#### QUICK NOTES

\*UK opens conference play this weekend, taking off to Columbia for a matchup with South Carolina on Friday before heading to Gainesville to play the Gators Sunday afternoon. Both matches will air on the SEC Network.

\*Sophomore Kaz Brown was named SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week for Sept. 21 following a weekend with 28 kills and 21 blocks in two matches.

\*Brown became the first UK middle to record a double-double in a match since 2007 with a 10-kill, 13-block performance against Louisville. Her 13 rejections also marked a new UK record for blocks in the 25-point rally scoring era and a new career high, while her 11 block assists against the Cards set a new Kentucky best for individual block assists in a four-set match during the rally-scoring era.

\*Senior setter Morgan Bergren was named one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award. Bergren is one of six players on the list to have garnered All-America honors by the AVCA in 2014 and one of 25 candidates to hold a 3.0 GPA or higher.

\*The Kentucky Wildcats are ranked No. 24 in the Sept. 21 AVCA poll. With the ranking, UK extends its ranking streak to 37 consecutive weeks, dating back to Aug. 18, 2012, the longest under head coach Craig Skinner. It is also the longest streak in program history.



#### Last Time Out: Xavier and Louisville

The 24th-ranked Kentucky Wildcats enter SEC play following a pair of 3-1 wins to cap the non-conference slate. UK first took the win over Xavier (22-25, 25-17, 25-17, 25-20) on Friday evening before taking down rival Louisville (25-27, 25-18, 25-20, 25-23) on Sunday afternoon.

Sophomore Kaz Brown paced the Cats on a weekend where she registered 23 kills and 21 blocks over the two matches. Classmate Darian Mack led the team in kills with 29, while Sharay Barnes and Anni Thomasson each had 13-kill matches. Senior setter Morgan Bergren also played well, contributing 81 assists and 11 blocks over the weekend while adding 16 digs and 10 kills.

#### Scouting the Opponent: South Carolina Gamecocks (7-6, 0-0 SEC)

Key Win: 3-1 vs. Clemson (148 Rich Kern)

Notable Loss: 0-3 at #24 Michigan (17 Rich Kern)

The Gamecocks enter Friday's matchup taking three of the last four following its 3-1 loss against Coastal Carolina on Tuesday night. Dessaa Legros leads the way for the Gamecocks, averaging 3.79 kills per set while digging 1.62 balls per set. Sarah Blomgren adds 2.83 kills each set, while Darian Dozier has a team-high 36 blocks.

#### #5 Florida Gators (8-1, 0-0 SEC)\*

Key Win: 3-1 at #3 Texas (5 Rich Kern) Notable Loss: 2-3 at Hawai'i (21 Rich Kern)

Florida enters SEC play on a nearly perfect record, with the team's lone loss to now-No. 10 Hawai'i earlier in the season. The Gators have won three straight, most recently against No. 18 Florida State. Rhamat Alhassan is UF's player to watch in the middle, where she averages 2.88 kills per set and a nation-leading 2.24 blocks.

#### **Brown Named SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week**

Sophomore Kaz Brown was named SEC co-defensive player of the week on Sept. 21. In a breakout season, Brown continued to impress over the week, where she averaged 2.88 kills per set on a .283 hitting clip and had a staggering 2.62 blocks per set. The sophomore had two phenomenal outings during the week, first posting 13 kills and tying her then-career best eight blocks at Xavier before an unbelievable defensive outing against Louisville in which she had 10 kills and 13 blocks. Brown leads the team in total points (168.5), blocks (62) and hitting percentage (.344) this season while placing second on the team in kills (133) and kills per set (3.02).

#### **Brown in National Top 20**

Following a stellar week of play, sophomore Kaz Brown finds herself among the national leaders in blocks per game. The Waterloo, Iowa, native is averaging 1.41 blocks per set, ranking No. 18 in the nation. Brown also ranks in the top 20 in total blocks, coming in at No. 19 with 62 during the 2015 campaign. Both Brown's blocks and blocks per set both rank second in the SEC, both behind Flordia's Rhamat Alhassan (2.24 B/S, 81 Total).

# Thomasson Shines in Return against Louisville

Junior Anni Thomasson returned to full action for the first time since Sept. 1 against the Louisville Cardinals and looked to be back in form. The junior outside had her 19th career double-double, registering 13 kills and 13 digs in the match. With the double-double, Thomasson moves into sole possession of fourth on the career double-doubles list for the 25-point rally scoring era, needing just three more to tie for third with Christine Hartmann (2009-12).

#### Thomasson Posed to Reach Top Five

Junior Anni Thomasson is on the verge of breaking the top five in career digs during the 25-point rally scoring era as a junior. The outside hitter has logged 633 so far, just one shy of Christine Hartmann's 634. The record during the rally scoring era is 1,924 by Stephanie Klefot.

#### **Dusek's Digs Lead Conference**

Sophomore libero Ashley Dusek leads the Southeastern Conference with a staggering 4.91 digs per set - 0.25 digs ahead of LSU's Haley Smith. Dusek's 4.91 digs per set also ranks No. 44 in the nation.

#### **Memorial Magic**

Memorial Coliseum has been the home of the Wildcats for all 39 volleyball seasons, and the historic venue has provided the Wildcats with a home court advantage unlike any other. UK was 16-4 at home in 2014.

#### Still Streaking

The 37-week streak is the longest ranked streak under head coach Craig Skinner and the longest in program history.

Premier Sports Management, Inc., announced the candidates for the 2015 Senior Class Award on Wed., Sept. 9, with Kentucky senior setter Morgan Bergren being tabbed as one of the 30 candidates for the annual honor. Bergren is one of six players on the list to have garnered All-America honors by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) in 2014 and is one of 25 candidates to hold a 3.0 GPA or higher. A national media committee narrows this field to 10 finalists per sport approximately eight weeks before the NCAA championship. Public fan voting on the Senior CLASS Award website takes place each year during the month leading up to the NCAA Championship.

#### **Breakout Weekend for Barnes**

Sophomore Sharay Barnes had a breakout performance during the Shocker Volleyball Classic, making starts against both Wichita State and Northern Illinois. In nine sets played, the outside hitter/middle blocker tallied 28 kills, while setting single match highs in kills, with 16 against Wichita State, and hitting percentage, going .600 against Northern Illinois.

# Front Line Defense Shines vs. No. 7 Illinois

Despite dropping the match in three sets, the Kentucky front line came to play against No. 7 Illinois, tying the record for block assists in a three set match during the 25-point rally scoring era with 26. Sophomore Kaz Brown led the team with a career-high-tying eight block assists, while freshman Brooke Morgan followed with a career-high six. Sophomore Emily Franklin tied her season best, registering five in the effort. Senior setter Morgan Bergren (3), sophomore Darian Mack (2) and freshman Anna Nyberg (2) all made multiple blocks as well.

#### Cats in the Top 10

On Aug. 31, the Wildcats were named No. 10 in the nation by the AVCA. It marked the first time the team had been in the top 10 since the team was ranked 10th in the Aug. 28 poll in 2012. The Cats are currently in the midst of a 35-week streak being ranked in the AVCA poll.

#### Memorial Coliseum to Host NCAA Regionals

UK is one of four sites selected for the Sweet 16 and Elite Eight matchups with one team advancing to the Final Four in Omaha, Neb., from the Lexington Region. This marks the third time in five seasons Memorial Coliseum will host this premier volleyball event. Kentucky advanced to the Sweet 16 and played in front of the largest crowd in the Craig Skinner era in 2011 where the unseeded Wildcats took No. 1 Texas to the brink. The Longhorns prevailed by a 3-1

#### Cats Dominant in Win over Northern Iowa

UK had a great all-around performance in the four-set win against Northern Iowa. On offense, the team logged a season-best 67 kills. The 67 kills ties the most kills in a fourset Kentucky match during the 25-point rally scoring era. During the match, five players had double figure kills in the match (Darian Mack, 17; Kaz Brown, 13; Anna Nyberg, 12; Brooke Morgan, 10; Sara Schwarzwalder, 10). It marked the first time four or more players had 10 or more kills since the team played Georgia Southern on September 13, 2014. Ashley Dusek had 31 digs, making her the only UK player to log 30 or more digs in multiple matches since the beginning of the 25-point rally scoring era.

The matchup with Nothern Iowa also proved to be a a big night for many individuals on the team, with five players setting or tying 10 career-bests, while two others made or tied five season-highs. Three career records were set for kills (Mack, 17; Nyberg, 12; Morgan, 10). Morgan (5) and Nyberg (2) also had a career-record five blocks, while Brown tied her career-best eight blocks. Dusek set new highs for assists (7) and service aces (3), while fellow defensive specialist McKenzie Watson had new highs in digs (9) and assists (3). Senior Morgan Bergren had a seasonbest 11 digs while tying her season-high five kills and three blocks. Classmate Sara Schwarzwalder had season highs in kills (10) while tying her season-high with three blocks.

#### Dusek Silver Lining in UNI Tournament

Dusek earned All-Tournament honors at UNI, logging 60 digs in three matches for a whopping 6.00 digs per set over the weekend. Dusek also provided four service aces during the three matches. Dusek enters this weekend on five consecutive matches charting 10 or more digs.

#### Mack's Career Night vs. Ohio

Darian Mack set new personal bests in the loss to Ohio, as the sophomore outside hitter posted her second double-double of the season. Mack had 15 kills and 15 digs in the effort, both marking new personal bests. Mack has seen an increased role in 2015,

where she's started in every match, and is currently leads the team in kills (117).

#### **Career Night for Brown**

The season opener against No. 19 Michigan State marked a career night for Kaz Brown, as the sophomore middle blocker doubled her previous single game high of 10 kills against Oakland in the first round of 2014's NCAA Tournament. Brown's 20 marks the most kills for a UK middle blockers wince the beginning of the 25-point rally scoring era. It marked the first time that a UK player had 20 or more kills since Lauren O'Conner did so with 21 against Georgia last season (11/7/14). Brown is the first middle blocker to log 20 or more kills in a match since Queen Nzenwa and Nicole Britenriker each turned the trick in 2007.

#### **Dusek Cracks the Record Books**

In addition to Brown's career night, sophomore libero Ashely Dusek also had an impressive match against No. 19 Michigan State. Dusek made history, registering 34 digs, the most ever in a five-set match in UK history in the 25-point rally scoring era. Dusek becomes just the second Wildcat to log 30 or more digs in a match, joining former player BriAnne Sauer. After her 31-dig performance vs. Northern Iowa, Dusek is also the only UK player during the 25-point rally scoring era to log multiple games with 30 or more digs.

#### Looking Back: Shocker Volleyball Classic

Kentucky enters the weekend after compiling a 1-2 record in the Shocker Volleyball Classic. On Friday, UK found itself on the wrong side of both matches in the doubleheader, first being swept by No. 7 Illinois (24-26, 19-25, 18-25) before dropping a five-set heartbreaker to host Wichita State (14-25, 26-24, 25-15, 23-25, 12-15). The Cats rallied in the final match, blanking Northern Illinois (25-19, 25-20, 25-19).

Sophomore tandem Darian Mack and Kaz Brown earned All-Tournament team honors, with both having stellar perfromances. Mack contributed a team-high 39 kills over the weekend while hitting at a .221 clip - the best she has registered over a tournament this season. Brown had 28 kills along with a team-best 18 blocks, with eight of them coming in the three-set match with Illinois. With 18 blocks, Brown registered more blocks than any one teammate or opponenet during the tournament.

#### **Looking Back: UNI Tournament**

The Wildcats had a rough outing in the most recent UNI tournament, grabbing a 1-2 record over the weekend. The Cats started strong, earning a 3-1 (25-20, 25-27, 25-19, 25-20) win over UNI. The second day was a struggle for UK, as it was swept twice in the day - first by now-No. 6 Southern California (11-25, 19-25, 21-25) before Creighton pulled the upset (23-25, 17-25, 18-25). Ashley Dusek continued her breakout season, registering an astounding 60 digs over the

weekend and adding four service aces to be named to the UNI All-Tournament Team.

#### **Looking Back: Ohio**

The Wildcats dropped their first match of the season on Sept. 1, falling to Mid-American Conference powerhouse Ohio, 3-1 (25-23, 19-25, 23-25, 28-30), despite a career day from sophomore outside hitter Darian Mack. Mack posted careerhighs in both kills and digs, registering 15 of each during the match. Ashely Dusek had another stellar performance, logging 28 digs in the match including 10 in the final frame. Both Anna Nyeberg and Sharay Barnes had personal bests in the match, logging five and four kills, respectively.

#### Looking Back: The Bluegrass Battle

The Wildcats opened the season hosting the Bluegrass Battle, where the team faced No. 19 Michigan State, IUPUI and Little Rock over the course of two days. UK exited the weekend unscathed, as the team went 3-0. Friday night's top-20 matchup came down to the wire, as the Cats prevailed, 3-2 (29-27, 15-25, 25-22, 23-25, 15-12) over Michigan State. Kentucky rolled on Saturday defeating both opponenets in straight sets (IUPUI 25-23, 25-17, 25-21; Little Rock 25-23, 25-14, 25-22). Three UK players were named to the All-Tournament team in senior Morgan Bergren and sophomores Ashely Dusek and Kaz Brown. Bergren posted 126 assists over three matches, helping guide the Cats to a .226 hitting clip. Ashley Dusek led the team in digs, logging 53 over the weekend. Brown had an outstanding weekend, posting 43 kills while hitting .411 while adding 13 blocks. For her outstanding play, Brown earned the tournament's MVP honors.

#### Bergren Tabbed to Preseason All-SEC Team

Senior Morgan Bergren was named to the preseason All-Southeastern Conference team as voted on by the league's coaches, while the Wildcats were tapped to finish third in the league standings. Bergren led UK with 1,291 assists in 2014, the second most in a single season in program history in the 25-point rally scoring era. The Muncie, Ind., native directed the UK offense to a .272 hitting percentage and a Southeastern Conference-best 14.25 kills per set, both the highest totals by the Wildcats since 2009. Along with earning American Volleyball Coaches Association second-team All-America accolades as well as All-Region honors, she was an All-SEC selection as a junior. Bergren earned SEC Player of the Week honors on Oct. 6, 2014 after she led UK to a .306 attacking percentage with six players averaging 1.29 kills per set or better in Kentucky's wins over Alabama and No. 21 Texas A&M. Bergren had 43 or more assists in each win and added 11 kills on .579 hitting with no errors.

#### Wildcats Ranked in the Preseason Again

For a program-record fourth consecutive year, the Kentucky volleyball team will begin the season ranked in the American

Volleyball Coaches Association's preseason top-25 after the Wildcats earned a No. 15 ranking in the poll. UK's spot in the top 25 poll marks the sixth time in the last seven years in which the Wildcats have earned a place in the preseason poll, all under 11th-year head coach, Craig Skinner. The preseason ranking marks the 77th time under Skinner the Wildcats have been ranked in the preseason, weekly or final poll by the AVCA. Kentucky debuted at No. 17 in 2013 and has been ranked in the top 25 every week since then.

Wildcats Earn AVCA Academic Award

For the first time in head coach Craig Skinner's tenure, the Kentucky volleyball team has earned the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Team Academic Award for the 2014-15 season. The Wildcats posted a GPA above a 3.3 both semesters in 2014-15, including a 3.563 in the spring, the second-highest GPA among all UK teams. The team's 3.378 GPA among scholarship student-athletes in the fall of 2014 ranked seventh among all UK teams.

#### 2015 Class Ranked No. 10 in the Nation

Kentucky's incoming class comprised of setter Olivia Dailey, middle blocker Brooke Morgan, outside hitter Anna Nyberg and defensive specialist McKenzie Watson has earned the distinction as PrepVolleyball.com's 10th rated class for 2015. The 2015 class marks the sixth top-20 class in Craig Skinner's tenure. Since Skinner's arrival, the Wildcats have hauled in nine classes rated in the top 30 of PrepVolleyball.com's rankings including his very first class in 2006 which came in at No. 26. That class included future Southeastern Conference Player of the Year and two-time All-American setter Sarah Rumely. In all, Kentucky has recruited 12 players who have garnered 17 All-America accolades during their careers. Players from these recruiting classes have notched 20 All-SEC distinctions and at least one member of every freshman class has earned an All-SEC Freshman team nod during Skinner's tenure.

#### Bergren and Team USA

Kentucky volleyball junior setter Morgan Bergren was selected as one of six setters to the U.S. Collegiate National Team this summer. The 36-member team trained and competed in conjunction with the USA Volleyball Girls' Junior National Championships, June 21-29 in New Orleans, La. Bergren led her squad to the championship of the event. UK's senior setter also competed for the U.S. Collegiate National Team last summer during a 10-day trip to China.

#### Ten In Ten

Kentucky is one of just 10 teams in the country to advance to the NCAA tournament in each of the last 10 seasons. UK joins Colorado State, Florida, Hawai'i, Nebraska, Penn State, Southern California, Stanford, Texas and Washington in achieving the feat.

#### **NCAA Revival Under Skinner**

When head coach Craig Skinner arrived in Lexington prior to the 2005 season, UK had made six NCAA Tournaments, most recently in 1993 and never in more than two consecutive seasons. Ten years later, the Wildcats have advanced to the postseason in each of Skinner's 10 seasons. Kentucky made its first NCAA Tournament under Skinner in 2005, won its first postseason match since 1992 in 2006 and advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2009. UK's Sweet 16 run in 2009 was UK's first regional appearance since 1993 and the first time the Wildcats had won two NCAA matches in the same season since 1989. Five times under Skinner's leadership, UK has earned a national seed and hosted the first and second

rounds.

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into a national prominence once again. Skinner has directed the Wildcats to 10 consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only 12 other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes THREE Sweet Sixteen appearances in the last six seasons. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured 17 or more victories in all 10 seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying 20 or more wins in SEVEN of the last EIGHT, including 2014.

He became the fastest coach in school allure to total 100 career victories in just his fifth season, and is the only coach in program history to advance to postseason play in each season at the helm. With the team's 3-1 victory over Georgia Southern on Sept. 13, 2014, he eclipsed Kathy DeBoer as the winningest coach in UK volleyball history.

Twelve players have garnered 18 All-America distinctions, while UK has hauled in 37 All-Southeastern Conference honors in his 10 seasons - including the 2008 SEC Player of the Year, 2006 SEC Freshman of the Year, 2010, 2011,2012 and 2014 SEC Libero of the Year and the 2005 SEC Defensive Player of the Year.

The Wildcats have enjoyed unprecedented success which has included a school-record run of 33 consecutive weeks ranked in the top 25 of the American Volleyball Coaches Association poll, record-breaking attendance marks and a six time host of NCAA Tournament play including serving as one of four host sites for the 2011 and 2013 NCAA Regionals. UK is slated to host against in 2015.
