QUICK HITTERS

- UC Riverside is 3-4 on the season after a 109-63 win over Bethesday on Sunday.
- UCR has already checked two of its four Power 5 road trips off the list (Utah, North Carolina). UC Riverside still has yet to visit UCLA (11/30) and Washington State (12/6).
- UCR has played multiple Power 5 schools each year since 2021-22. Four of those seven contests have been decided by single digits, including a 66-65 win at Arizona State on November 11, 2021.
- UC Riverside boasts nine returners from a 2022-23 squad that set a program Division I-record 22 overall wins and 14 in Big West play.
- Rising sophomore Nate Pickens was tabbed as a Preseason Second Team All-Big West selection and Big West Breakout Player by The Almanac.

HEAD COACH MIKE MAGPAYO



Mike Magpayo has set a new standard for UC Riverside men's basketball, entering his fourth year as full-time head coach in 2023-24 after having the interim tag removed on May 21, 2021. Magpayo is the fastest UC Riverside head coach to collect 25 Big West victories, doing so in just three seasons.

Magpayo was named the first Big West Coach of the Year in program history in 2022-23 after leading UCR to a program-record 22 wins - including 10 in Big West play - while picking up another program-record five Big West Player of the Week awards. The 2022-23 season also saw senior guard and First Team All-Big West honoree Zyon Pullin join the 1,000-point club, as UC Riverside secured its first season sweep of Long Beach State since 2008-09 and the first win at UC Santa Barbara in program history.

The 2022-23 Highlanders also reached 12 wins in January for just the third time in the program's 22-year Division I history and second with Magpayo on staff (2019-20). For his efforts in 2022-23, Magpayo was also named a finalist for the Hugh Durham Award, presented by Colleg Insider to the top mid-major head coach in Division I men's college basketball.

A 2021-22 recipient of the Rising Coaches Trailblazer Award, an award presented to individuals who have blazed the way for diversity, equity and inclusion through the coaching and sports industry, Magpayo led the '21-22 squad to a six seed in the Big West Tournament and a 16-12 season with wins over previously-unbeaten Hawaii and Cal State Fullerton on ESPNU, in addition to a memorable buzzer-beating win at Arizona State during the season's opening weekend that made the rounds through the college basketball world.

Magpayo's program garnered four All-Big West spots for the second consecutive year, including Dominick Pickett picking up All-Big West Honorable Mention honors and a second straight Best Hustle Player award.

Before the 2020-21 year, Magpayo had served as an assistant coach with the program since his arrival prior to the 2017-18 season.

Following his first year at the helm, Magpayo led the program to new heights in the 2020-21 season with its highest Big West Tournament seed in program history (three) and the first Big West Tournament win in 10 years. The 2020-21 Highlanders also posted the best Big West record since the 2008-09 season, doing so in four fewer games.

UCR's 57-42 win over Washington marked a number of firsts for Magpayo, including his first over a signature Power-5 opponent. It was his first win as a head coach, his first game coached on the sideline, and further, the first win for a team coached by a Division I head coach of Asian American descent.

For his efforts, Magpayo was named the 2021 Joe B. Hall Award recipient, given annually to the top first-year head coach in Division I college basketball.

He was promoted to Associate Head Coach after a 2019-20 season when he helped lead the program to a record-tying 17 wins. As defensive coordinator, Magpayo was able to push the 2019-20 Highlanders to the top of multiple national rankings defensively, including ranking in the top 10 in scoring defense, field goal percentage and defensive rebounding on their way to invitations to both the CBI and CIT.

Prior to arriving in Riverside, he spent a year as the men's basketball director of operations at the University of San Francisco on the staff of his coaching mentor, Kyle Smith. The Dons finished the season with 22 wins, a fourth-place finish in the West Coast Conference and an appearance in the CBI Championship.

Prior to his time at San Francisco, Magpayo spent three seasons at Campbell University in the Big South Conference, where he served as the defensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator. In 2016-17, he helped put together one of the best seasons in school history, as the Camels advanced to the conference championship game as well as the CIT quarterfinals in the program's first postseason appearance since 1992. While at Campbell, Magpayo recruited and developed current Houston Rockets guard Chris Clemons.

A Hacienda Heights, Calif. native, Magpayo was the lead recruiter at Columbia for Ivy Player of the year Maodo Lo from Germany as well as 6'11" all league player Luke Petrusek. He was also an integral part in helping bring Columbia to new heights, serving as director of operations, assistant coach, and recruiting coordinator and scheduler during the most successful four-year run in Columbia history 2010-14.

Magpayo has also found tremendous success off the court, both as the CEO of a multi-million dollar real estate firm in Southern California for seven years, and as the founder and president of the Asian Coaches Association. He graduated from UC Santa Barbara with a degree in business economics in 2001. He was also a Southern California High School basketball coach from 2001-2010 before starting his college coaching career.

Magpayo resides in Riverside with his wife Caroline, who is a UC Riverside alumna, class of 2011.



GAME NOTES

JORDAN YEAR

2023-24 will mark UC Riverside's 23rd year as a member of the Big West. In that time, the program has produced 23 All-Big West honorees, one Big West Coach of the Year, two Big West Sixth Man of the Year honorees, 29 Big West Player of the Week honors and 20 Big West All-Academic honorees.

MAKING HISTORY

UCR's season opener on November 7 was the first time in history of the University of California system that two head coaches of full Asian descent squared off in a Division I men's college basketball game when Mike Magpayo faced off with UC Merced head coach Kevin Pham. Jhaylon Martinez put up a double double (13 points, 10 rebounds) in the win while Barrington Hargress led UCR with 16 points.

LAST TIME OUT

UC Riverside's offense exploded for a 109-63 win over Bethesda on Sunday afternoon.

- Chip Brunt, Jayden Mojica and Clancy Bird all made their UCR debuts on Sunday. Brunt and Jhaylon Martinez led the bench with 12 points each while Martinez notched a double double, adding 10 rebounds.
- UCR hit the century mark for the second year in a row while improving to 9-1 at home in non-conference play under Mike Magpayo.
- The Highlanders nearly blanked Bethesda in second-chance points with a 25-4 advantage and shot 85.7 percent from the free throw line.

THURSDAY'S MATCHUP

The Highlanders are 0-5 all-time against UCLA dating back to 2001-02. A win will be UCR's first over the Bruins and the third over a Pac-12 school under Mike Magpayo (Arizona State, Washington).

SUCCESS UNDER MAGPAYO

The Mike Magpayo coaching era for UC Riverside has seen milestone after milestone, as the Highlanders have continued to raise the standard for UCR men's basketball with him on staff - both as a head coach and assistant coach.

- Magpayo won the program's first ever Big West Coach of the Year honor last season after leading UCR to a Division I program-record 22 wins overall and 14 in Big West play.
- UCR's win over Washington on December 1, 2020 was the first win at the NCAA Men's Division I level by a head coach of Asian American descent.
- UCR has won 25 Big West games since the start of the 2020-21 season, Magpayo's first as head coach. The program needed the previous five seasons to reach 25 conference victories, and Magpayo is the fastest UCR head coach to 25 Big West victories.
- Three of UCR's most recent wins over Power 5 schools have come with Magpayo on staff: 2019-20 at Nebraska, 2020-21 vs. Washington, 2021-22 at Arizona State.

HASHTAG HIGHLANDERS: WHAT'S TRENDING?

- UC Riverside is one of six schools in Division I with multiple players ranking in the top 40 for total assists (Kansas, Sam Houston, Monmouth, High Point, Hofstra). Individually, Barrington Hargress ranks seventh among Division I freshmen with 14 total assists.
- All seven games this season have seen both UCR and their opponent shoot under 50 percent.
- UCR is 3-0 on the year when leading at 5:00 of the second half, and all three wins have come when the Highlanders win the turnover battle.
- UC Riverside is 2-1 on the year when grabbing north of 40 rebounds.
- The Highlanders have assisted on at least 50 percent of their made field goals in every game this season and approximately 60 percent of all made field goals on the season.
- Wil Tattersall and Isaiah Moses are the only Highlanders to have started all seven games this year. Moses ranks in the top 60 in Division I in assist/turnover ratio (57th/4.50), assists (14th/18), and assists per game (35th/6.0).
- UCR has rotated Isaiah Moses and Barrington Hargress at the point guard position through seven games this season - both of whom made their Division I debuts in UCR's 76-69 win over UC Merced on November 7. The duo combined for 24 points, two rebounds and five assists that night.

MILESTONE WATCH

Wil Tattersall's next made three will give him 100 for his UCR career, while Mike Magpayo will coach his 92nd game as Highlanders head coach on Thursday.

A YEAR TO REMEMBER

2022-23 was one of the best seasons to date for UC Riverside men's basketball, as UCR achieved...

- The program's first 20-win Division I season after erasing an 11-point deficit at Hawai'i
- Three Big West major postseason awards, including UCR's first Coach of the Year in Mike Magpayo
- A program-record five Big West Players of the Week
- Two Colleg Insider National Players of the Week
- Six double-digit comeback victories
- The program's second third seed at the Big West Championship in the last three years
- 12 wins in January for the third time in the program's Division I history
- Program records of 22 overall wins and 14 Big West wins
- The program's first-ever win at UC Santa Barbara and first season sweep of the Gauchos
- Coach Magpayo's 50th win at UC Riverside
- UCR's 25th Big West victory under Magpayo. Prior to his appointment, the program needed the previous five years to reach that mark.
- The inclusion of Zyon Pullin into the program's 1,000-point club

fers (Clancy Bird, Ben Gristci), one true freshman (Chip Brunt) and three junior college transfers (Gavin Davis, Isaiah Moses, Jayden Mojica). Moses was named an NJCAA All-American last season at the College of Southern Idaho after being named the 2020 Alaska Gatorade Player of the Year. Brunt turned down offers from the likes of Akron, Jacksonville and North Carolina A&T to join UCR and is the third Highlander hailing from east of the Mississippi River since 2018-19 (Kobe Jerome, George Willborn III).

Gristci and Moses have both entered into immediate starting roles for Coach Magpayo's squad following the departures of Zyon Pullin and Lachlan Olbrich from last season. Moses already ranks 14th in Division I in total assists just seven games into the season (18). Barrington Hargress has also entered into a starting role after redshirting last season behind Pullin and Flynn Cameron. Hargress ranks 39th in Division I with 14 assists.

UC Riverside boasts nine returners from a 2022-23 squad that set a program Division I-record 22 overall wins and 14 in Big West play.

PICKING OUT PICKENS

Nate Pickens was named a Breakout Player per Big West coaches by The Alamanac earlier this offseason, and was also tabbed by the publication as a Preseason Second Team All-Big West selection.

The Arizona native appeared in 30 games off the bench last season, averaging 2.0 points and shooting .302 from the field. Pickens enjoyed a stretch from January 5 to the 21st with at least 10 minutes in six of those seven appearances. He scored a career-high 10 points in 20 minutes at CSUN on February 20.

Pickens made his first career start at Utah this season and on Sunday against Bethesda recorded career highs of seven rebounds, five assists and two steals.

POINTS OF PERSONNEL PRIDE

A pair of UC Riverside Athletics personnel earned some love this past May from Silver Wave Media. Athletics Director Wes Mallette was named one of the publication's 100 Most Impactful People in Men's College Basketball, while assistant coach Dustin Yoder was named one of the Top 75 Most Impactful Mid-Major Assistants.

SCHEDULE NOTES

UC Riverside under Mike Magpayo has faced grueling non-conference schedules, and 2023-24 is no different with Power 5 road trips to North Carolina, Utah, UCLA and Washington State. The Highlanders are facing at least one Pac-12 school for the eighth straight year, a run that includes a viral buzzer beater in November 2021 at Arizona State and Magpayo's first head coaching win in 2020 against Washington in Las Vegas.

Two Pac-12 road trips will be homecomings for a pair of Highlander staffers. Assistant coach Matt Hurwitz returns to his UCLA stomping grounds on November 30 before Eddie Hill - who played for Kelvin Sampson - reunites with his Pullman college roots when the Highlanders travel to Washington State.

Previous Power 5 opponents since 2015-16 outside the Pac-12 have included Nebraska (2019-20) and Michigan (2017-18). UC Riverside will begin Big West play on the road for the first time since 2019-20, traveling to UC Irvine on December 28.

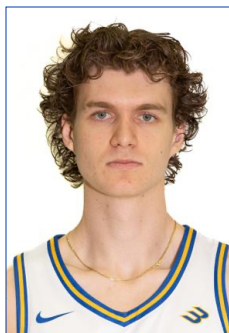

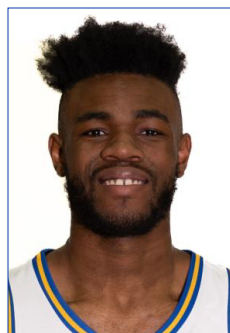
