CAT SCRATCHES

- The Wildcats are in their 111th season of basketball and are the national leaders in total wins with 2,125.
- Kentucky leads the all-time series with Georgia by a 115-26 margin. UK leads the series in Lexington by a 56-5 margin and that includes a 31-4 clip in Rupp Arena. John Calipari is 3-0 at home vs. the Bulldogs.
- Tuesday's meeting is the lone regular-season matchup of the 2014 season between the two teams.
- James Young leads UK in scoring in SEC games at a 15.6 rate. He's hit a 3-pointer in six-consecutive
- Alex Poythress is logging 10.6 points, 4.4 rebounds, 2.0 blocks and shooting at a .613 clip during league play. He's topped double figures in three SEC games, after only notching one during non-conference action.
- Freshman Julius Randle has scored 301 points and hauled in 190 rebounds in 18 games. That's seven more rebounds than Anthony Davis had through the same number of games in 2011-12. Davis owns the UK freshman record with 415 rebounds. Only two other Calipari-coached freshmen topped the 300-point plateau 18 games into the season (Terrence Jones and Brandon Knight both in 2010-11).
- Andrew Harrison is averaging 3.5 assists per game with just 2.5 turnovers per game. He's already played two turnover-less games. Marguis Teague (2011-12) and Knight are the only other freshman point guards to have tallied at least one turnover-less game through the same number of outings.
- Through 167 games as the head coach of UK John Calipari owns a 137-30 overall record. Adolph Rupp possessed a 136-31 record through the same number of games.
- Former All-America selection and SEC Player of the Year, Tony Delk, has been selected as UK's SEC Legend to be honored at the SEC Tournament in 2014.

Through the first five games, Poythress is averaging 10.4 points per game, 4.4 rebounds and 2.0 blocks while shooting at a .613 field goal clip. Three of his four 10+ scoring outputs on the season have come against league opponents.

Polson's Jersey to be Retired at High School

Senior Jarrod Polson's high school iersev is set to be retired on Friday, Jan. 24th at West Jessamine High School.

Polson finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,884 career points and was named first team All-State by a number of publications. As a senior he averaged 18.2 points, 6.4 assists and 4.9 rebounds.

Delk Tabbed UK's SEC Legend

Former Kentucky All-America selection Tony Delk has been tabbed as Kentucky's Southeastern Conference Basketball Legend and will be honored at this year's SEC Tournament being held in Atlanta, Ga.

Calipari on a Roll in Conference Play

Calipari has recorded a 103-15 record in league play over the last six-plus seasons. He's 56-15 in SEC action at the helm of Kentucky.

Calipari Comfortable at Home

Since the 2000 season, John Calipari-coached teams have posted a 234-21 (.918) record at home. In Calipari's first season, UK tallied an 18-0 mark at home, and the Cats were 15-0 in Rupp in his second season. Kentucky finished 18-0 in 2011-12 and is 12-0 this season.

His 54-game winning streak at Rupp was the longest streak since the arena opened in 1976.

The Success Rate

Coach Calipari has graduated 100% of the players (10 of 10) who have been eligiblie to graduate by the end of their senior years and exhausted their athletic eligibility. Of that group, Patrick Patterson and Jarrod Polson each completed their degrees in just three years. Current senior Jon Hood has also received a bachelor's degree, and will ahve another year of eligibility.
