NO. 15 UCLA HOSTS CROSSTOWN RIVAL USC ON PAC-12 NETWORKS

No. 15-ranked UCLA (9-4) continues a seven-game homestand this weekend, bringing in crosstown rival USC (9-2) in the first Pac-12 series of the year for both teams. All three games of the series will be televised live on the Pac-12 Networks, with game times of 5:00 p.m. PT on Friday and Saturday and a 3:00 p.m. PT finale on Sunday. J.B. Long will have the play-by-play call all weekend, and will be joined in the booth on Sunday by UCLA alumnus Ben Francisco. Fans can also follow along with an internet radio broadcast (play-by-play: Nick Koop) and live stats on UCLABruins.com, as well as live Twitter updates from @UCLABaseball.

QUICK HITS

- UCLA is 9-4 so far on the year, and has won seven of its last eight games
- Bruin starting pitchers have combined for an 1.44 ERA and 12.4 K/9 ratio so far
- UCLA has allowed 12 runs total over the last eight games (1.5 runs against per game)
- Last week, UCLA was crowned champion of the Shriner's Children's College Classic (2-1 record, plus-15 run differential)
- The Bruins have struck out 15+ batters in five games so far, including four consecutive from Feb. 20-25
- UCLA leads the country in WHIP (0.86) and is top-10 nationally in K-BB ratio (5.5, 2nd), H/9 (5.6, 4th), and strikeouts (153, 9th)
- Thatcher Hurd ranks third nationally with a 17.5 strikeouts per nine innings ratio
- UCLA is 32-36 this season in stolen base tries (89% success rate), including 13 SBs from Kenny Oyama (2nd in NCAA)
- UCLA's current freshman class was the No. 1-ranked recruit class in the country
- UCLA had six players on D1Baseball's Top 100 Impact Freshmen List, more than any other school in the country
- 2021: 37-20 record, No. 2 seed in NCAA Regionals, NCAA-high 10 players selected in MLB Draft

THE WEEK IN REVIEW

UCLA went 3-1 last week, winning two-of-three at the Shriner's Children's College Classic in Houston (Minute Maid Park) before defeating Cal State Fullerton in a Tuesday night contest:

- The Bruins were edged in a pitcher's duel, 2-1, by Baylor on Friday in the first game of the Shriner's Children's College Classic. Jake Brooks allowed just three hits and struck out seven in a complete game effort for the Bruins. Trailing 2-0 in the ninth, Carson Yates hit a pinch-hit solo homer to halve the deficit, and UCLA would go on to load the bases before a sharply-hit Cody Schrier grounder was gobbled up for the game's final out
- Yates had a team-high six RBIs, including a grand slam that drove in the game-winning run, to lead UCLA to a blowout 15-3 win over Oklahoma on Saturday. The Bruins posted six spots in the first and third innings against the Sooners to open a big lead, and three-spot in the sixth highlighted by a Schrier home run gave UCLA a season-high in runs scored. The game was called in the middle of the seventh with the run rule in effect for the tournament. Ethan Flanagan and Thatcher Hurd tossed 3 2/3 innings of scoreless relief for the Bruins, with the former picking up his first career win
- The Bruins picked up a signature win on Sunday, defeating top-ranked Texas by a score of 5-1. Kelly Austin (5.1 IP, 1 ER, 8 K), Luke Jewett (0.2 IP, K), and Alonzo Tredwell (3.0 IP, 5 K) teamed up to limit the Longhorns to just five hits. UCLA never trailed in the game, going ahead in the third on a Darius Perry RBI single and taking the lead for good with two runs in the fifth. Yates (2-4, triple), Ethan Gourson (two doubles, RBI), and Michael Curialle (2-4) all had multiple hits for UCLA
- UCLA's win over Texas was its first against a No. 1-ranked team since May 26, 2018 vs. Oregon State
- UCLA was crowned champion of the Shriner's Children's College Classic by virtue of a run differential tiebreaker (four of six teams at the tourney went 2-1, Tennessee's plus-eight differential was next-best after UCLA's plus-15)
- The Bruins defeated Cal State Fullerton 5-4 on Tuesday night at Jackie Robinson Stadium. UCLA led 3-0 by the end of the second inning, but had to rally late after the Titans tied it up at 4-4 with three unearned runs in the seventh inning. Kenny Oyama worked a leadoff walk in the bottom of the eighth, stole second, and later scored on a Michael Curialle double to bring in the game-winning run. Thatcher Hurd allowed one earned run and struck out seven over 4 1/3 innings, while the UCLA bullpen went the rest of the way without allowing an earned run.

ON THE MOVE

UCLA has been busy on the basepaths so far in 2022, stealing 32 bases at an 89% success rate to this point. The Bruins rank eighth in the country in total stolen bases, and 15th in stolen bases per game (2.5). UCLA has swiped multiple bags in nine of 13 games so far this year, including seven contests with at least three stolen bases. The Bruins stole 11 bases over three games against CSUN to open the year, the program's most in a single series over the last 10 years.

SAVAGE APPROACHING MILESTONES IN 2022

UCLA head coach John Savage is on track to hit a pair of milestones during the 2022 season. Entering the weekend, he needs two wins to reach 600 at UCLA, and he needs 14 victories to reach 700 overall for his career.

GOOD START

UCLA's starting pitching has been absolutely dominant in the early going in 2022, as the quintet of Jake Brooks, Max Rajcic, Kelly Austin, Ethan Flanagan, and Thatcher Hurd have combined for the following stats:

- 1.44 ERA and 94-13 strikeout-to-walk ratio over 68 2/3 innings
- 11 total runs allowed (0.85 per game)
- 0.74 WHIP, 12.4 K/9
- 6/13 games with 0 R allowed, 10/13 games with 1 ER or fewer allowed, 12/13 games with 2 ER or fewer allowed
- 5 games with 2 H allowed (the most hits allowed by a UCLA starter in one game so far has been 4)

RACKING UP THE STRIKEOUTS

UCLA pitchers have been piling up the Ks so far in 2022, ranking ninth in the country with 153 strikeouts to this point (just eight behind NCAA leaders Texas Tech). UCLA had 15+ strikeouts in four consecutive games from Feb. 20-25, the first time the program has achieved that feat over the last 10 years. The Bruins followed that up with a season-high 19 strikeouts on Mar. 1 against Long Beach State, matching the program's highest single-game K output of the last 10 years. The 19 strikeouts against the Dirtbags — all by Thatcher Hurd and Ethan Flanagan — is believed to be a program-record for single-game strikeouts by freshmen. UCLA paces the Pac-12 Conference in both total strikeouts and strikeouts per nine innings (11.7).

YATES NAMED PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UCLA sophomore outfielder Carson Yates was named the Pac-12 Baseball Player of the Week on Monday after a standout performance in Houston. Yates collected a hit in all three games at Minute Maid, going 5-9 overall on the weekend with two home runs and seven RBIs. He hit a pinch-hit home run on Friday vs. Baylor (his first-career HR), had a career-high six RBIs against Oklahoma on Saturday, then delivered two more hits Sunday as UCLA took down top-ranked Texas. It was Yates's first career weekly award, and he becomes the first Bruin to win the award this season.

HURD PICKS UP NATIONAL WEEKLY HONORS FROM PERFECT GAME, NCBWA

UCLA freshman right-hander Thatcher Hurd picked up a pair of national honors on Tuesday (prior to his start vs. CSF), as he was named the Perfect Game/Rawlings National Pitcher of the Week and NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week. Last week, Hurd allowed just two hits over 6 2/3 scoreless innings while striking out 15. That included a dozen-K performance against LBSU on Mar. 1, the most strikeouts in a game by a UCLA freshman since Gerrit Cole on Apr. 17, 2009 (13). He followed that up with a five-up, five-down relief appearance against Oklahoma on Saturday at Minute Maid Park.

HAPPY TO BE HOME

UCLA's 2022 schedule is home-heavy, especially in the early going. The Bruins opened the new campaign with a nine-game homestand, and will play 16 games at Jackie Robinson Stadium before the team's first true road game: Mar. 22 at Loyola Marymount (the latest road opener in program history).

IN THE POLLS

UCLA was featured in four of the five major national polls on Monday, appearing as high as No. 15 (Baseball America) and also checking in at No. 22 (NCBWA), No. 24 (Collegiate Baseball), and No. 25 (USA TODAY Coaches Poll). The Bruins were cited as one of three teams just outside the top-25 in D1Baseball's poll.

HURD MISSING BATS

Despite being a true freshman, right-hander Thatcher Hurd has been piling up strikeouts at one of the highest clips in the country, as he ranks top-three nationally in both strikeouts (35, 2nd) and K/9 (17.5, third). He totaled 23 strikeouts over his first two collegiate starts, including a 12-strikeout performance against LBSU on Mar. 1 that represented the most by a UCLA freshman since Gerrit Cole had 13 against Washington on Apr. 17, 2009. Nearly two-thirds of his recorded outs have come via the K (35-54, 65%). He struck out two batters in the first inning of his start against Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday, and that actually lowered his K/9 ratio for the season. He ended the night with 7 Ks in 4 1/3 innings.

RUB SOME DIRT ON IT

UCLA enters the weekend ranked eighth in the country in offensive HBPs (30). The Bruins have been hit by a pitch at least once in every game this season, including a season-high five by Pepperdine on Feb. 22. Ethan Gourson (6 HBPs) leads the Pac-12 in that statistic.

THE SERIES AGAINST USC

Though USC holds the the advantage in the all-time series, UCLA has turned the tide in recent years. In 17 previous years under head coach John Savage, UCLA has lost the season series to USC just twice (last: 2014). The Bruins captured weekend sweeps of the Trojans six times in that span, most recently in 2018. UCLA has won each of the last four weekend sets between the two rivals, accruing a 10-2 record in those games.

LAST YEAR AGAINST THE TROJANS

UCLA went 3-1 against the Trojans in 2021, taking a 10-1 win in the final game of the College Baseball Classic at Jackie Robinson Stadium on Mar. 7 and then rallying from a Friday night loss to take two of three at Dedeaux Field from Mar. 26-28. As a team, the Bruins batted .302 and pitched to a 2.27 ERA against the Trojans last year. Key performers in those games still on the UCLA roster include junior LHP Jake Saum (1.42 ERA, 8 K in 6.1 IP), sophomore RHP Max Rajcic (first-career save), and sophomore OF JonJon Vaughns (first-career home run).

IN THE ZONE

As is the case most years, the Bruins have been adept so far in 2022 at limiting free passes. Entering the weekend, UCLA leads the country in WHIP (0.86), is second in K-BB ratio (5.5), and fourth in BB/9 (2.1). Over the last eight games, UCLA has yielded just 10 bases on balls (compared to 89 strikeouts).

YOUNG BLOOD

Despite a heavy amount of turnover on the pitching staff, UCLA has continued to excel on the mound in 2022 thanks in large part to the performance of its newcomers. The five new Bruins pitchers to have appeared so far (Luke Jewett, Thatcher Hurd, Ethan Flanagan, Kelly Austin, Alonzo Tredwell) have combined for some gaudy numbers: 5-0, 0.82 ERA, 0.65 WHIP, and a 96-11 K-BB ratio over 65 2/3 innings.

PLENTY OF KENNY

Graduate outfielder and leadoff hitter Kenny Oyama has been quite the spark plug for UCLA's offense, reaching base safely in 11 of the team's first 13 games while going a perfect 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts. He is tied for the second-most stolen bases in the country, and he's the only player in the country 13+ stolen bases without a caught stealing. He's had several notable moments so far this season. On Feb. 20 he became the first Bruin since 2016 to record seven at-bats in a game, and went on to lead all Bruins in hits (6) and stolen bases (4) during the season-opening CSUN series. On Mar. 6 against No. 1 Texas, he stole second and third base on back-to-back pitches in the fifth inning before scoring the go-ahead and game-winning run.

NEW FACES

So far in 2022, many new Bruins have been seeing plenty of the field. On the position player side, six newcomers have started a game for UCLA, including four true freshmen. On the pitching side, three newcomers have started on the mound (two freshmen) and another two have appeared out of the bullpen.

UCLA LANDS NCAA-HIGH SIX PLAYERS ON D1BASEBALL IMPACT FRESHMEN LIST

D1Baseball released its annual list of the projected Top 100 Impact Freshmen in college baseball on Feb. 17, and the Bruins led the country with six inclusions on the list. Only Florida and Texas Tech (four apiece) came close to matching the Bruins. The UCLA selections included LHP Gage Jump (No. 9), INF Cody Schrier (26), RHP Thatcher Hurd (40), OF Malakhi Knight (65), INF Ethan Gourson (79) and OF Nick McLain (89).

UCLA BRINGS IN NATION'S NO. 1 RECRUITING CLASS

UCLA's 2022 roster has been bolstered by a strong recruiting class, which received a No. 1 national recruit class ranking from three separate outlets (D1Baseball, Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball).

- The group features three players from the top-100, and five from the top-125, of Baseball America's top 500 prospect list for the 2021 Draft.
- The newest group of Bruins is headlined by four players ranked inside the top-100 nationally by Perfect Game in outfielder Malakhi Knight (No. 26), right-handed pitcher Thatcher Hurd (36), infielder Cody Schrier (43), and left-handed pitcher Gage Jump (45).
- The Bruins also brought in talented transfers from the four-year and junior college ranks including outfielder Kenny Oyama (batted .320 last season at Loyola Marymount), outfielder Jake Palmer (career .446 OBP at UC Irvine), and right-handed pitcher Kelly Austin (6-0, 1.26 ERA last season at Orange Coast College).
- The class also features standout prep players in RHP Alonzo Tredwell (No. 164 national ranking from Perfect Game), RHP Luke Jewett (195), OF Nick McLain (211, younger brother of Bruin alum Matt McLain), C Jack Holman (292), and INF Bryce Grudzianek (314). The class is rounded out by RHP Josh Alger (No. 342 in the BA Top-500 Draft rankings) RHP Nate Leibold (2.19 ERA in the WCL), LHP Ethan Flanagan (Orange County All-Star), and INF Ethan Gourson (All-CIF shortstop).

WALK IT OFF

Ethan Gourson's game-winning, 13th inning home run against CSUN was UCLA's first walk-off home run since Michael Toglia hit a three-run blast against East Carolina on Apr. 13, 2019 (UCLA won, 8-5).

DOING A JOB

UCLA catcher Tommy Beres has laid down seven sacrifice bunts so far this season, second-most in the country. His safety squeeze against UC Riverside on Feb. 27 scored Malakhi Knight in a walk-off win for the Bruins.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021

- UCLA went 37-20 overall in 2021, hitting the 30-win plateau for the 12th time under John Savage
- The Bruins posted an 18-12 record in Pac-12 play, finishing fourth in the league standings
- UCLA earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament, and was placed in the Lubbock Regional at Texas Tech
- The Bruins went an undefeated 8-0 in midweeks
- JT Schwartz (.396) was the Pac-12 Batting Champion, UCLA's first since 2001

- UCLA was the only Pac-12 team to finish top-three in the league in both offense (7.3 runs per game, second) and pitching (3.95 team ERA, third)
- The Bruins had 10 players selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, the most of any school in the country
- SS Matt McLain was selected No. 17 overall by Cincinnati, giving UCLA a first-round pick in three consecutive drafts for the first time in program history

NOTES ON UCLA HEAD COACH JOHN SAVAGE

• Savage was named the 2019 Pac-12 Coach of the Year, the second time he's taken home the award in his career. He was previously named the Pac-12 Coach of the Year in 2015 after leading the Bruins to a league title. He was also named National Coach of the Year in 2010 and 2013. After the 2019 season, he was named the ABCA West Region Coach of the Year for the second time in his career (2013) and was also honored as the National Pitching Coach of the Year by Collegiate Baseball.

• Savage helped UCLA reach college baseball's pinnacle in 2013, as the Bruins won their first-ever NCAA baseball title. Under his guidance, UCLA has advanced to the postseason 12 times in 17 seasons and has hosted a regional six times, including four-straight from 2010 through 2013.

• In the summer of 2017, Savage was the manager of the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team after being an assistant coach in 2000. He led the U.S. to a 15-5 record over the summer, including 11-4 during international play. The United States won all three international series it competed in, including going 4-0 against Chinese Taipei and 3-2 versus both Cuba and Japan. The win over Cuba marked the third-straight series win, while also improving to 23-18 in 41 all-time series against Japan.

• 14 of his 16 recruiting classes have been nationally ranked in the top-25 by Baseball America. UCLA's incoming class in the fall of 2012 was rated No. 2, nationally, by Baseball America, the highest-such ranking of any of Savage's classes. UCLA's incoming group in the fall of 2006 was ranked No. 5, followed by No. 13 (fall 2007), No. 7 (fall 2008), No. 7 (fall 2009), No. 19 (fall 2010), No. 3 (fall 2011), No. 2 (fall 2012), No. 7 (fall 2014), No. 3 (fall 2015), No. 16 (fall 2016), No. 16 (fall 2017), and No. 4 (fall 2018), No. 5 (fall 2019), and No. 3 (fall 2020).

• Savage was named the 2013 National Coach of the Year by Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America, the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) and Perfect Game USA. His work with UCLA's pitching staff that season was no more evident than with the success of starting pitchers Adam Plutko, Nick Vander Tuig and Grant Watson. Plutko and Vander Tuig capped their UCLA careers in 2013 as the winningest pitching tandem in school history (56 total wins in three seasons).

• Under Savage's guidance, UC Irvine posted a 88-84-1 overall record and the Anteaters broke through with an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2004. That season, UC Irvine went 34-23-1 and competed at the NCAA Notre Dame Regional. The Anteaters earned their highest national ranking at the time, climbing to the No. 7 spot in Collegiate Baseball's weekly rankings in April 2004. At season's end, Savage was tabbed a finalist for National Coach of the Year honors by CollegeBaseballInsider.com.

• As pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at USC from 1997-2000, Savage helped the Trojans produce consecutive Pac-10 Pitcher of the Year selections in Seth Etherton, Rik Carrier and eventual American League Cy Young Award winner Barry Zito. Also under Savage's mentorship was former Chicago Cubs right-hander Mark Prior. As the Trojans' recruiting coordinator, Savage helped facilitate the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in 1999-2000, as ranked by Collegiate Baseball. He was honored as Collegiate Baseball's Assistant Coach of the Year in 1998, following the Trojans' run to the College World Series title. USC advanced to the NCAA Super Regional in 1999 and back to the College World Series in 2000.

John Savage is in his 21st season as a head coach in 2022. He has guided UCLA to three College World Series appearances, including winning the program's first national championship in 2013.

ELITE COMPANY

John Savage is one of just six head coaches in college baseball history to have guided his team to a College World Series title, produced the first overall pick in the MLB Draft (Gerrit Cole, 2011), and coached at least one Golden Spikes Award winner (Trevor Bauer, 2011). Also included in that illustrious group are former head coaches Skip Bertman (LSU) and Jim Brock (Arizona State) and Augie Garrido (Cal State Fullerton, Texas) and current head coaches Tim Corbin (Vanderbilt) and Jim Morris (Miami).

POSTSEASON SUCCESS

In 12 trips to the postseason at UCLA, Savage has compiled a 44-25 record (.638 winning percentage), recording the most postseason victories of any head coach in program history.

With Savage at the program's helm, UCLA advanced to the College World Series in 2010, 2012, and 2013, and reached the best-of-three championship series in 2010 and 2013. UCLA defeated Mississippi State, two games to none, at the 2013 College World Series. In 2010, the Bruins advanced to the championship series for the first time in school history, falling two games to none to South Carolina.

BRUINS IN THE PROS

Savage's strong work with UCLA's program has been equally evident in player development and the MLB Draft. Over his 17 seasons in Westwood, UCLA has produced 117 draft selections with 46 players being drafted within the first 10 rounds. Under Savage, the Bruins produced a first-round MLB draft pick in three consecutive years for the first time in program history (2019-21). In addition, he has coached 22 players at UCLA that have competed in the major leagues.
