# What is the Role of Technology in Hate Speech?

- Social media amplify false narratives (which fuel hate crimes) to drive engagement, as false narratives fuel hate crimes.
- Should tech firms be held accountable for hate speech on their platforms?
  - EU vs. U.S. Approach: The EU enforces stricter regulations, while U.S. platforms lean toward free speech.
- What about AI?
  - AI can detect hate speech but struggles with context, sarcasm, and bias. Over-reliance on AI risks censorship and suppression of legitimate speech.



# What are Connecticut's Legislative Efforts?

## State Hate Crime Laws

- There are penalties for crimes motivated by race, religion, gender identity, and sexual orientation.
- Civil penalties up to \$2,500 per offense.
- Proposed reforms (2025) aim to strengthen prosecutorial effectiveness.
- Early Anti-Hate Legislation (1917 Law): Imposed fines for advertisements ridiculing people based on race or religion.  
**Modern Challenges:** The law lacks focus on online hate speech and digital harassment.



# Call to Action

## Solutions & Policy Recommendations

### 1. Improving AI-Based Moderation

- Combining AI & Human Oversight with more context-aware detection models for evolving hate speech.

### 2. Platform Accountability

- Holding tech companies responsible for harmful algorithmic amplification and encouraging transparency in content moderation policies.

### 3. Legal & Educational Reforms

- Updating CT laws to address digital hate speech & cyber harassment.
