Today's Contest

Lamar will be playing its third straight road game, as well as second game in a row against a team ranked in the AP Top 5. The game will be broadcast live in Beaumont on KLVI 560 AM, and televised on ESPNU.

Series History

This will be the third meeting between the two schools with Kentucky winning the previous two on its home floor. UK won the first meeting 71-56 on Dec. 13, 1986, and took the second one 103-61 on Dec. 3, 2008.

Lamar head coach Pat Knight will be facing Kentucky for the first time, while Wildcat head coach John Calipari is 3-0 against Lamar.

Scouting Kentucky

Kentucky, which is coached by John Calipari in his third season at the school, brings an 11-1 record into tonight's game. The Wildcats are ranked third in the nation after disposing of Loyola (Md.) 87-63 last Thursday.

UK comes into tonight's game averaging 82.2 points per game on offense while allowing just 58.7. The Wildcats are pulling down 41.3 rebounds per game and outrebounding their opponents by 7.5 boards per contest. As a team, the Wildcats are shooting 49.9 percent from the field, 36.7 percent from 3-point range and 69.2 percent from the free throw line. Kentucky is easily the best shot-blocking team in the nation, swatting away 9.3 field goal attempts per game.

scoring at 16.1 points per game. He has also knocked down 26 of his 52 attempts from beyond the arc. Five other Wildcats are averaging at least 10 points per game, including freshman forward Anthony Davis who is posting 11.8 points and a team-leading 10.0 rebounds per game. Davis also is responsible for 52 of UK's 112 blocked shots, ranking second in the country in blocks per game at 4.3. Fellow freshman Marquis Teague is scoring 10.9 points to go along with his 4.5 assists per game.

Last Time They Met

Lamar and Kentucky last met on Dec. 3, 2008, with the Wildcats rolling to a 103-61 victory.

Kentucky shot a blistering 64.4 percent from the floor in the game, including 7-of-14 aim from beyond the arc, to win by 42 points. UK led 56-30 at the half, and didn't let the Cardinals get any closer than 22 points in the second half.

Lamar shot just 33.8 percent from the field, and a dismal 4-of-24 from 3-point range. UK outrebounded the Cards 38-33, and had a 46-2 advantage in points in the paint. The Wildcats also enjoyed a huge 37-5 edge in points off turnovers despite committing just two less turnovers than Lamar.

Kenny Dawkins and Coy Custer each scored 11 points to lead Lamar. Custer added seven rebounds off the bench to pace the Cardinals.

Patrick Patterson poured in 31 points in just 22 minutes of work. He was 11-of-12 from the field and 9-of-11 from the free throw line. Jodie Meeks added 19 points and six assists.

Lamar Last Time Out

Lamar last played eight games ago, falling 70-50 at No. 2 Ohio State as the Cardinals went 0-of-12 from 3-point range and Buckeye star Jared Sullinger finished with 18 points and 11 rebounds.

Lamar's only lead of the contest came with 17:25 to play in the first half as senior guard Anthony Miles hit a running jumper in the lane to give the Cards a 4-3 lead. Lenzelle Smith, Jr. answered with a 3-pointer just 22 seconds later to put the Buckeyes back on top, and they would never trail again.

The Cardinals couldn't find their shooting touch all night, going 8-of-26 (30.8 percent) from the field in the first half to trail 34-21 at the break. After hitting 8-of-11 from 3-point range at Rice on Saturday, the Cards missed all eight of their first half attempts Tuesday.

Lamar would finish the game shooting just 35.1 percent from the floor, including the 0-for-12 effort from beyond the arc.

Junior forward Stan Brown, who finished the game with 10 points and 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season, hit a pair of free throws to open the second half and pull the Cards to within 11. Despite making four of its first six shots in the second half, Lamar would get no closer the rest of the way.

The Buckeyes also struggled from the floor in the first half, shooting just 39.4 percent. However, OSU found its aim over the final 20 minutes to the tune of 51.7 percent shooting. OSU would also finish with six treys in the game to help offset a dismal 8-of-19 effort from the free throw line.

Despite a pronounced size advantage, Lamar was only outrebounded by two at 40-38. The Buckeyes did benefit from 16 Lamar turnovers, while committing just nine of their own, and outscored Lamar 13-4 in fast break points.

LU senior guard Devon Lamb was the only other Cardinal to score in double-figures, finishing with 10 points and seven boards. Mike James added

nine points, scoring seven in the first half, but was just 3-of-13 from the floor.

In addition to the big night from Sullinger, Deshaun Thomas scored 16 points for the Buckeyes. All 11 Buckeyes who played in the game scored at least two points.

Lamar vs. The Southeastern Conference

The Cardinals have played 12 games all-time against the current 12 members of the Southeastern Conference, compiling a 3-9 record.

Lamar is 1-0 against Alabama, and also has wins over LSU (1-3) and Mississippi (1-2). In addition to being 0-2 against Kentucky, Lamar is 0-1 against

Arkansas and Auburn.

Cards Get Disconnected from Long Distance

Despite the fact that Lamar is hitting only 4.3 3-pointers per game, Lamar's lowest single game effort on the season had been three makes. Against Ohio State on Dec. 20, Lamar went 0-of-12 from 3-point range, marking the first time since a 70-67 home win over Tulane on Jan. 2, 2010, that Lamar had gone an entire game without hitting a trey.

In addition to going 0-of-11 against the Green Wave, the Cardinals also had an 0-for-8 effort against Hawai'i (12/6/09) earlier that same season.

Eight different Cardinals attempted a 3-pointer against the Buckeyes. Brandon Davis was 0-of-3, and Devon Lamb and Mike James each missed two triples. Charlie Harper, Anthony Miles, Tre Lynch, Donley Minor and Vincenzo Nelson were all 0-for-1 from beyond the arc.

Cardinal Quick Hits

- Lamar is second in the Southland in blocked shots at 5.1 per game, good enough for 42nd in the country.
- Redshirt sophomore Osas Ebomwonyi is doing most of the damage in blocks, averaging 2.3 per game to stand 38th in the nation.
- Senior Devon Lamb is currently shooting 75.0 percent from the free throw line after making just 43.5 percent as a junior. Lamb made a personal-best seven free throws (on eight attempts) at Rice on Dec. 17.
- Lamar is 8-0 when outrebounding its opponent, and 7-0 when leading at the half.
- Six of the eight Cardinals' victories are by 10 points or more.
- Senior guard Anthony Miles ranks fourth in the Southland Conference in scoring at 15.1 ppg, and his 3.9 assists per game lead the league.
- Lamar is the only school in the Southland Conference to have two players ranked among the top 10 in scoring (Miles & James) and rebounding (Lamb & Harper).

Win No. 900 Comes at Rice

Lamar picked up the 900th win in school history Saturday at Rice by an 87-81 score. The Cardinals have been playing as a four-year school since the 1951-52 season.

Win No. 1 was a 52-50 victory over Northwestern State on Dec. 3, 1951,

in the third game of the season. Lamar knocked off North Texas 89-66 on Feb. 23, 1984, for the 500th win in school history. The 800th victory came on Nov. 20, 2005, when the Cardinals bested Montana State 92-82.

Knocking Down the Free Ones

Lamar has been among the best free throw shooting teams in the country, and that proved to be key in its 87-81 win at Rice on Dec. 17. The Cardinals knocked down 37-of-44 free throws (84.1 percent), including hitting 31-of-38 in the second half.

The 37 made free throws is the most Lamar has made in a game since hitting 42 in a 112-105 loss to Sam Houston State on Jan. 28, 2009.

As a team, Lamar shot 68.7 percent from the free throw line last season to rank seventh in the Southland Conference. Through 11 games this year, Lamar is hitting 74.2 percent to rank second in the Southland and 33rd in the country.

Lamar has two players ranked among the top 10 in the conference in shooting percentage in seniors Charlie Harper and Anthony Miles. Harper, who was 5-of-5 at Rice, is seventh in the conference at 81.1 percent.

Miles, who is right ahead of Harper in the SLC at 81.3 percent, had a huge night against the Owls. Miles knocked down 15 of his 18 free throw attempts to tie for the fifth-best single game mark in school history.

All 12 Cardinals have shot at least four free throws on the season, and nine are shooting over 70.0 percent on the year.

Pounding the Glass

Lamar knocked off Texas-Pan American 60-49 On Dec. 5, and one key to the victory was rebounding. Lamar finished the game with a 55-28 advantage in rebounds, setting a new Montagne Center record for rebound margin at 27 (previous high: 25 vs. Huston-Tillotson, 12/11/10).

In addition to nearly doubling up the Broncos on the glass, Lamar hauled in 20 offensive rebounds. The Cardinals enjoyed a healthy 15-2 advantage in second chance points.

For the season, Lamar is averaging 42.3 rebounds per game and limiting its opponents to 35.4. The +6.9 rebound margin per game ranks second in the Southland Conference, while the Cardinals' 42.3 per game average is fourth nationally.

Individually, the Cardinals have two of the top five rebounders in the

Southland Conference. Senior Devon Lamb is second at 8.7 rebounds per game, while fellow senior Charlie Harper is sixth at 7.4 per contest. Lamb is 63rd in the country in rebounding.

Lamar Double-Doubles

Senior guard Devon Lamb finished with 17 points and 11 rebounds at Rice (12/17) to record his team-leading third double-double of the season. Lamb, who stands just 6-foot-2, is the second-best rebounder in the Southland Conference at 8.7 rebounds per game. Lamb, who led the Cardinals with nine double-doubles last year, posted 13 points and 15 rebounds in the season opener against Arkansas State (11/11). He would add his second of the year with 15 points and 10 boards in LU's 85-65 win at Tennessee Tech (11/25).

Fellow senior Charlie Harper, who is second on the team with 7.4 rebounds per game, has two double-doubles this year. Harper posted 22 points and a career-high 18 rebounds in Lamar's 72-54 win over Charlotte (11/19). He added 21 points and 10 rebounds against TCU (11/30).

Junior Stan Brown has LU's only other double-double this season when he finished with 10 points and 10 rebounds against Ohio State (12/20). It was the second double-double of his career.

Southland Players of the Week

The Cardinals have earned three of the seven Southland Conference Player of the Week honors handed out this season.

Lamar senior guard Anthony Miles was named the Southland Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Nov. 28, and then repeated the honor one week later.

Miles earned the award the first time after helping the Cards win road games at UT Martin (80-69) and Tennessee Tech (85-65). Miles, who scored a career-high 31 points against Tech, finished the week with averages of 24.5 points, 6.0 assists and 4.5 rebounds.

The Cardinals split a pair of games the following week, losing 77-72 at TCU and winning 80-63 at home over Louisiana-Lafayette. For the week, Miles averaged 18.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists. In the two games, he made 10-of-17 shots from the floor (58.8 percent), 3-of-4 from 3-point range (75.0 percent) and 14-of-18 free throws (77.8 percent).

Fellow senior guard Mike James is the latest Cardinal to earn the honor after being recognized by the league office on Dec. 19. James was stellar in a pair of Cardinals' victories, 88-59 over Huston-Tillotson and 87-81 at Rice.

James came off the bench to score 16 against HTU, and then exploded for 26 points at Rice. He was a perfect 5-of-5 from 3-point range against the Owls, and averaged 21.0 ppg for the week.

Reaching a Miles(tone)

Senior guard Anthony Miles scored six points at Louisville on Nov. 13, to become the 19th player in school history with 1,000 career points. The senior guard from Clear Brook High School in Houston opened the 2011-12 season with 15 points against Arkansas State. He scored 188 points as a freshman, 433 as a sophomore and 358 as a junior.

Miles moved into 17th place on the all-time list following his 16-point effort against Louisiana-Lafayette. At his current scoring average of 15.1 points per game, Miles would finish the regular season with 1,447 points to move into seventh on the all-time list.

Ironically, Miles' 1,000th point did not actually go through the basket. After hitting four free throws to get within two points, his only made field goal at Louisville was actually goal tended by Chane Behanan.

Seeing 20/20

In Lamar's 72-54 win over Charlotte on Nov. 19, seniors Charlie Harper and Anthony Miles each scored at least 20 points in the game. Miles finished with an even

20 points, while Harper scored a game-high 22.

This is the fourth season for the two to play at Lamar together, and is the first time that they scored at least 20 points in the same game.

Cardinals vs. the AP Top 25

Tonight's game will be the Cardinals third game of the season against a team ranked in the AP Top 25. Lamar fell 68-48 to then No. 9 Louisville on Nov. 13 and 70-50 at No. 2 Ohio State on Dec. 21.

Lamar's last game out was against the Buckeyes, making this the third time in school history that it has faced ranked teams in back-to-back games. The Cards knocked off No. 17 Detroit 95-87 in the opening round of the 1979 NCAA Tournament before falling 95-64 to No. 4 Michigan State. Lamar also beat No. 17 Weber State 87-86 in the 1980 NCAA Tournament before beating No. 5 Oregon State 81-77 to advance to the Sweet 16. The win over the Beavers is the highest ranked opponent Lamar has ever beaten.

Following its 70-50 loss at Ohio State, the Cardinals are now 5-37 all-time against teams ranked in the AP Top 25 poll. Lamar has dropped its last 21 games against ranked opponents, with its last win coming on Jan. 26, 1985, over No. 12 Louisiana Tech (72-64).

Pat Knight facing new teams

Lamar's first six opponents of the 2011-12 season were all against schools that new head coach Pat Knight had never coached against. Knight and the Cardinals completed the six-game opening stretch with a 4-2 record.

TCU, which defeated Lamar 77-72 on Nov. 30, was the first team that Knight had ever faced as a head coach. He is now 1-3 against the Horned Frogs.

In fact, Lamar will take on 17 teams this season that Knight has never coached against (not including the Bracket Buster game). The former Texas Tech head coach has only faced eight of the teams on the Cardinals' schedule before this year.

All-Conference Cardinals

Lamar had a pair of guards voted to the Preseason All-Southland Conference Team. Devon Lamb and Mike James were both selected to the second-team in voting by the league's 12 head coaches. Lamb was an honorable mention all-conference pick last season after averaging 9.5 points and 8.3 rebounds per game. James led the Cards in scoring at 12.5 ppg.

Lamb was also named second-team all-conference by College Sports Madness, but was joined on the second team by senior guard Anthony Miles. Miles was also an honorable mention all-conference pick last year.

Caution, Road Work Ahead

The Cardinals are looking to improve their road record under head coach Pat Knight over what it has been the past five seasons. After falling at No. 2 Ohio State on Dec. 20, Lamar stands at 3-4 on the road this season.

While Lamar's 4-11 road record in 2010-11 was not great, it was an improvement over the 1-13 mark that Lamar achieved the year before (2009-10). In fact, heading into this season, Lamar is a dismal 17-53 away from the Montagne Center (not counting neutral site games) over the previous five years.

Lamar's last season with a winning road record was 2005-06 when the Cardinals were 7-6 under Billy Tubbs. Tubbs' coaching career would end on the road as Lamar fell 80-66 at Northwestern State in the semifinals of the Southland Conference Tournament.

Cardinals sign three

Lamar head coach Pat Knight signed three players in the early signing period to National Letters of Intent. All three are high school seniors, with two point guards and a wing player signing with the Cardinals.

Jason Smith is a 6-foot-4 wing player at Emmerich Manual (Ind.) High School who earned first-team all-city honors as a junior. Smith knocked down 40.0 percent of his 3-pointers on his way to averaging 19.6 points per game. An athletic wing, Smith also grabbed six rebounds a game as a sophomore.

Smith's AAU teammate Donnell Minton put up averages of 15.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and 4.4 assists per game as a junior for Northwest (Ind.) High School. A 6-foot point guard, Minton joins Smith on the preseason all-city team for his senior campaign.

The final signee is point guard Kielan Blanks from Spring Hill (Tenn.) High School. The 5-foot-10 Blank posted averages of 13.8 points and 6.5 assists as a junior. He also averaged 20 points and five assists per game at the AAU National Tournament for Nashville Stars Elite.

Billy & Pat Tubbs Court

When Lamar takes the floor at home this season, it will be on Billy & Pat Tubbs Court.

At halftime of Lamar's Feb. 19, 2011, game with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the arena floor in the Montagne Center was officially named the "Billy & Pat Tubbs Court" in honor of the legendary LU coach and his wife. Tubbs played at Lamar from 1955-57 before leading Lamar to its first two NCAA Tournament appearances, including a spot in the 1980 Sweet 16 which included a win over No. 5 Oregon State.

In 30 years as a head coach, Tubbs compiled a 641-340 record, is just the 28th coach to record 600 career wins, is the ninth head coach to record at least 100 wins at three different schools (Lamar, Oklahoma, TCU) and earned national coach of the year honors twice and conference accolades eight times. Tubbs also guided the Sooners to six straight NCAA Sweet 16 appearances and a spot in the 1988 national championship game.

Up Next for the Cards

Following tonight's game, Lamar will host Lyon College on Dec. 31 at 1p.m. The Cardinals then open Southland Conference play at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Jan. 4.

First Season at Lamar
5th Season as Head Coach

Looking to re-energize the Lamar University men's basketball program, former Texas Tech head coach Pat Knight was named to the same position at Lamar on April 5, 2011.

Knight came to Lamar after 10 seasons at Texas Tech, including the final three-plus years as head coach. Named head coach designate at Tech prior to the 2005-06 season, Knight took over for his Hall-of-Fame father Bob Knight toward the end of the 2007-08 season.

"It's an honor and a dream come true to be the head coach at Lamar University," Knight said. "It's an opportunity to build my own program and hopefully establish my own legacy in college basketball."

In three-plus seasons as head coach of the Red Raiders, Knight compiled a 50-61 record. His 2009-10 squad posted a 19-16 overall record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the postseason National Invitation Tournament before falling at Mississippi in double overtime.

Knight, who becomes the 10th person to coach Lamar since the university became a four-year institution in 1951, guided the Red Raiders to an 83-80 win over fifth-ranked Texas in just his eighth game as a head coach, while his first victory on the college level came against No. 18 Kansas State five games earlier. The Red Raiders were a solid 40-20 (.667) at United Spirit Arena under Knight.

Knight served for nearly

seven years as an assistant at Tech under his father which included four trips to the NCAA Tournament and a run to the Sweet 16 in 2005. Texas Tech enjoyed five 20-win seasons during Knight's tenure as an assistant.

Knight's professional career began as a scout and administrative assistant with the NBA's Phoenix Suns after his four-year playing career at Indiana. In 1997, Knight became an assistant coach with the Connecticut Pride of the Continental Basketball Association.

In 1998, Knight became a head coach for the first time, guiding the Wisconsin Blast of the International Basketball Association to a 19-15 record.

Knight began his college coaching career at his alma mater as an assistant for two seasons from 1998-2000. The Hoosiers were 43-20 during that time and played in the NCAA Tournament both years. In his second season at Indiana, senior guard A.J. Guyton earned AP First-Team All-America honors before becoming a second-round draft choice of the Chicago Bulls.

Knight then spent one season as an assistant at Akron before moving to Texas Tech.

A four-year letterwinner for the Hoosiers from 1991-95, Knight graduated in 1995 with a degree in sports management. During his playing days, Indiana appeared in the NCAA Tournament every season and advanced to the "Elite Eight" in 1993.

Knight and the former Amanda Shaw were married on May 10, 2002.
