SHOWBOATS, ROUGHNECKS LOOKING FOR WIN #1

Either the Memphis Showboats or the Houston Roughnecks will pick up their first win of the young 2025 United Football League season Saturday at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium. Both squads enter the contest 0-2 and will also be looking for their first conference wins as well.

Memphis is coming off two straight games where they held the ball in the fourth quarter with a chance to tie or win the game, but came up just short. Houston was blown out by St. Louis in the season-opener, 31-6. Last week, the Roughnecks scored a late touchdown against Arlington, leaving them a 2-point conversion opportunity to tie the game. But Houston's conversion attempt failed and the Renegades held on for an 11-9 win.

Saturday's game is slated for a 1:30 p.m. CT kickoff in Memphis and will be broadcast nationally on ESPN. The game will also be heard live on Sirius XM satellite radio.

The Memphis radio broadcast will be heard on Hot 107.1, with Eli Savoie (play-by-play) and Russell Copeland (analyst) in the booth. It will be the third consecutive year of calling the Showboats for the Savoie-Copeland duo.

LAST WEEK

The D.C. Defenders held off the Memphis Showboats 17-12 last week in Washington, D.C.

D.C. led 9-6 heading into the fourth quarter. But Showboats quarterback EJ Perry's 16-yard run was the game's first touchdown and also gave Memphis a 12-9 lead with 11:47 remaining in the contest.

A 45-yard completion from Jordan Ta'amu to Chris Rowland just five plays after the Perry score put the Defenders in the red zone at the Memphis 12-yard line. Three plays later, on 3rd-and-goal, Ta'amu tossed a pop pass over the middle to Ben Bresnahan to put D.C. on top 15-12. A Rowland reverse pass on the 2-point conversion gave the Defenders a five-point edge.

Memphis' next drive stalled and the Showboats elected to kick a field goal and attempt to retain possession with a 4th-and-12 (the UFL's alternate rule to an onside kick).

But Memphis never got to that 4th-and-12 attempt, as Matt Coghlin's 43-yard field goal attempt was blocked by the Defenders' Devonsha Maxwell.

PERRY PLAYS 'EM ALL

The Showboats rotated quarterbacks E.J. Perry and Troy Williams in the season-opener. But head coach Ken Whisenhunt elected to go with Perry for the duration of the contest against D.C. last week.

Perry finished 18-of-28 for 205 yards and 1 interception. He ran the ball 4 times for 26 yards and scored Memphis' lone touchdown on a 16-yard run early in the fourth quarter.

For the season, Perry is 45-of-28 with 2 interceptions and 1 touchdown. He ranks No. 5 in the UFL in completion percentage at 62.2 percent.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- E.J. Perry and Troy Williams competed as the top two signal-callers throughout camp, while Dresser Winn was brought in midway through camp for depth and development.
- Williams is the most experienced starter in the quarterback room, with 11 starts over the past three seasons in the USFL (2023 Pittsburgh Maulers) and UFL (2024 Memphis Showboats). He was 0-3 in his starts last season. Perry, meanwhile, has started 7 games including this season, the first five with the Michigan Panthers. He was 2-2 as the Panthers' starter last season, before being knocked out with an injury.
- Williams saw action in eight games for the Showboats last season, completing 54.7 percent of his passes (58-of-165) for 591 yards and 5 TDs with 5 interceptions. Perry completed 61.7 percent of his passes in his four starts with Michigan last season, going 55-of-89 for 664 yards with 2 TDs and 3 interceptions.
- Both Perry and Williams are dual-threat QBs. In 19 USFL/UFL games, Williams has rushed 72 times for 415 yards and 4 TDs. In 7 USFL/UFL games played, Perry has rushed for 232 yards and 6 TDs on 40 carries.



RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- Deneric Prince and Jacob Kibodi split time at running back last week. Prince led the Showboats vs. D.C., with 44 yards rushing on 9 carries. Kibodi toled the rock 13 times for 33 yards. Kibodi also pulled in 2 receptions, but both went for a loss of yardage.
- The Showboats entered the 2025 season with three newcomers in the running back room. Among the three Memphis backs -- Jalen Jackson, Jacob Kibodi and Prince -- they had three combined games of professional football experience coming into last week's game.
- Kibodi saw action in one game for the Cleveland Browns in 2024, recording 5 carries for 24 yards. Deneric Prince saw action in two games for the Kansas City Chiefs in 2023. Jackson spent the 2024 preseason with the Jacksonville Jaguars.
- Prince won a Super Bowl with the Chiefs in the 2023 NFL season, spending most of the season on the Kansas City practice squad, while seeing action in two games.
- In two games, Prince is averaging 41.0 yards per game for the Showboats.

ADAMS AWESOME AGAIN

In Week One, Jonathan Adams led all UFL wide receivers in receiving yards. He upped the ante in Week Two.

Adams' 6 catches for 93 yards were both league-best totals for Week One. In Week Two, he tallied a league-best 9 receptions for 128 yards. It was the first 100-yard receiving performance in the UFL this season.

Adams' 128-yard total is the fourth-best receiving performance in a UFL regular season game.

He currently leads the UFL in receptions (15) and yards (221).



WIDE RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- Dee Anderson and Kwamie Lassiter II were the only other Showboats WRs with multiple catches last week. Anderson: 4 for 30 yards; Lassiter: 2 for 6 yards.
- Six different Showboats wide receivers made at least one catch in Week One. In Week Two, just 4 wideouts tallied receptions.
- Eli Stove hauled in a 42-yard aerial for the longest reception of the season so far for Memphis.
- Adams ranked No. 1 on the team in yards per reception (13.4), No. 2 in receiving yards (442) and No. 3 in receptions (33) last season and saw action in all 10 games.
- Anderson played in 6 games with 8 receptions for 142 yards and 1 touchdown last year. Anderson also caught a 3-point conversion pass, one of just two successful 3-point conversions in the UFL last season.
- Four of the five newcomers in the wide receiver room bring pro football experience:
 - Kai Locksley played both quarterback and wide receiver in the Canadian Football League, with his most recent experience was with the Hamilton TigerCats in 2023.
 - Lassiter saw action in one game in both 2022 and 2023 with the Cincinnati Bengals.
 - Eli Stove played in 4 games for the CFL Ottawa RedBlacks in 2024 and played in 10 games for the New Orleans Breakers in the 2023 USFL.

TIGHT END NOTEBOOK

- All three Showboats tight ends saw action in Week One and Week Two. In the opener vs. Michigan, Ryan Izzo recorded one catch for 10 yards. Jay Jay Wilson caught one pass for 8 yards. Chris Pierce Jr. was targeted once. None of the TEs recorded a catch last week at D.C.
- Wilson is the only returning tight end for the Showboats. He is one of 3 current members of the team who have been with the squad since the franchise was resurrected in 2023 (DB Kyree Woods, DL John Atkins Sr.). Wilson also plays fullback.
- Izzo is one of three Showboats players with a Super Bowl ring. He was on injured reserve as a member of the New England Patriots when they won the title following the 2018 season. He played 18 career games for the Pats (19 rec, 313 yds, 1 TD).
- Pierce finished his college career at Vanderbilt as a WR, hauling in 109 receptions for 1,398 yards and 9 TDs. He was moved to tight end in 2022 with the Arizona Cardinals.



OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- Seven offensive linemen saw action in Week Two vs. D.C. Alec Lindstrom started at center, Jared Thomas started and Nash Jensen started at guard and James Tunstall (LT) and Nate Gilliam (RT) got the start at tackle. J.D. DiRenzo and Noah Henderson also saw action.
- Alec Lindstrom and Jared Thomas return to the Showboats offensive line. Lindstrom battled through injuries in 2024, but saw action in all 10 games, starting the first 2 and last 2 games of the season, seeing most of his action at guard. He is projected to play center in 2025. Thomas started all 10 games for the 'Boats last season, with 9 of those starts at center. He is projected to play guard this season.
- James Tunstall also returns to the squad from last season. He started 7 games for the Showboats in 2024.
- Nash Jensen brings starting NFL experience to the Memphis offensive line. He played in 11 games with 5 starts for the Carolina Panthers in 2023.
- Noah Henderson adds UFL experience to the group, starting 5 games and playing in 9 for the Arlington Renegades in 2024.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- P.J. Hall leads all Showboats defensive linemen with 10 total tackles. He tallied 6 stops in Week One and 4 tackles (all solo) last week. Hall's tackle for-loss vs. D.C. was for a loss of 5 yards on 3rd-and-goal from the 1-yard line, forcing a field goal.
- John Atkins Sr. is an OG Showboat. He is one of three 'Boats that have been with the team since it was brought back in 2023. He is also the only current player who was with the franchise before that. Atkins Sr. was a member of the 2022 USFL Tampa Bay Bandits, which were relocated to Memphis prior to the 2023 season.
- Josiah Bronson and P.J. Hall are also back from last year's Showboats. Bronson saw action in all 10 games with 12 tackles, 2 TFLs and 1.5 sacks. Hall played in 6 games with 11 tackles, 2 TFLs and 1 sack. Bronson and Hall were the only Memphis D-Linemen with multiple TFLs in 2024.
- Jaylon Allen and Nasir Player have both made an impact from the edge. Allen has 7 tackles in 2 games with half a sack, while Player has also added 7 total stops.
- Boogie Roberts brings experience to the Showboats. He also brings a SAG card. On the field, Roberts played for the Pittsburgh Maulers in the 2022 and 2023 USFL seasons with 52 tackles and 3 sacks. Off the field, Roberts has appeared in commercials for brands such as Copper Fit, The Farmer's Dog and Peloton. Roberts' first sack of the season came last week vs. D.C., the team that signed him but released him prior to the 2024 season.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DIGITS FOR CHAMBERS

Linebacker Steele Chambers is the only UFL defender to record double-digit tackles in both Week One and Week Two.

Chambers tallied 10 total tackles in both the Showboats' opener against Michigan and last week's game against D.C. Six of Chambers' 10 stops vs. the Defenders were solo tackles.

He leads the UFL in total tackles with 20. His 11 solo stops are the second-best mark in the league through two weeks.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- For the second straight week, inside linebackers Chambers and Zeke Vandenburg led the Showboats' defense in tackles. In addition to Chambers' 10 last week, Vandenburg added 7 stops. While Chambers leads the UFL in total tackles, Vandenburg ranks tied for No. 2 with 17.
- Chambers is a converted running back. He played two seasons as a running back at Ohio State, tallying 28 carries for 221 yards and 1 TD, before moving to linebacker. After moving to defense, Chambers recorded 190 tackles, 11.5 TFLs, 2 sacks and 3 interceptions for the Buckeyes.
- Vandenburg was the top defensive player in NCAA FCS in 2022, winning the Buck Buchanan Award. He led all of FCS in TFLs and sacks per game, averaging 2.1 and 1.4, respectively in 2022. Vandenburg signed with the Miami Dolphins as a UDFA in 2023, but was waived/injured in the preseason.
- Obi Melifonwu is one of three Showboats with a Super Bowl ring. He was a member of the 2018 New England Patriots, who won Super Bowl LIII.
- Melifonwu has 3 stops in two games this season.



SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- Keaton Ellis and Eli Walker each recorded 5 total tackles last week vs. D.C., to lead the way in the defensive backfield. For the season, Walker is tied for No. 5 in the UFL in total tackles with 14. He is one of 9 UFL players with 10-plus solo tackles through 2 games.
- Kyree Woods is one of three 'Boats to have been with the team since it was brought back in 2023. He tallied 2 total tackles and a diving pass breakup last week vs. D.C.
- Two of the Showboats' defensive backs have experience in a Jarren Horton defense. Walker and Gilbert both come to Memphis after having played under Horton with the Pittsburgh Maulers in the USFL. Walker was with the Maulers in 2022 and 2023, recording 48 tackles, 1 sack, 1 interception and 2 pass breakups. Gilbert played for the Maulers in 2023 with 33 tackles and 4 INTs. Gilbert also won a UFL Championship with the Birmingham Stallions last season, tallying 25 tackles and 1 INT.
- Lance Boykin recorded 4 total tackles and 2 pass breakups in last week's game vs. the Defenders. For the season, he has 8 total tackles to go along with those 2 passes defended.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

- Matt Coghlin was the most accurate kicker in the United Football League last season. He converted on 94.1 percent of his field-goal attempts (16-of-17) with a long of 57 yards in 2024.
- Coghlin was 4-for-4 to open the season, before seeing his third attempt vs. D.C. get blocked, bringing his season total to 4-of-5.
- In his professional career, Coghlin has missed just 4 field goals, going 38-of-42 (90.5 percent). With a 50-yarder in Week One, Coghlin is now 7-of-9 (77.8 percent) from 50-plus as a pro.
- Turner Bernard returns to handle the long-snapping duties. He successfully converted all 52 of his long snaps last season. Bernard's father Ben has been training long snappers for nearly 30 years and has sent numerous proteges on to college and professional football.
- Mengel is the lone newcomer among the specialists. He last played in the 2023 USFL with the Pittsburgh Maulers. During that season, he recorded 11 punts of 50 yards or more, including a USFL-record 83-yarder. Last week, Mengel averaged 42.3 yards per punt on three boots, including a 51-yarder. He placed 2 punts inside the 20-yard line in Week One vs. Michigan.

SHOWBOATS TEAMMATES

Three pairs of Showboats have now been teammates in college and at the professional level. Defensive lineman Boogie Roberts and defensive back Nehemiah Shelton played together at San Jose State. Long snapper Turner Bernard and defensive back Kyree Woods played together at San Diego State. Center Alec Lindstrom and quarterback E.J. Perry were also teammates at Boston College, before Perry transferred to Brown.

Three Showboats have been teammates in all three years of the team's existence following its return in 2023. Defensive lineman John Atkins Sr., tight end Jay Jay Wilson and defensive back Kyree Woods are all in their third season with the team.

NEW-LOOK SHOWBOATS

The Memphis Showboats saw a vast overhaul in personnel for the 2025 season.

Seven of the nine coaches on the Showboats' staff game are new to the team, including head coach Ken Whisenhunt. New coaches include: Jarren Horton (DC), Marc Hull (LB/ST), Brian Baker (DL), Steve Meyer (DQC), Luke Ferdinand (RB) and Lee Morris (OQC).

As for the roster, 14 players on the 50-man opening day roster were on the team last season, meaning the roster includes 72 percent newcomers from the previous season.

SUPER BOATS

Three Memphis Showboats players own Super Bowl rings.

- Ryan Izzo was a member of the 2018 New England Patriots, earning a Super Bowl ring despite being on injured reserve that season.
- Obi Melifonwu was also on the 2018 New England Patriots. He saw action in two games that season, recording three total tackles.
- Deneric Prince was a member of the Kansas City Chiefs practice squad for the 2023 season when the Chiefs won Super Bowl LVIII.

UNDER ARMOUR THREADS

Under Armour is the exclusive provider of all on-field uniforms, including jerseys, base layer, sideline and training apparel, for all XFL teams. The unique home and away sets are designed with an authentic execution of the individual team identities. The design process was a collaboration between XFL ownership, marketing, and Under Armour teams.

Each jersey features a "Blood, Sweat, Respect" mantra – a personal message from ownership to players, which is sublimated on the interior collars of all team uniforms.

Additional design details include embroidered team wordmarks and branding at the base of the neckline, UA's ArmourGrid nameplates with twill lettering, and all uniforms are branded with XFL, Under Armour, and Project Rock Brahma Bull patches.

Memphis Memorial Stadium (1965-75)
Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium (1975-2022)
Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium (2022-present)

History

The stadium was originally built as Memphis Memorial Stadium in 1965 for \$3 million, as a part of the Mid-South Fairgrounds, then home to one of the South's most popular fairs. It was dedicated as a memorial to the citizens of Memphis who had served in

World War I, World War II, and the Korean War.



The facility was built partially as a way to bring the Liberty Bowl to a permanent home in Memphis. The game was such a success for Memphis that the stadium was renamed Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium in December 1975.

It was renamed Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in a naming rights agreement with Simmons Bank, which operates in Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, Tennessee and Texas.

On December 19, 2023, the City of Memphis passed a vote to transfer ownership of the stadium to the University of Memphis. This past summer, renovation and construction of the stadium began, including the demolition of much of the west side, including the old press box. All operations previously hosted on the west side of the stadium have been moved to the east side.

Tenants

Since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Memphis Tigers football team from the University of Memphis. Also since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Liberty Bowl game.

The stadium is also the host of the "Southern Heritage Classic", a game between two historically black colleges, University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff and Tennessee State University. The stadium also has hosted home games of the Tennessee Volunteers, Ole Miss Rebels, and Mississippi State Bulldogs.

Professional Football at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium

In 1974 and 1975, the stadium hosted the Memphis Southmen, aka "Grizzlies," of the World Football League.

In 1984, the original United States Football League added the Memphis Showboats as an expansion team. The Showboats, featuring defensive end Reggie White and coached by flamboyant Memphian Pepper Rodgers, were one of the better draws in the league. They advanced to the semifinals in 1985.

In 1995 the Liberty Bowl welcomed the Memphis Mad Dogs as part of the Canadian Football League's attempt at bringing their league into American markets.

In 1997, the Houston Oilers announced they would relocate to Nashville, but played the 1997 season at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium.

A subsequent major professional tenant was the Memphis Maniax of the first XFL.

The Memphis Express of the Alliance of American Football played in the stadium for its sole season in 2019.

The second iteration of the USFL saw the Memphis Showboats return in 2023. The team would remain in Memphis as part of the merger between the XFL and USFL that created the United Football League.

Other Former Tenants

The Memphis Rogues (1978-80) of the North American Soccer League called the stadium home. A 1975 exhibition Major League Baseball game (Atlanta Braves vs Milwaukee Brewers) was played. The right-field fence was only 174 feet from home plate, about 125 feet shorter than most major league parks.

UFL RULES

The United Football League (UFL) will continue to build on the innovation of both the XFL and USFL with its rules for the 2025 season.. The UFL has adopted a number of innovative rules from both previous leagues to deliver an exciting, fast-paced game with plenty of action. Below are some highlights:

Points After Touchdown

Teams will have three scrimmage play options following a touchdown.
2-yard line = 1 point for a successful try
5-yard line = 2 points for a successful try
10-yard line = 3 points for a successful try

Kickoffs

The UFL's 2025 kickoff rules this season will be based on a combination of the kickoff used by XFL Legacy during its 2023 season and the NFL Dynamic Kickoff used by the NFL during the 2024 season. These changes include:

Kickoffs will start at the 30-yard line. The 10 remaining players on the kickoff team will line up at the receiving team's 40-yard line. The receiving team's set up zone will stretch from its 35-yard line to the 30-yard line and must have at least nine players in that zone. The landing zone will be from the receiving team's 20-yard line to the goal line. The ball must reach the landing zone or it will be spotted at the 40-yard line. There will be two touchback spots: the 35-yard-line for balls kicked into the end zone and the 20-yard line for balls that hit in the landing zone and then enter the end zone.

Onside Kicks

The league has eliminated this option. The kickoff team will be able to retain possession of the ball with the late-game possession option described below.

Late-Game Possession Option

Teams will have an alternate option to attempt to retain possession in the fourth quarter. If a team is tied or behind during the fourth quarter, it may elect to retain possession after a score with a 4th-and-12 from its own 28-yard line.

Two Forward Passes

Teams will be allowed, as they were last season, to throw two forward passes on one play. The ball cannot cross the line of scrimmage at any time prior to the second forward pass being thrown.

Replay Reviews

The officiating department may stop a game at any time before the ball is next legally put in play to review a play if there is reasonable evidence to believe an error was made and it would have a direct, competitive impact on the game. Any call or non-call related to player safety is also subject to review at any point, as well as any officiating ruling in the last five minutes of the or overtime that is obviously incorrect and will have a significant impact on the outcome.

Coach Challenges

Each coach may challenge any ruling, including fouls or potential fouls, provided the team has a timeout. A successful challenge will not result in a loss of a timeout, while the timeout is lost if the challenge fails.

New in 2025 is the addition of a second challenge if the first challenge was successful.

HEAD COACH KEN WHISENHUNT



Ken Whisenhunt was named head coach of the Memphis Showboats on Sept. 23, 2024.

Whisenhunt has an extensive coaching background, including two stints as a head coach in the National Football League and a Super Bowl Championship as offensive coordinator with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

Whisenhunt was the head coach of the Arizona Cardinals for six seasons (2007-2012), winning two NFC West Division Championships (2008, 2009), an NFC Championship and a berth in Super Bowl XLIII following the 2008 season. In addition, he served as head coach of the Tennessee Titans in 2014 and 2015.

Whisenhunt earned a Super Bowl Championship ring as offensive coordinator for the Pittsburgh Steelers, who won Super Bowl XL (following the 2006 season). He was on the Steelers' staff for six seasons, beginning as the tight ends coach from 2001-03 before being promoted to offensive coordinator in 2001, a role he held through the 2006 season.

Most recently, Whisenhunt served as Special Assistant to the Head Coach under Nick Saban at the University of Alabama for the 2023 season. He also spent two seasons (2021-22) with Penn State University as an offensive analyst.

His most recent stint in the NFL was as offensive coordinator for the Chargers from 2016-2019 and served in that capacity for the Chargers in 2013. He has also coached for the New York Jets (2000, special teams); Cleveland Browns (1999, tight ends); and Baltimore Ravens (1997-98, tight ends). Whisenhunt got his start in coaching with Vanderbilt University, where he coached special teams, tight ends and H-backs in 1995 and 1996.

Whisenhunt was an eight-year player in the NFL, playing tight end/H-back for Atlanta (1985-88), Washington (1989-90) and the New York Jets (1991-92). He played his collegiate football at Georgia Tech, where he was a two-time First Team All-ACC selection at tight end and earned Honorable Mention All-America honors as a senior in 1984.

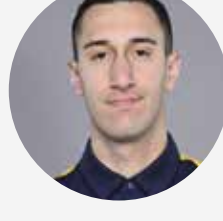

GAME TWO - D.C. 17, MEMPHIS 12

WASHINGTON, D.C. (April 5) – The D.C. Defenders held off the Memphis Showboats 17-12 at Audi Field.

DC led 9-6 heading into the fourth quarter. But Showboats quarterback EJ Perry's sixteen-yard run was the game's first touchdown and also gave Memphis a 12-9 lead with 11:47 remaining in the contest.

A 45-yard completion from Jordan Ta'amu to Chris Rowland just five plays after the Perry score put the Defenders in the red zone at the Memphis 12-yard line. Three plays later, on 3rd-and-goal, Ta'amu tossed a pop pass over the middle to Ben Bresnahan to put D.C. on top 15-12. A Rowland reverse pass on the 2-point conversion gave the Defenders a five-point edge.

The Showboats clawed their way down the field, driving to the D.C. 25-yard line. When the drive stalled, Memphis elected to kick a field goal and attempt to retain possession with a 4th-and-12 (the UFL's alternate rule to an onside kick). But Memphis never got to that 4th-and-12 attempt, as Matt Coghlin's 43-yard field goal attempt was blocked by the Defenders' Devonsha Maxwell.

DC worked enough clock to leave just one second before giving the ball back to the Showboats. A last-ditch attempt to keep the ball alive with laterals was quickly snuffed out, giving D.C. the five-point win.

Perry finished the game 18-of-28 for 205 yards with 1 interception. He also ran the ball 4 times for 26 yards and a TD. Jonathan Adams had another big day for the Showboats, becoming the first wide receiver in the UFL this season to eclipse the 100-yard mark. He tallied 9 catches for 128 yards. Memphis out-gained D.C. 308-257 for the contest.

Linebacker Steele Chambers logged another 10 total tackles, making this his second game in a row with double-digit tackles. Former DC Defender, now Memphis Showboat Boogie Roberts made the game's only sack and one of the Showboats' three TFLs.

Memphis led 3-0 after the first quarter on a 22-yard Coghlin field goal. D.C.'s Matt McCrane put two field goals on the board in the second quarter to give the Defenders a 6-3 lead. McCrane's third field goal early in the third quarter made it 9-3. Coghlin pulled the Showboats within three, 9-6, with a 33-yarder with 6:43 left in the third.
