- There is just one meeting between the Defenders and Showboats.
- D.C. defeated Memphis 36-21 on May 26, 2024 at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in Memphis.
- This is the first inter-conference contest for the Showboats this season. Each UFL team plays a round robin vs. conference opponents and plays one game each against the other conference.

NEW-LOOK SHOWBOATS

The Memphis Showboats saw a vast overhaul in personnel for the 2025 season.

Seven of the nine coaches on the Showboats' staff game are new to the team, including head coach Ken Whisenhunt, New coaches include: Jarren Horton (DC), Marc Hull (LB/ST), Brian Baker (DL. Steve Meyer (DQC), Luke Ferdinand (RB) and Lee Morris (OQC).

As for the roster, 14 players on the 50-man opening day roster were on the team last season, meaning the roster includes 72 percent newcomers from the previous season.

Saturday's game is slated for an 8 p.m. ET kickoff at Audi Field in Washington, D.C. and will be broadcast nationally on ABC. The game will also be heard live on Sirius XM satellite radio.

The Memphis radio broadcast will be heard on Hot 107.1, with Eli Savoie (play-by-play) and Russell Copeland (analyst) in the booth. It will be the third consecutive year of calling the Showboats for the Savoie-Copeland duo.

LAST WEEK

A Michigan Panthers Pick Six thwarted the Memphis Showboats' spirited comeback as the Panthers defeated the Showboats 26-12.

Trailing 20-6, the Showboats put together a 14play. 70-yard drive to pull within one score. 20-12. E.J. Perry threw a 6-yard bullet to Jonathan Adams for the Showboats' first TD of the season.

Memphis failed on its 4th-and-12 alternate possession option. The Showboats forced a 50yard field goal attempt that was missed and gave the Showboats life with 51 seconds remaining.

On the first play of the ensuing possession, Troy Williams found Adams for 38 yards, putting the Showboats into scoring position with a chance to tie or win the game. But Williams was pressured on the next play. As he looked to get the ball to the sideline, Nacua stepped in front of the aerial and raced the other direction for the game-sealing TD.

Williams was 8-of-11 for 104 yards and the interception in the final minute. Perry was 10-of-17 for 93 yards, 1 touchdown and 1 interception. Adams led all receivers in the game with 6 catches and 93 yards.

ROTATING QUARTERBACKS

Interim head coach Jim Turner elected to rotate quarterbacks E.J. Perry and Troy Williams in last week's game, with the duo playing alternating series. Williams was 8-of-11 for 104 yards and 1 interception. Perry was 10-of-17 for 93 yards, 1 touchdown and 1 interception.

Perry led the Showboats to their lone touchdown late in the fourth quarter. When the Showboats regained posession with less than one minute left, Williams rotated in. He promptly completed the longest pass play of the game for 38 yards to Jonathan Adams. But the next play saw Michigan's Kai Nacua intercept Williams for a touchdown the other way to effectively end the game.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- E.J. Perry and Troy Williams competed as the top two signal-callers throughout camp, while Dresser Winn was brought in midway through camp for depth and development.
- Williams is the most experienced starter in the quarterback room, with 11 starts over the past three seasons in the USFL (2023 Pittsburgh Maulers) and UFL (2024 Memphis Showboats). He was 0-3 in his starts last season. Perry, meanwhile, has started six games including this season, the first five with the Michigan Panthers. He was 2-2 as the Panthers' starter last season, before being knocked out with an injury.
- Williams saw action in eight games for the Showboats last season, completing 54.7 percent of his passes (58-of-165) for 591 yards and 5 TDs with 5 interceptions. Perry completed 61.7 percent of his passes in his four starts with Michigan last season, going 55-of-89 for 664 yards with 2 TDs and 3 interceptions.
- \bullet Both Perry and Williams are dual-threat QBs. In 19 USFL/UFL games, Williams has rushed 72 times for 415 yards and 4 TDs. In six USFL/UFL games played, Perry has rushed for 206 yards and 5 TDs on 36 carries.




RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- Deneric Prince and Jalen Jackson split time at running back last week. Prince led all rushers in the game vs. Michigan with 38 yards and a long of 16 on 10 carries. Jackson rushed for 24 yards on 11 carries. Both caught two passes as well, with Prince tallying 27 yards and Jackson recording 21.
- The Showboats entered the 2025 season with three newcomers in the running back room. Among the three Memphis backs -- Jackson, Jacob Kibodi and Prince -- they had three combined games of professional football experience coming into last week's game.
- Kibodi saw action in one game for the Cleveland Browns in 2024, recording 5 carries for 24 yards. Deneric Prince saw action in two games for the Kansas City Chiefs in 2023. Jackson spent the 2024 preseason with the Jacksonville Jaguars.
- Prince won a Super Bowl with the Chiefs in the 2023 NFL season, spending most of the season on the Kansas City practice squad, while seeing action in two games.

ADAMS TURNS IN TOP RECEIVER PERFORMANCE IN WEEK 1

Jonathan Adams had the best week of any wide receiver in the United Football League on UFL Kickoff Weekend.

Adams recorded six receptions for 93 yards and a touchdown. Only St. Louis' Jahcour Pearson matched Adams for receptions in Week One. Adams' 93 yards receiving was 10 better than Pearson's second-best total of 83.



WIDE RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- Kwamie Lassiter II was the only other Showboats wide receiver with multiple receptions, tallying 2 for 10 yards.
- Six different Showboats wide receivers made at least one catch last week.
- The Showboats return two WRs from last season, Adams and Dee Anderson.
- Adams ranked No. 1 on the team in yards per reception (13.4), No. 2 in receiving yards (442) and No. 3 in receptions (33) last season and saw action in all 10 games.
- Anderson played in 6 games with 8 receptions for 142 yards and 1 touchdown last year. Anderson also caught a 3-point conversion pass, one of just two successful 3-point conversions in the UFL last season.
- Four of the five newcomers in the wide receiver room bring pro football experience:
- Kai Locksley played both quarterback and wide receiver in the Canadian Football League, with his most recent experience was with the Hamilton TigerCats in 2023.
- Lassiter saw action in one game in both 2022 and 2023 with the Cincinnati Bengals.
- Eli Stove played in 4 games for the CFL Ottawa RedBlacks in 2024 and played in 10 games for the New Orleans Breakers in the 2023 USFL.
- Isiah Hennie has played in 16 USFL/UFL games, playing in 4 games for the Houston Roughnecks last season and in all 12 games for the Pittsburgh Maulers in 2023.

TIGHT END NOTEBOOK

- All three Showboats tight ends saw action last week vs. Michigan. Ryan Izzo recorded one catch for 10 yards. Jay Jay Wilson caught one pass for 8 yards. Chris Pierce Jr. was targeted once.
- Wilson is the only returning tight end for the Showboats. He is one of 3 current members of the team who have been with the squad since the franchise was resurrected in 2023 (DB Kyree Woods, DL John Atkins Sr.). Wilson also plays fullback.
- Izzo is one of two Showboats players with a Super Bowl ring. He was on injured reserve as a member of the New England Patriots when they won the title following the 2018 season. He played 18 career games for the Pats (19 rec, 313 yds, 1 TD).
- Chris Pierce Jr. is a converted wide receiver. He finished his collegiate career at Vanderbilt as a wide receiver, hauling in 109 receptions for 1,398 yards and 9 TDs. He was moved to tight end in 2022 with the Arizona Cardinals.



OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- Seven offensive linemen saw action in Week One vs. Michigan. Alec Lindstrom started at center, Jared Thomas started and Nash Jensen started at guard and James Tunstall and J.D. DiRenzo got the start at tackle. Nate Gilliam and Noah Henderson also saw action.
- Alec Lindstrom and Jared Thomas return to the Showboats offensive line. Lindstrom battled through injuries in 2024, but saw action in all 10 games, starting the first 2 and last 2 games of the season, seeing most of his action at guard. He is projected to play center in 2025. Thomas started all 10 games for the 'Boats last season, with 9 of those starts at center. He is projected to play guard this season.
- James Tunstall also returns to the squad from last season. He started 7 games for the Showboats in 2024.
- Nash Jensen brings starting NFL experience to the Memphis offensive line. He played in 11 games with 5 starts for the Carolina Panthers in 2023.
- Noah Henderson adds UFL experience to the group, starting 5 games and playing in 9 for the Arlington Renegades in 2024.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- P.J. Hall led all Showboats defensive linemen in last week's game vs. Michigan. He tallied 6 total tackles to rank No. 5 on the team in total stops. Nasir Player and Josiah Bronson added four stops each.
- John Atkins Sr. is an OG Showboat. He is one of three 'Boats that have been with the team since it was brought back in 2023. But he is the only current player who was with the franchise before that. Atkins Sr. was a member of the 2022 USFL Tampa Bay Bandits, which were relocated to Memphis prior to the 2023 season.
- Atkins led all Showboats defensive linemen in tackles last season with 21 total stops.
- Josiah Bronson and P.J. Hall are also back from last year's Showboats. Bronson saw action in all 10 games with 12 tackles, 2 TFLs and 1.5 sacks. Hall played in 6 games with 11 tackles, 2 TFLs and 1 sack. Bronson and Hall were the only Memphis D-Linemen with multiple TFLs in 2024.




DOUBLE DIGITS FOR CHAMBERS, VANDENBURGH

Linebackers Steele Chambers and Zeke Vandenburgh led the way for the Showboats' defense last week vs. Michigan, with both tallying a team-best 10 total tackles.

Chambers tallied 5 solo stops to tie for the team lead. Vandenburgh recorded a half sack and 1 tackle for-loss as well.

Chambers and Vandenburgh were the only teammates to tally double-digit tackles in Week One of the UFL season. They were two of just five UFL defensive players to rack up 10 tackles or more last week. Only Michigan's Frank Ginda had more tackles (11) than Chambers and Vandenburgh.



LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- All three linebackers who were active last week saw action and recorded tackles. In addition to Chambers and Vandenburgh, Obi Melifonwu added 2 total tackles to the Showboats' defensive ledger.
- Chambers is a converted running back. He played two seasons as a running back at Ohio State, tallying 28 carries for 221 yards and 1 TD, before moving to linebacker. After moving to defense, Chambers recorded 190 tackles, 11.5 TFLs, 2 sacks and 3 interceptions for the Buckeyes.
- Vandenburgh was the top defensive player in NCAA FCS in 2022, winning the Buck Buchanan Award. He led all of FCS in TFLs and sacks per game, averaging 21 and 1.4, respectively in 2022. Vandenburgh signed with the Miami Dolphins as a UDFA in 2023, but was waived/injured in the preseason.
- All four players currently listed as linebackers -- Chambers, Melifonwu, Yvondy Rigby and Vandenburgh -- are new to the Showboats.

WALKER IN MEMPHIS

Eli Walker made his Showboats' debut Sunday against Michigan and led all defensive backs with 9 total tackles. He tied for the team lead in solo stops with 5.

Walker comes to Memphis after having played under defensive coordinator Horton with the Pittsburgh Maulers in the USFL. Walker was with the Maulers in 2022 and 2023, recording 48 tackles, 1 sack, 1 interceptions and 2 pass breakups.





SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- Eight different defensive backs saw action in last week's game vs. Michigan. In addition to Walker's totals, Keaton Ellis recorded 8 total tackles to rank No. 4 on the team. Mark Gilbert contributed the team's lone pass breakup, positioning himself well on a Panthers' deep shot to thwart a potential big gain.
- Kyree Woods is one of three Showboats to play have been with the team since it was brought back in 2023. He tallied 5 total tackles last week vs. the Panthers.
- Two of the Showboats' defensive backs have experience in a Jarren Horton defense. Walker and Gilbert both come to Memphis after having played under Horton with the Pittsburgh Maulers in the USFL. Walker was with the Maulers in 2022 and 2023, recording 48 tackles, 1 sack, 1 interceptions and 2 pass breakups. Gilbert played for the Maulers in 2023 with 33 tackles and 4 INTs. Gilbert also won a UFL Championship with the Birmingham Stallions last season, tallying 25 tackles and 1 INT.
- Eric Garror brings NFL experience to the Showboats' secondary. He saw action in 12 games with 4 starts for the Tennessee Titans in 2023. During his time with the Titans, Garror recorded 22 tackles and 2 passes defended. Last week vs. Michigan, Garror recorded 6 total tackles.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

- Matt Coghlin picked up right where he left off from last season. Coghlin was the most accurate kicker in the United Football League last season. He converted on 94.1 percent of his field-goal attempts (16-of-17) with a long of 57 yards in 2024. Coghlin was 2-for-2 Sunday, successfully converting from 50 and 45 yards.
- In his professional career, Coghlin has missed just 3 field goals, going 36-of-39 (92.3 percent). With a 50-yarder last week, Coghlin is now 7-of-9 (77.8 percent) from 50-plus as a pro.
- Turner Bernard returns to handle the long-snapping duties. He successfully converted all 52 of his long snaps last season. Bernard's father Ben has been training long snappers for nearly 30 years and has sent numerous proteges on to college and professional football. While he had one long snap that bounced to punter Matt Mengel last week, his punter was able to get it off.
- Mengel is the lone newcomer among the specialists. He last played in the 2023 USFL with the Pittsburgh Maulers. During that season, he recorded 11 punts of 50 yards or more, including a USFL-record 83-yarder. Last week, Mengel averaged 44.5 yards per punt on four boots, placing a league-best 2 of his kicks inside the 20-yard line.



SHOWBOATS TEAMMATES

Three pairs of Showboats have now been teammates in college and at the professional level. Defensive lineman Boogie Roberts and defensive back Nehemiah Shelton played together at San Jose State. Long snapper Turner Bernard and defensive back Kyree Woods played together at San Diego State. Center Alec Lindstrom and quarterback E.J. Perry were also teammates at Boston College, before Perry transferred to Brown.

Three Showboats have been teammates in all three years of the team's existence following its return in 2023. Defensive lineman John Atkins Sr., tight end Jay Jay Wilson and defensive back Kyree Woods are all in their third season with the team.



MEMPHIS MAULERS

The 2025 Memphis Showboats have a fair amount of influence from the USFL's Pittsburgh Maulers.

The Showboats feature three coaches and eight players who were with the Maulers prior to the USFL-XFL merger that created the United Football League. The following is a look at the Maulers-Showboats connections:

Former Names

Memphis Memorial Stadium (1965-75) Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium (1975-2022) Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium (2022-present)

History

The stadium was originally built as Memphis Memorial Stadium in 1965 for \$3 million, as a part of the Mid-South Fairgrounds, then home to one of the South's most popular fairs. It was dedicated as a memorial to the citizens of Memphis who had served in



World War I, World War II, and the Korean War.

The facility was built partially as a way to bring the Liberty Bowl to a permanent home in Memphis. The game was such a success for Memphis that the stadium was renamed Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium in December 1975.

It was renamed Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in a naming rights agreement with Simmons Bank, which operates in Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Okalhoma, Tennessee and Texas

On December 19, 2023, the City of Memphis passed a vote to transfer ownership of the stadium to the University of Memphis. This past summer, renovation and construction of the stadium began, including the demolition of much of the west side, including the old press box. All operations previously hosted on the west side of the stadium have been moved to the east side.

Tenants

Since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Memphis Tigers football team from the University of Memphis. Also since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Liberty Bowl game.

The stadium is also the host of the "Southern Heritage Classic", a game between two historically black colleges, University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff and Tennessee State University. The stadium also has hosted home games of the Tennessee Volunteers, Ole Miss Rebels, and Mississippi State Bulldogs.

Professional Football at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium

In 1974 and 1975, the stadium hosted the Memphis Southmen, aka "Grizzlies", of the World Football League.

In 1984, the original United States Football League added the Memphis Showboats as an expansion team. The Showboats, featuring defensive end Reggie White and coached by flamboyant Memphian Pepper Rodgers, were one of the better draws in the league. They advanced to the semifinals in 1985.

In 1995 the Liberty Bowl welcomed the Memphis Mad Dogs as part of the Canadian Football League's attempt at bringing their league into American markets.

In 1997, the Houston Oilers announced they would relocate to Nashville, but played the 1997 season at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium.

A subsequent major professional tenant was the Memphis Maniax of the first XFL.

The Memphis Express of the Alliance of American Football played in the stadium for its sole season in 2019.

The second iteration of the USFL saw the Memphis Showboats return in 2023. The team would remain in Memphis as part of the merger between the XFL and USFL that created the United Football League.

Other Former Tenants

The Memphis Rogues (1978-80) of the North American Soccer League called the stadium home. A 1975 exhibition Major League Baseball game (Atlanta Braves vs Milwaukee Brewers) was played. The right-field fence was only 174 feet from home plate, about 125 feet shorter than most major league parks.

UNDER ARMOUR THREADS

Under Armour is the exclusive provider of all on-field uniforms, including jerseys, base layer, sideline and training apparel, for all XFL teams. The unique home and away sets are designed with an authentic execution of the individual team identities. The design process was a collaboration between XFL ownership, marketing, and Under Armour teams

Each jersey features a "Blood, Sweat, Respect" mantra – a personal message from ownership to players, which is sublimated on the interior collars of all team uniforms.

Additional design details include embroidered team wordmarks and branding at the base of the neckline, UA's ArmourGrid nameplates with twill lettering, and all uniforms are branded with XFL, Under Armour, and Project Rock Brahma Bull patches.

UFL RULES

The United Football League (UFL) will continue to build on the innovation of both the XFL and USFL with its rules for the 2025 season. The UFL has adopted a number of innovative rules from both previous leagues to deliver an exciting, fast-paced game with plenty of action. Below are some highlights:

Points After Touchdown

Teams will have three scrimmage play options following a touchdown.

2-yard line = 1 point for a successful try

5-yard line = 2 points for a successful try

10-yard line = 3 points for a successful try

Kickoffs

The UFL's 2025 kickoff rules this season will be based on a combination of the kickoff used by XFL Legacy during its 2023 season and the NFL Dynamic Kickoff used by the NFL during the 2024 season. These changes include:

Kickoffs will start at the 30-yard line. The 10 remaining players on the kickoff team will line up at the receiving team's 40-yard line. The receiving team's set up zone will stretch from its 35-yard line to the 30-yard line and must have at least nine players in that zone. The landing zone will be from the receiving team's 20-yard line to the goal line. The ball must reach the landing zone or it will be spotted at the 40-yard line. There will be two touchback spots: the 35-yard-line for balls kicked into the end zone and the 20-yard line for balls that hit in the landing zone and then enter the end zone.

Onside Kicks

The league has eliminated this option. The kickoff team will be able to retain possession of the ball with the late-game possession option described below.

Late-Game Possession Option

Teams will have an alternate option to attempt to retain possession in the fourth quarter. If a team is tied or behind during the fourth quarter, it may elect to retain possession after a score with a 4th-and-12 from its own 28-yard line.

Two Forward Passes

Teams will be allowed, as they were last season, to throw two forward passes on one play. The ball cannot cross the line of scrimmage at any time prior to the second forward pass being thrown.

Replay Reviews

The officiating department may stop a game at any time before the ball is next legally put in play to review a play if there is reasonable evidence to believe an error was made and it would have a direct, competitive impact on the game. Any call or non-call related to player safety is also subject to review at any point, as well as any officiating ruling in the last five minutes of the or overtime that is obviously incorrect and will have a significant impact on the outcome.

Coach Challenges

Each coach may challenge any ruling, including fouls or potential fouls, provided the team has a timeout. A successful challenge will not result in a loss of a timeout, while the timeout is lost if the challenge fails.

New in 2025 is the addition of a second challenge if the first challenge was successful.



HEAD COACH KEN WHISENHUNT



Ken Whisenhunt was named head coach of the Memphis Showboats on Sept. 23, 2024.

Whisenhunt has an extensive coaching background, including two stints as a head coach in the National Football League and a Super Bowl Championship as offensive coordinator with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

Whisenhunt was the head coach of the Arizona Cardinals for six seasons (2007-2012), winning two NFC West Division Championships (2008, 2009), an NFC Championship and a berth in Super Bowl XLIII following the 2008 season. In addition, he served as head coach of the Tennessee Titans in 2014 and 2015.

Whisenhunt earned a Super Bowl Championship ring as offensive coordinator for the Pittsburgh Steelers, who won Super Bowl XL (following the 2006 season). He was on the Steelers' staff for six seasons, beginning as the tight ends coach from 2001-03 before being promoted to offensive coordinator in 2001, a role he held through the 2006 season.

Most recently, Whisenhunt served as Special Assistant to the Head Coach under Nick Saban at the University of Alabama for the 2023 season. He also spent two seasons (2021-22) with Penn State University as an offensive analyst.

His most recent stint in the NFL was as offensive coordinator for the Chargers from 2016-2019 and served in that capacity for the Chargers in 2013. He has also coached for the New York Jets (2000, special teams); Cleveland Browns (1999, tight ends); and Baltimore Ravens (1997-98, tight ends). Whisenhunt got his start in coaching with Vanderbilt University, where he coached special teams, tight ends and H-backs in 1995 and 1996.

Whisenhunt was an eight-year player in the NFL, playing tight end/H-back for Atlanta (1985-88), Washington (1989-90) and the New York Jets (1991-92). He played his collegiate football at Georgia Tech, where he was a two-time First Team All-ACC selection at tight end and earned Honorable Mention All-America honors as a senior in 1984.

GAME ONE - MICHIGAN 26. MEMPHIS 12

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (March 30, 2025) – A Michigan Panthers Pick Six thwarted the Memphis Showboats' spirited comeback attempt Sunday at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium as the Panthers defeated the Showboats 26-12.

Michigan led 20-6 midway through the fourth quarter. But the Showboats put together a 14-play, 70-yard drive that spanned nearly six minutes to pull within one score, 20-12. Quarterback E.J. Perry threw a 6-yard bullet to Jonathan Adams for the Showboats' first TD of the season.

Memphis used the United Football League's alternate possession rule, attempting a 4th-and-12 from their own 28 to retain possession. An incompletion left Michigan with the ball at the Memphis 28 and with 1:47 left. The Showboats pushed the Panthers back four yards and forced a 50-yard field goal that would likely have iced the game. But Michigan kicker B.T. Potter missed and gave the Showboats life with 51 seconds remaining.

On the first play of the ensuing possession, Williams found Adams for 38 yards over the middle. The longest play of the game put the Showboats into scoring position with a chance to tie or win the game. But Williams was pressured by RonDell Carter on the next play. As Williams looked to get the ball to the sideline, Nacua stepped in front of the aerial and raced the other direction for the game-sealing TD.

The Showboats played both active quarterbacks – Perry and Williams. Williams was 8-of-11 for 104 yards and the costly interception in the final minute. Perry was 10-of-17 for 93 yards, 1 touchdown and 1 interception. Adams led all receivers in the game with 6 catches and 93 yards.

Steele Chambers paced the Memphis defense, racking up 10 tackles. Zeke Vandenburgh added 9 total stops and 1 tackle for-loss. Former Memphis Tiger Jaylon Allen recorded the Showboats' only sack of the day.

Michigan jumped out to a 10-0 lead early in the second quarter, scoring on its first two offensive possessions, including a run from quarterback Bryce Perkins to score on 4th-and-goal from the 2 where he overcame a bad snap, and broke at least three tackles to get the ball across the goal line. Memphis responded with a Matt Coghlin 50-yard field goal to make it 10-3 at halftime.

The Showboats pulled within four midway through the third quarter on another Coghlin field goal, this time from 45 yards. The Panthers padded the lead to 17-6 on a Perkins-to-Samson Nacua touchdown pass late in the third. A Potter 43-yard field goal with 7:52 remaining in the game made it 20-6 and set up the late drama.
