What You Need To Know

- Rider opens the 2024-25 season Monday night, when it begins a two-game West coast swing at nationally-ranked No. 22 UCLA at 10:30 p.m. (ET) on FS1.

- The Broncos return a pair of starters in TJ Weeks Jr. and Tariq Ingraham. Weeks Jr. is Rider's top returning scorer at 10.0 points per game to go along with 6.3 rebounds per game. Ingraham averaged a team-high 6.5 rebounds in addition to scoring 9.3 points per game.

- Also back for Rider are Ruben Rodriguez, Tyriek Weeks, Ife West-Ingram and Jack McFadden. Rodriguez is expected to take over the starting point guard role, while Weeks, West-Ingram and McFadden will have roles off the bench.

- Rider added nine incoming student-athletes for the 2024-25 academic year. The class includes six student-athletes with previous Division I experience and three freshmen. Seniors Jay Alvarez and Tank Byard and juniors Alaaeddine Boutayeb, Zion Cruz, Zocko Littleton Jr. and Andre Young join true freshmen Flash Burton, Maurizio D'Alessandro and Cole McCabe to comprise the nine-member incoming class.

- The Broncos were picked seventh in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll. Rider has had unique success in three prior occasions being picked seventh, outperforming their projections with the 1st (2017-18), 2nd (2014-15) and 6th (2016-17) seeds in the MAAC Tournament in those seasons.

- The MAAC Championships will have a new feel this season. With the additions of Merrimack and Sacred Heart to comprise a 13-team conference, the tournament, which previously featured all 11 teams, will now welcome just the top 10 teams in the standings on both the men's and women's sides. The tournament returns to Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ, from March 11-15.

- 13th-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 192-183 record. Baggett won MAAC Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2018.

- Only John Carpenter (292) has more wins at Rider.

HOLD THE O; WE ARE THE BRONCS

Originally nicknamed the Rough Riders by the father of Rider Athletics, Clair Bee, Rider's nickname later changed to the Broncos. What is a Bronc? It's a Bronco. But you can hold the second o. Why do we call ourselves the Broncos, then? The quick answer is a newspaper writer at least 70 years ago likely wanted a shorter word to fit their headline and called us the Broncos. Enough people actually liked it, so it stuck. Bee was not one who enjoyed the change, later saying he "damn near went through the ceiling" when he first read of the change. Still to this day, broadcasters and public address announcers routinely call us the Broncos in error, lighting up our SID's phone with texts, calls, emails and DM's to voice frustration. Your assistance in keeping the Broncos to a single "o" and our SID's phone to "0" messages about the issue is greatly appreciated.

SCOUTING THE UCLA BRUINS

The Bruins feature a mix of strong returners and six talented transfers. The returners are led by Dylan Andrews (12.9 ppg., 3.7 apg.) and Sebastian Mack (12.1 ppg., 3.6 rpg.), while Illinois and Louisville transfer Skyy Clark (13.2 ppg., 3.1 rpg., 3.0 apg.) gives the Bruins a loaded backcourt. Also added to the perimeter punch is Loyola Marymount transfer Dominick Harris, who shot 44.7 percent from long range and averaged 14.3 points per game a year ago. Senior Kobe Johnson returns with an all-around game, averaging 10.9 ppg., 4.6 rpg. and 3.3 apg. last year, while William Kyle III was named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Watch List after averaging 11.7 points on 62 percent shooting and grabbing 5.7 rebounds last year at South Dakota State. Oregon State transfer Lazar Stefanovich (11.5 ppg., 6.1 rpg.) and Utah import Tyler Bilodeau (14.3 ppg., 5.7 rpg.) give UCLA seemingly endless firepower.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. UCLA BRUINS

Rider and UCLA are meeting for the first time on the hardwood.

MISSISSIPPI STATE MEMORIES

The last time Rider defeated a nationally-ranked foe came Nov. 13, 2009, when the Broncos took down No. 18 Mississippi State in Starkville. Novar Gadson and Mike Ringgold both contributed 21 points in the victory.

NITTANY NIGHTMARE

Rider's last win over a Big 10 foe came Dec. 22, 2017 at Penn State. Frederick Scott hit a buzzer-beating three to take down the Nittany Lions in Happy Valley.

T.J.'S GOT A TRACK RECORD

T.J. Weeks Jr. is the Broncos top returning scorer at 10.0 points per game a year ago. It was Weeks Jr.'s first year with the Broncos following four years at UMAss. Weeks Jr. enters 2024-25 with 1,146 career points, shooting 36.0 percent from long range.

SECOND SIXTH-YEAR STARTER

Tariq Ingraham gives Rider a second sixth-year starter. After spending parts of three injury-plagued years at Wake Forest, Ingraham transferred to Rider and will enter his third year on the court for the Broncos. Last season, he averaged 9.3 points and led the Broncos at 6.5 rebounds per game, shooting 48.9 percent.

ROLLIN' WITH RUBEN

Ruben Rodriguez projects as the Broncos' starting point guard following 28 appearances off the bench last year. A prolific high-school scorer, his 2,008 scholastic points broke records set by Stu Jackson and Lonnie Walker IV.

PORTALING... EVERYBODY'S DOING IT

The Broncos will look to get contributions from six transfers with prior Division I affiliations in Jay Alvarez, Alaaeddine Boutayeb, Tank Byard, Zion Cruz, Zocko Littleton Jr. and Andre Young. Alvarez ranked fifth in the Southland Conference for Houston Christian at 15.6 points per game a season ago. Tank Byard was a solid contributor at Alcorn State, averaging 7.6 points and 4.4 rebounds, and will join Alvarez in the starting lineup. Boutayeb first was rostered at Florida State, before transferring to Arkansas State and Miami Dade College. The 7-foot-2 center will give the Broncos a dynamic option inside. Zocko Littleton Jr. played his freshman year at Appalachian State, before moving on to Chipola College. Andre Young continues the Rider pipeline from Pebblebrook High School, the same Georgia school that produced All-MAAC selections Dwight Murray Jr. and Mervin James. Young missed his true freshman year at Troy due to injury and played last season at Gulf Coast State College. Still awaiting clearance from the NCAA on an academic issue, Zion Cruz was a five-star prospect when he committed to DePaul for his freshman year and should be able to help the Broncos once eligible after a JUCO year at Pratt (Kansas) Community College.

FRESH FACES

Rider also welcomed two scholarship freshmen and a walk-on. Flash Burton, a 6-foot-3 guard out of Philadelphia averaged 21.6 points per game in his senior season at Cardinal O'Hara. Cole McCabe comes to Rider from the prestigious IMG Academy, while walk-on Maurizio D'Alessandro also joins the Broncos this year out of Fork Union Military Academy and New Hampton Prep.

BAGGETT SECOND ALL-TIME AT RIDER

12th-year Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett tied Thomas Leyden (1940-42, 1946-60) for second all-time at Rider with his 187th win on Feb. 18, 2024, at Manhattan and passed him with his 188th win on Feb. 23, 2024, vs. Iona. Now with 192 wins, only John Carpenter's program-record 292 wins outpace him.

RECORD-SHATTERING PERFORMANCE IN RIVERDALE

Rider shattered its program single-game records in assists (32) and field-goal percentage (76.4%, 42-55) in a 104-62 win at Manhattan on Feb. 18, 2024. The Broncos had reached 29 assists on four prior occasions, most recently Feb. 26, 2005 against Niagara. The previous Rider record for field-goal percentage was 68.9 percent (40-58) on Jan. 5, 1993 against St. Francis Brooklyn.

LET'S TAKE IT A STEP FURTHER

Rider's 76.4 percent shooting on Feb. 18 at Manhattan represented the most accurate shooting performance of the season across NCAA Division I, II and III men's and women's basketball last season. It's also the highest shooting percentage against an NCAA Division I opponent since Creighton shot 77.5 percent (31-40) in a Feb. 14, 2012 win at Southern Illinois.

Two-time MAAC Coach of the Year Kevin Baggett returns for his 13th season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2024-25. The 2024-25 season is the 19th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 18 years, Rider has compiled 303 wins, second-most in the MAAC behind only Iona (338). Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 28 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

'Baggs' is a two-time MAAC Coach of the Year (2015 and 2018) and has been a finalist for three different National Coach of the Year Awards - the Ben Jobe Award, the Joe B. Hall Award and the Hugh Durham Award.

As Head Coach at Rider, Baggett has led his players to 26 All-MAAC honors and two MAAC Sixth Player of the Year awards. The total increases to 36 including six seasons as an assistant coach, with mentorship of 2008 NBA Lottery Pick Jason Thompson, the 2008 MAAC Player of the Year and two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, to his credit. In addition, he's coached six MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees.

In his first season at Rider, Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place. With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee. Included in the 19 wins was Rider's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament victory, a road win at Hartford in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The last time Rider had won a game in a national postseason tournament came in 1957, when the Roughriders won a pair of games in the NCAA College Division Championships (now NCAA Division II).

In 2013-14, Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Baggett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

2017-18 was a banner year for Baggett and the Broncs. Picked to finish seventh in the MAAC after losing four starters to graduation, the Broncs won 22 games, a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship and advanced to the NIT for the second

time in program history. Baggett was named MAAC Coach of the Year for the second time in six years, took NABC All-District 1 Coach and was also a finalist for the Hugh Durham and Ben Jobe Awards. Baggett guided four players to All-MAAC honors, including First Teamer Dimencio Vaughn, Second Teamer Stevie Jordan and Third Team honorees Jordan Allen and Frederick Scott. Scott was named MAAC 6th Player of the Year, while Allen earned All-Rookie Team honors. Vaughn was also selected to the NABC All-District Second Team and earned Second Team All-Met. As a team, Rider led the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.465), offensive rebounds per game (13.2), rebound margin (+2.6), steals per game (7.5), rebounds per game (39.2), turnover margin (+2.2) and turnovers forced per game (15.4). Jordan led the league in assists (5.9) for the second-straight year and was 26th in the nation. Allen's 2.88 three-point field goals made per game ranked 50th in the country, while Vaughn's 1.83 steals per game were 55th. Baggett earned his 100th career win on Jan. 26, 2018, against Saint Peter's.

Stevie Jordan and Frederick Scott repeated as All-MAAC Second and Third Team selections, respectively, in 2018-19, as the Broncos finished tied for second in the MAAC Regular Season Standings. Jordan recorded his 1,000th career point, becoming the 37th player in Rider history to reach the plateau.

In 2019-20, Tyere Marshall joined the ranks of All-MAAC selections, earning Third Team recognition. Dimencio Vaughn returned to All-MAAC First Team form, while Scott earned his third-straight Third Team honor. Vaughn, Scott and Marshall became the 38th, 39th, and 40th Broncos to score their 1,000th points in the cranberry and white. The Broncos compiled an 18-12 overall record and a 12-8 mark in league play. Baggett's Broncos earned the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Championships and were riding a three-game winning streak when the tournament was halted due to COVID-19.

Rider once again won a MAAC Tournament game in 2020-21 under Baggett, taking an opening-round contest against sixth-seeded Canisius. Dwight Murray, Jr. earned All-MAAC Second Team and NABC All-District 1 Second Team honors.

While 2021-22 had its up's and down's, the year ended on a high note, as Baggett led the Broncos to a pair of MAAC Tournament wins, including an upset of top-seeded Iona in the quarterfinals. Dimencio Vaughn earned All-MAAC Second Team honors and Dwight Murray, Jr. was named to the MAAC All-Championship Team after hitting the game-winning shot against Iona with six seconds remaining in regulation.

Baggett led the Broncos to a second-place finish in the MAAC regular season standings in 2022-23, including a win at eventual champion Iona, snapping the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak. Rider ranked among the best rebounding teams in the nation with a +4.6 rebounding margin, good for 37th in Division I. Murray earned his second All-MAAC honor, being named to the First Team, while Mervin James was selected to the Second Team.

The Broncos again finished in the upper tier of the MAAC in 2023-24, with Baggett guiding Rider to a 15-17 mark, including a 12-8 record in league play. The Broncos finished the league slate with a seven-game winning streak to clinch a first-round bye in the MAAC Championships. During the win streak, Baggett moved past Thomas Leyden (187 wins) into second place all-time at Rider with his 188th victory at the school. James was a unanimous First Team All-MAAC honoree, while Allen Powell was selected to the Third Team.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He received his bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's in June, 1989.

Baggett came to Rider from the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he served as assistant coach from 2004-06. At UMBC Baggett recruited an America East All-Rookie Team member who went on to earn First Team All-Conference honors three times, as well as a pair of transfers from the Colonial Athletic Association who went on to earn All-America East honors.

Baggett has also served as an assistant coach at James Madison, Howard, Western Kentucky and Coastal Carolina.
