HEAD COACH GARY HENDERSON

Long considered one of the top pitching coaches in college baseball, Gary Henderson is in his fourth year as the head coach of Kentucky and his ninth season overall with the Wildcats after spending five seasons as the associate head coach.

Henderson, who was UK's associate head coach, recruiting coordinator and pitching coach for five years before becoming the 25th head coach in the history of Wildcat baseball on June 6, 2008, has been a cornerstone in the success of the UK program over the past nine years, the best nine-year run in the over 100-year history of the program.

A former national assistant coach of the year in 1996 at Florida, Henderson is in his second collegiate head coaching job, with assistant coaching stops at San Diego State, Fullerton State, Riverside CC, Pepperdine, Florida and Oregon State. Henderson's head coaching experience came as the head coach at Chapman University (Calif.), where he helped transition the program to Division I, guiding the program to a national ranking in just its first year.

Henderson's impact on the UK pitching staff has been drastic, helping transform the Wildcat staff into one of the top in the nation. Individually, impact can be seen by the improvements made to 2008 senior pitchers Andrew Albers, Brock Baber and Greg Dombrowski, a trio which exited UK among the pitching record holders. UK's 2007-08 Friday night starter Chris Rusin became the first Wildcat pitcher tabbed as a first-team All-SEC selection since current MLB reliever Scott Downs in 1997.

After securing the fourth-best recruiting class in the nation in 2008 - a school record - Henderson has helped mentor the group into the next phase of their baseball careers, most notably 2011 first-round MLB Draft pick Alex Meyer, who became the second-highest UK draft pick in program history.

With Henderson guiding the pitching staff in 2009, Kentucky ended the season setting a schoolrecord for strikeouts in a season, fanning 523 as a staff. Kentucky also had three pitchers drafted in the 2009 MLB Draft, including two players who signed contracts. Rusin, a 2009 senior, signed to play in the Chicago Cubs organization after being drafted by the Cubs in the fourth round. In 2010, UK junior Logan Darnell went in the sixth round to the Minnesota Twins, after going undrafted out of

Nashville suburb. Joelton. Tenn.

Henderson's pitching staff became a force during the 2006 SEC Championship season, ranking third in the conference in ERA. The Wildcats' pitching staff improved under Henderson immediately, as the team improved from a 5.23 ERA in 2005 to a 3.95 ERA during 2006. Most impressively, Henderson transformed the 2006 pitching staff into a weapon, using journeyman weekend starters, Dombrowski, Craig Snipp and Aaron Tennyson, a trio of players without imposing "stuff" that bought into Henderson's approach on the mound. Most notably, Henderson turned Dombrowski - a 5-foot-11 side-arm righty with an 82-mph fastball - into a 10-win performer in 2006.

Henderson and his wife, Vicki, have two sons, Alex and Ty.

Our Winter Camps are specifically designed to help players improve their individual skills. The drill work and one-on-one instruction have made Wildcat Baseball Camps an incredible success and we are dedicated to continuing this instructional excellence again this year.

We have assembled an extremely knowledgeable staff to work closely with each camper and teach him the proper techniques to succeed in baseball. Our instructors will consist of UK Baseball Coaches, current and former UK players, as well as outstanding local high school and college coaches. This staff will provide a terrific learning environment for each camper to show us his baseball talents.
