Series Notes

- This is just the second meeting of the Memphis Showboats and St. Louis Battlehawks, after the UFL merger took place prior to the 2024 season.
- It will be the first matchup between the Battlehawks and Showboats in Memphis.
- St. Louis won the only other matchup between these two squads, picking up a 32-17 victory at The Dome on April 20, 2024.

BOATS RETURN HOME TO FACE BATTLEHAWKS

The Memphis Showboats haven't played at home since April 12. The 'Boats finished a threegame road swing with losses at Michigan and Houston sandwiched around an upset victory at Birmingham.

The Battlehawks won two, lost two and have now won two straight again. St. Louis is in the thick of the playoff race in the XFL Conference and Memphis will be looking to play spoiler.

St. Louis and Memphis are both averaging exactly 262.5 yards per game. But the Battlehawks have been more successful at crossing the goal line, averaging 21.8 points per game, while Memphis averages 15.7.

Saturday's game is slated for a 2 p.m. CT kickoff at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium and will be broadcast nationally on ESPN. The game will also be heard live on Sirius XM satellite radio.

The Memphis radio broadcast will be heard on Hot 107.1, with Eli Savoie (play-by-play) and Russell Copeland (analyst) in the booth. It will be the third consecutive year of calling the Showboats for the Savoie-Copeland duo.

LAST WEEK

The Houston Roughnecks took advantage of a defensive score to upend the Memphis Showboats 21-20.

Momentum swung midway through the third guarter when Armani Marsh sacked Memphis quarterback Dresser Winn at the 45-yard line, forcing a fumble. T.J. Franklin returned it for a Roughnecks touchdown. A successful 2-point conversion pushed Houston's lead to 21-14 - an advantage they never relinquished.

Houston led 10-0 early, but the Showboats rallied and took a 14-10 edge at the intermission.

Houston' added a field goal after an interception of Winn to make it 14-13. The Roughnecks then flipped the game with the sack-and-score play late in the third quarter.

The Showboats kept battling. Kicker Matt Coghlin hit field goals from 42 and 27 yards to pull Memphis within one point, 21-20.

But the Houston offense picked up four first downs on its final possession to run the final 5:47 off the clock and seal the win.

WINN-ING TIME

Dresser Winn was the third team, emergency QB for the first four weeks of the season. But he was named the starter for Week 5 at Birmingham and passed for 235 yards and a TD on 17-of-29 attempts. He also completed a pass to Dee Anderson for a 2-point conversion in overtime to seal the victory.

Winn played well again last week in the loss to Houston. He was 22-of-34 for 207 yards with 1 touchdown and 1 interception. He also rushed for a TD.

OUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- Winn's victory at Birmingham was the first for a Showboats starting QB since Week 10 last season, when Josh Love led the team to a win over the Houston Roughnecks.
- Winn was with the LA Rams on the practice squad in 2023 and 2024. He made one start for the Rams in the 2024 preseason, going 9-of-16 for 72 yards. Winn was a Second Team All-OVC performer at UT-Martin in 2022, going 232-of-379 for 2,928 yards, 18 TDs and 11 INTs. He led the Skyhawks to an OVC Championship that season.
- Troy Williams saw action in eight games for the Showboats last season, completing 54.7 percent of his passes (58-of-165) for 591 yards and 5 TDs with 5 interceptions. Perry completed 61.7 percent of his passes in his four starts with Michigan last season, going 55-of-89 for 664 yards with 2 TDs and 3 interceptions.
- \bullet Both Perry and Williams are dual-threat QBs. In 21 USFL/UFL games, Williams has rushed 77 times for 454 yards and 5 TDs. In 8 USFL/UFL games played, Perry has rushed for 268 yards and 6 TDs on 50 carries.



RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- Wes Hills joined the Showboats early last week after missing the first half of the UFL season due to an injury sustained during the 2024 season with Michigan. In his first action since May 18, 2024 Hills rushed for 47 yards on 13 carries and added 3 receptions for 28 yards.
- Deneric Prince has started 5 of the 6 games at running back for Memphis and has rushed for 186 yards on 57 carries. Prince had a long TD run called back at Houston last week and a TD recption called back the week before at Birmingham.
- Prince won a Super Bowl with the Chiefs in the 2023 NFL season, spending most of the season on the Kansas City practice squad, while seeing action in two games.
- The Showboats entered the 2025 season with three newcomers in the running back room -- Jalen Jackson, Jacob Kibodi and Prince. They had three combined games of professional football experience coming into the season. Kibodi has since been released. The addition of Hills adds a veteran presence. Hills has now played in 1 NFL game, 7 CFL games, 10 USFL games and 9 UFL games.

ADAMS AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS

Jonathan Adams had two huge weeks to open the UFL season. While defenses focused in on ways to slow down his production, he has still managed to remain among the league leaders.

Adams is No. 2 in the UFL in receiving yards with 338. He is No. 4 in the league in receptions with 26.

Last week, Adams caught two balls for 25 yards and added a 2-point conversion reception.



WIDE RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- The Showboats wide receiver room has undergone some drastic change in the last two weeks. Daewood Davis, a 2024 All-UFL selection, returned from IR last week and could play this week. Meanwhile, Dee Anderson, who was the team's No. 3 receiver with 15 receptions for 182 yards and 1TD was traded to San Antonio Monday.
- Kwamie Lassiter II ranks No. 2 on the team in both receptions and receiving yards with 21 catches for 231 yards and 1TD.
- \bullet Isaiah Washington caught 2 passes for 18 yards last week. He now has 8 catches for 75 yards in 3 games played.
- Four of the five newcomers in the wide receiver room bring pro football experience:
- Locksley played both quarterback and wide receiver in the Canadian Football League. His most recent experience was with the Hamilton TigerCats in 2023.
- Lassiter saw action in one game in both 2022 and 2023 with the Cincinnati Bengals.
- Stove played in 4 games for the CFL Ottawa RedBlacks in 2024 and played in 10 games for the New Orleans Breakers in the 2023 USFL.
- Isiah Hennie has played in 20 USFL/UFL games.

TIGHT END NOTEBOOK

- Prior to last week's game at Houston, Memphis tight ends Jay Jay Wilson and Chris Pierce Jr. had combined for just 3 catches. They matched that number vs. the Roughnecks.
- Wilson hauled in his first touchdown reception since 2023 at Houston last week.
- Wilson is the only returning tight end for the Showboats. He is one of 3 current members of the team who have been with the squad since the franchise was resurrected in 2023 (DB Kyree Woods, DL John Atkins Sr.).
- Chris Pierce, Jr. recorded his first two receptions of the season at Michigan in Week 3, going for 20 yards. Pierce finished his college career at Vanderbilt as a WR, hauling in 109 receptions for 1,398 yards and 9 TDs. He was moved to tight end in 2022 with the Arizona Cardinals.



OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- Four Showboats' offensive linemen have started all 6 games this season. Left tackle James Tunstall, left guard Jared Thomas, center Alec Lindstrom and right guard Nash Jensen have all lined up at those positions for the first snap in all 6 games so far this season. At right tackle, Nate Gilliam has gotten the nod the last 5 weeks.
- Lindstrom and Thomas returned to the Showboats from last season. Lindstrom battled through injuries in 2024, but saw action in all 10 games, starting the first 2 and last 2 games of the season, seeing most of his action at guard. Thomas started all 10 games for the 'Boats last season, with 9 of those starts at center.
- Tunstall also returns to the squad from last season. He started 7 games for the Showboats in 2024.
- Jensen brings starting NFL experience to the Memphis offensive line. He played in 11 games with 5 starts for the Carolina Panthers in 2023.
- \bullet Noah Henderson adds UFL experience to the group, starting 5 games and playing in 9 for the Arlington Renegades in 2024.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- P.J. Hall was released Monday. He had been Memphis' leading tackler on the defensive line with 18 total stops and 3 TFLs. He did not play last week at Houston.
- Josiah Bronson has recorded 17 total tackles to pace the interior defensive linemen who are still active with the team. Boogie Roberts has added 13 stops, 2 TFLs and 1 sack
- Roberts brings plenty of experience to the Showboats ... and he also brings a SAG card. On the field, Roberts played for the Pittsburgh Maulers in the 2022 and 2023 USFL seasons with 52 tackles and 3 sacks. Off the field, he has appeared in commercials for brands such as Copper Fit, The Farmer's Dog and Peloton. Roberts' first sack of the season came vs. D.C., the team that signed him but released him prior to the 2024 season.
- Jaylon Allen and Nasir Player have made an impact from the edge. Allen has 18 tackles in 6 games with half a sack. Player is tied for the team lead with 3 TFLs, has recorded 1 sack and 17 total tackles.
- Allen is playing home games in his college stadium, after a standout career for the Memphis Tigers.
- Izayah Green-May has come on from the edge of late as well. He has 15 total stops and 1 sack on the season.



STEELE STACKING STOPS

Linebacker Steele Chambers has recorded double-digit tackles in 4 of the Showboats' 6 games.

Chambers is No. 2 in the United Football League with 53 total tackles, ranking directly behind Michigan's Frank Ginda. He ranks No. 1 in the league in solo tackles with 34.

Chambers is a converted running back. He played two seasons as a running back at Ohio State, tallying 28 carries for 221 yards and 1 TD, before moving to linebacker. After moving to defense, Chambers recorded 190 tackles, 11.5 TFLs, 2 sacks and 3 interceptions for the Buckeyes.



LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- Andrew Dowell joined the Showboats prior to Week 5 and jumped right into the starting lineup. He was No. 2 on the team in Week 5 at Birmingham with 7 total tackles, including 5 solo stops and 1 forced fumble. He raised his play even more last week at Houston, tallying a team-best 8 total tackles and 1 sack.
- Zeke Vandenburgh ranks No. 3 on the team with 33 total tackles. He missed Week 5 with an injury, but returned to action last week at Houston, tallying 6 total tackles.
- Vandenburgh was the top defensive player in NCAA FCS in 2022, winning the Buck Buchanan Award. He led all of FCS in TFLs and sacks per game, averaging 2.1 and 1.4, respectively in 2022. Vandenburgh signed with the Miami Dolphins as a UDFA in 2023, but was waived/injured in the preseason.
- Obi Melifonwu brings a Super Bowl ring to the Showboats. He was a member of the 2018 New England Patriots, who won Super Bowl LIII.



SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- Eli Walker was responsible for the Showboats' first and only takeaway of the season in Week 5, intercepting Birmingham Stallions QB Case Cookus deep in Memphis territory. He is No. 2 on the team in total tackles with 39 (32 solo).
- Kyree Woods is one of three 'Boats to have been with the team since it was brought back in 2023. He has tallied 16 total tackles this season.
- Two of the Showboats' defensive backs have experience in a Jarren Horton defense. Walker and Mark Gilbert both come to Memphis after having played under Horton with the Pittsburgh Maulers in the USFL. Walker was with the Maulers in 2022 and 2023, recording 48 tackles, 1 sack, 1 interceptions and 2 pass breakups. Gilbert played for the Maulers in 2023 with 33 tackles and 4 INTs. Gilbert also won a UFL Championship with the Birmingham Stallions last season, tallying 25 tackles and 1 INT. This season: Walker (39 tackles, No. 2 on team); Gilbert (16 tackles).
- Keaton Ellis is No. 4 on the team with 28 total tackles.
- Eric Garror is No. 5 on the team with 22 total tackles.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

- Isiah Hennie made UFL history in Week 5 at Birmingham. His 108-yard kick six is the longest touchdown of any kind in UFL history. It's also the first "Kick Six" in UFL history and the longest return in UFL history. Ironically, the "Kick Six" wouldn't be a Showboats franchise record. Derrick Dillon returned a missed field goal 109 yards for the Boats in a USFL game in 2023.
- Matt Coghlin is 10-of-12 this season on field goal attempts, with his only misses coming off a block and a 57-yarder at Birmingham. Coghlin was the most accurate kicker in the UFL last season. He converted on 94.1 percent of his field-goal attempts (16-of-17) with a long of 57 yards in 2024. He is now 8-of-11 for his career on attempts of 50-plus yards.
- Turner Bernard returns to handle the long-snapping duties. Bernard's father Ben has been training long snappers for nearly 30 years and has sent numerous proteges on to college and professional football.
- Mengel is the lone newcomer among the specialists. He last played in the 2023 USFL with the Pittsburgh Maulers. During that season, he recorded 11 punts of 50 yards or more, including a USFL-record 83-yarder. Mengel's 7 punts inside the 20 this season are tied for No. 3 in the UFL.



SHOWBOATS TEAMMATES

Three pairs of Showboats have now been teammates in college and at the professional level. Defensive lineman Boogie Roberts and defensive back Nehemiah Shelton played together at San Jose State. Long snapper Turner Bernard and defensive back Kyree Woods played together at San Diego State. Center Alec Lindstrom and quarterback E.J. Perry were also teammates at Boston College, before Perry transferred to Brown.

Three Showboats have been teammates in all three years of the team's existence following its return in 2023. Defensive lineman John Atkins Sr., tight end Jay Jay Wilson and defensive back Kyree Woods are all in their third season with the team.



MEMPHIS MAULERS

The 2025 Memphis Showboats have a fair amount of influence from the USFL's Pittsburgh Maulers.

The Showboats feature three coaches and eight players who were with the Maulers prior to the USFL-XFL merger that created the United Football League. The following is a look at the Maulers-Showboats connections:

- Coaches: Defensive coordinator Jarren Horton; Special Teams Coordinator/ Linebackers Coach Marc Hull; Defensive Quality Control Coach Steve Meyer
- Players: QB Troy Williams; DB Eli Walker; DL Boogie Roberts; DB Mark Gilbert; P Matt Mengel; DL Nasir Player; DL Izayah Green-May; WR Isiah Hennie.



TRANSACTIONS UPDATE

The Showboats made a number of personnel moves Monday and Tuesday.

Memphis traded WR Dee Anderson to San Antonio for CB Darius Phillips. With the Brahmas, Phillips had recorded 14 tackles and 3 pass breakups in 4 games.

The Showboats waived DL P.J. Hall Monday, while bringing back DL Dillon Faamatau, who had been with Memphis in both 2023 and 2024. In 12 games with the Showboats over the two previous seasons, Faamatau tallied 21 tackles.

SO CLOSE, BUT YET SO FAR

On paper, the Showboats are better than last season in many statistical categories. Memphis is averaging 32 more yards per game on offense and allowing 84 yards less per game this season, compared to 2024.

The Showboats have out-gained their opposition in 5 of 6 games this season, but only one of those performances translated into a victory.

In 3 of the 5 Showboats' losses, they have had the ball in the fourth quarter with a chance to tie or win the game. In all 5 of Memphis' losses, the Showboats have been within one score in the fourth quarter.

Turnover margin has been the biggest issue for the Showboats at -10. Memphis' opponents have outscored the Showboats 18-0 in points off turnovers.

NEW-LOOK SHOWBOATS

The Memphis Showboats saw a vast overhaul in personnel for the 2025 season.

Seven of the nine coaches are new to the team, including Jarren Horton (DC), Noel Mazzone (OC), Marc Hull (LB/ST), Brian Baker (DL, Steve Meyer (DQC), Luke Ferdinand (RB) and Lee Morris (OQC).

As for the roster, 14 players on the 50-man opening day roster were on the team last season, meaning the roster includes 72 percent newcomers from the previous season.

SUPER BOATS

Two Memphis Showboats players own Super Bowl rings.

- Obi Melifonwu was also on the 2018 New England Patriots. He saw action in two games that season, recording three total tackles.
- Deneric Prince was a member of the Kansas City Chiefs practice squad for the 2023 season when the Chiefs won Super Bowl LVIII.

Former Names

Memphis Memorial Stadium (1965-75) Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium (1975-2022) Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium (2022-present)

History

The stadium was originally built as Memphis Memorial Stadium in 1965 for \$3 million, as a part of the Mid-South Fairgrounds, then home to one of the South's most popular fairs. It was dedicated as a memorial to the citizens of Memphis who had served in

World War I, World War II, and the Korean War.

The facility was built partially as a way to bring the Liberty Bowl to a permanent home in Memphis. The game was such a success for Memphis that the stadium was renamed Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium in December 1975.

It was renamed Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in a naming rights agreement with Simmons Bank, which operates in Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Okalhoma, Tennessee and Texas

On December 19, 2023, the City of Memphis passed a vote to transfer ownership of the stadium to the University of Memphis. This past summer, renovation and construction of the stadium began, including the demolition of much of the west side, including the old press box. All operations previously hosted on the west side of the stadium have been moved to the east side.

Tenants

Since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Memphis Tigers football team from the University of Memphis. Also since its opening, the stadium has hosted the Liberty Bowl game.

The stadium is also the host of the "Southern Heritage Classic", a game between two historically black colleges, University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff and Tennessee State University. The stadium also has hosted home games of the Tennessee Volunteers, Ole Miss Rebels, and Mississippi State Bulldogs.

Professional Football at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium

In 1974 and 1975, the stadium hosted the Memphis Southmen, aka "Grizzlies," of the World Football League.

In 1984, the original United States Football League added the Memphis Showboats as an expansion team. The Showboats, featuring defensive end Reggie White and coached by flamboyant Memphian Pepper Rodgers, were one of the better draws in the league. They advanced to the semifinals in 1985.

In 1995 the Liberty Bowl welcomed the Memphis Mad Dogs as part of the Canadian Football League's attempt at bringing their league into American markets.

In 1997, the Houston Oilers announced they would relocate to Nashville, but played the 1997 season at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium.

A subsequent major professional tenant was the Memphis Maniax of the first XFL.

The Memphis Express of the Alliance of American Football played in the stadium for its sole season in 2019.

The second iteration of the USFL saw the Memphis Showboats return in 2023. The team would remain in Memphis as part of the merger between the XFL and USFL that created the United Football League.

Other Former Tenants

The Memphis Rogues (1978-80) of the North American Soccer League called the stadium home. A 1975 exhibition Major League Baseball game (Atlanta Braves vs Milwaukee Brewers) was played. The right-field fence was only 174 feet from home plate, about 125 feet shorter than most major league parks.

UFL RULES

The United Football League (UFL) will continue to build on the innovation of both the XFL and USFL with its rules for the 2025 season. The UFL has adopted a number of innovative rules from both previous leagues to deliver an exciting, fast-paced game with plenty of action. Below are some highlights:

Points After Touchdown

Teams will have three scrimmage play options following a touchdown.

2-yard line = 1 point for a successful try

5-yard line = 2 points for a successful try

10-yard line = 3 points for a successful try

Kickoffs

The UFL's 2025 kickoff rules this season will be based on a combination of the kickoff used by XFL Legacy during its 2023 season and the NFL Dynamic Kickoff used by the NFL during the 2024 season. These changes include:

Kickoffs will start at the 30-yard line. The 10 remaining players on the kickoff team will line up at the receiving team's 40-yard line. The receiving team's set up zone will stretch from its 35-yard line to the 30-yard line and must have at least nine players in that zone. The landing zone will be from the receiving team's 20-yard line to the goal line. The ball must reach the landing zone or it will be spotted at the 40-yard line. There will be two touchback spots: the 35-yard-line for balls kicked into the end zone and the 20-yard line for balls that hit in the landing zone and then enter the end zone.

Onside Kicks

The league has eliminated this option. The kickoff team will be able to retain possession of the ball with the late-game possession option described below.

Late-Game Possession Option

Teams will have an alternate option to attempt to retain possession in the fourth quarter. If a team is tied or behind during the fourth quarter, it may elect to retain possession after a score with a 4th-and-12 from its own 28-yard line.

Two Forward Passes

Teams will be allowed, as they were last season, to throw two forward passes on one play. The ball cannot cross the line of scrimmage at any time prior to the second forward pass being thrown.

Replay Reviews

The officiating department may stop a game at any time before the ball is next legally put in play to review a play if there is reasonable evidence to believe an error was made and it would have a direct, competitive impact on the game. Any call or non-call related to player safety is also subject to review at any point, as well as any officiating ruling in the last five minutes of the or overtime that is obviously incorrect and will have a significant impact on the outcome.

Coach Challenges

Each coach may challenge any ruling, including fouls or potential fouls, provided the team has a timeout. A successful challenge will not result in a loss of a timeout, while the timeout is lost if the challenge fails.

New in 2025 is the addition of a second challenge if the first challenge was successful.

GAME ONE - MICHIGAN 26. MEMPHIS 12

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (March 30, 2025) – A Michigan Panthers Pick Six thwarted the Memphis Showboats' spirited comeback attempt Sunday at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium as the Panthers defeated the Showboats 26-12.

Michigan led 20-6 midway through the fourth quarter. But the Showboats put together a 14-play, 70-yard drive that spanned nearly six minutes to pull within one score, 20-12. Quarterback E.J. Perry threw a 6-yard bullet to Jonathan Adams for the Showboats' first TD of the season.

Memphis used the United Football League's alternate possession rule, attempting a 4th-and-12 from their own 28 to retain possession. An incompletion left Michigan with the ball at the Memphis 28 and with 1:47 left. The Showboats pushed the Panthers back four yards and forced a 50-yard field goal that would likely have iced the game. But Michigan kicker B.T. Potter missed and gave the Showboats life with 51 seconds remaining.

On the first play of the ensuing possession, Williams found Adams for 38 yards over the middle. The longest play of the game put the Showboats into scoring position with a chance to tie or win the game. But Williams was pressured by RonDell Carter on the next play. As Williams looked to get the ball to the sideline, Nacua stepped in front of the aerial and raced the other direction for the game-sealing TD.

The Showboats played both active quarterbacks – Perry and Williams. Williams was 8-of-11 for 104 yards and the costly interception in the final minute. Perry was 10-of-17 for 93 yards, 1 touchdown and 1 interception. Adams led all receivers in the game with 6 catches and 93 yards.

Steele Chambers paced the Memphis defense, racking up 10 tackles. Zeke Vandenburgh added 9 total stops and 1 tackle for-loss. Former Memphis Tiger Jaylon Allen recorded the Showboats' only sack of the day.

Michigan jumped out to a 10-0 lead early in the second quarter, scoring on its first two offensive possessions, including a run from quarterback Bryce Perkins to score on 4th-and-goal from the 2 where he overcame a bad snap, and broke at least three tackles to get the ball across the goal line. Memphis responded with a Matt Coghlin 50-yard field goal to make it 10-3 at halftime.

The Showboats pulled within four midway through the third quarter on another Coghlin field goal, this time from 45 yards. The Panthers padded the lead to 17-6 on a Perkins-to-Samson Nacua touchdown pass late in the third. A Potter 43-yard field goal with 7:52 remaining in the game made it 20-6 and set up the late drama.

GAME TWO - D.C. 17, MEMPHIS 12

WASHINGTON, D.C. (April 5) – The D.C. Defenders held off the Memphis Showboats 17-12 at Audi Field.

DC led 9-6 heading into the fourth quarter. But Showboats quarterback EJ Perry's sixteen-yard run was the game's first touchdown and also gave Memphis a 12-9 lead with 11:47 remaining in the contest.

A 45-yard completion from Jordan Ta'amu to Chris Rowland just five players after the Perry score put the Defenders in the red zone at the Memphis 12-yard line. Three plays later, on 3rd-and-goal, Ta'amu tossed a pop pass over the middle to Ben Bresnahan to put D.C. on top 15-12. A Rowland reverse pass on the 2-point conversion gave the Defenders a five-point edge.

The Showboats clawed their way down the field, driving to the D.C. 25-yard line. When the drive stalled, Memphis elected to kick a field goal and attempt to retain possession with a 4th-and-12 (the UFL's alternate rule to an onside kick). But Memphis never got to that 4th-and-12 attempt, as Matt Coghlin's 43-yard field goal attempt was blocked by the Defenders' Devonnsha Maxwell.

DC worked enough clock to leave just one second before giving the ball back to the Showboats. A last-ditch attempt to keep the ball alive with laterals was quickly snuffed out, giving D.C. the five-point win.

Perry finished the game 18-of-28 for 205 yards with 1 interception. He also ran the ball 4 times for 26 yards and a TD. Jonathan Adams had another big day for the Showboats, becoming the first wide receiver in the UFL this season to eclipse the 100-yard mark. He tallied 9 catches for 128 yards. Memphis out-gained D.C. 308-257 for the contest.

Linebacker Steele Chambers logged another 10 total tackles, making this his second game in a row with double-digit tackles. Former DC Defender, now Memphis Showboat Boogie Roberts made the game's only sack and one of the Showboats' three TFLs.

Memphis led 3-0 after the first quarter on a 22-yard Coghlin field goal. D.C.'s Matt McCrane put two field goals on the board in the second quarter to give the Defenders a 6-3 lead. McCrane's third field goal early in the third quarter made it 9-3. Coghlin pulled the Showboats within three, 9-6, with a 33-yarder with 6:43 left in the third.

GAME THREE - HOUSTON 18. MEMPHIS 17

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (April 12, 2025) – The Houston Roughnecks (1-2) clinched their first win of the United Football League season, topping the Memphis Showboats (0-3) at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium, 18-17.

Quarterback Troy Williams came off the bench in the fourth quarter after a pair of interceptions from starting QB E.J. Perry. The Showboats trailed 18-11 before Williams and the Showboats offense got going. Williams led a 19-play, 70-yard drive that culminated in a 4-yard touchdown run from the backup quarterback. Head coach Ken Whisenhunt made the decision to play for the win and go for a 2-point conversion. Williams' pass sailed just out of the reach of Kwamie Lassiter II, leaving Houston with an 18-17 advantage and just 13 seconds remaining.

An unsuccessful last-minute challenge on the 2-point conversion from Whisenhunt with 13 seconds remaining, left Memphis to utilize the UFL's 4th-and-12 from its own 28. After a Houston penalty, Williams completed a pass to Lassiter for 29 yards, but the Showboats' lateral was eventually recovered by the Roughnecks to end the game.

Houston led 15-11 heading into the fourth quarter after Leon O'Neal Jr. stepped in front of a Perry pass and returned it 30 yards for the go-ahead touchdown. Chris Blewitt added a field goal early in the fourth quarter to give the Roughnecks a seven-point advantage.

The Showboats came into the second half with the upper hand. A 32-yard field goal from Matt Coghlin opened the scoring and a touchdown reception and a successful two-point conversion from Lassiter, gave the Showboats an 11-3 lead at halftime.

Houston's response in the third quarter changed the tide of the game. Roughnecks backup quarterback, Nolan Henderson tossed a 6-yard touchdown pass to Emmanuel Butler, pulling Houston within two, 11-9. Four plays later, O'Neal, Jr. gave Houston the lead with the aforementioned pick six.

Perry finished the game 13-of-20 for 131 yards with 2 interceptions and 1 touchdown. He rushed once for six yards. Williams finished the game 4-of-8 for 63 yards. He led the Showboats in rushing, carrying the ball four times for 35 yards and a touchdown. Lassiter hauled in six receptions for 79 yards and a touchdown. For the second straight game, out-gained its opponent but still lost. The Showboats had 261 yards of total offense, compared to 238 for Houston.

Keaton Ellis led the Showboats for eight tackles, tallying two tackles for-loss and a forced fumble. Zeke Vandenburgh tallied seven total tackles.

GAME FOUR - MICHIGAN 27. MEMPHIS 9

DETROIT, Mich. (April 18, 2025) – The Memphis Showboats fell to the Michigan Panthers 27-9 Friday night at Ford Field.

Michigan (3-1) led 14-9 at halftime and got the ball after the intermission. But the Memphis defense forced a 3-and-out, followed by a 53-yard punt return from Isiah Hennie that put the Showboats in position to take the lead. In three plays, Memphis moved to the Michigan 20-yard line.

Quarterback E.J. Perry looked to Eli Stove near the 10-yard line. Stove looked to haul the ball in, but it was pulled away in a juggling interception by the Panthers' Arnold Tarpley III. The game seemed to change from that point, as the Memphis offense continued to struggle.

Michigan's Jaylon Moore hauled in a 27-yard touchdown early in the fourth quarter to give the Panthers a 21-9 lead after the 1-point conversion. The Panthers added a late TD to account for the final score.

The Showboats grabbed an early lead, thanks to a Michigan miscue. Poor execution on a punt snap following Michigan's first possession led to a Showboats possession at the Michigan 20-yard line. A pass interference penalty gave the Showboats the ball at the 6 and two plays later, Deneric Prince went into the end zone from 3 yards out to put Memphis on top 6-0. The Panthers took their first lead just before the end of the first quarter when Toa Taua rumbled 15 yards over right tackle and also converted the 1-point conversion..

Michigan increased its lead late in the first half, driving 89 yards in 10 plays. Nate McCrary's 19-yard touchdown run up the middle and a Bryce Perkins-to-Samson Nacua 2-point conversion pass put the Panthers on top 14-6 with 41 seconds remaining in the first half. Memphis utilized that 41 seconds to move 33 yards and six plays, setting up a Matt Coghlin 52-yard field goal to make it 14-9.

The Memphis offense was stagnant for much of the contest. Michigan out-gained the Showboats 369-150. Perry passed for 47 yards on 8-of-16 attempts. He was also the team's leading rusher with 30 yards on 9 carries. Linebacker Steele Chambers reprised his title as the Showboats top defender, tallying 11 tackles, including eight solo stops. Safety Eli Walker added nine total tackles, all of which were of solo variety.

GAME FIVE - MEMPHIS 24. BIRMINGHAM 20 (OT)

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (April 25, 2025) – The Memphis Showboats earned their first win of the season in dramatic fashion, defeating the Birmingham Stallions 24-20 in overtime at Protective Stadium.

Memphis snapped Birmingham's two-year home win streak and handed the defending UFL champions their first at-home loss since 2023.

In the UFL's overtime format – three alternating 2-point conversion attempts per team – the Shwoboats struck first, aided by back-to-back Birmingham penalties. Memphis stopped the Stallions on their opening try, and after both teams came up empty on their second attempts, Dresser Winn connected with Dee Anderson on a successful third attempt, securing the victory for the 'Boats.

Winn, making his first start in nearly 900 days dating back to his time at UT-Martin, finished 17-of-29 for 235 yards and a touchdown. He opened the game with a strike to Anderson for a 78-yard TD, giving Memphis an early 8-0 lead after a successful 2-point run by Jalen Jackson. Matt Coghlin added a 32-yard field goal to make it 11-0 at the end of the first quarter.

Birmingham trailed 11-3 late in the first half and looked to cut into the deficit with a long field goal on the last play of the half. But the kick fell short. Isaiah Hennie, who was back deep in case of a short kick, hauled in 8 yards deep in the end zone. Hennie set up his blockers, made a couple Stallions miss as he raced down the Memphis sideline for a 108-yard Kick Six to put the Showboats on top 17-3 at halftime.

Former Showboats QB Case Cookus led Birmingham back in the second half with a 33-yard touchdown pass to Jordan Thomas early in the third quarter. Mevis added another field goal early in the fourth to close the gap 17-12. Coghlin answered with a 37-yard field goal to put Memphis on top 20-12. But Cookus tied the game in the final minute with a 6-yard TD pass to Marlon Williams and a successful 2-point conversion to Jace Sternberger, sending the game to overtime tied at 20.

Steele Chambers led the Showboats defense with a game-high 10 tackles (seven solo), his fourth game this season as the team's top tackler. Memphis recorded three sacks – one each from P.J. Hall, Izayah Green-May and Nasir Player. Eli Walker added the team's first interception of the season at the Memphis 1-yard line, thwarting a Birmingham scoring threat.

Cookus was 15-of-33 for 145 yards with two touchdowns and one interception. He also led the Stallions in rushing yards, with 83 on six carries.

GAME SIX - HOUSTON 21. MEMPHIS 20

HOUSTON (May 3, 2025) – The Houston Roughnecks took advantage of a defensive score to upend the Memphis Showboats 21-20 Saturday afternoon at TDECU Stadium. It was the second one-point loss to Houston this season for Memphis, after falling to Houston 18-17 at home in Week 3.

Momentum swung midway through the third quarter when Armani Marsh sacked Memphis quarterback Dresser Winn at the 45-yard line, forcing a fumble. T.J. Franklin scooped up the loose ball and returned it for a Roughnecks touchdown. A successful two-point conversion pass from Jalan McClendon to Justin Hall pushed Houston's lead to 21-14 — an advantage they never relinquished.

Houston scored first late in the first quarter when McClendon found Hall for a 13-yard scoring strike. A successful 1-point conversion made it 7-0 lead. The Roughnecks extended their advantage to 10-0 early in the second quarter on a 49-yard field goal by Chris Blewitt.

Memphis answered with a 9-play, 65-yard drive capped by a 2-yard touchdown pass from Winn to Jay Jay Wilson to trim the deficit to four points, 10-6.

The Showboats grabbed the lead on their next possession. Winn powered in for a 9-yard rushing touchdown and connected with Jonathan Adams on a 2-point conversion to make it 14-10.

Houston's defense stiffened after halftime, adding a field goal after an interception of Winn to make it 14-13. The Roughnecks then flipped the game with the sack-and-score play late in the third quarter.

But the Showboats kept battling. Kicker Matt Coghlin hit field goals from 42 and 27 yards to pull Memphis within one point, 21-20. But the Houston offense picked up four first downs on the next possession to run the final 5:47 off the clock and seal the win.

Winn completed 22-of-34 passes for 207 yards with one passing touchdown and his first interception of the season. He also added a rushing score. Newcomer Wes Hills led the ground attack with 13 carries for 47 yards. Andrew Dowell paced the defense with eight tackles (four solo), 1 sack and 1 tackle for-loss.

Memphis outgained Houston across the board – rushing (92-68), passing (205-142) and total offense (287-209) – but couldn't convert those yards into victory.


