RAZORBACK NOTES

WHAT A START

With their win over No. 9 Florida, the Razorbacks improved to 13–2 overall and 3–0 in SEC play. The 13–2 start ties the best start in program history (1998) while Arkansas is 3–0 in conference play for the first time since 2003. The win was also the Razorbacks' first vs. Florida since 2007.

FIVE SETS. NO PROBLEM

Arkansas moved to 4–0 in five setters this season with its win over Florida. The Razorbacks' five-set victories have come against Florida, Wisconsin, Kansas State and LSU.

JOINING THE NATION'S BEST

Breaking a 15-year absence, the Razorbacks entered the Oct. 5 release of the AVCA coaches' poll as the No. 22 team in the country. Arkansas had been receiving votes in the previous two polls and last appeared in the top 25 in the final ranking of the 1999 season.

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS

For just the sixth time in program history, and for the first time since 2002, the Razorbacks won 10 matches in one month with their 10-1 record in September. In the month, Arkansas played six teams (5-1) that played in last year's NCAA Tournament.

DUO EARNS SEC HONORS

Pilar Victoria earned SEC Player of the Week honors (Sept. 28) after averaging 5.56 kills per set, 3.11 digs per set and 6.11 points per set in road wins over LSU and Texas

NCAA WEEKLY RANKING | THE OFFENSE

Through the first six weeks of the season, Arkansas ranks 22nd in the NCAA with a .267 hitting percentage and 42nd in the country with 12.98 assists per set. Individually, Adrien Wohlschlaeger is 26th among the nation's setters with 11.15 assists per set.

1-2 PUNCH

Chanell Clark–Bibbs, a top–six performer in three statisical categories within the SEC, is 38th in the NCAA with her .396 hitting percentage. From the outside, Pilar Victoria is 14th in the country with 4.47 kills per set and 18th among the nation's attackers with 5.01 points per set.

DIG BABY DIG

With her match-high nine digs against Northwestern State (Sept. 11), senior Monica Bollinger moved into 14th place on the program's all-time digs list. She currenly has 883 career digs, just 18 shy of becoming the 13th player in program history to reach 900. Bollinger had a season high 13 digs in a five-set win over Kansas State (Sept. 19).

GOING THE DISTANCE (AGAIN)

For a third-consecutive match, Arkansas found itself in a fifth set and came away with the win over LSU (Sept. 23) in the team's SEC opener. It marked the eighth time Arkansas played three-straight five setters. Arkansas is 7–1 in SEC openers under head coach Robert Pulliza.

30-KILL CLUB

Pilar Victoria became the seventh Razorback in program history with 30 kills when she reached the milestone in the SEC opener at LSU (Sept. 23). She is the first to do so since Kelli Stipanovich in 2011, and just the second Razorback with 30 kills in a road match (Krystal Osborne).

CLOSING TIME

In the win at LSU (Sept. 23), the Razorbacks hit .632 (13–1–19) in the fifth set to clinch the SEC opener. During its run of five–set wins, Arkansas hit .394 with just six attack errors in the decisive sets against K–State, Wisconsin and LSU.

NELLIE!

Chanell Clark-Bibbs earned espnW National Player of the Week honors (Sept. 23) after hitting .443 with 3.85 kills per set and 1.31 blocks per set at the Creighton Classic. She totaled 50 kills during the weekend including a career-high 24 kills in Arkansas' win over No. 11 Wisconsin. She also tied a career high with eight total blocks against Kansas State.

MORE THAN A FRESHMAN

On the heels of a weekend highlighted by 26 digs against Kansas State, libero Okiana Valle was recognized as the SEC Freshman and Player of the Week (Sept. 21). She averaged 3.92 digs per set at the Creighton Classic and helped the defense total 95 digs against K-State which is the most by the program since 2006.

SUPER SATURDAY

The Razorbacks capped their non-conference slate with a pair of top-30 victories Sept. 19 at the Creighton Classic. In a pair of five-set thrillers, Arkansas knocked off No. 11 Wisconsin and Kansas State, which was one spot out of that week's AVCA Top 25. The win over the Badgers gave the

NOTHING HITS THE FLOOR

In its five-set win over Kansas State (Sept. 19), the defense picked up a season-high 95 digs. The effort was led by a career-high 26 digs by Okiana Valle who paced a quartet of Razorbacks with at least 10 digs. Kori Ortiz also tallied a career high with 18 digs in the match. The display marks the most digs by Arkansas since 2006 and currently stands as the 13th-best effort in program history.

OFF TO A GOOD START

Arkansas' 10 wins entering SEC play match the program high for wins going into conference play. The run of wins included top-30 victories over No. 11 Wisconsin and Kansas State and a six-match winning streak which ties the longest streak under head coach Robert Pulliza.

SEC SETTER OF THE WEEK

After averaging 12.33 assists per set and setting the team to a .327 hitting percentage, junior Adrien Wohlschlaeger was named the SEC Setter of the Week (Sept. 14). She had a career-high 44 assists in a sweep of UT Arlington (Sept. 12) and is now 7-1 as the starting setter.

RAZORBACK INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONS

Arkansas posted three straight-set victories in winning the Razorback Invitational. Pilar Victoria was named the MVP, Okiana Valle earned Outstanding Libero honors while Chanell Clark-Bibbs and Liz Fortado were selected to the all-tournament team. Arkansas had wins over Northwestern State, Southeast Missouri and UT Arlington.

CAREER HIGH FOR DAPIC

5 p.m.

In the team's win over UT Arlington (Sept. 12), junior Barbara Dapic registered a career-high 12 kills, surpassing her previous best of 11 kills against Creighton in the first round of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

PRESSURE FROM THE SERVICE LINE

Arkansas tallied 19 service aces during its weekend run to the Razorback Invitational title. Chanell Clark–Bibbs led the way with six aces, followed closely by four each from Barbara Dapic and Okiana Valle. Clark–Bibbs has at least one aces in four–straight matches.

SIUE COUGAR CLASSIC CHAMPS

With an undefeated run through Louisiana Tech, Northern Kentucky and host SIUE, the Razorbacks claimed the title at the Cougar Classic in Edwardsville, III. Chanell Clark-Bibbs (.489, 2.80 k/s) was named the tournament MVP while Pllar Victoria (.255, 4.10 k/s, 2.30 d/s) earned a spot on the all-tournament team.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST VS LA TECH

Arkansas posted a season-high .416 hitting percentage in sweeping Louisiana Tech (Sept. 4). The figure stands as the No. 12 overall showing in program history and the seventh best against a non-conference opponent, and was Arkansas' highest since hitting .434 against Ole Miss in 2013.

ARKANSAS INVITATIONAL ALL-TOURNAMENT

Chanell Clark-Bibbs (.417, 2.64 k/s, 1.09 b/s) and Pilar Victoria (4.45 k/s, 3.18 d/s, two double-doubles) were named to the Arkansas Invitational All-Tournament Team. Victoria reached 10+ kills in each match.

ON THE WAY TO 500

With her second kill against Army West Point (Aug. 29), Liz Fortado recorded the 400th kill of her career, and enters the Creighton Classic just 43 shy of reaching 500. She had a season-high 16 kills against the Black Knights.

WELCOME TO BARNHILL

In a continuing trend of re-writing the attendance records list, the Razorback fans tallied the seventh- and eighth-largest crowds in program history (see page 6). Five of the top-10 home crowds at Barnhill Arena have come during a season-opening weekend.
