## CAT SCRATCHES

- The Wildcats are in their 111th season of basketball and are the national leaders in total wins with 2,126.
- Kentucky leads the all-time series with Missouri by a 5-0 margin. UK will be making its first trip to Columbia, Mo., in program history. The two teams have met three times in Lexington and twice on neutral sites.
- James Young knocked down a career-high five 3-pointers at LSU on Tuesday. He now has 47 made long balls on the year, a mark that's good for sixth for UK freshmen in program history. He's two shy of cracking the top four.
- Led by Young, Kentucky drained a season-high nine 3-pointers against LSU. Aaron Harrison added three.
- Freshman Dakari Johnson had a career-high 15 points in 20 minutes of action at LSU. He also chipped in with six rebounds and connected on .875 percent from the field (7-of-8).
- Johnson has poured in 44 points in seven SEC contests. He scored 43 points in 13 non-conference games.
- Sophomore Alex Poythress is averaging 10.6 points, 4.9 rebounds and has 11 blocked shots during league play.
- With 321 points on the season, Julius Randle is the 20th freshman in program history to tally 300 or more points and with 204 rebounds, he's the ninth freshman to accumulate 200 or more rebounds in his first year.
- Jarrod Polson is averaging 10.4 minutes per game against SEC foes and is connecting on .571 of his shots from behind the arc.
- Kentucky's win over Georgia in Rupp Arena marked the 21st straight home victory for the Cats which is tied for the nation's fourth-longest home winning streak. UK is 80-2 in Rupp Arena in the Calipari era.

#### Calipari to Raise Awareness for Autism

Coach Calipari is one of nearly 100 men's basketball coaches throughout the country that will be wearing the "Autism Speaks" pin on his suit jacket at Missouri. Towson's Pat Skerry and Marshall's Tom Herrion, each who have sons on the autism spectrum, have started a nationwide campaign to raise awareness about this disease.

## **SEC Domination**

- · Since the SEC's inception in 1932-33, the Wildcats have been the most dominant team in the league, recording a 916-258 mark (.781).
- Only one other team has won more than 700 regular season SEC games (Alabama) and no other team has a better winning percentage.
- UK has averaged 11.6 wins and only 3.2 losses per season in 78 years in the SEC.

- The Wildcats have won 45 SEC titles and 27 SEC Tournament championships, more than the other 13 teams combined.
- Kentucky has won 11 of the last 20 SEC Tournament titles.

#### Signees Named to McDonald's All-America Game

All four of Kentucky's fall signees, Devin Booker, Trey Lyles, Karl Towns and Tyler Ulis were selected to the McDonald's All-America game slated for April 2 in the United Center in Chicago. With UK's four 2014 signees selected, John Calipari has now had 20 signees play in the game since he became head coach at Kentucky.

#### Former Cats Named to All-Star Teams

Former Wildcat greats John Wall, Anthony Davis and Terrence Jones were tapped to participated in the NBA's All-Star weekend. Wall earned his first selection to the East All-Star squad, while Davis and Jones were picked to represent the sophomores in the Rising Stars game.

#### On Fire from Downtown

James Young has sunk 47 3-pointers on the season for an average of 2.35 made 3-pointers per game. That total ranks sixth in program history for a freshman. He's also the only firstyear player to rank among the SEC leaders in

both 3-point percentage (.338) and made 3's per game.

#### Johnson Provides Spark

Freshman Dakari Johnson has provided a spark to the Wildcats during conference play. Johnson is logging 6.3 points and 3.4 rebounds per game in 13.7 minutes. He's already scored more points (44) in seven league games than he had in 13 non-confernece games (43). He's also shooting at a team-high efficency rate of .792 from the floor, while hauling in 13 offensive rebounds, a total that ranks second on the squad.

#### **Poythress Scores 500th Career Point**

Alex Poythress scored his 500th career point at LSU and now has 508 for his career in just 53 games. That mark is good for 140th all-time in UK's scoring record books. He needs three more to move past Dick Parksons for 139th place.

## Hitting the Boards for Points

The 2013-14 edition of the Kentucky Wildcats is the best rebounding teams in the John Calipari era. Through 20 contests, UK is hauling in 42.4 rebounds per game. The 2009-10 Cats rank second in the five-year tenure of Calipari with an average of 42.1 boards per game through the same number of games.

#### Calipari Comfortable at Home

Since the 2000 season, John Calipari-coached teams have posted a 235-21 (.918) record at home. In Calipari's first season, UK tallied an 18-0 mark at home, and the Cats were 15-0 in Rupp in his second season. Kentucky finished 18-0 in 2011-12 and is 13-0 this season.

His 54-game winning streak at Rupp was the longest streak since the arena opened in 1976.
