BY THE NUMBERS

6-1 The Wildcats' record at home this season, its best since 1991 when they also went 6-1. Kentucky's six wins include three over ranked teams in 2014.

UK has now scored a 196.000 or higher in **196.150** back-to-back meets, both resulting in upset wins. After a 196.275 vs. No. 11 Auburn two weeks ago, UK scored a 196.150 last week.

8 Friday's meet at No. 1 LSU is UK's eighth against a top-eight team this year, its second against the nation's top-ranked team and its fourth in the top three.

Kentucky has scored a 49.000 or higher on floor seven times this season, **7** and UK has notched a 48.875 or better in all 10 meets. UK is ranked 16th nationally with a 49.140 RQS and a 49.113 average.

QUICK NOTES

- The No. 24 Kentucky gymnastics team closes the regular season at No. 1 LSU Friday at 8 p.m. ET in Baton Rouge, La. The top-25 matchup will be the second time UK has faced the top ranked team in the country and the eighth time the Wildcats have met a team ranked in the top eight.
- The Wildcats and Tigers met in a four-team meet earlier in the season, on Feb. 15 in Fort Worth, Texas, at the Metroplex Challenge. UK finished fourth with a 194.850, while then-No. 3 LSU placed second, behind No. 2 Oklahoma and ahead of 17th-ranked Arizona.
- The Wildcats are ranked 24th nationally with a 195.585 regional qualifying score, while LSU is first with a 197.660 RQS. UK is 16th on floor, 21st on vault, 28th on bars and 39th on beam. The Tigers are in the top five on all four events.
- UK is coming off a back-to-back meets where they scored a 196.000 or higher, both resulting in upset wins at home. After a season-best 196.275 to beat No. 11 Auburn on Feb. 28, the Wildcats downed No. 22 California and Centenary with a 196.150 on March 7 for a Senior Night victory.
- LSU has also won two in a row, with a win over Missouri before a victory over No. 25 North Carolina State. LSU's SEC win over Mizzou came with a school-record score of 198.050.

Ticket Information

NO. 24 UK CLOSES REGULAR SEASON AT TOP-RANKED LSU

The No. 24 University of Kentucky gymnastics team closes the regular season at No. 1 LSU Friday at 8 p.m. ET in Baton Rouge, La. The matchup against the nation's top-ranked team marks the second time UK has faced the nation's No. 1 team and the eighth time the Wildcats have faced a squad ranked in the top eight.

A live video stream and live results from LSU's Maravich Center will be available on LSUSports.net. The regular season finale will be broadcast by Cox Sports Television and air on March 23 at 9 p.m. ET on CST, with Lyn Rollins and Ashley Lee on the call. Live updates can also be found on Twitter at @UKgymnastics.

Friday's meet marks the second meeting between the Wildcats and Tigers in 2014. UK and LSU joined Oklahoma and Arizona in Fort Worth, Texas, on Feb. 15 at the Metroplex Challenge. UK finished fourth with a 194.850, while then-No. 3 LSU placed second with a 197.875, a school record at the time. No. 2 OU won with a 198.175.

Kentucky, 9-9 on the season and 2-4 in SEC competition, is coming off back-to-back home meets where the Wildcats scored a 196.000 or higher and upset ranked teams in both contests. After a season-best 196.275 to beat No. 11 Auburn on Feb. 28, the Wildcats downed No. 22 California and Centenary with a 196.150 on March 7 for a Senior Night victory.

LSU is 9-3 and 4-2 in the SEC. The Tigers have won two consecutive meets, both at home, with a 198.050-194.825 win over Missouri on Feb. 28 before a 197.500-195.525 victory over No. 25 North Carolina State on March 7. LSU's 198.050 marked the first time in school history the team had eclipsed the 198.000 mark. LSU has been in the top spot in the rankings for three consecutive weeks.

WILDCAT TO WATCH



Audrey Harrison • Senior • Knoxville, Tenn.

Senior Audrey Harrison is competing in her regular season meet Friday. The team's all-around leader the past three seasons, Harrison is coming off a season-best all-around performance last week. She scored a 39.325 to win the all-around title along with a 9.900 to win floor against No. 22 California and Centenary. She has won 10 event titles this year and 31 in her career and leads the team with a 9.865 RQS on floor, tied for 44th nationally and tied for 13th in the SEC.

IN THE RANKINGS

In the rankings, the Wildcats are 24th nationally with a 195.585 Regional Qualifying Score. UK boasts top-21 rankings on both floor and vault. Kentucky is 16th on floor with a 49.140 RQS and 21st on vault with a 49.075. UK also is 28th on bars with a 48.895 RQS and 39th on beam with a 48.565.

Along with the nation's top overall ranking, the Tigers are in the top five on each event, including No. 1 on vault with a 49.545 Regional Qualifying Score. LSU is also third on beam and floor and fifth on uneven bars.

RECORD-BREAKERS ON FLOOR

Through eight weeks of competition, the Wildcats are ranked 16h nationally on floor with a 49.113 average, including a UK-record 49.650 two weeks ago vs. No. 11 Auburn. Seven of UK's 12 best team scores have come on floor, with five consecutive and seven of the last eight scores of 49.000 or higher.

In Feb. 28's upset win over Auburn, the Wildcats closed with a school-record 49.650 on floor. The third-highest floor score in the country at the time, Kentucky counted five scores of 9.925 or higher. Led by senior Audrey Harrison's 9.950, juniors Shelby Hilton, Kenzie Hedges and Kayla Hartley and freshman Taylor Puryear all recorded a 9.925. UK became the third team this season to have five scores of 9.925 or higher in one meet.

Kentucky recorded a 49.125 at Missouri, followed by a 49.000 at Georgia and a 49.025 against Florida. In all three meets, it was a consistent effort from the Wildcats that resulted in the high totals. At Mizzou, all six UK gymnasts scored a 9.700 or higher, while all five Wildcats to score at UGA and against Florida each posted at least a 9.775.

FEBRUARY 15, 2014 VS. THE TIGERS

The Wildcats and Tigers previously met on Feb. 15, 2014 in Fort Worth, Texas, at the four-team Metroplex Challenge. Competing against three teams ranked in the top 17, including two of the nation's top three teams, Kentucky placed fourth with a 194.850, while LSU was second with a then-school-record 197.875. No. 2 Oklahoma won the event, while No. 17 Arizona was third.

For the second consecutive meet, UK posted a 49.000 or higher on two events, with a 49.050 on uneven bars and also a 49.050 on floor to begin the competition. The Wildcats added a 48.650 on vault and a 48.100 on balance beam. Eight individual season or career highs were set or tied, including two career-bests set by sophomore Amy Roemmele on uneven bars and balance beam. Senior Audrey Harrison competed in the all-around for the sixth time in 2014 and scored a 38.425.

UP NEXT: SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS, MARCH 22, 3 or 7 p.m. ET

Postseason competition begins for the Wildcats at the Southeastern Conference Championship in Birmingham, Ala. The SEC's eight teams will be split into two sessions, at 3 p.m. ET and 7 p.m. ET. Seeding will be announced on March 17.

LAST TIME OUT: VS. NO. 22 CALIFORNIA, CENTENARY

Kentucky sent its seniors out in style with another win over a ranked opponent with a 196.150 to defeat No. 22 California and Centenary on March 7 in Memorial Coliseum. The second consecutive score of 196.000 or higher for the Wildcats come in the home finale and resulted in an upset win over a ranked team in back-to-back meets. California placed second with a 196.075, while Centenary was third with a 189.625. UK won three individual events along with senior Audrey Harrison's win in the all-around.

Last week, UK set the program record floor score, and the Wildcats followed it up with a 49.425 Friday, the third-highest total in school history and the highest floor score among the three teams Friday night. UK's vault score of 49.275 is a season best and tied for seventh best all-time. Kentucky added

Senior Kayla Sienkowski also went out with a bang in her final home meet with a win on balance beam with a season-best 9.825 for her first career event title. Junior Kenzie Hedges tied for the vault title with a career-best 9.925, her first event title of the season.

PHIPPS NAMED TO SEC COMMUNITY SERVICE TEAM

Sophomore Tiara Phipps was named to the 2014 SEC Gymnastics Community Service Team. It is Phipps' first Community Service Team honor.

Phipps' community service work is highlighted by a mission trip with 10 other UK student-athletes to Ethiopia last summer. During the week-long trip, they repainted schools, helped build houses, supplied families with mosquito nets along with interacting with several communities.

The San Antonio, Texas, native also has volunteered with Hope for Haiti, packed meals at Southland Christian Church, assisted with the UK Blanked Project and packed backpacks for the Back Pack Program this season.

RECORD CROWDS AT HOME

In UK's four home meets this season, the Wildcats averaged 3,265 fans in Memorial Coliseum. The average marks the best home attendance for UK since at least the 1998 season, when records became available. Since 1998, the Wildcats have never averaged more than 3,000 fans.

As Kentucky beat three teams to win its season-opener on Jan. 10, it did so in front of one of the largest crowds in UK gymnastics history. A crowd of 5,839 witnessed the Excite Night victory, which marked the largest since 2007, when 6,875 were in attendance. It also marked the third-largest UK home crowd since at least 1997.

UK UPSETS NO. 11 AUBURN ON RECORD-BREAKING NIGHT

Kentucky recorded the fifth-highest team score in program history to upset 11th-ranked Auburn on Feb. 28 in Memorial Coliseum, 196.275-194.825. The Wildcats' program-record 49.650 on floor was one of three season-best team scores, all which resulted in event titles for the Wildcats. Kentucky's team score was also the second-best at home in UK history after a 196.375 last season.

Kentucky's floor score also was the third-highest in the country this year as the Wildcats improved to 5-1 against Auburn in the past three seasons, all under head coach Tim Garrison. UK has won

four consecutive regular season meets against AU.

Along with a school-record 49.650 on floor, UK posted a 49.175 on uneven bars, tied for the seventh-best in team history. Kentucky's vault score of 49.200 to open the night is tied for the 15th best in the UK record books.

The Wildcats added 12 season or career bests in the victory as Kentucky won four individual events. Individually, Kentucky tallied the top five scores on floor, all with a 9.925 or higher and all career-high scores. Senior Audrey Harrison scored a career-best 9.950, while redshirt junior Kayla Hartley, juniors Shelby Hilton and Kenzie Hedges and freshman Taylor Puryear all scored a 9.925. UK posted the top two scores on balance beam, led by Harrison's 9.925. Junior Shannon Mitchell tied for the vault title with a career-high-tying 9.900, while Hartley tied for the uneven bars title, also with a 9.900.

CAREER-HIGHS FALL IN RARE TWO-MEET WEEKEND ROADTRIP

In a rare two-meet weekend, Kentucky posted a season-best 195.975 score Feb. 21 at No. 13 Arkansas and a 195.200 two days later at No. 8 Nebraska. UK placed second among four teams at Nebraska after a loss to Arkansas, the first time the Wildcats competed twice in one weekend since 2011.

On Feb. 21 at Arkansas, UK notched a 49.150 on vault and a 48.900 on beam, while junior Shannon Mitchell led the Wildcats with a career-high 9.900 on both vault and beam, both team highs. Sophomore Amy Roemmele led UK on bars with a 9.825, while senior Audrey Harrison and redshirt junior Kayla Hartley each tallied a 9.850 on floor to lead the squad.

Two days later in Lincoln, Neb., UK scored a 195.200 in a loss to Nebraska and a win over Bridgeport and Wisconsin-Stout. Senior Holly Cunningham recorded a team-best and career-high-tying 9.900 on vault, while sophomore Amy Roemmele led the way on bars with a 9.900. Mitchell's 9.850 on beam was a team high, while Hartley paced the way with a 9.850 on floor.

UK SCORES THEN-SEASON-HIGH 195.450 VS. NO. 1 FLORIDA ON DANCEBLUE NIGHT

In its return home after three consecutive road meets, Kentucky scored a 195.450 against No. 1 Florida on Feb. 7 on DanceBlue Night. UF recorded a 197.175 to win and keep its perfect record intact.

The Wildcats tallied a season-high score by 0.300 points against the defending national champion-Gators thanks to a 2014-best vault score and six individual season-highs. For the first time this year, UK scored a 49.000 or

higher on two events, with a 49.025 on floor and a 49.000 on vault.

Audrey Harrison led UK with a 39.225 in the all-around, a season-best. Harrison also led the Wildcats with a 9.825 on beam, a 9.800 on bars and tied Kayla Hartley with a 9.825 on floor. Holly Cunningham notched a team-best 9.850 on vault.

The meet was DanceBlue Night, to raise awareness and money to benefit children with cancer being treated at UK's Pediatric Oncology Hematology Clinic. UK wore gold warm-up tops, which are being auctioned off on UKathletics.com to benefit DanceBlue. More information about DanceBlue can be found at DanceBlue.org.

CATS BEAT THREE TO WIN OPENER

In front of nearly 6,000 fans, Kentucky defeated three teams and won the annual Excite Night at the Kentucky Classic event to open the 2014 season in Memorial Coliseum on Jan. 10.

UK scored a 195.000 and claimed the top scores on vault, beam and floor. The Wildcats finished ahead of No. 15 Penn State's 193.975, while West Virginia placed third and Ball State fourth. UK senior Audrey Harrison won the all-around title with a 39.075 along with a win on beam with a 9.850. She joined redshirt junior Kayla Hartley with a meet-best 9.825 on floor.

2014 SCHEDULE NOTHING TO LAUGH AT

With 10 top-25 teams on Kentucky's 2014 slate, including four of the top five, ranked in the preseason coaches poll, the Wildcats face one of the most grueling schedules in the nation. Among top-25 teams, CollegeGymFans.com has tabbed UK's schedule as the toughest in the country, while RoadtoNationals.com ranks the Blue and White's schedule as the second-best strength of schedule among all NCAA teams. Seven of the SEC's eight teams enter the season ranked nationally, with the eighth, Missouri, receiving votes.

HIGHEST PRESEASON RANKING

The Wildcats earned their highest preseason ranking in team history at 21st. In the GymInfo Preseason Coaches Poll, UK is one of seven SEC teams ranked nationally, led by top-ranked and defending national champion Florida and No. 2 Alabama. In 2012, head coach Tim Garrison's first season, the Wildcats were ranked 23rd while they were voted 25th last season.

RETURNING STARPOWER

UK returns 13 letterwinners from the record-setting 2013 team and lost just two. Among the returners are seniors Holly Cunningham, Audrey Harrison and Kayla Sienkowski along with redshirt junior Kayla Hartley. Harrison

Kentucky's meet at Arkansas on Feb. 21 will also air on FSN, on March 1. The times for all eight of FSN's SEC gymnastics broadcasts will be announced at a later date.

The Wildcats will appear on CSS (Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast) once. Jan. 18's tri-meet, against Alabama and Nebraska in Knoxville, Tenn., will be broadcast on Jan. 24, with a time to be announced.

SEC'S ALL-AROUND LEADER IS BACK

Senior Audrey Harrison is coming off a record-setting 2013 season. One of the most consistent competitors in the nation last season, the Knoxville, Tenn., native tallied a league-leading six all-around titles in SEC meets and totaled seven in all competitions. Harrison scored a career-high score of 39.425 at Ball State and also won all-around titles against then-No. 13 Auburn, No. 9 Arkansas, No. 6 LSU, No. 6 Georgia and No. 1 Florida.

A LOOK BACK AT A RECORD-SETTING 2013

Kentucky is coming off a record-setting 2013 campaign that saw numerous school records fall. UK earned a ninth-consecutive NCAA Regional bid with a school-record regional qualifying score of 196.06 after breaking the team best score twice. A 196.775 in the regular season finale at Penn State bested the previous high score, set earlier in the season at Ball State.

The Wildcats notched three wins against SEC opponents, the most in program history and earned a 3-3-1 league mark, also a school best. All three wins were against teams ranked in the top 15, with two over top-nine foes. In postseason play, UK tallied the program's highest-ever NCAA Regional team score of 195.575 and finished fourth at the regional.

WINNING BIG AT THE CATSPY AWARDS

The Kentucky gymnastics team wrapped up a historic 2013 season by claiming the prestigious "Team of the Year Award" at the annual CATSPY Awards along with two individual awards.

Tim Garrison was named Coach of the Year alongside baseball coach Gary Henderson and rifle coach Harry Mullins, while sophomore Shannon Mitchell picked up the Scratch Award, given to the top non-scholarship student-athlete.

The 11th-annual CATSPYs recognized UK's athletic and academic performance during the year. A spin-off of the popular ESPY Awards held each year by ESPN, the CATSPYS feature 24 individual and team honors, chosen from UK's 22 varsity sports.

SEC DOMINANCE

Across all sports the Southeastern Conference is one of the toughest in the country, and gymnastics is certainly no exception. With seven of the SEC's eight teams ranked in the top 25, including four in the top five, the league is primed for another season of elite competition.

SEC schools have won eight of the last nine NCAA Championships, including the last three, but the league's dominance is nothing new. Seventeen national titles have been won by SEC schools since the inaugural NCAA Championship in 1982.

Florida captured the program's first NCAA Championship last season to join Alabama and Georgia. Four SEC teams advanced to the Super Six at last season's NCAA Championships.

The SEC has placed at least two teams among the top six in 30 of the possible 32 NCAA Championship events. A record five SEC teams advanced to the NCAA Super Six team final in 2009. The SEC also leads all conferences in NCAA individual titles (92).
