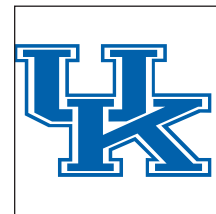

STARTING FIVE

1 Ole Miss opened the SEC slate with a 71-57 win over Arkansas on Friday. The win was Ole Miss' first in an SEC opener since 2010-11 and the 14-point margin of victory was the largest margin of victory in an SEC home opening win since a 70-56 win over Alabama in 2009-10.






2 Tia Faleru posted her third consecutive double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds against Arkansas. Faleru now has 25 career double-doubles including five this season, which ranks No. 7 all-time at Ole Miss. She also moved up to No. 18 on the all-time scoring list with 1,183 career points.

3 The Rebels ran their undefeated streak to five straight, which is the longest of the season and the most since a seven-game undefeated streak in 2013-14. Ole Miss is just one win shy of 12 wins, which was the win total in each of the last two seasons. Ole Miss is in search of its first 20-win season since 2006-07.

4 Erika Sisk led Ole Miss in scoring for the fourth time this season with a game-high 19 points against Arkansas. Sisk's 19 points was her sixth game in double figures and her fourth game in double figures in the last five games. Sisk is averaging 9.7 points per game this season and has scored in each game this season.

5 Ole Miss will play its second televised contest on Sunday and will make its first appearance on the SEC Network. This season, Ole Miss is 0-1 on television falling to Western Kentucky. Ole Miss is looking for its first in a televised game since defeating Florida in 2012-13.

In his first season as head coach at Ole Miss, Matt Insell laid the foundation for a promising future. Beginning his career with the Rebels, Insell led Ole Miss to a 10-6 non-conference record, including a seven-game win streak - the longest win streak for the Rebels since the 2007-08 season. Ole Miss' non-conference schedule was highlighted by a matchup in Waco, Texas, where the Rebels took on the Baylor Bears, who had reached the Sweet Sixteen a year before. With Ole Miss leading in the final minutes, Baylor battled back to spoil the upset, giving fans a glimpse of the success to come under the vision of Insell.

After battling through the always challenging SEC schedule, the Rebels entered the SEC Tournament at the No. 14 seed, determined to take the momentum from a regular season finale victory over Auburn into the postseason tournament. Drawing the No. 11 seed Arkansas, the Rebels took care of business with a 63-62 victory, giving Ole Miss a statement win for Insell's process. "I didn't look at it as rebuilding, I looked at it as a process of getting us back to the top," said Insell after the SEC Tournament win. "A win like this helps you get there."

Insell also led the Rebels to wins over in-state rival, Mississippi State to give the first-year head coach his first SEC victory. In addition to the Rebel's battle with 2014 Elite Eight participant, Baylor, Ole Miss posted victories against women's basketball powerhouse, Louisiana Tech and sent the Ole Miss senior class out in style with a Senior Day overtime win over Auburn at Tad Smith Coliseum.

Insell, who was responsible for the guards while also having recruiting and player development duties, served as the top assistant coach and helped UK ink three top-10 recruiting classes and seven McDonald's All-Americans. During his time at Kentucky, Insell helped develop guard A'dia Mathies, a two-time SEC Player of the Year and All-America candidate, and Bria Goss who was named SEC Freshman of the Year. Prior to Kentucky,

Insell earned valuable basketball experience while attending the University of Tennessee from 2001-2005. He worked closely with both the men and women's basketball programs, serving as a student assistant/video coordinator under former men's head coach Buzz Peterson and as an instructor at Pat Summitt's summer basketball camps. The Shelbyville, Tenn., native transferred to Middle Tennessee State during the 2005-06 season where his father, Rick Insell, is the head women's basketball coach. He went on to earn his bachelor's degree in political science from MTSU in 2007.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Ole Miss vs. Middle Tennessee game (11/23/14) went down as one for the NCAA history books as it was the first time in NCAA Division I women's basketball that a father and son squared off as head coaches.

Ole Miss vs. Kentucky Notables

-This will be the 36th meeting between Ole Miss and Kentucky with the Rebels holding a 20-15 series advantage despite dropping the last five meetings to the Wildcats. Ole Miss leads the series in Lexington, 9-8, but is looking for its first win in Lexington since a 67-65 OT win in 2006-07.

-Ole Miss head coach Matt Insell honed his coaching skills with five seasons on Matthew Mitchell's staff at Kentucky prior to being named head coach at Ole Miss. The Wildcats advanced to three Elite Eight's during Insell's time in the Bluegrass state.

-Ole Miss is hoping to stop the Wildcats high powered offense in this meeting. In last season's meeting, the Wildcats scored 108 points for the most points in the history of the series and is averaging 86.8 points against the Rebels in the last five meetings.

-Sunday's game will be the second consecutive televised game between the Rebels and Wildcats and marks the first of two televised contests between the teams this season. The teams will square off on an SEC Monday night game on Feb. 23 when Kentucky makes the trip to Oxford.

-Current Ole Miss graduate manager Brian Sensibaugh is also quite familiar with Kentucky after spending time working with both the Kentucky men and women's teams as a manager during his undergraduate days at UK.

A Win Would...

-Give Ole Miss its first win over Kentucky in the last five meetings and give head coach Matt Insell a win over his former employer for the first time. Additionally, it would extend Ole Miss' current win streak to six straight and move Ole Miss to 2-0 in SEC action for the first time since 2006-07.

Kentucky enters Sundays' matchup with a 12-2, 1-0 SEC record after defeating Alabama 78-66 in their SEC opener on Friday. The Wildcats are winners of its last two since a loss to No. 13/13 Duke snapped a six-game win streak. Jennifer O'Neill leads four Wildcats in double figures with 14.9 points per game. Makayla Epps with 13.4 points, Linnae Harper with 10.4 points and Janee Thompson with 10.1 points round out the Kentucky double-digit scorers. Azia Bishop and Harper lead Kentucky on the boards with 6.5 and 6.4 rebounds, respectively. As a team, the Wildcats are averaging 79.4 points per game and 42.2 rebounds.

About Ole Miss

Senior forward Tia Faleru continues to lead Ole Miss with 16.0 points per game and 10.6 rebounds per game. Faleru has scored in double figures in 12 of Ole Miss' 14 games and has grabbed eight or more rebounds in 13 of Ole Miss' 14 games, while recording five double-doubles on the season. Faleru is the lone player in double figures but Erika Sisk is nearing double figures with 9.7 points per game. The Rebels boast a fairly balanced scoresheet with 10 players averaging at least four points. Danielle McCray and A'Queen Hayes are helping Faleru shoulder the rebounding load averaging 4.8 and 3.7 rebounds per game, respectively.

Recapping the Arkansas Game

Behind big games from sophomore guard Erika Sisk and senior forward Tia Faleru the Ole Miss women's basketball team picked up a 71-57 win over Arkansas in the Southeastern Conference opener for both teams on Friday at Tad Smith Coliseum. Sisk led all scorers with 19 points on 8-of-12 shooting, while Faleru picked up her third consecutive double-double, her fifth of the season and the 25th of her career, with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Senior forward Danielle McCray also joined them in double figures with 11 points. Ole Miss (11-3, 1-0 SEC) shot 50 percent (24-of-48) from the floor, the highest field-goal percentage for an Arkansas (10-3, 0-1 SEC) opponent this season. The Rebels also turned 17 Razorback turnovers into 28 points off turnovers.

Win SEC Opener ... Check!

For the first time in the last four years, Ole Miss picked up a win in its SEC opener when it defeated Arkansas, 71-57. Ole Miss last won an SEC opener in 2010-11 when they defeated Vanderbilt at home. The Rebels move to 7-4 in SEC openers over the last 11 seasons.

TV Time

The Rebels will make their second appearance this season on television when they take on Kentucky and their first appearance on the SEC Network. Ole Miss is 0-1 on television this season with a 98-69 setback at Western Kentucky on American Sports Net. Ole Miss is seeking its first win in a regular season televised contest since defeating Florida, 88-81 on CSS on Jan. 14, 2013. The Rebels are 1-9 in televised game in the Matt Insell era with a 63-62 win over Arkansas in the first round of the 2014 SEC Tournament.

Back to the Bluegrass For Coach Insell

Ole Miss Head coach Matt Insell heads back to Memorial Coliseum for the second time since taking over the Ole Miss program prior to the 2013-14 season. Insell spent five years as the top assistant at Kentucky, helping lead the Wildcats to three Elite Eight appearances.

Road Warriors Early

Ole Miss is hitting the road for the first time in the last six games when it travels to Lexington, Ky. The Rebels are 2-1 in road or neutral games this week with the lone loss coming to Western Kentucky. The Kentucky game is the first of two straight roadies for the Rebels, as they will stay on the road at Florida for their next contest. Ole Miss will hit the road three times in the first six games of the SEC slate, also traveling to Texas A&M.

Another Ranked Foe on Tap

Kentucky marks the second nationally-ranked opponent for the Rebels this season. The Rebels took on then No. 11/11 Baylor back on Dec. 7 in Oxford, falling 96-54. Ole Miss is looking for its first win over a nationally ranked foe in four years. The last time Ole Miss defeated a nationally ranked opponent was No. 23/24 Arkansas in Fayetteville. Ole Miss will have several chances at a ranked opponent coming up hosting No. 19 Georgia on Jan. 15 and traveling to No. 5/9 Texas A&M on Jan. 18.

Faleru Nets Third Straight Double-Double

Ole Miss leading scorer and top rebounder Tia Faleru posted her third consecutive double-double against

Arkansas in the SEC opener. It is her fifth double-double of the season and the 25th of her career. In total, Faleru has posted 20 double-doubles under the tutelage of Matt Insell. Faleru has now scored in double figures in 11 games, including the last five games, and has posted double figures rebounds in six games. Faleru opened the season with five straight games in double figures. Ole Miss is 6-1 when Faleru is the leading scorer and rebounder and is 3-1 when she just leads the squad in rebounding.

Sisk Gets In The SEC Groove

Oxford native Erika Sisk, definitely made an impression in her first SEC contest. She led all-scorers with 19 points and had a game best four steals. Sisk's 19 points was her sixth game in double figures this season and her fourth time in the last five games.

Points of Turnovers HUGE For Rebels

Ole Miss has capitalized on opponent miscues this season and on the season has scored 352 points off opponent mistakes, averaging 25.1 points of turnovers on the season. Ole Miss tallied a season-high 43 against Grambling and in the last three games is averaging 27.6 points from opponent miscues. Ole Miss started SEC strong in that category forcing Arkansas into 17 turnovers leading to 28 Ole Miss points.

Faleru Among SEC Leaders

Tia Faleru is among the SEC leaders in several crucial categories. The Ozark, Ala., native leads the SEC in rebounds with 10.6 rebounds per game and is second in scoring with 16.0 points per game and field goal percentage at 57.3 percent. Faleru is the lone player in the SEC in the top two in each of those categories. She's also ranked No. 4 in steals with 2.6 steals per game.

McCray Takes It Up a Notch

Senior captain Danielle McCray has played quite well as of late. The West Palm Beach, Fla., native posted back-to-back games in double figures with 11 points vs. Arkansas and went 7-of-9 from the free throw line for the second consecutive games. McCray entered the Southeastern Louisiana game shooting just 58.6 percent from the charity stripe. She's also been giving up her body leading the team with five charges and posted two in the win over Arkansas.

Ole Miss Runs Win Streak to Five

Ole Miss ran its win streak up to five games with a win over Arkansas. It's the longest win streak of the season and the longest since Ole Miss won seven consecutive games in 2013-14. Ole Miss has three times posted three-game win streaks this season.

Best Non-Conference Season Since 2011-12

With its 10-3 non-conference record, Ole Miss posted its best start to the season since going 10-3 in 2011-12. The Rebels will now set their sights on winning more than 12 games for the first time since 2009-10 season and is in search of its first 20-win campaign since 2006-07.

Gettin' It Done at the Charity Stripe

Ole Miss went 15-of-18 from the charity stripe against Alabama A&M. The Rebels, who entered the game shooting just 61.9 percent from the free throw line, shot

a season-best 83.3 percent against the Lady Bulldogs. Tia Faleru was 8-of-9 while A'Queen Hayes was a perfect 3-of-3.

Block Party

Tia Faleru had a block party against Baylor, swatting a career-best five shots. Faleru's five blocked shots are the most for an Ole Miss player this season. She currently has 54 career blocks. She needs just one more to break into the top 5 in blocked shots in a single season at Ole Miss. Shawn Goff holds the single-season record with 67 in 2007-08. Faleru's five blocks was the most since Nikki Byrd had five against Southeast Louisiana on 2011-12.

Davis Goes For 40+

Baylor's Nina Davis scored a record 43 points against Ole Miss. The 43 points are the most points scored in the Tad Smith Coliseum, breaking Ole Miss' Peggie Gillom-Granderson's record of 39, which stood for nearly 40 years. Prior to Davis' 43, the last opponent to score 40 in the Tad Pad was Tennessee's Sheila Collins in 1985.

70 is the Magic Number

When Ole Miss can get to 70 points, the outcome is typically a win. Ole Miss is 8-0 when they can reach 70 points but conversely when they fail to get to 70 points they are 3-3. The Rebels opened the season with three straight games of 90+ points.

Did You Know?

The Rebels are looking for their first win over a ranked opponent since the 2010-11 season. Ole Miss had its first shot against No. 11 Baylor. Ole Miss will have eight

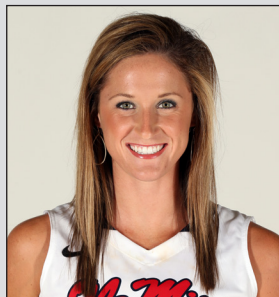
