 kills on back-to-back nights.
