UCLA PLAYS THREE AT OUTRIGGER CHALLENGE

The No. 23-ranked UCLA women's volleyball team will play three matches at the Outrigger Volleyball Challenge at the Stan Sheriff Center in Honolulu, Hawaii this week. The Bruins open competition versus West Virginia on Thursday, Sept. 1 at 7:45 p.m. PT and play Texas State on Friday, Sept. 2 at 7:45 p.m. PT. UCLA closes the weekend versus Hawai'i at 8 p.m. PT which will be available for streaming on ESPN+.

WEEK IN REVIEW

The Bruins split their season-opening weekend at the Utah State Invitational, losing to Utah State, 3-1, and bouncing back with a 3-0 sweep of Cal Poly. The loss to the Aggies marked UCLA's fourth-ever loss in a season-opener. In that contest, UCLA tallied 20.0 team blocks which was its most in a match since Sept. 2, 2018 versus San Diego (22.0 team blocks). Three separate Bruins logged double-digit kills in their first victory of the season over the Mustangs: élan McCall (14), Iman Ndiaye (10) and Grayce Olson (10).

WESTWOOD BLOCK PARTY

The Bruins pace the nation in blocks per set with 4.29 roofs a frame. UCLA shattered last season's high of 16.0 team blocks with 20.0 in its very first match of the 2022 season against Utah State. Sophomore middle blocker Francesca Alupe established a new career high of three solo blocks in that match. McCall also set a UCLA career high of six total blocks in that match (1-5).

FRESH IMPACT

Six new faces – three transfers, two freshman and redshirt freshman Katie McCarthy – made their first appearances in a UCLA uniform last weekend. Among the transfers were setter Matti McKissock (Georgia Tech), libero Mackenzie Cole (Duke) and Peyton Dueck (Cal Poly). Outside hitters Grayce Olson (Foothill HS) and Cheridyn Leverette (Eagle's Landing Christian Academy) made their collegiate debuts. Freshman outside hitter Grayce Olson found her rhythm in the third set of UCLA's victory over Cal Poly, going off for a team-high six kills and a solo block for 7.0 total points. The Pleasanton, Calif. native finished the match with 10 kills, reaching double-figures in just her second collegiate match.

SERVING LOOKS

Sophomore defensive specialist Peyton Dueck served it tough all weekend for the Bruins at the Utah State Invitational. In UCLA's win over Cal Poly, Dueck served a team-high 15 attempts and dealt two aces, including one for match point against her former squad. Alupe is also making her debut in UCLA's serving rotation this year. She led a key 4-0 run in the first set of the Cal Poly match to bring the score to 20-14.

OLD STOMPING GROUNDS

Head coach Michael Sealy, who begins his 13th season at the helm of the UCLA women's volleyball program, returns to Hawai'i where her served as associate head coach from 2006-09. Sealy helped Hawai'i to a berth in the National Semifinals in 2009. The Rainbow Wahine recorded their second-straight, 30-win season last year, going 32-3 overall. They also posted a 16-0 mark in conference play to earn their 14th-straight Western Athletic Conference title and went on to claim their 10th-consecutive WAC Tournament championship. Sealy's record during his tenure at Hawai'i was 119-19 (.862 winning percentage).

PRESEASON RANKINGS

UCLA enters the second week of the season ranked No. 23 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll. This is UCLA's 554th week ranked in the AVCA poll dating back to 1982, which ranks third most all-time behind Nebraska (588) and Stanford (564). UCLA, coming off its highest conference finish (2nd) since 2016, was tabbed to finish third and received one first-place vote in the Pac-12 Preseason Coaches Poll.

BRUINS TO WATCH

Sophomore outside hitter Charitie Luper and graduate transfer middle blocker Lauren Forte (Florida) were named to the 2022 All-Pac-12 Preseason Team. Luper was a four-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week last season, ranking second on the squad with 227 kills despite playing in only 18 of UCLA's 31 matches. Luper's 3.39 kills per set were second only to Mac May (4.85 KPS). The duo led all Pac-12 scoring tandems through October of conference play with a combined 388 kills and 480 points prior to Luper's injury. Forte transfers into Westwood from Florida after a pair of All-SEC and AVCA All-American honors. In her two seasons as a Gator, Forte averaged 1.02 blocks per set (147.0 total blocks) and 2.06 kills per set at a .422 hitting percentage.

WHO'S BACK?

In addition to returning Luper, UCLA brings back All-Pac-12 Team middle blocker Anna Dodson and All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention outside hitter élan McCall. The trio of Bruins helped push UCLA to sole possession of first place in the Pac-12 standings in 2021 after defeating Washington State (Oct. 29) and Washington (Oct. 31). It was the first time the Bruins sat atop the conference standings since 1999.

- Dodson led UCLA with 109 total blocks and a .342 hitting percentage (min. 150 total attempts). Dodson also ranked third on the team with 216 kills, racking up 10+ kills in seven matches all at above a .400 clip.
- McCall was a two-way star for the Bruins in Fall 2021. She ranked third amongst Pac-12 pin hitters in digs per set (2.65) with 286 total digs on the season. McCall recorded 15 double-digit dig performances, including a career-best 28 digs in a victory over Oregon which tied a program three-set match record by Lainey Gera in 2011. Offensively, McCall dealt 40 service aces which was second on the squad behind Mac May as well as averaged 1.40 kills per set.
- Outside hitter Iman Ndiaye, who was an All-Pac-12 Team and Pac-12 All-Freshman Team selection in Spring 2021, also returns to the team her junior campaign. Ndiaye compete in 18 of UCLA's 31 matches in Fall 2021, averaging 1.53 kills per set. Ndiaye had a standout performance in the Bruins' NCAA Second Round match up with UCF, tallying 10 block assists which was the most by a UCLA player that season.
- Middle blocker Francesca Alupeí is back in the fold for her sophomore season. As a freshman, Alupeí started in 28 of UCLA's 31 matches and led the Bruins in the blocking category in 13 contests.

WHAT'S NEW, BRU?

UCLA returns nine letterwinners from last season's roster and looks to replace starters Mac May, who ranks third on the Bruins' career kills list (2,065), Zoe Fleck (grad transfer to Texas) and Shelby Martin (graduated). To do so, UCLA brought in four transfers, including two AVCA All-Region team members in setter Matti McKissock (Georgia Tech) and libero Mackenzie Cole (Duke). Two-time All-SEC member Lauren Forte also joined the Bruins in the offseason. In addition to head coach Michael Sealy's transfer haul, his 2022 class of incoming freshmen includes a pair of players tabbed to VolleyballMag.com's Feb 50 list in outside hitters Cheridyn Leverette and Grayce Olson.

Matti McKissock: McKissock, a native of Windermere, Fla., picked up two All-ACC First Team nods, was named ACC Setter of the Year in 2019 and was a two-time AVCA East Coast All-Region Team honoree in her four seasons at Georgia Tech. Last season, she helped produce two AVCA First Team All-American attackers in Julia Bergmann and Mariana Brambilla with an ACC-best 11.81 assists per set. She was instrumental in getting Georgia Tech to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2004 in the 2020-21 season as well as its best finish in program history the next season at the Elite 8 in the Fall 2021 NCAA Championships

Mackenzie Cole: Cole, from Long Island, N.Y., was named ACC Defensive Player in Fall 2021 and was a two-time All-ACC Second Team and AVCA All-East Coast Region selection in her four years at Duke. Cole led the Blue Devils in digs and digs per set in each of the last four seasons, accumulating 1,664 career digs which ranks fifth all-time in Duke's record books. Last season, she racked up 427 digs and averaged 4.19 digs per set.

Lauren Forte: Forte, a 6-3 star at both Florida and California, earned All-SEC accolades twice and was named an AVCA Third Team All-American in her two seasons at Florida in addition to two AVCA All-Southeast Region selections. She competed in 44 matches and 144 sets over two seasons as a Gator, averaging 2.06 kills per set at a .422 hitting percentage (296 total kills) and 1.02 blocks per set (147.0 total blocks). In Fall 2021, Forte ranked 17th in the nation and second in the SEC with a .401 hitting percentage as well as tallied five or more blocks in six matches.

Peyton Dueck: A libero from Aptos, Calif., Dueck starred both indoors and on the beach at Cal Poly before transferring to UCLA. She was named to the Big West All-Freshman Team and selected All-Big West Honorable Mention after leading the Mustangs with 467 digs and ranking fourth in the conference at 4.17 digs per set. She also led her team and ranked second in the Big West with 41 service aces. After a successful indoor season, Dueck was named the AVCA National Beach Volleyball Pair of the Week alongside Addison Hermstad on May 2 after going a perfect 4-0 to help Cal Poly win its third straight Big West Championship and earn an automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

Cheridyn Leverette: Leverette, a 6-0 outside hitter out of Hampton, Ga., attended Eagle's Landing Christian Academy where she was honored as the 2021-22 Georgia Gatorade Volleyball Player of the Year. Leverette was ranked No. 34 on PrepVolleyball.com's Top 150 class of 2022 recruits and named an AVCA High School Second Team All-American and Under Armour Second Team All-American in 2021. She was also selected as the Georgia Class 1A Private Player of the Year in 2021. In her senior season, she paced the state with 564 kills at a .416 hitting percentage to pair with 370 digs and 72 service aces, leading the Chargers (39-6) to the Georgia Class 1A Private semifinal. Leverette also participated in the 2021 USA Volleyball Indoor Girl's

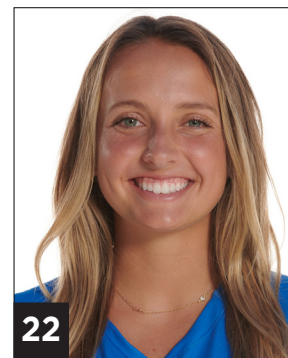
