Meet 1 - at Minnesota, w/ Iowa (Jan. 19)

In its delayed 2022 season opener, UCLA scored 194.850 and placed third in a tri-meet behind host Minnesota (196.900) and Iowa (195.950). Norah Flatley placed third in the all-around in her first all-around appearance since 2019, scoring 39.225, and finished second on bars with a 9.900. Chae Campbell also earned a second-place finish with a 9.9 on a stuck Yurchenko full. The Bruins had to count a fall on bars in the first rotation and low marks on vault in the final rotation. The Bruins' top event score was 49.125 on floor exercise, led by Brooklyn Moors' 9.875.

UCLA improved upon its season-opening score by nearly a point and a half, placing second in a tri-meet at Oregon State with a score of 196.300. The Bruins scored over 49 on bars (49.175), beam (49.275) and floor (49.000) and enjoyed strong contributions from the freshman class, including a 39.100 all-around debut from Emma Malabuyo, a team-high 9.9 on beam from Ana Padurariu and team-high scores on vault (9.875) and bars (9.925) from Jordan Chiles. Oregon State won the meet with a score of 197.000. UC Davis was third with a 194.700.

Meet 3 - Arizona (Jan. 30)

UCLA improved for the third-consecutive week, defeating No. 33 Arizona with a season-best 196.400 to 195.125. The Bruins scored over 49 on vault (49.250), bars (49.050), and beam (49.250) and enjoyed a strong contribution from senior Norah Flatley's personal-best 39.450 all-around score. She recorded a season-high and meet-winning 9.900 on floor exercise, a season-high 9.90 on balance beam, and a career-high 9.850 on vault. The Bruins recorded six scores of 9.900 or better, including three on balance beam. Freshman Emma Malabuyo had the highest score with a 9.925 that included a 10.0 from one judge. Four Bruins scored above 39.1 in the all-around – Flatley (39.450), Jordan Chiles (39.350), Malabuyo (39.250) and Chae Campbell (39.175).

Meet 4 - Utah (Feb. 4)

Facing No. 3 Utah on an ESPN2 nationally-televvised meet, No. 22 UCLA rose to the occasion and delivered season-high team totals on all four events, scoring 197.650 to smash its season-best score by 1.25 points. The Utes edged the Bruins, however, by just one-tenth of a point, thanks to a 9.975 by Maile O'Keefe on beam to clinch the win. UCLA freshman Jordan Chiles won the all-around with a score of 39.700 and scored a perfect 10 on floor exercise. UCLA recorded season-bests of 49.275 on vault, 49.450 on uneven bars, 49.325 on balance beam and 49.600 on floor exercise.

Meet 5 - at Stanford (Feb. 12)

UCLA received season-high all-around performances from Chae Campbell (39.500) and Emma Malabuyo (39.475), a perfect 10 from Jordan Chiles on uneven bars, and closed out the meet with four consecutive scores of 9.9 or higher on balance beam, but was edged out by host Stanford by a slim .050 margin, 196.900-196.850. Kyla Bryant's 9.975 on floor exercise on the final routine clinched the victory for the Cardinal. The Bruins led by a slim margin (147.525-147.300) going into the final rotation and had the final four competitors score 9.9 or higher, including career-high marks from Samantha Sakti (9.95, with a perfect 10 from one judge) and late sub Kendal Poston (9.9), but it wasn't enough to hold off the Cardinal, who scored 49.6 on floor to close.

Meet 6 - at Arizona State (Feb. 20)

UCLA earned a season-high total on vault, but mishaps on uneven bars in the first rotation put the Bruins in a deep hole in a 197.800-195.475 loss at Arizona State. UCLA scored just 47.825 on uneven bars in rotation one, and although the Bruins recovered with a season-high 49.325 on vault and a 49.400 on floor exercise, the difference in the first rotation was insurmountable, as the Sun Devils recorded a season-high total. Freshman Emma Malabuyo tied her career-high in the all-around with a 39.475 and tied for first on beam with Kendal Poston, both earning career-high-tying marks of 9.900. Jordan Chiles scored 9.975 on floor exercise to win the event.

Meet 8 - vs. California (Mar. 6)

No. 17 UCLA surpassed the 198 mark for the first time since 2020 and posted its highest team score since 2019 in a 198.050-197.200 dual meet victory over No. 8 California. Jordan Chiles, Norah Flatley and Chae Campbell went 1-2-3 in the all-around, each scoring 39.700 or higher. The trio combined for 11 scores of 9.9 or higher, including seven that went 9.95 or higher. Chiles earned her third perfect 10 of the season, notching her second on floor exercise. Campbell had a perfect score as well, as she scored 9.95 on her 9.95 start-valued vault. Chiles posted a winning all-around mark of 39.800 as she captured her second all-around win of the year. UCLA recorded season-high scores on vault (49.475), beam (49.625) and floor (49.775).

Fifth-seeded UCLA finished in first place after Session 1 and fourth place overall at the Pac-12 Championships, scoring 196.950, a new season-high road score for the team. The Bruins improved on each event as the meet went on, recording the meet's third-highest beam total with a 49.375 and the second-highest floor score with a 49.425. Norah Flatley led four UCLA all-arounders with a fifth-place finish and 39.450 score. Emma Malabuyo led on floor exercise after Session 1 and earned third place overall with a 9.925. Chae Campbell was UCLA's other Top 3 finisher, tying for second on vault with a 9.900.

The Bruins earned the meet's highest event scores on vault (49.400), uneven bars (49.475) and floor exercise (49.625) to advance to the regional final with the highest score of the day. Norah Flatley won the all-around with a score of 39.575. Jordan Chiles tied for first on uneven bars with a 9.950 and tied with sophomore Chae Campbell for first on floor exercise, also scoring 9.950.

The Bruins led all teams after the first two rotations after scoring 49.550 on floor exercise and 49.325 on vault but were overtaken for first by Michigan in the third rotation despite scoring 49.400 on uneven bars. In the final rotation, Missouri scored 49.575 on floor exercise to surpass the Bruins, who scored 49.125, with only had one score over 9.825 - Emma Malabuyo's 9.975 on the final routine.
